Team Notes

- Virginia (22-9, 13-7 ACC) earned the No. 3 seed in the ACC Tournament with the win
- UVA has won 22 or games in 11 of 15 seasons under Tony Bennett
- UVA has 13 or more league wins in six of the last seven seasons
- The Cavaliers finished with a 15-2 record at John Paul Jones Arena in 2023-24, marking the ninth time UVA has won 15 or more home games
- UVA is 168-11 all-time when scoring 70 or more points under Bennett
- UVA is 11-0 when scoring 70 or more points in 2023-24.
- UVA led 38-24 at the half and improved to 20-0 when leading at halftime
- UVA shot 51.8 percent (29 of 56), including 12 of 26 from 3-point range
- UVA made 10 or more 3-pointers for the eighth time and first since drilling 10 at Florida State on Feb. 10
- UVA attempted a season-low four free throws
- UVA forced one shot clock violation (26 in 2023-24)

Series Notes

- Virginia is 49-40 all-time vs. Georgia Tech, including a 27-11 mark in Charlottesville, in a series that dates to 1947-48
- The Cavaliers have a 12-game win streak in the series and 10-game home win streak against the Yellow Jackets
- Virginia is 20-2 in its last 22 games against Georgia Tech, including a 19-2 mark under head coach Tony Bennett

Player Notes

- Double Figure Scorers: Reece Beekman (21), Isaac McKneely (16), Taine Murray (12)
- Beekman matched a career high with 21 points
- Beekman moved into 42nd on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,152 points
- Beekman reached double figures for the 56th time (26 in 2023-24)
- McKneely reached double figures for the 25th time
- Murray reached double figures for the fourth time (3 in 2023-24)
- Murray played a career-high 28 minutes
- Beekman (9 assists) moved into seventh on UVA's single-season assist list with 18
- UVA honored seniors Tristan How, Jordan Minor, Jake Groves and Reece Beekman and managers Joe Busch, Wayne Yen and Brian Rodgers in a pregame ceremony
