### OPENING DRAW

#### GAME OVERVIEW

- No. 2 Virginia (10-1, 1-0) travels to No. 3 Duke (10-3, 0-2) for the Cavaliers' first ACC road contest and highest ranked matchup of the 2024 season on Sunday (April 14).
- Opening faceoff from Koskinen Stadium is set for 2 p.m. as Chris Cotter (play-by-play), Quint Kessenich (analyst) and Paul Carcaterra (analyst) will have the call on ACC Network.

#### SEASON OVERVIEW

- Virginia is in its eighth season under head coach **Lars Tiffany**, who boasts a 90-31 record as Cavalier head coach.
- The Hoos are coming off their third Championship Weekend appearance in the last four opportunities.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- In its ACC opener at Klöckner Stadium last Saturday (April 6), Virginia dominated North Carolina, 14-6, on the way to its sixth consecutive win of the series against the Tar Heels.
- The win also marked UVA's seventh consecutive of the season.
- On the defensive end, the Cavaliers were led by **Cole Kastner** (2gb, 3ct), **Chase Yager** (1gb, 4ct) and ACC Defensive Player of the Week **Noah Chizmar** (2g, 4gb, 2ct).
- Chizmar scored his first of two goals on the game's opening possession only 11 seconds in.
- Kastner held his matchup – attackman Owen Duffy, the No. 1 prospect in the 2023 signing class according to Inside Lacrosse – to one goal and two assists.
- UVA's defense kept the Tar Heels off the scoreboard for 26:43 in the second half, and forced six failed clears, while remaining perfect going the other way.
- Offensively, the Hoos received goals from 10 different players. **Connor Shellenberger** (2g, 3a) led the charge with five points.

## THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

### UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

**Grounds:** The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

**First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year:** Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

**Commonwealth:** Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

### UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

### THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

### UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

### WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

## SERIES HISTORY

- Virginia leads the all-time series over the Blue Devils, 50-38, but Duke leads the series in Durham, 23-19, and has won 15 of the last 16 meetings overall.
- The last time the two teams met was on April 15, 2023, at Koskinen Stadium, when the then third-ranked Blue Devils defeated No. 2 Virginia, 15-14. Duke led by as many as seven goals [10-3] in the first half, and UVA outscored the Blue Devils 6-3 in the fourth quarter, but ultimately ran out of time to mount a comeback.
- Ian Laviano's double overtime game-winning goal in the 2019 NCAA Tournament semifinals at Lincoln Financial Field marks the last time that the Cavaliers defeated Duke.
- The Hoos have dropped their last 18 regular-season meetings against Duke. UVA's last regular-season win over the Blue Devils was a 13-4 victory on April 17, 2004.
- Virginia's last win in Durham was an 11-8 victory on April 12, 2003. The Cavaliers have lost the last 12 meetings held at Koskinen Stadium.
- UVA and Duke have different all-time series records due to the fluidity of when a program was a "varsity" sport up until the conclusion of WWII. UVA lists its "varsity only" record against Duke above.

## A WIN FOR THE CAVALIERS WOULD...

- Give Virginia an 11-1 overall record, its best start through the first 12 games of the season since 2010.
- Tie for UVA's longest win streak since winning eight straight games in 2019.
- Snap an 18-game losing skid in the regular-season series with the Blue Devils, which began in 2005.
- Deliver UVA's first win at Koskinen Stadium since 2003.
- Be Virginia's seventh win over a top-3 team under Lars Tiffany.
- Give Tiffany his second career win over the Blue Devils.

## VIRGINIA IS ONE OF THE NATION'S HOTTEST TEAMS

- Virginia is one of four teams nationally with an active win streak of at least seven games.
- Only Georgetown (8), Saint Joseph's (7) and Sacred Heart (7) are currently riding win streaks of seven games or more.
- Virginia's most recent loss was against then-No. 7 Johns Hopkins on March 2 in a 16-14 decision at Klöckner Stadium.
- The last time UVA rode a seven-game win streak was during the 2019 regular season. The Cavaliers won three consecutive overtime games over Princeton, Syracuse and Brown to kick off the streak.

## HOOS TO DEBUT 1999 NAVY BLUE UNIFORMS IN DURHAM

- After debuting its 1999 throwback uniforms in white to commemorate the 25th anniversary of UVA's 1999 national championship team, Virginia will don the navy blue version against Duke on Sunday.
- Last weekend, UVA welcomed back members of the program's second NCAA championship team and recognized them at halftime of its game against North Carolina.
- The 1999 title marked the first of four ('99, '03, '06, '11) under legendary head coach Dom Starsia.
- The 1999 championship ended Virginia's 27-year drought since it won its first title in 1972.
- After the '72 championship run, the Hoos reached the NCAA title game four times (1980, 1986, 1994, 1996), but lost in overtime each time.

## CHIZMAR NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- For his performance against North Carolina, short-stick defensive midfielder **Noah Chizmar** was named the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week on April 9.
- The announcement marked Chizmar's first career ACC weekly honor.
- He scored only 11 seconds in on the game's opening possession and again with 10:36 remaining in the first half, which proved to be the game-winning goal.
- On defensive end, Chizmar collected four ground balls and a pair of caused turnovers, one of which was while the Cavaliers were man-down.

## CAVALIERS AMONG THE NATION'S STATISTICAL LEADERS

- For games played through April 10, Virginia leads the nation in assists (10.09), caused turnovers (11.64) and win percentage (.909).
- The Cavaliers are second in points (25.27), third in ground balls (39.18), fourth in man-up offense (.524) and scoring margin (5.45), fifth in scoring offense (15.18), and seventh in shooting percentage (.331).
- Among all Division I players this season, **Payton Cormier** is currently No. 1 in goals (3.73) and 16th in points (4.64). **Connor Shellenberger** is ninth in assists (3.00) and 13th in points (4.82). **Matthew Nunes** is sixth in save percentage (.583) and ninth in goals-against (9.54) and **Cole Kastner** is 16th in caused turnovers (1.82).



**THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM**

- Virginia owns a 179-46 (.796) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 6-1 record in 2024, and has won 22 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 6.8 goals.
- Virginia is 53-14 (.791) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach **Lars Tiffany**.
- UVA is also 14-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in NCAA Tournament contests.
- Lacrosse debuted in Klöckner Stadium in 1993.

**ON THE HORIZON**

- The Cavaliers continue their two-game road stint when they travel to Syracuse (9-4, 1-1), which is ranked No. 9 in the most recent USILA coaches poll, on Saturday (April 20).
- Opening faceoff from the JMA Wireless Dome is set for 2 p.m. on ESPN+.

**CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE**

- Virginia attackman **Connor Shellenberger** is in his final collegiate season in 2024.
- Shellenberger guided the Hoos to Championship Weekend last season after leading the nation in assists (3.38/gm).
- With **173** career assists, he is Virginia's all-time assist record holder, and currently leads all active Division I players.
- Shellenberger is one of just two Cavaliers to garner USILA First Team All-America honors, the other being former defenseman Ken Clausen.
- In addition to being a Tewaaraton finalist for the second time of his career in 2023, Shellenberger garnered NCAA All-Tournament honors after combining for 11 goals and 11 assists in the Cavaliers' three tournament games last season.
- Shellenberger was also the 2021 NCAA Tournament Most Outstanding Player after leading the Hoos to their seventh NCAA championship, also the program's ninth national championship overall.

**CONNOR SHELLENBERGER RECORD WATCH**

- With his second point of the day against UAlbany (March 19), **Connor Shellenberger** became UVA's all-time leader in career points.
- Shellenberger currently leads all active Division-I players in career assists and is one of just two active players (Matt Brandau, Yale) with at least **292** career points.

**PAYTON CORMIER: VIRGINIA'S CAREER GOALS LEADER**

- With his second goal at Richmond (Feb. 17), **Payton Cormier** became Virginia's all-time leading goal scorer.
- Cormier shattered Doug Knight's previous program record of 165 career goals, which Knight accomplished in 60 games.
- Cormier broke the record in just 57 career games.
- Now with **200** career goals, Cormier currently lead all active Division I players.
- Among all of UVA's 100-career goal scorers, Cormier is the only one to average at least **3.03** goals per game.
- Cormier is also the only player in program history to record a pair of 50-goal seasons, having scored 52 goals last year and 50 goals in 2022.
- He notched a career-high seven goals against Ohio State in 2023, which tied for No. 2 in UVA single-game history.
- This season Cormier has recorded multiple goals in all but one of UVA's games, six of which have been hat tricks.

**MATTHEW NUNES: ONE OF UVA'S MOST ELITE GOALIES**

- Junior goalie **Matthew Nunes** set the Virginia single-season program record with 213 saves in 17 games last season.
- Nunes broke Alex Rode's 2021 program record of 212 saves, which Rode achieved in 16 games.
- During his freshman season in 2022, Nunes broke Tillman Johnson's program freshman record with 159 saves.
- In 2023, Nunes led all ACC goalies in save percentage (.551) among conference games only.
- He finished second overall in the ACC in goals-against average (11.95) and saves per game (14.33) last season.
- Nunes has been at his best in the biggest of games (see table below).

**CORMIER, NUNES SWEEP ACC WEEKLY HONORS**

- For the performances in UVA's 13-10 comeback win at then-No. 16 Harvard (March 30), **Payton Cormier** and **Matthew Nunes** swept ACC's Offensive and Defensive player-of-the-week honors, respectively, the conference office announced April 2.
- The announcement marked Cormier's sixth career ACC weekly honor, including third this year. Nunes now has five ACC career weekly honors, including a pair this season.
- Cormier scored a game-high four goals and dished out one assist. His third goal of the day kickstarted a 7-0 run in the fourth quarter, which ultimately put the Hoos ahead to stay.
- Nunes scored the game-winning goal in dramatic fashion and recorded a game-high 16 against the Crimson.
- Amid a UVA clear with five minutes remaining, Nunes carried the ball end to end and fired a shot that bounced past the Harvard keeper to break a 10-10 tied score.
- Nunes' goal against the Crimson is the first by a UVA goalie since Adam Ghitelman scored in 2010 ACC Tournament semifinals against Duke.
- It's also the first score by an ACC goalie since Syracuse's Evan Molloy found the back of the net against Colgate in 2017.

**CORMIER NAMED ACC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

- For games played March 18-24, **Payton Cormier** was named ACC Offensive Player of the Week after averaging 5.5 goals in UVA's wins over UAlbany (March 19) and Drexel (March 23).
- Cormier's six goals against Drexel also propelled him into the top 10 of the NCAA Division I career goals list
- He is also the only ACC player to record at five three goals in three different games this season.

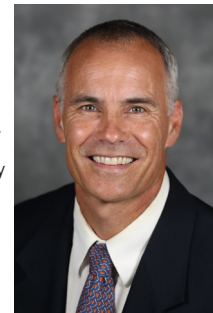
**NUNES TABBED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**OVERVIEW**

Lars Tiffany was named Virginia's 17<sup>th</sup> head coach on June 21, 2016. He is currently in his seventh season at UVA and 19th season overall as head coach. Tiffany is Virginia's only head coach to win back-to-back national championships (2019 & 2021). Tiffany begins the 2023 season with 67 wins as UVA head coach, good for No. 3 all-time in program history behind only Jim "Ace" Adams (137) and Dom Starsia (274).

He was Co-MVP of the Brown squad that captured its first-ever NCAA playoff victory in 1990 (12-9 vs. UMass). Tiffany capped his career by playing in the North-South Senior All-Star game.

## CORMIER, WAYER NAB ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- For their performances against Richmond (Feb. 17), **Payton Cormier** and **Ben Wayer** were named ACC Co-Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week, respectively, the league office announced on Feb. 20.
- The announcement marks Cormier's fourth career ACC weekly honor and Wayer's first.
- Cormier scored three goals and set the program's all-time goals record in the win.
- For the second consecutive week, Wayer collected ground balls and added one caused turnover.
- Wayer also played a pivotal role in the Spiders' six failed clears, four of which occurred in the fourth quarter.
- Wayer was also a key contributor on UVA's faceoff unit, which won 15 of the game's 26 total faceoffs, including 10 of 14 in the second half.
- Additionally, UR's starting midfield line combined for just two goals.

## ACC CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

- Virginia has claimed at least a share of 19 ACC championships, including two (2019 & 2022) under head coach **Lars Tiffany**.
- The Cavaliers won 11 titles (1962, 1964, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1975, 1980, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986) prior the ACC establishing a tournament from 1989-2019 to determine the champion.
- Virginia has won seven ACC Tournament championships: 1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2010 and 2019.
- In the last ACC Tournament, which was held in 2019 at Klöckner Stadium, UVA defeated Notre Dame 10-4 in the championship game.
- From 1989-2019, Virginia won 14 regular-season titles (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012 and 2019), more than any other ACC School.
- The ACC Tournament returns this season and will be contested at American Legion Stadium in Charlotte, N.C. on May 3 and 5.

## 2023 SEASON RECAP

- Virginia finished its 2023 season with an overall record of 13-4, marking the Cavaliers' seventh consecutive winning season.
- For the third time in their last four opportunities, the Cavaliers reached Championship Weekend after NCAA Tournament wins over Richmond and Georgetown.
- For the second consecutive year and 12th time in program history, **Connor Shellenberger** was named one of the nation's five Tewaaraton Finalists.
- Despite knocking off Notre Dame in both regular-season matchups last season, Virginia fell to the Fighting Irish in overtime, 13-12, in the NCAA semifinals at Lincoln Financial Field.
- Shellenberger combined for 11 goals and 11 assists in three tournament games and was named to the NCAA All-Tournament Team for the second time of his career.
- The Cavaliers did not return a total of 18 players from 2023 to this year.
- Virginia had arguably its most prolific season offensively in school history as the Cavaliers set program records in goals (293), assists (195) and points (488).
- Former UVA midfielder Thomas McConvey was named the program's seventh recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Award, which is given to the nation's top midfielder.
- Xander Dickson set the program's single-season goals record with 61 scores. He is UVA's only 60-goal scorer in a single season.

## TRANSFERS ADD IMMEDIATE DEPTH

- This offseason, Lars Tiffany signed five transfers: **Jack Boyden** (Tufts), **Chase Yager** (Harvard), **Anthony Ghobriel** (Navy), **Thomas Colucci** (Colgate) and **Matthew DeSouza** (Binghamton).
- Boyden was the Division-III national player and attackman of the year in 2023. He logged 167 goals and 143 assists during his tenure (2020-23) with the Jumbos.
- Yager was a standout short-stick defensive midfielder at Harvard from 2020-23. Prior to his career with the Crimson, Yager attended Norfolk Academy. Yager was named a 2024 Inside Lacrosse Preseason All-American.
- Ghobriel, Colucci and DeSouza are all faceoff specialists. Ghobriel is a junior, while Colucci and DeSouza are graduate transfers.

- Tiffany often reflects on the roots of the game and admiration of the Onondaga in interviews and press conferences (via Inside Lacrosse).

**KEVIN CASSESE NAMED ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH**

- Last summer, head coach Lars Tiffany announced the addition **Kevin Cassese** as the program's associate head coach and offensive coordinator.
- Cassese spent the previous 16 seasons as the head coach of Lehigh University, where he became the school's all-time winningest coach and guided the Mountain Hawks to three Patriot League titles.
- A total of 21 Lehigh players achieved USILA All-America status under Cassese's tutelage, including 2021 first-team faceoff specialist Mike Sisselberger, who set the NCAA Division-I single season faceoff win percentage record (79.5).
- Prior to serving as Lehigh head coach, Cassese was an assistant coach at his alma mater, Duke, from 2005-07. In 2007, Cassese and the Blue Devils reached the NCAA Championship game, which marked the program's second national championship appearance. He also served as Duke's interim head coach for part of the summer of 2006.
- In 2005, Cassese was an assistant coach and offensive coordinator at Stony Brook under Tiffany and conducted the nation's top man-up unit. Tiffany, Cassese and the Seawolves finished the season with a 10-6 overall record.
- A National Lacrosse Hall of Fame class of 2018 inductee, Cassese enjoyed an illustrious playing career at Duke from 2000-03, where he was twice team captain and Tewaaron Award finalist (2002-03), a three-time All-American (2001-03), and the recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Outstanding Midfielder award (2002). He was named ACC Player of the Year in 2001 and garnered All-ACC honors three times (2001-03).
- After his collegiate playing career, Cassese was selected second overall by the Rochester Rattlers in the 2003 MLL draft. He went on to play professionally for seven seasons and was a two-time all-star, including in 2006 when he was the game's MVP.
- Cassese represented the United States at the World Championships on four occasions, including as an assistant coach in 2014. As a midfielder, he helped the U.S. win gold in 2002 and 2010. He served as Team USA's captain in 2010.
- Cassese graduated from Duke in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in sociology. He was named a USILA Scholar All-American and named one of four ACC student-athletes conference wide to receive Weaver-James-Corrigan Honorary Award, which recognized student-athletes for outstanding athletic and academic achievement.
