- · Virginia meets its first of two Coastal Athletic Association foes in 2023-24 (North Carolina A&T and Northeastern).
- · UVA meets its first CAA opponent since posting an 89-42 win over Monmouth on Nov. 11, 2022.
- · UVA is 167-50 (.770) in non-conference action under Bennett. ·The Cavaliers have started 2-0 for the second straight season.

HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

· We play defense, take quality shots, pass the basketball, limit turnovers and transition points, rebound and play more defense. · UVA returns one starter - Reece Beekman (14.5 ppg, 6.0 apg, 3.5 rpg & 3.0 spg) - from last season's ACC regular-season champion and NCAA tournament team that finished 25-8. · Beekman, who earned All-ACC third-team honors last season,

needs 57 steals to pass Othell Wilson (222 steals from 1981-84) for first all-time at UVA.

· Isaac McKneely (12.0 ppg, 5.0 rpg, 50% 3FG), Ryan Dunn (7.5 ppg, 7.5 rpg, 4.0 spg) and Taine Murray (5.0 ppg) also return. McKneely averaged 6.7 points and shot a team-best 39.2 percent from 3-point range last year, while Dunn tallied 2.6 points and 2.9 rebounds in 12.9 minutes per game.

· Transfers Andrew Rohde (6.5 ppg), Jake Groves (10.5 ppg) and Jordan Minor, and redshirts Leon Bond III (7.0 ppg, 5.0 rpg)and Dante Harris (6.5 ppg, 1.5 apg) and newcomer Blake Buchanan (9.5 ppg, 5.5 rpg) are main contributors.

· Elijah Gertrude, Anthony Robinson and Christian Bliss will redshirt the season, while recruited walk-ons Desmond Roberts and Tristan How round out the roster.

 \cdot UVA is shooting 46.7 percent from the field, 42.5 percent from 3-point range and 60.3 percent from the free throw line.

 \cdot UVA has committed just 14 turnovers and has 2.14 assist/turnover ratio.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- \cdot UVA is 232-54 (.812), including a 1-0 mark in 2023-24, in 18 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavaliers finished 15-1 and 10-0 at home in ACC league play last season for the first time since the ACC expanded to a 20-game schedule.
- · UVA is 194-38 (.836), including a 159-23 (.874) mark the past 12 seasons, at JPJ under Bennett.
- · UVA has an ACC-leading 88 wins in league home games over the past 11 seasons. Duke is second at 87.
- UVA has won 10+ home games for 13 straight seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. NORTH CAROLINA A&T

- · Virginia is 1-0 all-time against North Carolina A&T in the series that dates to the 1994-95 season.
- · Junior Burrough scored 24 points and Cory Alexander and Curtis Staples added 17 each as Virginia defeated North Carolina A&T 94-50 on Nov. 30, 1994, at University Hall.
- · Current associate head coach Jason Williford added six points, three rebounds and two assists in the contest.

LAST TIME OUT

- · Blake Buchanan scored 18 points along with seven rebounds to lead Virginia to a 73-70 non-conference win over Florida on Nov. 10 in Charlotte. N.C.
- Reece Beekman added 13 points, five assists and three steals, and Jake Groves chipped in 12 points.
- · Ryan Dunn tied a school record with seven steals and UVA had just six turnovers.
- · Will Richard led five Gators in double figures with 16 points.
- · UVA won despite being out-rebounded 47-30 and shooting 14 of 24 from the charity stripe.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Dean and Markel Families Head Men's Basketball Coach Tony Bennett has a 343-125 (.733) mark in 15 seasons at UVA and 412-158 (.723) career mark in 18 seasons as a head coach.
- Bennett passed Terry Holland (326-173, 16 seasons) as UVA's all-time winningest coach with the win over Syracuse (1/7/23).
- \cdot Bennett recorded his 400th career win at Wake Forest (1/21/23).
- · Bennett has guided the Cavaliers to six ACC regular-season titles (2014, 2015, 2018, 2019, 2021, 2023), two ACC Tournament titles (2014 and 2018) and one NCAA national championship (2019).
- The three-time National (2007, 2015 and 2018) and four-time ACC Coach of the Year (2014, 2015, 2018 and 2019) guided UVA to its 11th consecutive postseason berth in 2022-23.
- \cdot In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and a school-record 35 wins.
- · Bennett is the third coach in ACC men's basketball history to lead his program to 12-straight winning conference seasons, joining North Carolina's Dean Smith (33) and Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (13).
- · He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- · Bennett is the fifth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- · UVA is 176-75 (.701) in ACC play (100-25 at home & 76-50 away), 194-38 (.836) at home and 167-50 (.770) in non-conference action (92-10 at JPJ) under Bennett.
- · Bennett ranks fourth all-time in winning percentage (.701) among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC wins.

VIRGINIA RECEIVES VOTES IN LATEST AP POLL

- · UVA received votes in the latest AP top-25 poll.
- · UVA earned votes in the AP preseason top-25 poll.
- \cdot UVA was not ranked in the AP preseason top-25 poll for the first time since 2017-18 when it received votes.
- \cdot Prior to this year, UVA was ranked in the preseason AP top-25 five consecutive seasons and nine of the last 10 seasons under Tony Bennett.

BEEKMAN EARNS PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS

- \cdot Reece Beekman was named to the preseason All-ACC first team.
- · In 2022-23, Beekman was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, All-Defensive Team and All-ACC Third Team.
- · Beekman ranked second nationally and first in the ACC in assist/turnover ratio (3.36), and ranked second in steals (1.8 spg) and third in assists (5.3 apg).

WATCH OUT FOR REECE

- · Reece Beekman was named to the 2023-24 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Men's Preseason 50 Watch List.
- · Beekman is among the 50 men's players to watch during the season-long competition for the 2024 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Men's Player of the Year honor.
- · Beekman has averaged 7.9 points, 4.6 assists and 3.3 rebounds in 94 career games (89 starts) for the Cavaliers.

SEASON STORYLINES

- · Virginia returns one starter (Reece Beekman) from last season's team that won the ACC regular season title (15-5) and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- •The Cavaliers return 28.1 percent of their scoring from last season compared to 91.4 percent from 2021-22.
- · Virginia's roster includes eight newcomers, including transfers Jake Groves (Oklahoma), Jordan Minor (Merrimack) and Andrew Rohde (St. Thomas), and freshman Blake Buchanan, Elijah Gertrude (redshirt), Anthony Robinson (redshirt), Christian Bliss (redshirt) and Desmond Roberts.
- · Leon Bond III and Dante Harris (Georgetown) made their UVA debuts after redshirting last season.
- · In addition to head coach Tony Bennett (Green Bay), UVA's roster includes Wisconsin natives Beekman (Milwaukee), Bond III (Wauwatosa) and Rohde (Milwaukee).
- · Associate head coach Ron Sanchez returns to Virginia after serving the last five seasons as head coach at Charlotte from 2018-23. Sanchez served nine seasons on Bennett's staff from 2009-18, the last three as associate head coach.

OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- · UVA is yielding 60 points per contest in 2023-24.
- •The Cavalier have ranked sixth nationally in scoring defense in each of the past three seasons.
- The Cavaliers ranked sixth nationally in scoring defense in 2022-23 at 60.5 ppg.
- \cdot UVA has limited its opponents to 37.3 percent field goal shooting, including 26.3 percent from 3-point range.
- •The Cavaliers have forced one shot clock violation and have averaged 27.6 shot clock violations since 2018-19.
- \cdot UVA is 1-0 when outrebounding its opponents and 2-0 when limiting foes to less than 50 percent shooting.
- · Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense seven times and finished in the top-five nationally 11 times.

ABOUT THE 2023-24 SCHEDULE

· Four of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 preseason poll (Duke, Miami, Texas A&M and North Carolina), while Wisconsin and Clemson received votes.

DID YOU KNOW?

- · Reece Beekman tested the NBA waters in the offseason and decided to return to Virginia for his senior season.
- Ryan Dunn is the younger brother of Major League Baseball pitcher Justin Dunn.
- · Isaac McKneely was named West Virginia Mr. Basketball in 2020 and 2021.
- · Taine Murray has competed for the Tall Blacks, New Zealand's national team.
- Andrew Rohde was the Summit League Freshman of the Year in 2022-23.
- Dante Harris earned the Dave Gavitt Trophy as the Most Outstanding Player of the 2021 BIG EAST Tournament, averaging 11.8 ppg, 4.8 rpg and 3.3 apg in four games.
- \cdot Leon Bond III won a state high school championship as a junior at Wauwatosa East in Wisconsin.
- · Blake Buchanan was invited to the USA Basketball U19 Men's National Team training camp and participated in the 2023 Nike Hoop Summit, collecting eight points, eight rebounds and one steal in Team USA's 90-84 win over the International team.
- · Jake Groves' brother, Tanner, played three seasons at Eastern Washington (2018-21) and one at Oklahoma (2022-23), and now plays professionally in Europe.
- · Jordan Minor was the Northeast Conference Co-Player of the Year and NEC Defensive Player of the Year in 2022-23.

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN THE ACC

- \cdot Virginia was fourth in the 2023-24 ACC Tipoff Preseason Poll.
- · Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Miami, North Carolina, Virginia and Clemson in the top five.
- · ACC preseason voters selected Wake Forest sixth, followed by NC State, Virginia Tech, Pittsburgh and Syracuse. Florida State was picked 11th, while Boston College, Georgia Tech, Louisville and Notre Dame rounded out the voting.
- •The Cavaliers were selected third in the 2022-22 ACC Preseason Poll and finished first (15-5) in the standings.
- \cdot The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 13 of the last 15 seasons.

· UVA is 27-0 when holding foes to fewer than 40 under Bennett.
