OPENING DRAW

GAME OVERVIEW

- No. 6 Virginia (10-3, 1-2) looks to finish the regular season on a high note, when the Cavaliers welcome No. 1 Notre Dame (9-1, 3-0) for their Senior Day on Saturday (April 27).
- Opening faceoff from Klöckner Stadium is set for 2 p.m. as Chris Cotter (play-by-play) and Paul Carcaterra (analyst) will have the call on ESPNU.

SEASON OVERVIEW

- Virginia is in its eighth season under head coach **Lars Tiffany**, who boasts a 90-33 record as Cavalier head coach.
- The Hoos are coming off their third Championship Weekend appearance in the last four opportunities.

LAST TIME OUT

- In a contest that featured six lead changes, then-No. 7 Syracuse scored the final four goals of the game to seal an 18-17 comeback victory over No. 4 Virginia at JMA Wireless Dome last Saturday (April 20).
- **Connor Shellenberger** (4g, 5a) recorded nine points, his career high against an ACC opponent and the most by an ACC player in a league game this season.
- Defensively, **John Schroter** (3gb, 1ct) held his matchup, Joey Spallina, point-less for the first time of his career.
- **Matthew Nunes** finished with 15 saves, including eight in the third quarter, and **Anthony Ghobriel** won 15 of his 26 attempts at the faceoff X.

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

SERIES HISTORY

- Virginia leads the all-time series over Notre Dame, which began in 1993, 11-9.
- The Cavaliers are 10-4 all-time against the Fighting Irish at Klöckner Stadium and have won the last four meetings held in Charlottesville, Va.
- The Hoos have also won the previous five regular-season head-to-head battles.
- The first-ever meeting on May 15, 1993, was an NCAA Tournament game that UVA won 19-9 at Klöckner Stadium in the facility's inaugural season.
- Last year, UVA won both regular-season meetings before falling 13-12 in overtime in the NCAA semifinals at Lincoln Financial Field (Philadelphia, Pa.). Prior to their postseason loss, the Cavaliers had won the previous six meetings with Notre Dame.
- Today's game marks the third consecutive regular-season meeting in which either team covets the nation's top ranking in the USILA coaches poll.
- In the last 776 days dating back to March 13, 2022, Notre Dame has only lost to two different teams, Virginia (three times) and Georgetown in overtime earlier this season (Feb. 25).
- The two teams have squared off in the NCAA Tournament five times ('93, '94, '06, '12, '23) with the Cavaliers leading 3-2 in such contests.
- In last year's 15-10 win at Arlotta Stadium, **Connor Shellenberger's** (2g, 5a) five assists were good for the most by a UND individual opponent in Arlotta Stadium history.
- In the 2019 ACC Tournament championship game, Virginia knocked off the Fighting Irish, 10-4, at Klöckner Stadium after holding UND scoreless for 42:12 of game time.
- In 2006, Virginia defeated the Irish 20-8 in the quarterfinals before capturing the program's fourth NCAA title, in a 15-7 decision over UMass at Lincoln Financial Field.
- In the 2012 NCAA Tournament quarterfinals at PPL Park (Chester, Pa.), both teams were tied 6-6 heading into the fourth quarter before the Irish outscored UVA 6-4 in the final period.
- Notre Dame attackman and Charlottesville native Max Pfeifer (Western Albemarle HS) recorded his first hat trick of the season. The Irish were eliminated by eventual-champion Loyola in the semifinals.
- The loss marked the final career game for UVA All-Americans Steele Stanwick, Colin Briggs, Chris Bocklet, Matt Lovejoy and Rob Fortunato.

- Be Lars Tiffany's third over a No. 1 opponent as UVA head coach. In addition to last year's victory over the top-ranked Fighting Irish, Tiffany and the Cavaliers held on to knock off No. 1 Maryland, 17-16, in the 2021 NCAA championship game.
- Snap the Fighting Irish's seven-game win streak, which is tied for the longest among all Division I teams.
- Assure the Cavaliers of at least a .500 record in ACC play for the third consecutive year.

SENIOR DAY AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM

- Prior to opening faceoff, Virginia will recognize five fourth years and four graduate students for Senior Day.
- The list includes: **Jack Boyden** (M.Ed. Higher Education), **Gable Braun** (English), **Thomas Colucci** (M.S. Commerce), **Matthew DeSouza** (M.S. Accounting), **Cole Kastner** (Commerce), **Patrick McIntosh** (Foreign Affairs), **Mike Prestipino** (Commerce), **Jack Walshe** (History) and **Chase Yager** (M.S. Commerce).

CAVALIERS AMONG THE NATION'S STATISTICAL LEADERS

- For games played through April 23, Virginia leads the nation in assists (9.85) and ground balls (40.00).
- The Cavaliers are second nationally in caused turnovers (11.54) and clearing (.930), fourth in man-up offense (.500) and points (24.92), fifth in scoring offense (15.08), sixth in win percentage (.769) and ninth in scoring margin (4.08).
- Virginia's clearing percentage, assists, caused turnovers, ground balls, and saves (13.15) per game averages also lead the ACC.
- Among all Division I players this season, **Payton Cormier** currently leads the nation in goals (3.69) and is 18th in points (4.54). **Connor Shellenberger** is fifth in assists (3.15) and sixth in points (5.08), and **Matthew Nunes** is 16th in save percentage (.551).

HOOS WINNING FACEOFFS BY COMMITTEE

- This offseason, Virginia lost the program's most accomplished faceoff specialist in Petey LaSalla – who was selected in the second round of the 2023 PLL Draft – to graduation.
- This year, Virginia has relied on **Anthony Ghobriel** (95-166/.572), **Thomas Colucci** (66-129/.512) and **Matthew DeSouza** (33-69/.478) at the center X.
- The combination of Ghobriel, Colucci, and DeSouza have guided UVA to finish above 50 percent at the faceoff X in **eight** of its **13** total games so far this year.
- **As of April 26**, 10 of UVA's 14 total regular-season opponents are among the nation's top-25 leaders in faceoff win percentage.
- Additionally, Virginia LSM **Ben Wayer** (65 GBs) who was named an honorable mention midseason All-American according to Inside Lacrosse, has proven to be one of the nation's best faceoff wings.

KASTNER, SHELLENBERGER NAMED TEWAARATON AWARD NOMINEES

- Virginia captains **Cole Kastner** and **Connor Shellenberger** were named two of 25 Tewaaraton Award Nominees, the Tewaaraton Foundation announced April 18.
- The five finalists from the group of 25 nominees will be announced on May 9 after the conclusion of the regular season.
- Virginia is one of six schools nationally – four of which are also ACC members – to have at least two nominees.
- The Tewaaraton Award is recognized as the preeminent lacrosse award, annually honoring the top male and female college lacrosse player.

ON THE HORIZON

- The Cavaliers travel to the ACC Tournament, which will be held at American Legion Stadium in Charlotte, N.C.
- The semifinals will commence on Friday (April 3) when the No. 1 seed takes on the No. 4 seed at 5 p.m., while the No. 2 seed squares off against the No. 3 seed at 8 p.m.
- The championship game is set for noon on Sunday (April 5).
- All three tournament games will be broadcast on ACC Network.

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- No. 6 Virginia has been ranked in the top 10 in 87 percent of USILA coaches polls all-time.
- Virginia has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 70 all-time polls, good for 12 percent all-time.
- UVA has been ranked in 530 out of 551 (96.2) total USILA polls all-time.
- The USILA poll began in 1973.

THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM

- Virginia owns a 179-46 (.796) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 6-1 mark in 2024, and has won 22 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 6.4 goals.
- Virginia is 53-14 (.791) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- UVA is also 14-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in NCAA Tournament contests.
- Lacrosse debuted in Klöckner Stadium in 1993.

CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE

- Virginia attackman **Connor Shellenberger** is in his final collegiate season in 2024.
- Shellenberger guided the Hoos to Championship Weekend last season after leading the nation in assists (3.38/gm).
- With **181** career assists, he is Virginia's all-time assist record holder, and currently leads all active Division I players.
- Shellenberger is one of just two Cavaliers to garner USILA First Team All-America honors, the other being former defenseman Ken Clausen.
- In addition to being a Tewaaron finalist for the second time of his career in 2023, Shellenberger garnered NCAA All-Tournament honors after combining for 11 goals and 11 assists in the Cavaliers' three tournament games last season.
- Shellenberger was also the 2021 NCAA Tournament Most Outstanding Player after leading the Hoos to their seventh NCAA championship, also the program's ninth national championship overall.

CONNOR SHELLENBERGER RECORD WATCH

- With his second point of the day against UAlbany (March 19), **Connor Shellenberger** became UVA's all-time leader in career points.
- Shellenberger currently leads all active Division-I players in career assists and is one of just two active players (Matt Brandau, Yale) with at least **305** career points.

PAYTON CORMIER: VIRGINIA'S CAREER GOALS LEADER

- With his second goal at Richmond (Feb. 17), **Payton Cormier** became Virginia's all-time leading goal scorer.
- Cormier shattered Doug Knight's previous program record of 165 career goals, which Knight accomplished in 60 games.
- Cormier broke the record in just 57 career games.
- Now with **207** career goals, Cormier currently lead all active Division I players.
- Among all of UVA's 100-career goal scorers, Cormier is the only one to average at least **3.04** goals per game.
- Cormier is also the only player in program history to record a pair of 50-goal seasons, having scored 52 goals last year and 50 goals in 2022.
- He notched a career-high seven goals against Ohio State in 2023, which tied for No. 2 in UVA single-game history.
- This season Cormier has recorded multiple goals in all but one of UVA's games, six of which have been hat tricks.

CHIZMAR NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- For his performance against North Carolina, short-stick defensive midfielder **Noah Chizmar** was named the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week on April 9.
- The announcement marked Chizmar's first career ACC weekly honor.
- He scored only 11 seconds in on the game's opening possession and again with 10:36 remaining in the first half, which proved to be the game-winning goal.
- On defensive end, Chizmar collected four ground balls and a pair of caused turnovers, one of which was while the Cavaliers were man-down.

CORMIER, NUNES SWEEP ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- For the performances in UVA's 13-10 comeback win at then-No. 16 Harvard (March 30), **Payton Cormier** and **Matthew Nunes** swept ACC's Offensive and Defensive player-of-the-week honors, respectively, the conference office announced April 2.
- The announcement marked Cormier's sixth career ACC weekly honor, including third this year. Nunes now has five ACC career weekly honors, including a pair this season.
- Cormier scored a game-high four goals and dished out one assist. His third goal of the day kickstarted a 7-0 run in the fourth quarter, which ultimately put the Hoos ahead to stay.
- Nunes scored the game-winning goal in dramatic fashion and recorded a game-high 16 against the Crimson.
- Amid a UVA clear with five minutes remaining, Nunes carried the ball end to end and fired a shot that bounced past the Harvard keeper to break a 10-10 tied score.
- Nunes' goal against the Crimson is the first by a UVA goalie since Adam Ghitelman scored in 2010 ACC Tournament semifinals against Duke.
- It's also the first score by an ACC goalie since Syracuse's Evan Molloy found the back of the net against Colgate in 2017.

CORMIER NAMED ACC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- For games played March 18-24, **Payton Cormier** was named ACC Offensive Player of the Week after averaging 5.5 goals in UVA's wins over UAlbany (March 19) and Drexel (March 23).
- Cormier's six goals against Drexel also propelled him into the top 10 of the NCAA Division I career goals list
- He is also the only ACC player to record at five three goals in three different games this season.

HEAD COACH LARS TIFFANY

OVERVIEW

Lars Tiffany was named Virginia's 17th head coach on June 21, 2016. He is currently in his seventh season at UVA and 19th season overall as head coach. Tiffany is Virginia's only head coach to win back-to-back national championships (2019 & 2021). Tiffany begins the 2024 season with 80 wins as UVA head coach, good for No. 3 all-time in program history behind only Jim "Ace" Adams (137) and Dom Starsia (274).

He was Co-MVP of the Brown squad that captured its first-ever NCAA playoff victory in 1990 (12-9 vs. UMass). Tiffany capped his career by playing in the North-South Senior All-Star game.

NUNES TABBED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- For his performance against Ohio State (Feb. 25), **Matthew Nunes** was named the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week.
- He was also the first goalie to be named ACC Defensive Player of the Week this season.
- In addition to his 17 saves, which are the most by an ACC goalie this year, Nunes only surrendered seven goals against OSU.

CORMIER, WAYER NAB ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- For their performances against Richmond (Feb. 17), **Payton Cormier** and **Ben Wayer** were named ACC Co-Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week, respectively, the league office announced on Feb. 20.
- The announcement marks Cormier's fourth career ACC weekly honor and Wayer's first.
- Cormier scored three goals and set the program's all-time goals record in the win.
- For the second consecutive week, Wayer collected ground balls and added one caused turnover.
- Wayer also played a pivotal role in the Spiders' six failed clears, four of which occurred in the fourth quarter.
- Wayer was also a key contributor on UVA's faceoff unit, which won 15 of the game's 26 total faceoffs, including 10 of 14 in the second half.
- Additionally, UR's starting midfield line combined for just two goals.

ACC CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

- Virginia has claimed at least a share of 19 ACC championships, including two (2019 & 2022) under head coach **Lars Tiffany**.
- The Cavaliers won 11 titles (1962, 1964, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1975, 1980, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986) prior the ACC establishing a tournament from 1989-2019 to determine the champion.
- Virginia has won seven ACC Tournament championships: 1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2010 and 2019.
- In the last ACC Tournament, which was held in 2019 at Klöckner Stadium, UVA defeated Notre Dame 10-4 in the championship game.
- From 1989-2019, Virginia won 14 regular-season titles (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012 and 2019), more than any other ACC School.
- The ACC Tournament returns this season and will be contested at American Legion Stadium in Charlotte, N.C. on May 3 and 5.

2023 SEASON RECAP

- Virginia finished its 2023 season with an overall record of 13-4, marking the Cavaliers' seventh consecutive winning season.
- For the third time in their last four opportunities, the Cavaliers reached Championship Weekend after NCAA Tournament wins over Richmond and Georgetown.
- For the second consecutive year and 12th time in program history, **Connor Shellenberger** was named one of the nation's five Tewaaraton Finalists.
- Despite knocking off Notre Dame in both regular-season matchups last season, Virginia fell to the Fighting Irish in overtime, 13-12, in the NCAA semifinals at Lincoln Financial Field.
- Shellenberger combined for 11 goals and 11 assists in three tournament games and was named to the NCAA All-Tournament Team for the second time of his career.
- The Cavaliers did not return a total of 18 players from 2023 to this year.
- Virginia had arguably its most prolific season offensively in school history as the Cavaliers set program records in goals (293), assists (195) and points (488).
- Former UVA midfielder Thomas McConvey was named the program's seventh recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Award, which is given to the nation's top midfielder.
- Xander Dickson set the program's single-season goals record with 61 scores. He is UVA's only 60-goal scorer in a single season.

TRANSFERS ADD IMMEDIATE DEPTH

- This offseason, Lars Tiffany signed five transfers: **Jack Boyden** (Tufts), **Chase Yager** (Harvard), **Anthony Ghobriel** (Navy), **Thomas Colucci** (Colgate) and **Matthew DeSouza** (Binghamton).
- Boyden was the Division-III national player and attackman of the year in 2023. He logged 167 goals and 143 assists during his tenure (2020-23) with the Jumbos.
- Yager was a standout short-stick defensive midfielder at Harvard from 2020-23. Prior to his career with the Crimson, Yager attended Norfolk Academy. Yager was named a 2024 Inside Lacrosse Preseason All-American.
- Ghobriel, Colucci and DeSouza are all faceoff specialists. Ghobriel is a junior, while Colucci and DeSouza are graduate transfers.

VIRGINIA'S FIRST-YEAR (FRESHMAN) CLASS

- Additionally, the Cavaliers added first-year goalies **Bennet Yue** (Virginia Beach, Va.) and **Colin Hook** (Lutherville, Md.) this past Fall.

KASTNER, NUNES, SHELLENBERGER NAMED TEWAARATON AWARD WATCH LIST SELECTIONS

- **Cole Kastner** (defense), **Matthew Nunes** (goalie) and **Connor Shellenberger** (attack) were have been named Tewaaraton Award Watch List selections, the Tewaaraton Foundation announced Feb. 14.
- Only Duke (4), Virginia (3), Notre Dame (3) and Syracuse (3) had at least three selections in this year's initial list.

VIRGINIA'S SIX PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

- Six Cavaliers in **Connor Shellenberger** (first team), **Cole Kastner** (first team), **Payton Cormier** (third team), **Griffin Schutz** (third team), **Chase Yager** (third team) and **Noah Chizmar** (honorable mention) were named Inside Lacrosse Preseason All-Americans.
- Virginia's six honorees were third most among all programs nationally.

- Tiffany often reflects on the roots of the game and admiration of the Onondaga in interviews and press conferences (via Inside Lacrosse).

KEVIN CASSESE NAMED ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

- Last summer, head coach Lars Tiffany announced the addition **Kevin Cassese** as the program's associate head coach and offensive coordinator.
- Cassese spent the previous 16 seasons as the head coach of Lehigh University, where he became the school's all-time winningest coach and guided the Mountain Hawks to three Patriot League titles.
- A total of 21 Lehigh players achieved USILA All-America status under Cassese's tutelage, including 2021 first-team faceoff specialist Mike Sisselberger, who set the NCAA Division-I single season faceoff win percentage record (79.5).
- Prior to serving as Lehigh head coach, Cassese was an assistant coach at his alma mater, Duke, from 2005-07. In 2007, Cassese and the Blue Devils reached the NCAA Championship game, which marked the program's second national championship appearance. He also served as Duke's interim head coach for part of the summer of 2006.
- In 2005, Cassese was an assistant coach and offensive coordinator at Stony Brook under Tiffany and conducted the nation's top man-up unit. Tiffany, Cassese and the Seawolves finished the season with a 10-6 overall record.
- A National Lacrosse Hall of Fame class of 2018 inductee, Cassese enjoyed an illustrious playing career at Duke from 2000-03, where he was twice team captain and Tewaaron Award finalist (2002-03), a three-time All-American (2001-03), and the recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Outstanding Midfielder award (2002). He was named ACC Player of the Year in 2001 and garnered All-ACC honors three times (2001-03).
- After his collegiate playing career, Cassese was selected second overall by the Rochester Rattlers in the 2003 MLL draft. He went on to play professionally for seven seasons and was a two-time all-star, including in 2006 when he was the game's MVP.
- Cassese represented the United States at the World Championships on four occasions, including as an assistant coach in 2014. As a midfielder, he helped the U.S. win gold in 2002 and 2010. He served as Team USA's captain in 2010.
- Cassese graduated from Duke in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in sociology. He was named a USILA Scholar All-American and named one of four ACC student-athletes conference wide to receive Weaver-James-Corrigan Honorary Award, which recognized student-athletes for outstanding athletic and academic achievement.
