## OPENING DRAW

### GAME OVERVIEW

- No. 3 Virginia (2-0) kicks off a three-game homestand on Sunday (Feb. 25) when the Cavaliers welcome No. 20 Ohio State (4-0). Opening faceoff from Klöckner Stadium is set for 1 p.m. on ACC Network Extra.
- For the first time since 2001, the Hoos begin their season by facing three ranked opponents.
- Last year, UVA and Ohio State squared off in Naples, Florida at the Paradise Coast Sports Complex. The Cavaliers won handedly, 17-6, with the help of seven Payton Cormier goals.
- Virginia and the Buckeyes are currently one of 15 unbeaten Division I teams.

### LAST TIME OUT

- In its first road game of the season, Virginia scored four of the game's last five goals to grind out a 14-10 win over then-No. 16 Richmond last Saturday (Feb. 17).
- The Cavaliers surrendered the first two goals of the game and were flagged for six penalties, but UVA forced eight Spider turnovers in the fourth quarter.
- **Connor Shellenberger** (2g, 5a) recorded a game-high seven points and **Payton Cormier** (3g, 1a) became UVA's all-time career goals leader.
- **Anthony Ghobriel** finished 15 for 24 at the faceoff X.

### SEASON OVERVIEW

- Virginia is in its eighth season under head coach **Lars Tiffany**, who boasts an 82-30 record as Cavalier head coach.
- The Hoos are coming off their third Championship Weekend appearance in the last four opportunities.

## NUMBERS TO KNOW

In just his third season, goalie **Matthew Nunes** (26-8) needs just one win to tie for seventh on UVA's career wins list.

**23** For the first time in 23 years, Virginia's first three opponents of the season are ranked in the USILA coaches poll.

**774** **Jack Boyden** (320), **Connor Shellenberger** (248) and **Payton Cormier** (206) have combined for 774 career points.

## THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

### UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

**Grounds:** The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

**First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year:** Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

**Commonwealth:** Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

### UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

### THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

### UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

### WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

**SERIES HISTORY**

- Virginia leads the all-time series over the Buckeyes, which began in 1968, 7-1.
- The Cavaliers won the first six meetings between the two teams, a win streak that spanned from 1968 until 2013.
- OSU claimed its first win of the series in an 11-10 decision after 103-minute lightning delay at Klöckner Stadium on March 16, 2013. The Cavaliers had a chance to force overtime, but former OSU goalie Greg Dutton stopped Nick O'Reilly's shot from the crease with five seconds remaining.
- The two teams met in the first-ever neutral site meeting last year at the Paradise Coast Sports Complex in Naples on Feb. 25, 2023. **Payton Cormier** scored a career-high seven goals, which tied for second in UVA single-game history.
- Virginia was ranked No. 1 at the time and the Buckeyes were No. 9.
- Last year's contest was also UVA's first-ever held in the state of Florida.
- UVA has only faced the Buckeyes in true road games twice, but in separate venues in Columbus. The Cavaliers' first road game against OSU was in 2000, a 13-7 victory from Jesse Owens Stadium, and an 11-9 win at Ohio Stadium in 2012.

**2023 SEASON RECAP**

- Virginia finished its 2023 season with an overall record of 13-4, marking the Cavaliers' seventh consecutive winning season.
- For the third time in their last four opportunities, the Cavaliers reached Championship Weekend after NCAA Tournament wins over Richmond and Georgetown.
- For the second consecutive year and 12th time in program history, **Connor Shellenberger** was named one of the nation's five Tewarraton Finalists.
- Despite knocking off Notre Dame in both regular-season matchups last season, Virginia fell to the Fighting Irish in overtime, 13-12, in the NCAA semifinals at Lincoln Financial Field.
- Shellenberger combined for 11 goals and 11 assists in three tournament games and was named to the NCAA All-Tournament Team for the second time of his career.
- The Cavaliers did not return a total of 18 players from 2023 to this year.
- Virginia had arguably its most prolific season offensively in school history as the Cavaliers set program records in goals (293), assists (195) and points (488).
- Former UVA midfielder Thomas McConvey was named the program's seventh recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Award, which is given to the nation's top midfielder.
- Xander Dickson set the program's single-season goals record with 61 scores. He is UVA's only 60-goal scorer in a single season.

## THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM

- Virginia owns a 174-45 (.795) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 1-0 record in 2024, and has won 20 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 5.36 goals.
- Virginia is 48-13 (.787) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- UVA is also 14-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in NCAA Tournament contests.
- Lacrosse debuted in Klöckner Stadium in 1993.

## CAVALIERS AMONG THE NATION'S STATISTICAL LEADERS

- For games played through Feb. 20, Virginia is second in the nation in assists (12.00/gm), third in clearing percentage (.961), fourth in points (28.5/gm) and sixth in scoring offense (16.5/gm) and turnovers (13.00/gm).
- The Cavaliers' clearing percentage also leads all ACC teams.
- Virginia is currently one of 15 unbeaten teams nationally.
- **Payton Cormier** (4.00/gm) is currently ninth in the nation in goals per game. Faceoff specialist **Anthony Ghobriel** (.638) is currently 16th in faceoff win percentage. Goalie **Matthew Nunes** (12.50/gm) is currently 18th and leads the ACC in saves per game.

## VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- No. 3 Virginia has been ranked in the top 5 of the USILA Coaches poll in 330 weeks all-time.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in 470 polls all-time, including in the most recent edition of the poll.
- Virginia has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 70 all-time polls.
- UVA has been ranked in 518 out of 538 (.961) total USILA polls all-time.
- The USILA Poll began in 1973.

## CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE

- Virginia attackman **Connor Shellenberger** returns for his final collegiate season in 2024.
- Shellenberger guided the Hoos to Championship Weekend last season after leading the nation in assists (3.38/gm).
- He and Notre Dame attackman Pat Kavanagh are currently the only two active players in the nation with 145 career assists.
- Shellenberger is one of just two Cavaliers to garner USILA First Team All-America honors, the other being former defenseman Ken Clausen.
- In addition to being a Tewaaratron finalist for the second time of his career in 2023, Shellenberger garnered NCAA All-Tournament honors after combining for 11 goals and 11 assists in the Cavaliers' three tournament games last season.
- Shellenberger was also the 2021 NCAA Tournament Most Outstanding Player after leading the Hoos to their seventh NCAA championship, also the program's ninth national championship overall.

**PAYTON CORMIER: VIRGINIA'S CAREER GOALS LEADER**

- With his second goal of the game at Richmond (Feb. 17), **Payton Cormier** became Virginia's all-time leading goal scorer.
- Cormier shattered Doug Knight's previous program record of 165 career goals, which Knight accomplished in 60 games.
- Cormier broke the record in just 57 career games.
- Cormier's 167 career goals currently leads all active Division-I players.
- Among all of UVA's 100-career goal scorers, Cormier is the only one to average at least 2.93 goals per game.
- Cormier is also the only player in program history to log a pair of 50-goal seasons, having recorded 52 goals last year and 50 goals in 2022.
- In 15 appearances last season, he recorded 12 multi-goal games, including 10 hat tricks.
- He scored a career-high seven goals against Ohio State in 2023, which tied for No. 2 in UVA single-game history.

**CORMIER, WAYER NAB ACC WEEKLY HONORS**

- For their performances against Richmond, **Payton Cormier** and **Ben Wayer** were named ACC Co-Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week, respectively.
- The announcement marks Cormier's fourth career ACC weekly honor and Wayer's first.
- Cormier scored three goals and set the program's all-time goals record in the win.
- For the second consecutive week, Wayer collected ground balls and added one caused turnover.
- Wayer also played a pivotal role in the Spiders' six failed clears, four of which occurred in the fourth quarter.
- Wayer was also a key contributor on UVA's faceoff unit, which won 15 of the game's 26 total faceoffs, including 10 of 14 in the second half.
- Additionally, UR's starting midfield line combined for just two goals.

**ON THE HORIZON**

- The Cavaliers return to Klöckner Stadium on Saturday (March 2) to host Johns Hopkins in a battle for the Doyle Smith Cup.
- Opening faceoff is set for 1 p.m. on ACC Network.

**VIRGINIA IS A GROUND BALL MACHINE**

- In 2023, UVA led the nation in ground balls per game (39.65) for the ninth time since 2009.
- It also marked the eighth consecutive year the Cavaliers finished in the top-2 nationally in ground balls.
- UVA is the only school in the nation to finish in the top-3 nationally in ground balls per game 14 times over the last 15 seasons.
- The only school in 2016 to finish with more ground balls per game was UVA head coach Lars Tiffany's 2016 Brown team.

## MATTHEW NUNES: ONE OF UVA'S MOST ELITE GOALIES

- Junior goalie **Matthew Nunes** set the Virginia single-season program record with 213 saves in 17 games last season.
- Nunes broke Alex Rode's 2021 program record of 212 saves, which Rode achieved in 16 games.
- During his freshman season in 2022, Nunes broke Tillman Johnson's program freshman record with 159 saves.
- In 2023, Nunes led all ACC goalies in save percentage (.551) among conference games only.
- He finished second overall in the ACC in goals-against average (11.95) and saves per game (14.33) last season.
- Nunes has been at his best in the biggest of games (see chart below).

## ACC CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

- Virginia has claimed at least a share of 19 ACC championships, including two (2019 & 2022) under head coach **Lars Tiffany**.
- The Cavaliers won 11 titles (1962, 1964, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1975, 1980, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986) prior the ACC establishing a tournament from 1989-2019 to determine the champion.
- Virginia has won seven ACC Tournament championships: 1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2010 and 2019.
- In the last ACC Tournament, which was held in 2019 at Klöckner Stadium, UVA defeated Notre Dame 10-4 in the championship game.
- From 1989-2019, Virginia won 14 regular-season titles (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012 and 2019), more than any other ACC School.
- The ACC Tournament returns this season and will be contested at American Legion Stadium in Charlotte, N.C. on May 3 and 5.

## TRANSFERS ADD IMMEDIATE DEPTH

- This offseason, Lars Tiffany signed five transfers: **Jack Boyden** (Tufts), **Chase Yager** (Harvard), **Anthony Ghobriel** (Navy), **Thomas Colucci** (Colgate) and **Matthew DeSouza** (Binghamton).
- Boyden was the Division-III national player and attackman of the year in 2023. He logged 167 goals and 143 assists during his tenure (2020-23) with the Jumbos.
- Yager was a standout short-stick defensive midfielder at Harvard from 2020-23. Prior to his career with the Crimson, Yager attended Norfolk Academy. Yager was named a 2024 Inside Lacrosse Preseason All-American.
- Ghobriel, Colucci and DeSouza are all faceoff specialists. Ghobriel is a junior, while Colucci and DeSouza are graduate transfers.

**25TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE 1999 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM**

- This year marks the 25th anniversary of the Cavaliers' 1999 national championship team, the program's second NCAA title.
- The 12-10 victory over Syracuse in College Park, Md., ended Virginia's 26-year drought since it won its first title in 1972.
- After the '72 championship run, the Hoos reached the NCAA title game four times (1980, 1986, 1994, 1996), but lost in overtime each time.
- In 1999, the third-seeded Cavaliers knocked off No. 2 seed Johns Hopkins in the semifinals before defeating the eighth-seeded Orange.
- SU nearly sent the game into overtime as the Orange scored five consecutive goals in the fourth quarter to close to within one [10-9] with 3:36 remaining. UVA then received goals from freshman attackman Conor Gill, who was also named the tournament's most outstanding player, and senior midfielder Henry Oakey (Charlottesville, Va.) in a 21-second span.
- In addition to Gill, Ryan Curtis, Derek Kenney, Jay Jalbert, Tucker Radebaugh and Court Weisleder were named all-tournament team selections.
- The '99 championship run marked the first of four (99, 03, 06, 11) by the Cavaliers under former head coach Dom Starsia.
- Virginia will honor members of the 1999 for Alumni Weekend at Klöckner Stadium for the Cavaliers' ACC opener against North Carolina on Saturday, April 6.



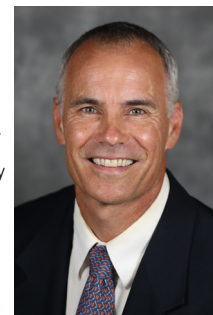
**LARS TIFFANY LEADS HAUDENOSAUNEE NATIONAL TEAM AT 2023 WORLD LACROSSE CHAMPIONSHIPS**

- Last summer, Virginia head coach **Lars Tiffany** guided the Haudenosaunee national team to a third-place finish at the 14th World Lacrosse Games, which were held in San Diego, Calif.
- The Haudenosaunee roster featured star attackman Lyle Thompson and Zed Williams '17, who played close defense instead of his natural position, attack.
- Tiffany grew up near the Onondaga Nation, located just outside of Syracuse, N.Y.
- His Alfie Jacques' wooden stick is a close memento made for Tiffany's late father, Bradford.
- Tiffany often reflects on the roots of the game and admiration of the Onondaga in interviews and press conferences (via Inside Lacrosse).

**HEAD COACH LARS TIFFANY**

**OVERVIEW**

Lars Tiffany was named Virginia's 17<sup>th</sup> head coach on June 21, 2016. He is currently in his seventh season at UVA and 19th season overall as head coach. Tiffany is Virginia's only head coach to win back-to-back national championships (2019 & 2021). Tiffany begins the 2023 season with 67 wins as UVA head coach, good for No. 3 all-time in program history behind only Jim "Ace" Adams (137) and Dom Starsia (274).

He was Co-MVP of the Brown squad that captured its first-ever NCAA playoff victory in 1990 (12-9 vs. UMass). Tiffany capped his career by playing in the North-South Senior All-Star game.

**KEVIN CASSESE NAMED ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH**

- Last summer, head coach Lars Tiffany announced the addition **Kevin Cassese** as the program's associate head coach and offensive coordinator.
- Cassese spent the previous 16 seasons as the head coach of Lehigh University, where he became the school's all-time winningest coach and guided the Mountain Hawks to three Patriot League titles.
- A total of 21 Lehigh players achieved USILA All-America status under Cassese's tutelage, including 2021 first-team faceoff specialist Mike Sisselberger, who set the NCAA Division-I single season faceoff win percentage record (79.5).
- Prior to serving as Lehigh head coach, Cassese was an assistant coach at his alma mater, Duke, from 2005-07. In 2007, Cassese and the Blue Devils reached the NCAA Championship game, which marked the program's second national championship appearance. He also served as Duke's interim head coach for part of the summer of 2006.
- In 2005, Cassese was an assistant coach and offensive coordinator at Story Brook under Tiffany and conducted the nation's top man-up unit. Tiffany, Cassese and the Seawolves finished the season with a 10-6 overall record.
- A National Lacrosse Hall of Fame class of 2018 inductee, Cassese enjoyed an illustrious playing career at Duke from 2000-03, where he was twice team captain and Tewaaraton Award finalist (2002-03), a three-time All-American (2001-03), and the recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Outstanding Midfielder award (2002). He was named ACC Player of the Year in 2001 and garnered All-ACC honors three times (2001-03).
- After his collegiate playing career, Cassese was selected second overall by the Rochester Rattlers in the 2003 MLL draft. He went on to play professionally for seven seasons and was a two-time all-star, including in 2006 when he was the game's MVP.
- Cassese represented the United States at the World Championships on four occasions, including as an assistant coach in 2014. As a midfielder, he helped the U.S. win gold in 2002 and 2010. He served as Team USA's captain in 2010.
- Cassese graduated from Duke in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in sociology. He was named a USILA Scholar All-American and named one of four ACC student-athletes conference wide to receive Weaver-James-Corrigan Honorary Award, which recognized student-athletes for outstanding athletic and academic achievement.
