## FOR OPENERS

- UVA begins its 119th season of men's basketball, sporting a 1,720-1,204 (.588) all-time record.
- Virginia meets Tarleton State for the first time.
- UVA is 23-2 in its last 25 season-opening games.
- UVA is 12-2 in season openers under head coach Tony Bennett. -The Cavaliers are 95-23 all-time in 118 season-opening games. - UVA is $91-10$ at JPJ in non-conference action under Bennett.


## SEASON STORYLINES

-Virginia returns one starter (Reece Beekman) from last season's team that won the ACC regular season title (15-5) and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
-The Cavaliers return 28.1 percent of their scoring from last season compared to 91.4 percent from 2021-22.
-Virginia's roster includes eight newcomers, including transfers Jake Groves (Oklahoma), Jordan Minor (Merrimack) and Andrew Rohde (St. Thomas), and freshman Blake Buchanan, Elijah Gertrude, Anthony Robinson, Christian Bliss (redshirt) and Desmond Roberts.

- Leon Bond III and Dante Harris (Georgetown) will make their UVA debuts after redshirting last season.
- In addition to head coach Tony Bennett (Green Bay), UVA's roster includes Wisconsin natives Beekman (Milwaukee), Bond III (Wauwatosa) and Rohde (Milwaukee).
- Bennett begins his 15th season at Virginia and 18th overall. He is 341-125 at UVA and 410-158 overall.
- Associate head coach Ron Sanchez returns to Virginia after serving the last five seasons as head coach at Charlotte from 2018-23. Sanchez served nine seasons on Bennett's staff from 2009-18, the last three as associate head coach.

VIRGINIA RECEIVES VOTES IN AP PRESEASON RANKINGS

- UVA received votes in the AP preseason top-25 poll.
- UVA is not ranked in the AP preseason top-25 poll for the first time since 2017-18 when it received votes.
- Prior to this year, UVA was ranked in the preseason AP top-25 five consecutive seasons and nine of the last 10 seasons under Tony Bennett.


## BEEKMAN EARNS PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS

- Reece Beekman was named to the preseason All-ACC first team.
- In 2022-23, Beekman was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, All-Defensive Team and All-ACC Third Team.
- Beekman ranked second nationally and first in the ACC in assist/turnover ratio (3.36), and ranked second in steals (1.8 spg) and third in assists (5.3 apg).


## H00 ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

-We play defense, take quality shots, pass the basketball, limit turnovers and transition points, rebound and play more defense. - UVA returns one starter - Reece Beekman ( $9.5 \mathrm{ppg}, 5.3 \mathrm{apg}$, $3.0 \mathrm{rpg} \& 1.8 \mathrm{spg})$ - from last season's ACC regular-season champion and NCAA tournament team that finished 25-8.

- Beekman, who earned All-ACC third-team honors last season, needs 63 steals to pass Othell Wilson (222 steals from 198184) for first all-time at UVA.
- In 2021-22, Beekman became the first ACC player since Grant Hill (1993-94) to register at least 175 assists, 50 steals and 25 blocks in a season.
- Isaac McKneely, Ryan Dunn and Taine Murray also return. McKneely averaged 6.7 points and shot a team-best 39.2 percent from 3-point range, while Dunn tallied 2.6 points and 2.9 rebounds in 12.9 minutes per game.
- Transfers Andrew Rohde (17.9 ppg), Jake Groves ( 6.8 ppg ) and Jordan Minor (17.4 ppg), redshirts Leon Bond III and Dante Harris (11.9 ppg at Georgetown in 2021-22) and newcomer Blake Buchanan will contribute immediately.
- Elijah Gertrude, Anthony Robinson, Christian Bliss and recruited walk-ons Desmond Roberts and Tristan How round out the roster


## THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- UVA is 231-54 (.811), including a 15-1 mark (10-0 ACC) in 2022-23, in 17 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Virginia finished 10-0 at home in ACC league play last season for the first time since the ACC expanded to a 20 -game schedule.
$\cdot$ UVA is 193-38 (.836), including a 158-23 (.873) mark the past 11 seasons, at JPJ under Bennett.
- UVA has an ACC-leading 88 wins in league home games over the past 11 seasons. Duke is second at 87 .
- UVA has won $10+$ home games for 13 straight seasons.

## VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNEIT

- Dean and Markel Families Head Men's Basketball Coach Tony Bennett has a 341-125 (.732) mark in 14 seasons at UVA and 410-158 (.722) career mark in 17 seasons as a head coach.
- Bennett passed Terry Holland (326-173, 16 seasons) as UVA's all-time winningest coach with the win over Syracuse $(1 / 7 / 23)$. - Bennett recorded his 400th career win at Wake Forest (1/21/23).
Bennett has guided the Cavaliers to six ACC regular-season titles (2014, 2015, 2018, 2019, 2021, 2023), two ACC Tournament titles (2014 and 2018) and one NCAA national championship (2019).
-The three-time National $(2007,2015$ and 2018) and four-time ACC Coach of the Year (2014, 2015, 2018 and 2019) guided UVA to its 11th consecutive postseason berth in 2022-23.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and a school-record 35 wins.
Bennett is the third coach in ACC men's basketball history to lead his program to 12 -straight winning conference seasons, joining North Carolina's Dean Smith (33) and Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (13).
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018). - Bennett is the fifth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
UVA is 176-75 (.701) in ACC play (100-25 at home \& 76-50 away), 193-38 (.836) at home and 165-50 (.767) in nonconference action (91-10 at JPJ) under Bennett.
- Bennett ranks fourth all-time in winning percentage (.701) among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC wins.


## UVA VS. THE WAC

-The Cavaliers meet their first WAC opponent since an 83-43 win over Seattle on Nov. 17, 2012 at John Paul Jones Arena.

- Virginia is 2-1 all-time vs. current WAC opponents with all games vs. Seattle.


## DID YOU KNOW?

- Reece Beekman tested the NBA waters in the offseason and decided to return to Virginia for his senior season.
- Ryan Dunn is the younger brother of Major League Baseball pitcher Justin Dunn.
Isaac McKneely was named West Virginia Mr. Basketball in 2020 and 2021.
- Taine Murray has competed for the Tall Blacks, New Zealand's national team.
- Andrew Rohde was the Summit League Freshman of the Year in 2022-23.
- Dante Harris earned the Dave Gavitt Trophy as the Most Outstanding Player of the 2021 BIG EAST Tournament, averaging $11.8 \mathrm{ppg}, 4.8 \mathrm{rpg}$ and 3.3 apg in four games.
- Leon Bond III won a state high school championship as a junior at Wauwatosa East in Wisconsin.
- Blake Buchanan was invited to the USA Basketball U19 Men's National Team training camp and participated in the 2023 Nike Hoop Summit, collecting eight points, eight rebounds and one steal in Team USA's 90-84 win over the International team.
- Jake Groves' brother, Tanner, played three seasons at Eastern Washington (2018-21) and one at Oklahoma (2022-23), and now plays professionally in Europe.
- Jordan Minor was the Northeast Conference Co-Player of the Year and NEC Defensive Player of the Year in 2022-23.


## VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN THE ACC

-Virginia was fourth in the 2023-24 ACC Tipoff Preseason Poll. - Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Miami, North Carolina, Virginia and Clemson in the top five.

- ACC preseason voters selected Wake Forest sixth, followed by NC State, Virginia Tech, Pittsburgh and Syracuse. Florida State was picked 11th, while Boston College, Georgia Tech, Louisville and Notre Dame rounded out the voting.
-The Cavaliers were selected third in the 2022-22 ACC Preseason Poll and finished first (15-5) in the standings.
-The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 13 of the last 15 seasons.

## OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTED

- UVA has ranked sixth nationally in scoring defense in each of the past three seasons.
-The Cavaliers ranked sixth nationally in scoring defense in 2022-23 at 60.5 ppg .
- UVA limited its opponents to 41.5 percent field goal shooting, including 34.1 percent from 3-point range.
-The Cavaliers forced 26 shot clock violations and have averaged 27.6 shot clock violations since 2019.
- UVA was 12-2 when outrebounding its opponents and 23-6 when limiting foes to less than 50 percent shooting.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense seven times and finished in the top-five nationally 11 times.


## SUPER 70s AND AWESOME 80s

- Virginia is $157-11$ all-time when scoring 70 or more points under Tony Bennett.
- UVA was 13-0 when scoring 70 or more points in 2022-23. - Virginia is 46-1 all-time under when scoring 80 or more points under Bennett with their lone loss a 93-81 setback at North Carolina in 2012-13.
- Bennett was 4-0 when scoring 80+ at Washington State. - UVA scored 100 points against Marshall (2018-19) for the first time under Tony Bennett and added 97 points against Coppin State (2018-19).
- UVA is 4-0 all-time when scoring 90 or more under Bennett.


## ABOUT THE 2023-24 SCHEDULE

- Four of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 preseason poll (Duke, Miami, Texas A\&M and North Carolina), while Wisconsin and Florida received votes.


## 2022-22 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

- UVA claimed a share of its 11th ACC regular-season title. - UVA earned its 25th NCAA Tournament berth and 11th consecutive postseason berth.
- UVA won 25 or more games for the sixth time under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA won 12 or more ACC games for the fifth straight year. - UVA advanced to its 10th ACC Tournament final.
- UVA captured the Continental Tire Main Event in Las Vegas, defeating Baylor (86-79) and Illinois (70-61).


## UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 51-45 against ranked foes in the Tony Bennett era. - UVA is 3-3 vs. ranked opponents in 2022-23, recording wins against Baylor, Illinois and NC State.
- UVA's 11 ranked wins in 2018-19 marked a school record. - UVA is 163-338 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1-31 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).


## HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- UVA is 109-2, including a 3-0 mark in 2022-23, when limiting foes to fewer then 50 points during the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 134-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points ( $25-1$ in 3 years at Washington State).
- UVA is 27-0 when holding foes to fewer than 40 under Bennett.
