LEADING OFF

- The Hoos picked up a series win at No. 3 Duke over the weekend to kick of a seven-game road swing that ends with this weekend's series at Georgia Tech to close ACC play.
- It was the sixth ACC series win of the season for Virginia and is the first time in program history for UVA to win six ACC series as well as the first-ever series win over Duke.
- Included in those six series wins are the win at No. 3 Duke and over No. 11 Clemson.
- With the wins at Duke, the Cavaliers locked up a berth in the ACC Softball Championships.
- Bigham leads the ACC in strikeouts (158) and ranks 23rd nationally in the category
- She earned ACC Pitcher of the Week honors for the second consecutive week and third time this season on Tuesday after her 10.0 scoreless innings and a save at No. 3 Duke
- The UVA pitching staff ranks third in the ACC in ERA (2.27) and ranks 20th nationally.
- Bigham and Madi Harris rank in the top 25 nationally in strikeouts per seven with Bigham coming in 15th (9.1/7) and Harris at 25th (8.5/7). Bigham is also 16th nationally in fewest hits allowed per 7.0 innings pitched (4.17) and second in the ACC.
- Jade Hylton hit two home runs against Duke - including a grand slam - to extend her team-leading total to 11 home runs and her team-leading RBI to 35. She drove in six of the seven runs scored by the Hoos against the Blue Devils.
- The Cavaliers hold an RPI of 29 and a strength of schedule of 14 entering the weekend
- The Hoos close out their tough seven-game road trip with the three-game set at Georgia Tech (RPI 63) this weekend after games at Duke (RPI 5) and Virginia Tech (RPI 18) to start

HOO TO WATCH

JADE HYLTON • SO. • SS

- Named an NFCA All-Region selection in 2023
- All-ACC Freshman Team selection last year
- Hit two home runs in the weekend series against NC State including the opening run in the 3-run rally for the 3-2 series-clinching win.
- Team leader in average (.345), home runs (11), RBI (35) and runs scored (29)
- Has been even more effective in ACC play with a .362 average against ACC teams
- Also leads the team in stolen bases with 13 so far this season.
- Hit first grand slam of the season in 4-3 win at No. 3 Duke last weekend

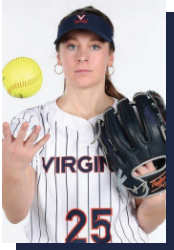

NOTING THE HOOS

THE SERIES WITH GEORGIA TECH

- Virginia and Georgia Tech have faced each other 98 times with the Yellow Jackets leading the series 54-44
- There have been 44 meetings in Atlanta with Georgia Tech leading 23-21 in those games
- Georgia Tech won the serie last season in Charlottesville by taking the first two games of the series

HOOS HIT 30-WIN MARK FOR SECOND STRAIGHT YEAR

- With the win over No. 3 Duke on Saturday, the Cavaliers hit the 30-win mark for the second straight season
- The Cavaliers hit 30 wins last year for the first time since the 2010 campaign
- This is the first time the Hoos have done consecutive 30-win seasons since UVA posted at least 30 wins each season from 2001-2004

THREE IS THE CHARM FOR VIRGINIA OFFENSE

- With the Virginia pitching staff, three runs has been the magic number for the Cavaliers when it comes to winning games this season
- Heading into the final week of the regular season, the Hoos are 25-2 when scoring three runs or more
- The two times Virginia dropped a game when scoring at least three runs were the Saturday game at Notre Dame (10-3) and the Saturday game against NC State (10-9)

HYLTON HAS BEEN THE HAMMER FOR THE HOOS

- Sophomore Jade Hylton has been the hammer for the Hoos this season, hitting a team-leading 11 home runs
- In addition to being the team's leading hitter by average (.345), she also leads the team in slugging (.683) and has 25 extra-base hits on the season
- Hylton has five home runs in ACC play including a grand slam this past weekend at No. 3 Duke

VIRGINIA SHOCKS NO. 3 DUKE WITH DH SWEEP

- Virginia delieverd one of the biggest series wins in program history this past weekend at No. 3 Duke
- After dropping the opener 1-0 in 12 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers came back and swept a Saturday doubleheader
- Virginia won game one of the doubleheader 4-3 thanks to a Jade Hylton grand slam before taking game two of the doubleheader 3-2
- Hylton hit a two-run shot in that series clinching win
- It was a gritty outing from the Hoos played three complete games spanning 25.1 innings in less than 24 hours from first pitch to final out

CAVALIERS CLAIM PROGRAM BEST SIXTH ACC SERIES

- Virginia has won six of the seven ACC series played this season to mark the first time in program history the Hoos have won six ACC series in a season
- The 2010 season was the last time the Hoos won five ACC series with four of them a traditional three-game series and one being a doubleheader with Maryland
- The Hoos swept the twin bill with the Terps that season and also won the series with No. 22 UNC and NC State, while sweeping Virginia Tech and Boston College that year
- This season, the Hoos have series wins over Boston College, Syracuse, No. 11 Clemson, Notre Dame, NC State and No. 3 Duke

HOOS COME THROUGH WITH BACKS AGAINST WALL

- Virginia has gone to the rubber match in all seven ACC series this season and have come through in game three in six weekends to claim the series
- Against BC, Syracuse and No. 3 Duke, the Cavaliers dropped game one and then won the next two games to claim the series
- Against No. 11 Clemson, Notre Dame and NC State, the Cavaliers won game one and then took game three to lock up the weekend
- The lone series loss was at UNC when the Cavaliers took game one and then dropped a Sunday doubleheader after Saturday's game was rained out

BIGHAM EARNS 3RD ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Eden Bigham took home her third ACC Pitcher of the Week honor on Tuesday to earn the honor for the second straight week and third time this season
- Bigham threw 9.0 innings of shutout softball in the series opener at No. 3 Duke with nine strikeouts in the 12.0 inning affair
- She then came back in game two of the series to earn the save - her third of the season - as she worked the seventh and got out of a bases-loaded jam

BIGHAM EARNS ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK AGAIN

- Sophomore right-hander Eden Bigham earned her second ACC Pitcher of the Week honor on Tuesday (4/16)
- She went 2-0 in the series against NC State with a complete-game shutout in game one and worked a second complete-game in the finale to clinch the series
- Bigham struck out 15 across the two games
- It marked Bigham's third complete-game shutout in ACC play and her fourth complete game against an ACC foe this season

HARRIS NAMED ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Senior right-hander Madi Harris was named ACC Pitcher of the Week (3/26) following her performance in a series win over No. 11 Clemson
- Harris went 2-0 in relief with 9.1 scoreless innings of work and eight strikeouts against the Tigers
- She worked 4.1 scoreless innings in the Friday game and then worked 5.0 scoreless innings in the Sunday finale.
- It is the first ACC Pitcher of the Week honor for Harris.

CAVALIERS TAKE SERIES FROM NO. 11 CLEMSON

- The Hoos made another step forward with a series win over No. 11 Clemson by taking the Friday and Sunday games of the series
- The Friday night win over the Tigers was the first win over Clemson in program history by the Cavaliers
- Clemson was the final league team the Hoos didn't have a tally in the win column against in program history and they added that mark in emphatic fashion this season
- The Sunday win, a 3-0 victory, marked the first time this season a team held Clemson off the scoreboard

BOGGS' BAT PICKS UP IN ACC PLAY

- Leah Boggs has been hot at the plate in ACC play after a slow start out of the gates
- While hitting .301 on the year, Boggs is hitting at a .327 clip in ACC games and is second on the team in those games
- Boggs hit her first home run of the season in game two against Syracuse - a two-run shot - for the 2-1 victory as the Cavaliers picked up the series win
- Boggs has also gone 4-for-4 in steal attempts

FRESHMAN CABRAL MAKING EARLY IMPACT

- Freshman Bella Cabral has made an early impact for the Cavaliers in her first season
- She enters the weekend second in RBI with 28 this season and her six home runs is second on the squad
- Her 19 runs scored is second on the team and she is second on the team in doubles with nine this season and her .470 slugging percentage is second on the squad
- She has 16 extra base hits on the season

HOOS TAKE FIRST SERIES FROM SYRACUSE

- The Cavaliers accomplished another first under head coach Joanna Hardin last weekend with a series win over the Syracuse Orange
- Virginia won games two and three of the series to grab the series win - the first ever over the Orange

BIGHAM HITS 100 STRIKEOUT MARK VS. RUTGERS

- Sophomore right-hander Eden Bigham hit the 100 strikeout mark for the season with her relief outing against Rutgers
- Bigham struck out six in her five innings of work against the Scarlet Knights
- She had 115 strikeouts a year ago and passed that mark with a nine strikeout performance at Liberty (3/26) and holds 132 strikeouts entering the NC State series

HOUGE GETS WIN IN FIRST START SINCE 2022

- Senior right-hander Mikayla Houge picked up her first win of the season in the series finale against Syracuse
- It was the first start for Houge since the 2022 season when she took the circle against Central Arkansas in the final game of the year at the National Invitational Softball Championship in Colorado

• Houge worked 4.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits in the outing.

HYLTON, CABRAL GO BACK-TO-BACK AT LONGWOOD

- Jade Hylton and Bella Cabral went back-to-back with home runs for the Hoos to open the game at Longwood
- Both players went deep to left to give the Cavaliers the 2-0 lead on the Lancers
- It was the first time for the Hoos to go back-to-back since Virginia players did it twice in the series finale at Pittsburgh last season (3/26/23)
- The leadoff home run from Hylton was the first for a Ho since she did it last season in the series opener against No. 13 Virginia Tech (4/6/23)

BIGHAM NAMED WEEK 3 ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Eden Bigham was named ACC Pitcher of the Week (2/27) after striking out 23 batters in 11.0 innings of work
- She picked up wins over Lehigh and Iowa State on the week to help the Hoos to an undefeated weekend
- She struck out 14 in her start against Lehigh before fanning nine batters in 6.0 relief innings against the Cyclones

BIGHAM FANS 14 MOUNTAIN HAWKS FOR CAREER HIGH

- Eden Bigham set a career mark of 14 strikeouts in her start against Lehigh (2/23) to open the Rawlings Classic
- She struck out the first 12 batters of the game and finished with the 14 strikeouts on 16 batters faced in the five inning victory
- The 14 strikeouts is the most by a UVA pitcher since Melanie Mitchell's 16 strikeout performance against George Washington (3/20/13)

BIGHAM OPENS 2024 WITH 11 K VS. UNCG

- Eden Bigham set a new career high for strikeouts in the season opener when the freshman fanned 11 batters through her 5.0 innings of work
- Bigham retired 12 of the first 13 batters faced with nine strikeouts across those batters faced

HYLTON NAMED TO TOP MIDDLE INFIELD LIST

- Jade Hylton was named to the preseason top middle infielder list by D1 Softball prior to the start of the season
- She was tabbed No. 13 on the list by the organization

HOOS BACK IN 2024

- UVA returns 18 players from last year's squad, including 13 position players and five pitchers
- Eden Bigham is expected to lead in the circle after a freshman campaign that saw her work 111.0 innings with a 13-6 record and a 2.52 ERA
- Bigham earned All-ACC and All-Region honors as she also held opponents to a .189 batting average against
- The Hoos return a bulk of the offense with four of the top five hitters from a year ago returning to the lineup
- Returning is 72 percent of the runs scored and 70 percent of the RBI from a year ago with All-Region selection Jade Hylton leading the way
- Hylton was named a TUCCI/NFCA Top 25 Freshman as she hit at a team-leading 33 runs scored and 26 RBI. She also tied for the team lead with 10 home runs.

HARRIS SET UVA CAREER SAVE MARK

- Sophomore Madison Harris set the program record for saves in the series finale at No. Duke (4/20)
- The RHP picked up her 10th save of her career to pass Erin Horn (2003-06) for most in a UVA career
- She matched the mark set by Horn with her save in the Cavaliers' second game against Lehigh (2/24) earlier this season
- Harris set the single-season save mark at UVA with six saves in the 2022 season

HOOS LOOK TO STAY AGGRESSIVE ON BASEPATH

- Virginia was aggressive on the basepath in 2023 with 98 steals for the third most in a season in UVA history
- The tally put Virginia third in the ACC and tied for 26th nationally in steals a year ago
- Jade Hylton and Kelly Ayer led the way with 22 steals each and both players are back for the 2024 campaign
- The Hoos have 63 steals entering the weekend with Kelly Ayer going 8-for-8 and Jade Hylton going 13-for-17 in steal attempts.
- Freshman Kamyria Woody-Giggetts and senior Leah Boggs are also aggressive on the basepath having gone 9-for-10 and 9-for-9, respectively, entering the weekend
- As a team, the Cavaliers are fourth in the ACC in stolen bases per game (1.39)

CAVALIERS BUILDING ON STOUT DEFENSE

- The Cavaliers look for 2024 to continue the trend of stout defense under head Coach Joanna Hardin
- Virginia posted a .971 fielding percentage last season - the second highest in program history
- The .971 fielding percentage a year ago came on the heels of a program-best .975 fielding percentage in 2022
- Last season, the Cavaliers were one of the top 50 defenses in the country and fourth in the ACC
- This season, the Hoos hold a .970 fielding percentage which is among the top 50 nationally

BARBEE HAS WILD WEEKEND VS. NC STATE

- Shelby Barbee had a unique weekend against NC State with a .900 on base percentage while only recording three hits on the weekend
- Barbee opened the series with a 3-for-3 night at the plate in the series opener on Friday night

- In Saturday's game she reached base four times without an official at bat as she was hit by three pitches and drew a walk - three of the four times she went on to score
- In Sunday's finale, Barbee was hit by two more pitches to start the game before flying out in her final at bat
- Barbee finished the weekend 3-for-4 at the plate with five HBP and a walk to go along with three runs scored and a 1.250 slugging percentage

CAVALIERS WELCOME SIX NEWCOMERS FOR 2024

- The Cavaliers welcome six newcomers to the squad for the 2024 with the No. 22 ranked recruiting class
- Featured in the class are five players who were ranked among the top 100 recruits nationally by Extra Inning Softball
- RHP Julia Cuozzo is expected to help bolster the bullpen as the No. 23 recruit and a two-time Virginia Player of the Year
- The No. 31 recruit overall is Macee Eaton out of Ohio, an infielder who was a three-time NFCA All-America selection in high school
- Bella Cabral from Oklahoma was the No. 51 recruit and a multiple-time All-State selection at Choctaw High
- Utility player Melissa Carr is the No. 60 recruit while Brie Biddle was the No. 100 recruit and can play either infield or outfield for the Hoos
- Rounding out the class is All-State first team selection Kamyria Woody-Giggetts and a 2022 offensive player of the year



A LOOK BACK AT 2023

BIGHAM THROWS NO-NO IN COLLEGIATE DEBUT

- Freshman RHP Eden Bigham started her career with a bang, turning in a complete-game shutout and no-hitting Lamar in the season opener
- Bigham struck out nine in the outing to kick off an outstanding weekend in the circle for the freshman

BIGHAM NAMED ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Following her performance at the Houston Invitational in the opening weekend, Bigham was named ACC Pitcher of the Week
- Bigham went 1-0 with a pair of saves following her no-hit shutout of Lamar on opening day
- The freshman struck out 16 on the weekend and allowed only two hits on the weekend through three games
- She was UVA's first ACC Pitcher of the Week since Erika Osherow in the 2017 season (3/25/17)

BIGHAM EARNS SECOND ACC WEEKLY HONOR

- Eden Bigham was named the ACC Pitcher of the Week for the second time on Tuesday, April 18 last season
- The freshman posted a complete-game shutout of Liberty in the midweek before picking up the win in UVA's 6-5 win at No. 4 FSU
- The win over Liberty was the first for UVA since 2019 and the win over FSU was the first since 2014 and first in Tallahassee since 2011

MC EATON EXPLOSIVE TO START 2023 CAMPAIGN

- Freshman utility player MC Eaton burst out of the gates hitting .357 on the opening weekend with three home runs and seven RBI
- Eaton's first collegiate hit was a two-run home run in the fifth inning against Lamar in the season opener
- She followed it up with a two-RBI single in the first inning against Houston that evening and another two-RBI home run in the second game against Lamar
- Eaton had a team-leading four home runs and 10 RBI and before injury cut her season short

CAVALIERS PASS 2022 WIN TOTAL VS. JMU

- Virginia continue to move forward as a program with the win over JMU being the 29th of the year
- With the 29 wins, the Hoos passed last year's win total that included an appearance at the NISC

HOOS HIT 30-WIN MARK FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 2010

- With the Hoos' win at Longwood to close the regular season, the Cavaliers hit the 30-win mark for the season
- It marks the first time for the Hoos to hit the 30-win mark since the 2010 season when Virginia went 34-23 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament
- It is also only the second time in the last 18 seasons for the Hoos to hit 30 wins in a season

HOOS HOMER IN BUNCHES

- When UVA hit home runs, they tended to come in bunches
- Virginia had 14 multiple-home run games last season with a season-high five home runs in the series opener at Pittsburgh
- Of those 14 multiple-home run games, five of them saw the Hoos hit at least three home runs in those games
- Those 14 multiple-home run games accounted for 37 of Virginia's 49 home runs last season

FIVE HOME RUN GAME AT PITT MATCHES UVA RECORD

- Virginia's five home run game at Pitt in the series finale was the fifth time in program history that the Hoos hit five home runs in a game
- It was the first time for the Hoos to hit five home runs in a game since a win over UMBC on March 3 in the 2018 season

HARDIN PICKS UP 200TH CAREER COACHING WIN

- Virginia head coach Joanna Hardin picked up her 200th career coaching victory against Radford (2/28) in game one of a doubleheader
- The skipper had 79 wins at McNeese State before taking over the Virginia program in the 2017 season

2023 POWER NUMBERS AMONG BEST IN UVA HISTORY

- The Cavaliers' power numbers last season have been among the best in program history
- With 49 home runs, Virginia currently finished fifth all-time for home runs in a season, passing the 2016 team with two home runs in the finale at Syracuse
- The 2015 team set the program standard for home runs with 55 on the year that season

PALMER PARK

- Virginia opened its new stadium, Palmer Park, on March 3, 2020 against JMU. Palmer Park is named after former Cavalier pitcher Lisa Palmer and her mother Fran. The Palmers were the lead contributors to the stadium project.
- The Cavaliers hosted a dedication ceremony for Palmer Park prior to Virginia's matchup against Virginia Tech on Friday, March 6, 2020.
- Palmer Park is a state-of-the-art facility which houses all of the Cavaliers' needs. Within the confines of Palmer Park is the team locker room and lounge, athletic training room, meeting rooms and a brand new indoor facility.
- Lisa Palmer pitched for the Cavaliers from 1986-89, establishing school records in wins (74), innings pitched (861.2), complete games (102) and games started (112). She still holds the UVA single-season records for wins (27), shutouts (14) and assists (221).
- The 2022 season was the first time it will be open to the full public for a full season.
