- · Opening faceoff from Klöckner Stadium is set for noon on ESPNU as Anish Shroff (play-by-play) and Paul Carcaterra (analyst) will have the call.

SEASON OVERVIEW

- · Virginia is in its eighth season under head coach Lars Tiffany, who boasts an 89-31 record as Cavalier head coach.
- The Hoos are coming off their third Championship Weekend appearance in the last four opportunities.

- · Virginia trailed by as many as five goals in the third quarter and four in the fourth, but claimed the final seven scores to seal a 13-10 comeback victory over No. 16 Harvard last Saturday (March 30) at Jordan Field.
- · Goalie Matthew Nunes (9-1) finished with a game-high 16 saves, including eight in the third period, and scored the game-winning goal after going end-to-end and burying his first career score with less than five minutes to play.
- · After a sluggish start at the faceoff X, the Cavaliers dominated the faceoff game in the fourth, winning eight of the quarter's nine total draws.
- · Offensively, Virginia was led by Payton Cormier, who recorded a game-high four goals and dished out one assist, and Griffin Schutz (2g, 2a).
- On the defensive end, Cole Kastner led the way with four caused turnovers, and Ben Wayer (1g) and Noah Chizmar tallied five ground balls each.

NUMBERS TO KNOW

Payton Cormier (199 goals) needs just one goal to move into sole possession of No. 7 on the NCAA Division I career goals list and eclipse the 200-goal milestone.

Virginia has won the last five meetings of the series against the Tar Heels dating back to 2021.

Jack Boyden (334), Connor Shellenberger (287) and Payton Cormier (246) combine for 867 career points. No other team in the nation has three active players on its roster who combine for that amount.

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

SERIES HISTORY

- Saturday's game marks the 91st all-time meeting between the Cavaliers and North Carolina, a series UVA owns a 58-32 advantage in since 1938.
- The Cavaliers' 58 wins places the Tar Heels on UVA's list of most beaten opponents (UVA has defeated Duke 50 times).
- After dropping seven of its previous eight contests to UNC from 2012-17, the Cavaliers have won eight of the series' previous nine games, including the last five.
- •The Hoos' most recent loss to UNC was at Klöckner Stadium during the 2021 regular season, when the Tar Heels won 16-13. Later that year, UVA claimed back-to-back meetings against the Heels, including in the NCAA semifinals on the way to capturing 2021 national title over Maryland.
- •The last time the Cavaliers and UNC squared off at Klöckner Stadium was on April 9, 2022, when UVA held the Tar Heels to just four goals [11-4], the fewest goals scored by UNC in a single game since Joe Breschi was named the program's head coach in 2006.
- UVA faced the Tar Heels every year from 1964-2019 until the pandemic shutdown the 2020 season.
- Virginia and North Carolina are charter members of the ACC, which held its inaugural regular season in 1954. Duke and Maryland, which left the ACC for the Big Ten following the 2014 season, are the only other two original members.

HOOS WELCOME BACK 1999 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM

- On Saturday, Virginia welcomes back members of its 1999 national championship team to celebrate the 25th anniversary of the program's second NCAA title and fourth national championship overall.
- The 1999 title also marked the first of four ('99, '03, '06, '11) under legendary head coach Dom Starsia.
- In the regular season, the Cavaliers suffered losses on the road to Syracuse, Johns Hopkins and Duke in overtime.
- However, UVA averaged all three losses in the postseason, edging Duke by one goal in the ACC Tournament championship game, and Hopkins and Syracuse in the NCAA semifinals and finals, respectively.
- The 12-10 victory over eighth-seeded Syracuse in College Park, Md., ended Virginia's 27-year drought since it won its first title in 1972.
- After the 172 championship run, the Hoos reached the NCAA title game four times (1980, 1986, 1994, 1996), but lost in overtime each time.
- Cuse nearly sent the game into overtime as the Orange scored five consecutive goals in the fourth quarter to close to within one [10-9] with 3:36 remaining. UVA then received goals from freshman attackman Conor Gill, who was also named the tournament's most outstanding player, and senior midfielder Henry Oakey (Charlottesville, Va.), who was assisted by gill, in a 21-second span.
- In addition to Gill, Ryan Curtis, Derek Kenney, Jay Jalbert, Tucker Radebaugh and Court Weisleder were named all-tournament team selections.
- Earlier this week on Twitter, Starsia said, "That '99 team was the hardest working group I have ever worked with. We needed to establish that mentality and they were up to the task."
- •The Cavaliers will don special throwback uniforms to pay homage to the 1999 squad, which will be recognized at halftime.

CAVALIERS AMONG THE NATION'S STATISTICAL LEADERS

- For games played through March 31, Virginia leads the nation in assists (10.40), caused turnovers (11.50) and winning percentage (.900). The Cavaliers are second in the nation in clearing (.934), ground balls (39.70) and points (25.70), fourth in man-up offense (.524), and fifth in scoring margin (5.20) and scoring offense (15.30).
- Among all Division I players this season, **Payton Cormier** is currently No. 1 in goals (4.00) and seventh in points (5.00). **Connor Shellenberger** is sixth in assists (3.00) and 11th in points (4.80). **Matthew Nunes** is eighth in save percentage (.575), 18th in goals-against (9.97) and 22nd in saves (11.90).

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- No. 2 Virginia has been ranked in the top 5 of the USILA Coaches poll in 335 weeks all-time including in the most recent edition of the poll.
- · Virginia has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 70 all-time polls.
- \cdot UVA has been ranked in 527 out of 548 (.962) total USILA polls all-time.
- ·The USILA Poll began in 1973.

THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM

- Virginia owns a 178-46 (.795) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 5-1 record in 2024, and has won 21 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- •The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 6.0 goals.
- Virginia is 52-14 (.788) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- UVA is also 14-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in NCAA Tournament contests.
- · Lacrosse debuted in Klöckner Stadium in 1993.

ON THE HORIZON

- The Cavaliers travel to Duke (10-2), which is ranked No. 3 in this week's USILA coaches poll, on Sunday (April 14) for a possible top-3 showdown.
- · Opening faceoff from Koskinen Stadium is set for 2 p.m. on ACC Network.

CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE

- Virginia attackman **Connor Shellenberger** is in his final collegiate season in 2024.
- Shellenberger guided the Hoos to Championship Weekend last season after leading the nation in assists (3.38/gm).
- With **170** career assists, he is Virginia's all-time assist record holder, and currently leads all active Division I players.
- Shellenberger is one of just two Cavaliers to garner USILA First Team All-America honors, the other being former defenseman Ken Clausen.
- In addition to being a Tewaaraton finalist for the second time of his career in 2023, Shellenberger garnered NCAA All-Tournament honors after combining for 11 goals and 11 assists in the Cavaliers' three tournament games last season.
- Shellenberger was also the 2021 NCAA Tournament Most Outstanding Player after leading the Hoos to their seventh NCAA championship, also the program's ninth national championship overall.

PAYTON CORMIER: VIRIGINIA'S CAREER GOALS LEADER

- With his second goal at Richmond (Feb. 17), **Payton Cormier** became Virginia's all-time leading goal scorer.
- Cormier shattered Doug Knight's previous program record of 165 career goals, which Knight accomplished in 60 games.
- · Cormier broke the record in just 57 career games.
- Now with 199 career goals, Cormier currently lead all active Division I players.
- Among all of UVA's 100-career goal scorers, Cormier is the only one to average at least **3.06** goals per game.
- Cormier is also the only player in program history to record a pair of 50-goal seasons, having scored 52 goals last year and 50 goals in 2022.
- He notched a career-high seven goals against Ohio State in 2023, which tied for No. 2 in UVA single-game history.
- •This season Cormier has recorded multiple goals in all but one of UVA's games, six of which have been hat tricks.

CORMIER. NUNES SWEEP ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- · For the performances in UVA's 13-10 comeback win at then-No. 16 Harvard (March 30), Payton Cormier and Matthew Nunes swept ACC's Offensive and Defensive player-of-th-week honors, respectively, the conference office announced April 2.
- The announcement marked Cormier's sixth career ACC weekly honor, including third this year. Nunes now has five ACC career weekly honors, including a pair this season.
- · Cormier scored a game-high four goals and dished out one assist. His third goal of the day kickstarted a 7-0 run in the fourth quarter, which ultimately put the Hoos ahead to stay.
- · Nunes scored the game-winning goal in dramatic fashion and recorded a game-high 16 against the Crimson.
- · Amid a UVA clear with five minutes remaining, Nunes carried the ball end to end and fired a shot that bounced past the Harvard keeper to break a 10-10 tied score.
- · Nunes' goal against the Crimson is the first by a UVA goalie since Adam Ghitelman scored in 2010 ACC Tournament semifinals against Duke.
- · It's also the first score by an ACC goalie since Syracuse's Evan Molloy found the back of the net against Colgate in 2017.

CORMIER NAMED ACC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- · For games played March 18-24, Payton Cormier was named ACC Offensive Player of the Week after averaging 5.5 goals in UVA's wins over UAlbany (March 19) and Drexel (March 23).
- · Cormier's six goals against Drexel also propelled him into the top 10 of the NCAA Division I career goals list
- · He is also the only ACC player to record at five three goals in three different games this season.

NUNES TABBED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- · For his performance against Ohio State (Feb. 25), Matthew Nunes was named the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week.
- · He was also the first goalie to be named ACC Defensive Player of the Week this season.
- · In addition to his 17 saves, which are the most by an ACC goalie this year, Nunes only surrendered seven goals against OSU.

HEAD COACH LARS TIFFANY

OVERVIEW

Lars Tiffany was named Virginia's 17th head coach on June 21, 2016. He is currently in his seventh season at UVA and 19th season overall as head coach. Tiffany is Virginia's only head coach to win back-to-back national championships (2019 & 2021). Tiffany begins the 2023 season with 67 wins as UVA head coach, good for No. 3 all-time in program history behind only Jim "Ace" Adams (137) and Dom Starsia (274).

He was Co-MVP of the Brown squad that captured its first-ever NCAA playoff victory in 1990 (12-9 vs. UMass). Tiffany capped his career by playing in the North-South Senior All-Star game.

CORMIER, WAYER NAB ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- For their performances against Richmond (Feb. 17), **Payton Cormier** and **Ben Wayer** were named ACC Co-Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week, respectively, the league office announced on Feb. 20.
- The announcement marks Cormier's fourth career ACC weekly honor and Waver's first.
- Cormier scored three goals and set the program's all-time goals record in the win.
- For the second consecutive week, Wayer collected ground balls and added one caused turnover.
- Wayer also played a pivotal role in the Spiders' six failed clears, four of which occurred in the fourth quarter.
- Wayer was also a key contributor on UVA's faceoff unit, which won 15 of the game's 26 total faceoffs, including 10 of 14 in the second half.
- · Additionally, UR's starting midfield line combined for just two goals.

ACC CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

- · Virginia has claimed at least a share of 19 ACC championships, including two (2019 & 2022) under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- The Cavaliers won 11 titles (1962, 1964, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1975, 1980, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986) prior the ACC establishing a tournament from 1989-2019 to determine the champion.
- Virginia has won seven ACC Tournament championships: 1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2010 and 2019.
- In the last ACC Tournament, which was held in 2019 at Klöckner Stadium, UVA defeated Notre Dame 10-4 in the championship game.
- From 1989-2019, Virginia won 14 regular-season titles (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012 and 2019), more than any other ACC School.
- The ACC Tournament returns this season and will be contested at American Legion Stadium in Charlotte, N.C. on May 3 and 5.

2023 SEASON RECAP

- Virginia finished its 2023 season with an overall record of 13-4, marking the Cavaliers' seventh consecutive winning season.
- For the third time in their last four opportunities, the Cavaliers reached Championship Weekend after NCAA Tournament wins over Richmond and Georgetown.
- For the second consecutive year and 12th time in program history, **Connor Shellenberger** was named one of the nation's five Tewarraton Finalists.
- Despite knocking off Notre Dame in both regular-season matchups last season, Virginia fell to the Fighting Irish in overtime, 13-12, in the NCAA semifinals at Lincoln Financial Field.
- Shellenberger combined for 11 goals and 11 assists in three tournament games and was named to the NCAA All-Tournament Team for the second time of his career.
- The Cavaliers did not return a total of 18 players from 2023 to this year.
- Virginia had arguably its most prolific season offensively in school history as the Cavaliers set program records in goals (293), assists (195) and points (488)
- Former UVA midfielder Thomas McConvey was named the program's seventh recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Award, which is given to the nation's top midfielder.
- Xander Dickson set the program's single-season goals record with 61 scores. He is UVA's only 60-goal scorer in a single season.

TRANSFERS ADD IMMEDIATE DEPTH

- •This offseason, Lars Tiffany signed five transfers: Jack Boyden (Tufts), Chase Yager (Harvard), Anthony Ghobriel (Navy), Thomas Colucci (Colgate) and Matthew DeSouza (Binghamton).
- Boyden was the Division-III national player and attackman of the year in 2023. He logged 167 goals and 143 assists during his tenure (2020-23) with the Jumbos
- Yager was a standout short-stick defensive midfielder at Harvard from 2020-23. Prior to his career with the Crimson, Yager attended Norfolk Academy. Yager was named a 2024 Inside Lacrosse Preseason All-American.
- Ghobriel, Colucci and DeSouza are all faceoff specialists. Ghobriel is a junior, while Colucci and DeSouza are graduate transfers.

VIRGINIA'S FIRST-YEAR (FRESHMAN) CLASS

- •The Cavaliers' highly-touted signing class of 2023 consists of: Chase Band (Potomac, Md.), Wills Burt (Newtown Square, Pa.), Caulley Deringer (Alexandria, Va.), Will Erdmann (South Norwalk, Conn.), Kian McCarthy (Rye, N.Y.), Henry Metz (Bloomfield Hills, Mich.), McCabe Millon (Reisterstown, Md.), Eli Petty (Richmond, Va.), Luke Pisani (Jupiter, Fla.) and Cole Webber (Garden City, N.Y.).
- Additionally, the Cavaliers added first-year goalies Bennet Yue (Virginia Beach, Va.) and Colin Hook (Lutherville, Md.) this past Fall.

KASTNER, NUNES, SHELLENBERGER NAMED TEWAARATON AWARD WATCH LIST SELECTIONS

- Cole Kastner (defense), Matthew Nunes (goalie) and Connor Shellenberger (attack) were have been named Tewaaraton Award Watch List selections, the Tewaaraton Foundation announced Feb. 14.
- Only Duke (4), Virginia (3), Notre Dame (3) and Syracuse (3) had at least three selections in this year's initial list.

- Six Cavaliers in **Connor Shellenberger** (first team), **Cole Kastner** (first team), **Payton Cormier** (third team), **Griffin Schutz** (third team), **Chase Yager** (third team) and **Noah Chizmar** (honorable mention) were named Inside Lacrosse Preseason All-Americans.
- · Virginia's six honorees were third most among all programs nationally.

KEVIN CASSESE NAMED ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

- Last summer, head coach Lars Tiffany announced the addition Kevin Cassese as the program's associate head coach and offensive coordinator.
- Cassese spent the previous 16 seasons as the head coach of Lehigh University, where he became the school's all-time winningest coach and guided the Mountain Hawks to three Patriot League titles.
- A total of 21 Lehigh players achieved USILA All-America status under Cassese's tutelage, including 2021 first-team faceoff specialist Mike Sisselberger, who set the NCAA Division-I single season faceoff win percentage record (79.5).
- Prior to serving as Lehigh head coach, Cassese was an assistant coach at his alma mater, Duke, from 2005-07. In 2007, Cassese and the Blue Devils reached the NCAA Championship game, which marked the program's second national championship appearance. He also served as Duke's interim head coach for part of the summer of 2006.
- In 2005, Cassese was an assistant coach and offensive coordinator at Stony Brook under Tiffany and conducted the nation's top man-up unit.
 Tiffany, Cassese and the Seawolves finished the season with a 10-6 overall record.
- A National Lacrosse Hall of Fame class of 2018 inductee, Cassese enjoyed an illustrious playing career at Duke from 2000-03, where he was twice team captain and Tewaaraton Award finalist (2002-03), a three-time All-American (2001-03), and the recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Outstanding Midfielder award (2002). He was named ACC Player of the Year in 2001 and garnered All-ACC honors three times (2001-03).
- After his collegiate playing career, Cassese was selected second overall by the Rochester Rattlers in the 2003 MLL draft. He went on to play professionally for seven seasons and was a two-time all-star, including in 2006 when he was the game's MVP.
- Cassese represented the United States at the World Championships on four occasions, including as an assistant coach in 2014. As a midfielder, he helped the U.S. win gold in 2002 and 2010. He served as Team USA's captain in 2010.
- Cassese graduated from Duke in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in sociology. He was named a USILA Scholar All-American and named one of four ACC student-athletes conference wide to receive Weaver-James-Corrigan Honorary Award, which recognized student-athletes for outstanding athletic and academic achievement.
