## **Team Notes**

- Virginia (15-5, 6-3 ACC) has a four-game win streak and two-game road win streak
- UVA is 2-4 in true road games
- Virginia is 10-2 all-time at the KFC Yum! Center, including a pair of wins at the 2019 NCAA South Regional
- UVA led 41-13 at the half and improved to 14-0 when leading after the first 20 minutes
- The 13 first-half points allowed marked a season low for UVA
- UVA started the game on an 11-0 run on 5 of 5 shooting, while limiting Louisville to 0 of 5 shooting
- UVA led 25-7 at 6:45 of the first half, holding Louisville to 2 of 13 shooting
- $\cdot$  An 18-1 run staked UVA to a 32-8 lead at 4:43 of the first half
- $\cdot$  UVA (14 steals) had 10 or more steals for the fifth time
- UVA forced one shot clock violation (14 in 2023-24)

- UVA has a nine-game win streak vs. Louisville
- · UVA completed its fourth straight season sweep of Louisville

- The Cavaliers are 11-4 vs. the Cardinals in Louisville, including an 8-2 mark at KFC Yum! Center
- $\cdot$  UVA is 19-2 vs. Louisville since the Cardinals joined the ACC
- Tony Bennett is 19-2 vs. Louisville as head coach at Virginia
