BOSTON COLLEGE VS. VIRGINIA - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game is the 29th all-time meeting between the two teams.
- Boston College is 9-19 all-time against Virginia.
- In ACC regular season play, BC is 8-15 against Virginia.
- This is the lone 2023-24 regular season meeting with the Cavaliers.
- Last season, the two teams split the regular season series.
- The #7/7 Cavs won, 76-57, at John Paul Jones Arena on Jan. 28, 2023.
- In the last meeting, BC beat #6/6 Virginia, 63-48, on Feb. 22, 2023.
- The win for BC snapped a five-game losing streak vs. UVA..

MASON MADSEN, FOR STARTERS

- Since entering the starting lineup five games ago, Mason Madsen is averaging 17.2 points, 4.6 rebounds, 2.2 assists. and 1.0 steals.
- Last time out at N.C. State, Madsen scored 21 points (8-11 FG; 4-7 3FG) to go with seven boards and two assists.
- On Feb. 17, Madsen drilled a career-high seven 3-pointers en route to a career-high 25 points in a win over Miami.
- Over the last five games, Madsen is also posting a 1.83:1 ATR.
- At Florida State, he made 4-of-8 3-pointers, scoring 14 points.
- In the Feb. 13 win over Louisville, the 6-4 guard had 11 points, four rebounds, four assists and a block in 23 minutes.
- Madsen had a team-high 15 points (6-11 FG) at Duke on Feb. 10.
- In six total games as a starter this year, he is averaging nearly 17.0 points per game and has made 20-of-38 3-pointers.
- In the 21 games he came off the bench, Madsen averaged 6.1 points per game in nearly 17 minutes per outing.
- For the season, he leads BC in 3FG% (46-98, .469), is second in 3FGM (46), and has connected on all 29 of his FT attempts.

POST AMONG NATION'S ELITE

- Quinten Post is one of the best players in the country and his stat line for the Eagles this season is perfect evidence.
- He is the only major conference player in the nation averaging 15.9 points, 7.7 boards, 3.0 assists, and 1.9 blocks per game.
- The last ACC player to average that season stat line: Wake Forest's Tim Duncan in 1996-97.
- Using only points and rebounds: Post is one of seven major conference players averaging at least 15.9 points and 7.7 rebounds per game; two in the ACC (Flipkowski, Omier); four of those players are on the Wooden midseason list.
- Using only points and assists: Post is one of 21 major conference players to average at least 15.9 points and 3.0 assists per game. Since 1996-97, he is one of seven major conference players 6-10 or taller to average 15.9 ppg/3.0 apg.
- Post is also posting nearly a 50/40/80 line of shooting percentages - at 50.8 FG%, 44.3 3FG%, and 79.4 FT%.
- Post is one of two players in the nation to post those percentages (min. 16.0 ppg).
- It's not a small sample: in 76 games at BC since 2021-22, Post has registered nearly a 50/40/80 shooting line - .514 FG; .418 3FG; .786 FT. - the only active player (min. 10.0 ppg) to post such shooting lines since the start of 2021-22-present.
- Over the past three seasons vs. major conference opponents (57 games), Post is averaging 13.0 points, 6.1 rebounds, 1.6 assists, and 1.3 blocks while shooting .519/.430/.771.
- Quinten Post is one of three players to rank among the top 10 in the ACC in scoring, rebounding, blocks, and FG percentage.

TODAY'S BOSTON COLLEGE NOTE(S) YOU CAN'T LIVE WITHOUT

- Since Feb. 13, Mason Madsen has registered the fifth-most 3-pointers (17) and the sixth-best 3FG% (.548) in the nation.
- Boston College is one of six major conference schools to have five or more players with at least 20 3FG made and shooting at least 35% from beyond the arc (Creighton, Miami, Purdue, Texas, Wake Forest).

ON THIS DATE: FEBRUARY 28

- Boston College is 14-10 all-time and 4-0 in ACC in games played on the February 28 calendar date.
- Last year, a late-game layup from Makai Ashton-Langford sealed a 71-69 win at Wake Forest on Feb. 28, 2023.
- On February 28, 2006, BC downed Wake Forest, 80-65, led by 23 points from Craig Smith and 22 from Jared Dudley.
- February 28 marks the dual celebration of National Tooth Fairy and National Public Sleeping Days.
- Several notable events in history occurred on February 28 - 1827 - the first commercial railroad - the Baltimore & Ohio (B&O) is chartered; 1849 - the first boat load of gold rush prospectors arrives in San Francisco from the east coast; 1940 - Pittsburgh beats Fordham, 50-37, in the first-ever televised basketball game; 1940 - Richard Wright's "Native Son" published; 1953 - Crick & Watson discover the double-helix structure of DNA; 1981 - Calvin Murphy sets a new NBA record with his 78th consecutive made free throw; 1983 - U2's "War" released.
- Notable February 28 birthdays: NBA star Luka Doncic; chemist Linus Pauling; gangster Bugsy Siegel; architect Frank Gehry; actor Gavin McLeod; auto racing legend Mario Andretti; actress Bernadette Peters; former NBA great Adrian Dantley; pro wrestling star Ricky "the Dragon" Steamboat; actor John Turturro.

MOST IMPROVED McGLOCKTON

- Devin McGlockton is one of the ACC's Most Improved Players, showing major jumps in several stat categories
- Through 27 games, McGlockton is fourth on the Eagles in scoring (10.6) and second in rebounding (6.3) and blocks (1.0).
- McGlockton's per game averages have increased across the board: scoring +4.6, rebounding +2.1, and blocked shots +0.3.
- **In ACC play (16 games), McGlockton is averaging 12.5 points and 6.6 rebounds in 32 minutes per game.**
- **Year-over-year, he has almost tripled his scoring (+7.2) and more than doubled his rebounding (+4.0) in ACC games.**
- McGlockton ranks first in the league in FG percentage (ACC games only) at .609 (81-133); up from .500 a year ago.
- The 6-7 forward has scored in double figures in 11 of 16 ACC games.
- McGlockton registered the seventh-highest single-game scoring total in ACC play - a 30-point performance at Georgia Tech.
- He has logged two double-doubles this season, both in ACC play: at Syracuse (15p/14r) and at Virginia Tech (19p/10r).
- He has set new single-game career-highs in scoring (30), rebounding (14), and blocks (3) this year.

ALWAYS LOOK FOR THE HELPERS

- As a playmaker, Jaeden Zackery ranks among the top players nationally in three different categories.
- He is 73rd nationally in assist/turnover ratio (2.40:1), 109th in total assists (115), and 114th in assists per game (4.3).
- Earlier this month, Zackery became the 14th different Eagle since 1996-97 to reach the 100 assist mark in a season.
- Zackery's 115 assists are the most by a BC player since Ky Bowman (125) during the 2018-19 campaign.

DISHIN' AND SWISHIN'

- Boston College's top three scorers - Quinten Post, Claudell Harris Jr., and Jaeden Zackery - are also its top three assists men.
- Zackery ranks third in scoring (11.7) and first in assists (4.3), Post is first in scoring (15.9) and second in assists (3.0), and Harris is second in scoring (13.7) and third in assists (2.1). The trio combines for nearly 9.3 of the 14.4 assists per game.
- Wake Forest is the only other ACC school to have its top three scorers rank as its top three distributors.

THREE IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

- BC has connected on 44 3-pointers over its last four games: 11 vs. Louisville, 15 vs. Miami, nine at FSU and N.C. State.
- Over that stretch, the Eagles are connecting at a .463 clip from the perimeter, making 44-of-95 shots from deep.
- The 15 3-pointers made against Miami tied for the fourth-most in a single-game in Boston College men's basketball history.
- The Eagles rank 37th nationally - and third in the ACC - in 3-point percentage, making 36.9% of their attempts from long-range.
- The 36.9% clip ranks as the 10th-best season 3FG% in BC history; the 221 made 3-pointers is 11th-best in a single-season.

JAEDEN ZACKERY JOINS 1,000-POINT CLUB

- Connecting on a 3-pointer with 14:51 to play, Jaeden Zackery became the 46th member of Boston College's 1,000-point club.
- The junior guard has scored 1013 points in 93 career games as an Eagle - a 10.9 points per game average.
- He is the first Boston College player to join the 1,000-point club since Nik Popovic did so during the 2019-20 season.

QUINTEN POST'S BOSTON COLLEGE 1,000-POINT WATCH IS UNDERWAY

- Quinten Post needs eight more points to become the 47th member of Boston College's 1,000-point club.
- Since joining the Eagles in 2021-22, Post has tallied 992 points in 76 games for the Maroon and Gold.
- Earlier this season, Post scored his 1,000th collegiate point on Feb. 6 against Florida State.

RECORD BOOK RESET

Career

- Quinten Post is 10th all-time on BC's career blocked shots list. He has 98 swats in 75 games.
- Jaeden Zackery is five steals away from cracking Boston College's all-time top 10 list. He has 154 swipes in 93 games.
- Zackery also ranks seventh on BC's all-time 3-point field goal percentage list, connecting on .394 for his career (104-264).

Season

- Post's 50 blocked shots this season rank as the eighth-most in a single-season in Boston College history.
- Devin McGlockton's .586 field goal percentage mark would rank as the 10th-best single-season FG proficiency mark.
- Claudell Harris Jr. needs 14 more 3-pointers to crack the top 10 mark for most 3FGM in a single-season.

POSSESSION IS THE BETTER PART OF VALOR

- Boston College's 1.34:1 assist/turnover ratio ranks as the third-best mark in program history and the best since 2005-06.
- BC's assist/turnover ratio ranks 72nd nationally - and seventh in the ACC - having compiled 392 assists to 292 turnovers.
- Since turnovers were compiled as a statistic in 1978-79, BC has registered an ATR of 1.30:1 or better only four times.

IF THIS, THEN THAT...

WITH A WIN VS. VIRGINIA...

- BC would move to 16-12 overall and 7-10 in ACC play
- The Eagles would move to 10-19 all-time vs. Virginia, including a 7-5 mark vs. UVA at Conte Forum
- BC would improve to 11-4 in home games, 3-4 in February, 12-5 in night games, and 11-7 on weekdays
- Head coach Earl Grant would earn his 45th win at Boston College and his 171st as a collegiate head coach.
- BC would earn victory #1,269 all-time through 91 seasons of basketball, dating back to 1904-05.

WITH A LOSS VS. VIRGINIA...

- BC would fall to 15-13 overall and 6-11 in ACC play
- The Eagles would drop their third straight game
- The Eagles would fall to 9-19 all-time vs. UVA, including a 6-6 mark at Conte Forum
- The Eagles would move to 10-5 at home, 2-5 in February, 11-6 in night games, and 10-8 on weekdays
- Boston College would register the 1,096th loss all-time in program history, dating back to the 1904-05 season.

LOW TURNOVER COUNT

- Boston College ranks 79th nationally (7th in ACC) in turnovers per game, committing 10.8 turnovers per game.
- It would rank as the lowest turnovers/game rate since Boston College tracked the stat beginning in 1979-80.
- Previously, the lowest turnovers per game rate was 2010-11, when BC committed 11.1 turns per outing.
- BC has registered single-digits in the TO column 14 times (10-4 in those games), including 3-1 in games with five or fewer.

YEAR OVER YEAR IMPROVEMENTS

- Boston College ranks 106th nationally (7th ACC) in scoring, at 76.0 points per game.
- A year ago, the Eagles were 303rd (14th ACC) in points per game, at nearly 10 points less (66.6) per outing.
- BC currently ranks 73rd nationally (4th ACC) in field goal percentage, connecting on 46.6% of its shot attempts.
- A season ago, the Eagles were 222nd (11th ACC), making only 43.7% of its shots from the floor.
- BC has seen similar jumps, year-over-year, in its 3-point field goal percentage.
- This year, the Eagles rank 37th nationally (3rd ACC) in 3FG%, connecting on 36.9% of their long-distance tries.
- In 2022-23, BC ranked among the bottom nationally - 294th (14th ACC) at 31.9%.

ANALYTICALLY CORRECT

- Per KenPom, Boston College ranks 54th nationally (6th ACC) in adjusted offensive efficiency with a 114.5 rating.
- The metric measures the total points scored by a team per 100 possessions.
- It is the highest national ranking in the key offensive metric since the 2013-14 season, when BC was 32nd with a 114.3 mark.
- In ACC play only, BC ranks seventh overall in the conference, with a 106.7 adjusted offensive efficiency mark.

McBLOCKTON

- BC is 23-11 when Devin McGlockton blocks at least one shot and 10-2 when he blocks at least two shots.
- The sophomore forward has registered at least one block in 18 of 27 games in 2023-24 and two blocks in six games.
- The versatile 6-7 post presence is averaging 1.0 blocked shots per game in over 30 minutes of playing time.

CAN'T KNOCK THE HUSTLE

- Boston College is 5-3 this year, 7-1 in 2022-23 and 13-5 since Feb. 21, 2022 when Jaeden Zackery scores at least 15 points.
- He scored a team-high 19 points, making all three 3-point attempts - including his 1,000th career points - at Florida State.
- Zackery tallied a career-high 21 points in nearly 39 minutes of play at The Citadel on Nov. 10.
- Against Notre Dame, Zackery had a team-high 20 points, grabbing three rebounds, and dropping three dimes.
- When Zackery goes to the free throw line at least five times, BC is 3-3 this year, was 7-2 in 2022-23, and is 12-6 all-time.
- Zackery has committed one or fewer turnovers in 12 games in 2023-24 and has 42 total turns in 790 minutes this year.
- Boston College has won 13 of its last 16 games when Zackery commits one or fewer turnovers in a game.
- Zackery is one of three ACC players (Beekman - 13; Mintz - 13; Zackery - 12) with at least 12 games of 10 pts/4 asst/2 stl.
- Last season, Zackery had nine games with four or more assists. He's done so in 19 of 27 games this season.
- On Feb. 13, Zackery became the 17th different Boston College player since the 1996-97 season to tally at least 100 assists.
- With 115 assists so far this season, it is the most dimes by an Eagle since 2018-19 (Ky Bowman - 125).

BRINGING YOU THE BEST OF THE 80'S AND 90'S

- Boston College has put forth two games with at least 95 points on the scoreboard - at Georgia Tech and vs. Holy Cross.
- Prior to this season, it marks the team's highest scoring total since Feb. 16, 2022 vs. Notre Dame (95).
- The 95 points at Georgia Tech ties for the third-most points scored by BC in an ACC game since joining the league in 2005-06.
- It the most points in a regulation game for BC since Jan. 1, 2017, when BC tallied 96 points in a home win over Syracuse.
- It ties as the highest single-game scoring total of the Earl Grant era and tied for the most points in a regulation Division I game under Grant as a head coach (95 pts at CofC vs. Hofstra - Feb. 14, 2019)
- In ACC play, Boston College has scored better than 80 points on four occasions - all wins.
- In nine-plus seasons between College of Charleston and Boston College, Earl Grant-coached teams are 48-6 when they score at least 80 points, 25-3 when they score at least 85, and 8-2 when scoring 90 or more.

COMEBACK KINGS

- Six of Boston College's 15 wins have come when the Eagles have trailed by double digits: Richmond (14, 1st half); Harvard (10, 2nd half); vs. St. John's (10, 2nd half), at Georgia Tech (16, 2nd half); Notre Dame (12, 1st half); Louisville (10, 1st half).
- Boston College's 16-point comeback win at Georgia Tech was the largest for the Eagles since Jan. 15, 2022.
- On that date, the Eagles came back from 23 down in the first half at Clemson to win by two - 70-68.
- The 16-point comeback at GT was the third-most in BC history, behind Clemson (23) and Kent State (18) on Dec. 29, 2004.

FEAST AND FAMINE

- In Boston College's ACC victories, the Eagles are averaging 78.8 points, connecting on 50.3% from the floor, 47.0% from the perimeter, and 70.7% from the foul line, while posting a 1.61:1 assist/turnover ratio and averaging 9.8 turns per outing.
- In ACC losses, BC is averaging 70.3 points, shooting 43.6% from the floor, 31.9% from beyond the arc, and 71.9% from the charity stripe, while registering a 1.07:1 ATR while averaging 12.0 turnovers per game.

BOSTON'S NEW BIG THREE FOUR

- Quinten Post (15.9 ppg), Claudell Harris Jr. (13.7), Jaeden Zackery (11.7), and Devin McGlockton (10.6) account for over 68% of BC's scoring. Through 27 games, the trio is averaging 52 of BC's 76.0 points per outing.
- The four account for over 55% of BC's rebounds, 70% of assists, 80% of blocks, 60% of steals, and 63% of 3-pointers made.
- In ACC games, the quartet accounts for nearly 71% of the Eagles' scoring output.

JUST PEACHY

- Devin McGlockton poured in a career-high 30 points in a sort of homecoming at Georgia Tech on Jan. 6.
- The sophomore from Cumming, Ga. - about 45 min. from Atlanta - added five rebounds, two assists, two steals, and a block.
- McGlockton connected on a career-best 12 field goals, including three 3-pointers, in the win.
- He is the second Eagle to reach the 30-point mark this season; Quinten Post poured in 31 points in BC's lidlifter vs. Fairfield.

UNPRECEDENTED

- This year, Quinten Post has set new single-game career-highs in points (31), rebounds (19), assists (9), blocks (6), and steals (6).
- **Since 1996-97, no player has equalled those single-game high statistical figures in a single-season.**
- In fact, since 1996-97, only four other players have tallied career-highs equal to what Post has done this season alone.
- Included in that list - 2002-23 National Player of the Year and 15-year NBA veteran David West (Xavier).

VIDEO GAME NUMBERS FOR QP

- Twice this season, Quinten Post has put up incredible stat lines, showcasing his versatility as a player.
- On Feb. 13 vs. Louisville, Post had 17 points, six boards, five assists, and a career-high six blocks.
- He is only the second player to post that line this season (St. John's' Joel Soriano vs. Xavier) and the first player to compile that stat line in an ACC game since Tim Duncan vs. Florida State (22 pts/10 reb/6 asst/9 blk) on Jan. 25, 1997
- Against Harvard, Quinten Post registered 20 points, 19 rebounds, five blocked shots, a steal and two assists in the win.
- The double-double was Post's third in four games and his 19 rebounds and five blocks were new career-highs.
- Since 1996-97, only two other players in the ACC have posted similar stat lines: Duncan (Wake) and Shelden Williams (Duke).
- Duncan posted 22 points, 22 boards, five blocks, and two assists in a win over Saint Mary's on March 14, 1997.
- Williams had 21 points, 19 rebounds, five blocks, three assists, and two steals on Dec. 4, 2005 against Virginia Tech.
- Over the last 25 years, two Boston College players have had games with at least 20 points and 19 rebounds.
- Ryan Anderson had 23 points and 19 boards (three blocks) against UNH on Dec. 16, 2012 and Ryan Sidney had 22 points and 19 rebounds (9 assists) against St. Bonaventure on Dec. 4, 2002.

ROAD-TESTED

- Boston College began the season 3-0 in true road games, earning wins at The Citadel, Vanderbilt, and Georgia Tech.
- It marked the first time since the 2004-05 campaign that BC has won its first three road games to start the year.
- They were 2-21 in their previous 23 ACC road contests. (*h/t BC radio play-by-play announcer Josh Maurer*).
- *The Eagles have logged four true road victories, matching the team's total from 2022-23 and 2019-20.*
- *The last time Boston College won at least five true road games was 2010-11.*

THAT'S OFFENSIVE

- Devin McGlockton's seven offensive rebounds vs. Wake Forest were the most by a Boston College player in an ACC game since Feb. 8, 2022 when James Karnik had seven offensive rebounds vs. Duke on Feb. 12, 2022.
- Quinten Post also had seven offensive boards at home versus Syracuse on Feb. 8, 2022.

HARRIS SHINES AMONG THE BRIGHT LIGHTS OF THE HEIGHTS

- Claudell Harris Jr. has scored in double figures in 18 of the 26 games in which he has appeared this season.
- Harris has scored 20 or more 16 times in his career - including four with BC this season.
- On Feb. 13, Harris led the Eagles with 20 points (8-12 FG; 4-6 3FG) last time out at Louisville.
- He scored a season-high 29 points - including the 1,000th of his career - knocking down 7-of-10 3FG against Lehigh.
- At Georgia Tech, Harris had 26 points shooting 8-of-10 from the floor - and 4-of-4 from beyond the arc - in the road win.
- The junior guard also added 22 points at Vanderbilt, making 9-of-13 shots - including 4-of-6 from beyond the arc.
- Harris arrived at BC as a transfer from Charleston Southern and will have two seasons of eligibility remaining.
- He shined for CSU for two seasons, earning All-Big South second team honors as a sophomore a season ago.
- The 6-3 guard averaged 17.5 points per game last year - the second-best scoring mark in the Big South.
- Harris scored in double figures in 28 of 30 games for the Buccaneers in 2022-23 - including two consecutive 30-point games.
- Harris spent two seasons at Charleston Southern and was named to the 2021-22 Big South All-Freshman Team, averaging 10.3 points, 4.2 rebounds, and 2.0 assists in 31 games played (14 starts) in his first collegiate season.

WELCOME TO THE 30/25 CLUB

- Devin McGlockton (30) and Claudell Harris Jr. (26) joined a rare club in Boston College Men's Basketball history.
- It marked the first time since the 2006-07 season that BC had a game where a player had at least 30 points and another 25.
- On Dec. 28, 2006, Sean Marshall (30) and Tyrese Rice (29) did so in an overtime loss to Duquesne.
- Troy Bell had 30 and Craig Smith 27 in an overtime win against St. Bonaventure on Dec. 4, 2002.
- On Feb. 19, 2000, when Bell (31) and Xavier Singletery (25) did so in an 80-76 regulation win at West Virginia.

A HELPING HAND FOR 2023-24

- Donald Hand Jr. is averaging over 5.0 points and has connected on 20 3-pointers off the bench for BC.
- Hand scored a career-best 16 points against CCSU on Dec. 5, making 5-of-9 shots - including 3-of-6 from the perimeter.
- The redshirt freshman scored 11 of his 16 points in the second half, also adding three rebounds and two steals.
- On Dec. 10, Hand Jr. scored 11 points in a win over St. John's in 17 minutes of play.
- Against Lehigh, he had nine points to go with a career-best six rebounds while tallying seven points against Wake Forest.
- He has reached double-digits in the scoring column on four occasions; he had 13 points vs. Holy Cross and 14 at The Citadel.
- Last year, Hand Jr. tore his ACL after :37 of play in the first half vs. Detroit Mercy - game two of the season - on Nov. 11, 2022.
- After successful surgery on Nov. 30, 2022, the 6-5 guard relentlessly attacked his rehabilitation.
- Despite being fully cleared for action during this past summer, Hand did not play in the Eagles' three-game European tour.

BACK TO DECEMBER

- BC closed out a 4-1 December with four straight victories, including an 86-80 win over St. John's in Brooklyn.
- Over those five games, Claudell Harris Jr. led the Eagles in scoring, at nearly a 17.0 ppg clip.
- Harris scored the 1,000th point of his career en route to pouring in a season-high 29 vs. Lehigh.
- During the month of December, Harris drilled nearly 55% of his 3-point attempts (13-24) - including 7-10 vs. Lehigh.
- Jaeden Zackery averaged 15.2 points, 3.6 rebounds, 4.2 assists, and 1.8 steals in five December games.
- The junior guard connected on nearly 61% from the floor (31-51), while registering a 3.50:1 assist/turnover ratio.
- In 151 minutes played in five December games, Zackery committed only six turnovers.
- Quinten Post dominated the stat sheet in December: 14.0 points, 8.3 boards, 4.4 assists, 2.0 blocks, and 1.2 steals per game.
- The 7-footer set new career-highs in assists (9 vs. St. John's) and blocked shots (6 vs. Holy Cross) in December.

CLAUDELL HARRIS JR. REACHES 1,000-POINT MARK

- Claudell Harris Jr. scored his 1,000th point on Dec. 21 vs. Lehigh. The milestone basket was a 3-pointer with 4:45 remaining.
- Entering the game, Harris needed 28 points to reach 1,000 - he scored a season-high 29 points, connecting on seven 3FG.
- Prior to arriving at BC, Harris tallied 840 points in 61 games at Charleston Southern.
- Harris became the third transfer player in the past three seasons to score his 1,000th career point at BC.

EAGLES PERFECT FROM THE LINE VS. COLORADO STATE

- Boston College put forth the second-best FT proficiency mark in program history (min. 20 FTA) vs. Colorado State.
- BC made 20-of-20 from the charity stripe vs. the Rams. The next game, BC made 10-of-11 free throws vs. Loyola Chicago.
- The Eagles' all-time best single-game mark (22-of-22) - came at Providence on Jan. 10, 1995.
- The Eagles rank 26th nationally in free throw percentage, having connected on a 77.4% (103-133) clip this season.

QUINTEN POST EARNS USBWA NATIONAL & ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

- Quinten Post was named one of five Oscar Robertson National Players of the Week by the USBWA on Nov. 21.
- A day earlier, he was named the ACC Player of the Week, it was announced by the conference office on Nov. 20.
- It marked the first time since Feb. 12, 2018 that a BC player was honored as ACC Player of the Week (Jerome Robinson).
- He averaged 18.5 points, 14.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists, and 3.0 blocks - including two double-doubles - in a 2-0 week.
- Post had 17 points, 10 rebounds, and a career-best five assists in a win over Richmond on Nov. 15.
- He followed that up with 20 points and new career-highs with 19 rebounds and five blocked shots in the win over Harvard.

QP POURS IN CAREER-HIGH 31 VS. FAIRFIELD

- Quinten Post poured in a career-high 31 points in Boston College's season opening win over Fairfield.
- Post was 11-of-14 from the floor, including 5-of-6 from 3FG, and 4-of-5 from the FT line.
- The 7-footer added 11 rebounds and a career-high four blocked shots in 29 minutes of play.
- He is the first Boston College player since Ky Bowman (37 vs. FSU; Jan. 20, 2019) to score at least 30 points in a game.
- It was the highest point total by a BC player in a season opener since Troy Bell had 31 vs. St. Peter's on Nov. 19, 2000.
- Since 1996-97, there have been eight occasions where a BC player registered a double-double with at least 30 points.
- Additionally, since 1996-97, there have been a total of 134 games where a player tallied at least 30 points, 10 rebounds, and four blocked shots. **Only 15 have done it in 29 minutes of game action or less.**

PIONEER AND TRAILBLAZER JOHN AUSTIN HONORED ON FEB. 17

- On Feb. 17, Boston College men's basketball pioneer and trailblazer John Austin had his jersey retired.
- Austin was the first African American to play for the Eagles' and the first-ever BC player to earn All-American accolades.
- He starred for BC from 1963-66 and quickly established himself as one of the top scorers in the country.
- As a sophomore at the Heights, the 6-1 guard averaged 29.2 points per game - good for eighth nationally.
- He followed that up by ranking sixth nationally in scoring as a junior, pouring in 26.9 points per game. For his efforts that season, Austin earned the first of his numerous All-American honors from the AP, NABC, USBWA, and the Helms Foundation.
- As a senior, Austin scored at a 25.4 points per game clip for the Eagles, leading the way for another trip to the NIT.
- Austin again was honored nationally, earning All-American accolades from the NABC, USBWA, Helms Foundation, and UPI.
- Each of Austin's single-season scoring averages still rank 1-2-3 in Boston College history.
- This season marks the 60th anniversary of his single-game scoring record. On Feb. 21, 1964, Austin erupted for 49 points against Georgetown. He scored 33 of his 49 points in the first half, finishing with 16 made FG and 17 made FT.
- In addition to his BC record, it remains the most points ever scored against Georgetown by an opposing player.
- At the time of Austin's graduation in 1966, he left as the program's all-time leading scorer, totaling 1,845 points in 68 games.
- Austin was inducted into the Boston College Varsity Club Athletic Hall of Fame in 1972. He passed away in November 2020.

BOSTON COLLEGE OPENS THE HOAG BASKETBALL PAVILION

- On September 28, Boston College officially dedicated the Hoag Basketball Pavilion.
- The new home for its men's and women's basketball programs was made possible by a \$15 million gift - the largest in BC athletics history - from University Trustee Michaela "Mikey" Hoag '86 and her husband Jay.
- Located at the northwest corner of Conte Forum, the Hoag Basketball Pavilion features a grand illuminated glass entrance and walls, which provide a significant infusion of natural light and views to and from the campus.
- The nearly 40,000-square-foot facility features new player locker rooms and lounge areas, a sports medicine center, and a nutrition center on the first floor.
- Upstairs, the crown jewel of the Hoag Basketball Pavilion is the renovated 10,700-square-foot practice gym, adjacent to the newly created strength & conditioning center and team video rooms.

QP POSTS THE FIRST 50/40/80 LINE IN A DECADE

- Last year, Quinten Post became the first player in 10 years to post a 50/40/80 shooting line while scoring better than 15.0 ppg.
- Post connected on 53.9% from the floor, 42.6% from the perimeter, and 86.0% from the free throw line in 2022-23.
- The 7-footer made 111-of-204 shots from the floor, including 23-of-54 from the perimeter. Post also made 43-of-50 FT.
- Post - the 2022-23 ACC Most Improved Player - averaged a team-best 15.1 points in 19 games.
- He scored 20 or more points six times and reached double figures on 13 occasions.
- Last season, Post scored a career-high 29 points and tied a career-best with 14 rebounds in a win at Notre Dame on Jan. 21.
- Post was 10-for-14 from the floor, 4-of-5 from the beyond the arc, and 5-of-5 from the charity stripe in 29 minutes.
- He missed the first 13 games of the 2023-24 campaign (foot).
- The last player to post those percentages for an entire season (min. 15.0 ppg): Creighton's Doug McDermott in 2012-13.

EARL GRANT

THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Earl Grant enters his third season as the Clement and Elizabeth IZZI Family Head Men's Basketball Coach at Boston College. Throughout his first two seasons at the Heights, Grant has established a culture of gritty and relentless play on the court, combined with selfless humility family atmosphere, and holistic development as people and players off the court.

Grant guided BC to 16 wins during the 2022-23 season, including nine in ACC play. As a result, BC and Grant extended their partnership through the 2028-29 season.

During the 2022-23 campaign, Grant's gritty group tallied three wins over nationally ranked opponents, including a 63-48 drubbing of No. 6 Virginia - the first win over a top 10 team in nearly six seasons. Led by ACC Most Improved Player Quinten Post, Boston College won nine games in ACC play - the most since the 2010-11 campaign. Four of the Eagles nine ACC wins came on the road - the highest win total in away games since 2008-09.

In his first season, Grant's Eagles advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2022 New York Life ACC Tournament in Brooklyn, narrowly missing a trip to the semis after a two-point overtime loss to Elite Eight participant Miami. Grant also orchestrated one of the highest-rated recruiting classes in program history, signing two four-star ranked players in the same class for the first time ever. The incoming class of newcomers ranked 30th nationally by Rivals.com and 33rd by 247sports.com.

On March 17, 2021 Grant was introduced as Boston College's 13th head men's basketball coach, bringing an impressive track record to Chestnut Hill after he turned the College of Charleston men's basketball program into a consistent championship contender in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Under Grant's leadership, the College of Charleston was one of only 21 NCAA Division I schools to have players drafted in both the 2019 and 2020 NBA Drafts. Grant led the Cougars to a top-four finish in the CAA in each of the last five seasons, including the 2018 regular season and conference tournament championship.

A finalist for the 2019 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, presented annually to a coach who not only achieves success on the basketball court, but who also displays moral integrity off the court, Grant led the Cougars to a memorable run in 2017-18 that included the program's second-straight 25-win campaign, an impressive 26-8 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. The co-regular-season champions earned the No. 1 seed in the CAA Men's Basketball Championship and defeated No. 2 seed Northeastern in an overtime thriller to punch the program's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 1999.

Grant guided the Cougars to three 20-win campaigns and a 67-22 home-court winning record over the previous six years and produced 12 all-conference honorees.

For the first time in program history, College of Charleston's men's basketball was recognized by the NCAA for the 2018-19 academic year. Under the guidance of Grant, the programs' four-year rolling APR was in the Top 10% of all men's basketball programs in the country. The Cougars were one of only 51 men's basketball programs honored nationally. In all, 24 players have gone on to earn their degree at The College.

In 2018-19, CofC posted a 24-9 overall record with non-conference victories over Rhode Island, VCU and Memphis. Two players - Grant Riller and Jarrell Brantley - were named to the All-CAA First Team. Known for their gritty defense, the Cougars led the CAA in scoring defense for the fourth-straight year holding opponents to 68.6 points per game. CofC also ranked No. 17 in the nation in turnovers per game (10.5 avg.) and No. 16 in free-throw percentage (76.4%).

Known as a player's coach, Grant and his staff helped develop Brantley into a 2019 NBA Draft Pick and Riller into a 2020 NBA Draft Pick - the third and fourth-ever College of Charleston players to be drafted. Brantley is currently a two-way player with the Utah Jazz and was named to the 2020 NBA G League First Team and All-Rookie Team as a member of the Salt Lake City Stars. He was second in voting for NBA G League Rookie of the Year honors. Riller was selected in the second round by the Charlotte Hornets giving the Cougars back-to-back NBA Draft picks for the first time in school history.

In 2016-17, Grant led the Cougars to a 25-10 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. It marked the program's first 20-win campaign since 2013. Charleston, seeded a program-best No. 2, advanced to the championship game of the CAA Tournament for the first time since CofC joined the Colonial in 2013. They were also selected and made their fifth all-time appearance in the Postseason NIT. It was their first postseason berth (NCAA or NIT) since 2011.

In his second season with the Cougars, Grant and his staff turned the program into one of the most improved in NCAA Division I and developed four all-conference players including Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and All-CAA Third Team selection Jarrell Brantley - the first freshman to receive such honors since 2006.

Known as a top recruiter, Grant has shown impressive credentials in both identifying and developing top-flight talent. No stranger to the ACC, he previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Clemson under Brad Brownell, where he made a positive impact on the Tiger men's basketball program, both in recruiting and with player development. He worked primarily with Clemson's point guards.

He recruited 2014 first-team All-ACC selection K.J. McDaniels to Clemson, where he ultimately ended up averaging 17 points per game as a junior and was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, before declaring early for the NBA Draft. McDaniels was selected 32nd overall in the 2014 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers.

Several Tiger point guards have flourished under Grant's mentoring including incumbent starter Rod Hall. After recruiting the Augusta, Ga., native to Clemson, Grant has seen Hall develop into one of the leaders of the program. During the 2013-14 season, Hall was second on the team in scoring average and ranked among the ACC's top 10 in both assists per game and assist-to-turnover ratio.

In 2010-11, Grant worked with Demontez Stitt, who was named third-team All-ACC and was a member of the All-ACC Tournament Team. That same season, Grant helped Andre Young to an ACC-leading 2.55 assist-to-turnover ratio. Young went on to lead the conference in steals per game as a senior in 2011-12, earning All-ACC Defensive Team honors. He also led the Tigers in scoring under Grant's direction.

Clemson put together strong team results with Grant in the fold as well. In 2013-14, the Tigers went 23-13 overall and recorded a 10-win improvement from the previous season. Clemson advanced to the NIT semifinals and was 10-8 during the ACC regular season.

In Grant's first season in 2010-11, Clemson put together a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 league mark in the ACC. The Tigers earned the No. 4 seed at the ACC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals in Greensboro, N.C. Clemson also went to a fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament and won its first-round game over UAB, 70-52, in Dayton, Ohio.

Clemson was strong defensively in four seasons with Grant part of its coaching staff. In 2010-11, the Tigers ranked No. 24 nationally in scoring defense. In 2011-12, Clemson yielded just 60.6 points per game to the opposition, the second-best figure among ACC schools. In 2012-13, the Tigers dropped their average even further to 60.1 points per game. That figure dropped to an ACC era-best at Clemson - 58.4 points per game - in 2013-14. The Tiger perimeter defense was No. 1 nationally defending the three-pointer (.286).

Grant personally signed 10 of Clemson's 15 players recruited by Brownell's staff. He was Clemson's lead recruiter for players such as Austin Ajuikwa, Jaron Blossomgame, Gabe DeVoe, Ibrahim Djambo, Sidy Djitte, Hall, K.J. McDaniels and Patrick Rooks.

Prior to Clemson, Grant served as an assistant coach first at Winthrop and then at Wichita State. He helped the Eagles to three consecutive Big South championships and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2004-05, the Eagles were 27-6 overall. The next season, Winthrop finished the year with a 23-8 overall record and came within two points of upsetting Tennessee in the NCAA Tournament. In 2007, Grant helped the Eagles to a 29-5 overall record and unblemished 14-0 mark in Big South play.

The 2007 campaign was a memorable one for Winthrop. With Grant's assistance, the Eagles claimed a 74-64 upset over No. 6 seed Notre Dame in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. It was Winthrop's first-ever NCAA Tournament win in seven tries.

Grant was at Wichita State from 2007-10, when the Shockers made gradual improvement each season. In 2008-09, Wichita State made its first postseason appearance in three years and also defeated one of the nation's top mid-major programs in Siena during the regular season. In 2009-10, Wichita State improved its win total by eight and finished 25-10 overall, 12-6 in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Shockers advanced to the championship game of the conference tournament and also earned a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Prior to his stint at Winthrop, Grant was an assistant coach at The Citadel from 2002-04. Grant played two years at the Division II level at Georgia College. He led the school to two appearances in the NCAA Tournament and to consecutive Peach Belt Conference championships (1999, 2000). In 2000, the Bobcats advanced to the Elite Eight of the Division II national tournament.

A native of North Charleston, S.C., Grant earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgia College in 2000. He and his wife, Jacqui, have three sons: Trey, Eyaiah and Elonzo.
