THE FAST BREAK

▶ Off to its first 4-0 start under head coach Jennie Baranczyk, No. 25/21 Oklahoma travels to Charlottesville this weekend for a Sunday matchup at Virginia (3-0, 0-0 ACC) at 1 p.m. The contest is OU's second road game against a Power Five opponent this season as the Sooners knocked off then-No. 12 Ole Miss, 80-70, in Oxford on Nov. 9. The game will air on ACC Network with Brenda VanLengen and Brooke Weisbrod on the call, while Chad McKee calls the action on the Sooner Radio Network.

▶ One of the nation's best offenses once again, Oklahoma is scoring 91.8 points per game through four games and has reached 90 points in all but one game (at Ole Miss) this season. The Sooners' nearly 92 PPG rank 15th nationally and is powered by a Big 12-best 23.5 assists per game (7th NCAA) and the 23rd-best rebounding margin (15.2) in the country. OU is shooting 49.8% this season and is doing so at a blistering pace of 83 possessions per game (16th NCAA).

► OU's 2023-24 season marks the 50th in program history as Oklahoma launched its women's basketball program in the 1974-75 year. Since its inception, Oklahoma has won a total of 12 conference championships and appeared in three Final Fours. The Sooners' 23 appearances in the NCAA Tournament are the second most in the Big 12 and 23rd most in the country.

NOTE OF THE NIGHT

▶ Oklahoma's offensive attack is highlighted by its balance, as five different Sooners score in double figures. The Sooners are one of 27 teams nationally to boast five or more scorers that average 10.0 PPG, and the only team to do so in the Big 12 among teams that are 4-0. Payton Verhulst (15.8), Skylar Vann (13.5), Aubrey Joens (13.0), Sahara Williams (11.0) and Lexy Keys (10.3) all score over 10 PPG for the Sooners.

► OU is 12-13 all-time vs. teams from the ACC, but is 2-1 in the state of Virginia.

Sunday's game is a reunion of sorts as Baranczyk and Agugua-Hamilton have met four times previously as head coaches when the two led Drake and Missouri State, respectively. Augugua-Hamilton is 4-0 vs. Baranczyk and also knocked off Oklahoma, then coached by Sherri Coale, in Norman on Nov. 14, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT: OU 92, BAMA ST 46

► No. 25/21 Oklahoma improved to 4-0 for the first time under head coach Jennie Baranczyk on Wednesday, following a 92-46 win over Alabama State at Lloyd Noble Center in Norman. Skylar Vann scored her 1,000th career point en route to a team-high 16-point, nine-rebound performance. Over 8,900 kids powered the Sooners (4-0, 0-0 Big 12) to victory as the program celebrated the largest Field Trip Day since 2018.

50 YEARS OF OU WOMEN'S HOOPS

▶ Improve Baranczyk's record vs. non-conference opponents to

► The 2023-24 campaign marks the 50th season of Oklahoma Women's Basketball as they program's inception came on the heels of 1972 Title XI legislation. The program's inaugural season came in 1974-75 when OU went 2-14 under head coach Amy Dahl.

► Since then, OU has won 892 games and made 23 NCAA Tournaments, reaching the Final Four three times and winning 12 conference championships.

► In Oklahoma's 50 years of basketball, the program has produced 49 All-America honors and 15 WNBA Draft picks.

PULSE OF THE POLLS

The Sooners rose to **No. 25** in the latest AP poll after opening the season without receiving votes in the preseason poll. OU was tabbed at No. 21 in the WBCA Coaches Poll.

► OU's debut in the AP poll marks the third consecutive season that OU has appeared in the AP poll under head coach Jennie Baranczyk. OU has now been ranked in the poll in 25 different seasons (20 since 2000).

► The Sooners have appeared in 16 of the last 17 editions of the AP poll.

THE MARCH TO MADNESS

The Sooners appear in the latest version (Nov. 14) of Charlie Creme's ESPN Bracketology as a No. 6 seed.

A staple of the NCAA postseason, Oklahoma has appeared in 23 NCAA Tournaments, including 21 since the turn of the century and back-to-back berths under Baranczyk. The Sooners' 23 appearances in the tournament are the second most in the Big 12 Conference and the 23rd most in NCAA history.



OKLAHOMA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

POINTS ON THE PRAIRIE

► If you want to see high-octane offense, then come to Norman, Oklahoma. The Sooners are averaging 91.8 points per game this season and have posted three games of 90+ points. Guided by a blistering pace of 83 possessions per game, the Sooners are one of the nation's best and most efficient offenses.

▶ One of the country's most prolific offenses over the last two seasons, Oklahoma averaged 84.2 points last season (2nd NCAA) and 82.6 PPG the season before (3rd NCAA). The Sooners join lowa as the only team in the country to average 850.0 PPG in each of the last two years.

Baranczyk's teams are known for prolific offense and the head coach has delivered in Norman. In her Oklahoma tenure, the Sooners have **posted 90+ points 25 times** (2nd in NCAA since start of 2021-22 season) and are 24-1 in such games.

► Oklahoma's eight games of 90 points vs. Power Five opponents in 2022-23 were the most in the country and the team's 12 total games of 90+ were also first in the nation.

The Sooners have posted 100 points six times under Baranczyk, the most in the Big 12 since 2021-22.

Oklahoma gets its scoring in different ways, but does so in bunches in the transition game. OU's 24.3 fast break points per game rank fifth nationally and account for 26.4% of the Sooners' points.



- Skylar Vann became the 39th Sooner to eclipse 1,000 career points on Nov. 15, 2023.

RECIPES FOR SUCCESS

▶ Over the last two years, Oklahoma is 22-1 under Baranczyk when holding opponents under 70 points. On the flip side, the Sooners are 43-2 (undefeated in 2022-23 and 2023-24) under her when scoring 80 points or more.

Perhaps the most indicative KPI is that Oklahoma is 43-1 under Baranczyk when shooting a better percentage from the floor than the opponent, and 40-4 when holding its opponent under 42% from the floor.

Starting fast is critical for the Sooners, who are 35-2 in the last two years when leading at the half. Since 2021-22, Oklahoma is 43-7 when winning the rebounding battle, including an 18-4 record last year.

DIME TIME

Oklahoma women's basketball has become synonymous with assists in the Baranczyk era. The Sooners ranked third nationally last season with 20.8 APG and fifth in 2021-22 (18.8 APG). OU joins lowa as the only teams to rank inside the top five in each of the last two seasons.

► The Sooners averaged **23.5 assists** this season, good for first in the Big 12 and seventh nationally. OU's **30 dimes** in the win over Oral Robers (11/12) were the most for an OU team in the Big 12 era (1996-present).

Eight different Sooners have at least one career game with five or more assists: Nevaeh Tot (18), Kennady Tucker (4), Skylar Vann (3), Lexy Keys (3), Payton Verhulst (2), Reyna Scott

PAINTING A MASTERPIECE

(2), Beatrice Culliton (1) and Aubrey Joens (1).

A staple of the OU offense is its points in the paint, which have ranked inside the top 30 in each of the last two seasons. With Oklahoma's depth, the 2023-24 campaign will look to be no different.

Last season, the Sooners posted 37.3 paint points/game (18th NCAA, 2nd Big 12) and 34.2 paint pts/game in 2021-22, good for first in the Big 12. Through four games this year, OU is posting 49.0 paint pts/game (7th NCAA, 1st Big 12) and is doing so by making a Big 12-best 58.9% of its FGA inside the painted area.

PLAYER HIGHS IN THE BARANCZYK ERA

ONE LAST TIME AROUND THE BIG 12 BLOCK

► The 2023-24 campaign is Oklahoma's last as a member of the Big 12 Conference, as the Sooners will move into the Southeastern Conference on July 1, 2024.

Since the Big 12 was launched in 1996, OU has been a stalwart of the league's women's basketball contingent. OU has won 11 Big 12 championship, reaching the NCAA Tournament 21 times since 1996, tied for second most in the league. All-time, Oklahoma has posted a 352-265 (.570) record vs. Big 12 teams.

▶ Oklahoma will join the SEC, a league that is has an all-time record of 81-77 against. Under Baranczyk, OU is 4-0 vs. SEC teams and has two scheduled games (Ole Miss [W] & Tennessee) vs. teams from the league in 2023-24.

EYES ON SKY

Skylar Vann will look to star for the Sooners this season. The Big 12's only two-time Big 12 Sixth Player of the Year, Vann was named to the Cheryl Miller Award watch list, awarded annually to the nation's best small forward.

► Vann, named to the **preseason All-Big 12 team**, is the only player in Big 12 history to win the league's Sixth Player Award twice. An honorable mention All-Big 12 selection last season, she posted 11.5 points, a team-high 6.8 rebounds and a career-high 2.1 assists per game, and her 20 games of double-digit points a season ago were the most in the Big 12 among players without a start.

► In the last 15 years of women's college basketball, there have only been two seasons in which a player with one or fewer starts has averaged 11.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game – Vann is responsible for both.

She poured in a **career-high 24 points** (9-of-18 FG) to help OU knock off No. 12 Ole Miss in Oxford on Nov. 9, securing OU's first non-conference road win over a top-25 team in 16 years.

TOT TIME

The Oklahoma offense runs through veteran starting point guard **Nevaeh Tot** who entered the season having played in 94 games as a Sooner, including 76 starts (every game in 2022-23).

► Tot, a 5'3" guard from Columbus, Ohio, had the best season of her career last year, averaging 7.5 points. 3.0 rebounds and 3.7 assists per game. She is the first Sooner since Morgan Hook to post three consecutive seasons of 100 assists, and she is one of just two active Big 12 players to do so.

An All-Big 12 Freshman Team selection in 2021, Tot entered the season with 17 career games of five or more assists.

WELCOME TO THE SAHARA SHOW

► Freshman **Sahara Williams** will look to shine in a big way in her first season as a Sooner. A consensus five-star prospect from Waterloo, lowa, Williams was a McDonald's All-American and two-time U18 3x3 gold medalist from USA Basketball. Ranked as the No. 23 prospect in the 2023 class, Williams averaged 21.2 points, 10.1 rebounds, 4.7 assists and 3.2 steals per game as a senior at Waterloo West High School (lowa).

► In just her second game as a Sooner, she posted a 13-point, 11-rebound double-double, becoming the sixth Sooner freshman ever to tally a double-double in one of their first two games. She joined Courtney Paris and Madi Williams as the only Sooner to do so since 2000.

P IS A PROBLEM

► Payton Verhulst, a five-star prospect that spent two years at Louisville, had a career day against Oral Roberts (11/12). The guard finished with 32 points, six rebounds, six assists and three blocks. Her stat line made her the only player in the country since at least 1999 to score 32 points on 80% shooting with 6 assists and 3 blocks

► Her effort vs. the Golden Eagles also made her the fourth Big 12 player since 2001 to post 32-6-6 and just the second Sooner, joining Danielle Robinson.



- Sahara Williams is the ninth McDonald's All-American to call Oklahoma home.





- Payton Verhulst was a top-15 recruit in the 2021 class per ESPN and transferred to 0U from Louisville during the 2023-23 season.

► As a team, Oklahoma has been one of the most lethal 3-point shooting squads in the country over the last few seasons. Since 2021-22, OU has 50 games where it's sunk eight or more 3-pointers (3rd NCAA), and is 43-7 in such games.

SOONER MAGIC

The Sooners have used Sooner Magic to **come back from double-digit deficits 12 times** in the Baranczyk era to win, including three times vs. ranked opponents.

Jennie Baranczyk was named the ninth head coach of the Oklahoma women's basketball program on April 10, 2021, and will enter her third season at the program's helm in 2023-24.

Baranczyk (pronounced bah-RAHN-check), a 12-year head coach, spent nine seasons at Drake before starting her Oklahoma tenure in 2021-22. In each of her first two seasons in Norman, Baranczyk was a WBCA National Coach of the Year finalist. Her 51-16 (.761) record marked the best two-year start in program history.

In her second season at Oklahoma, Baranczyk led Oklahoma to its first Big 12 championship since 2009. The Sooners posted a 14-4 record in league play to share the conference's regular season title en route to a

play to share the conference's regular season title en route to a 26-7 overall record and second consecutive NCAA Tournament. The Sooners swept a program-record six teams in league play, and the team's 26 wins were the most for Oklahoma in 13 years.

She coached Madi Williams to a unanimous All-Big 12 first-team selection, Taylor Robertson and Ana Llanusa to second-team honors and Skylar Vann to an honorable mention. Vann also won the league's Sixth Player Award for the second consecutive year, and freshman Beatrice Culliton earned an All-Freshman nod. In addition, Baranczyk developed Williams into one of the nation's top players, as the forward became OU's first WNBA Draft Pick (18th overall) since 2013. Williams and Robertson earned WBCA All-America honors, and Williams garnered an AP All-America nod, too.

In her first year in Norman, she led one of the greatest turnarounds in the country, guiding the Sooners to a 25-9 record and into the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The 13-win improvement from the season before Baranczyk's arrival was the second-largest turnaround in program history. The Des Moines, Iowa, product was named a WBCA National Coach of the Year finalist for her efforts. In

She became the only first-year head coach in OU history to sweep Baylor and Oklahoma State in the regular season and added a win over Texas in her first campaign. Her four wins over top-25 teams were the most for a first-year Sooner head coach and were the most for the program since 2009-10, the last time OU posted 25 wins in a season.

She coached two Sooners, Taylor Robertson and Madi Williams, to unanimous first-team All-Big 12 selections, the first Sooner pair to do since 2012. Under Baranczyk's watch, Skylar Vann was named the 2022 Big 12 Sixth Player of the Year, and Kelbie Washington earned All-Big 12 Freshman Team honors. Robertson became OU's first All-America selection since Aaryn Ellenberg in 2014, earning an honorable mention.

Baranczyk came to OU after amassing a 192-96 (.667) record at Drake and leading the Bulldogs to six consecutive 20-win seasons (2014-15 through 2019-20) and three NCAA tournament berths (2017-19). A two-time Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year, Baranczyk's .667 winning percentage ranks fifth in the league's history.

Baranczyk won back-to-back MVC Coach of the Year awards after her team's historic 2016-17 and 2017-18 campaigns, leading the Bulldogs to an 18-0 regular-season conference record both years and winning both MVC Tournaments. And after the 2018-19 squad posted a 17-1 league record, the Bulldogs had amassed a near-perfect three-year MVC mark of 53-1 (.981).

Drake's 2016-17 team finished with a 28-5 record, including a school- and MVC-record 22-game winning streak. That season, Baranczyk was named Mid-Major Coach of the Year by ESPNW.

Three of Baranczyk's players at Drake combined to win five Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Year awards. During her Drake tenure, she produced 24 all-conference selections, including a league-high 18 first-team honorees and a league-leading 38 MVC Player of the Week winners. In addition, she coached four players to MVC Freshman of the Year honors and the program's first two MVC Defensive Player of the Year recipients in 2018 and 2019.

Baranczyk began her coaching career in the Big 12 Conference, serving first as an assistant coach at Kansas State during the 2005-06 season (the Wildcats won the WNIT) and returning to the league as an assistant coach at Colorado from 2010-12. Between her Big 12 stints, Baranczyk served as an assistant coach at Marquette from 2006-10, helping the Golden Eagles to an 81-53 record and four postseason appearances. The 2007-08 squad won the WNIT title.

Formerly Jennie Lillis, Baranczyk spent her collegiate career at the University of Iowa (2000-04) and is regarded as one of the best all-around players in Hawkeye women's basketball history. She was a three-time All-Big Ten Conference selection, earning first-team honors as a junior (2003) and second-team recognition as a sophomore (2002) and senior (2004).

Baranczyk, who obtained a master's degree in counseling and student development from Kansas State in 2006, is married. She and her husband, Scott, have a son, Eli, and two daughters, Jordi and Hope.




