GAME OVERVIEW

- No. 6 seed Virginia (11-5) and third-seeded Johns Hopkins (11-4) meet in the NCAA Tournament for the 17th time on Sunday (May 19) in the quarterfinals on the campus of Towson University.
- Opening faceoff from Johnny Unitas Stadium is set for 2:30 p.m. as Anish Shroff (play-by-play) and Quint Kessenich (analyst) will have the call on ESPNU.
- The two teams previously clashed earlier this season on March 2 at Klöckner Stadium as the Blue Jays edged UVA, 16-14, to reclaim the Doyle Smith Cup.

VIRGINIA IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- This year, the Cavaliers earned the program's 43rd all-time berth in the NCAA Tournament.
- Sunday's contest against the Blue Jays marks UVA's 96th tournament game all-time as the Hoos boast a 60-35 (.632) record in NCAA postseason, including 12-2 dating back to 2019.
- Only Johns Hopkins (73), Maryland (71) and Syracuse (66) have more NCAA Tournament wins than Virginia.
- Seven of the Cavaliers' nine national championships have come in NCAA Tournament ('72, '99, '03, '06, '11, '19, '21), which debuted in 1971.
- Since **Lars Tiffany** was hired as UVA head coach in 2017, the Hoos have qualified for six out of seven possible NCAA Tournaments. Under Tiffany, Virginia is 12-3 in the tournament.
- The Cavaliers have advanced to three (2019, 2021, 2023) of the last four Championship Weekends. UVA and Duke are the only two Division I teams to have accomplished that feat.
- Last year, Virginia lost 13-12 in overtime to eventual-national champion Notre Dame in the NCAA semifinals at Lincoln Financial Field (Philadelphia, Pa.).

NUMBERS TO KNOW

Sunday's contest between Johns Hopkins and Virginia marks the 17th meeting between the two teams in the NCAA Tournament. No two teams have gone head-to-head in the tournament more than UVA and Hopkins.

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

A WIN FOR THE CAVALIERS WOULD...

- Send the Hoos to the NCAA semifinals for the 26th time in school history.
- Improve Virginia's record to 13-2 in its last 15 tournament contests dating back to 2019.
- Mark UVA's first win over Hopkins in the NCAA Tournament since 2009.
- Be Virginia's fifth upset in the tournament (based on seeding) since 2019.

SEASON OVERVIEW

- Virginia is in its eighth season under head coach **Lars Tiffany**, who boasts a 91-35 record as Cavalier head coach.
- The Hoos are coming off their third Championship Weekend appearance in the last four opportunities.

SERIES HISTORY

- Dating back to 1904, Sunday's matchup marks the 98th all-time meeting between the UVA and Hopkins.
- The Blue Jays lead the all-time series over UVA, 62-34-1.
- The two teams met at least once every season from 1948-2019.
- Virginia has not faced any other opponent more than Hopkins in program history.
- The two teams have gone head-to-head a whopping 16 times in the NCAA Tournament all-time (see more below). UVA is 6-10 in such meetings.
- Five of the last 13 matchups have gone to overtime. UVA is 3-2 in such contests.
- Each year that the Hoos and Hopkins go head-to-head in the regular season, the two teams vie for possession of the Doyle Smith Cup. The first Smith Cup was contested in 2006.
- Sunday's quarterfinal will not count towards the Smith Cup standings.

VIRGINIA-HOPKINS: THE NCAA TOURNAMENT'S MOST RECURRING MATCHUP

- Virginia and Johns Hopkins will square off in the NCAA Tournament for the 17th time on Sunday.
- The 17 meetings between the UVA and the Blue Jays are the most by any two teams in NCAA Tournament history.
- The Cavaliers are 6-10 all-time in tournament against Hopkins, but two of UVA's wins were for the national title (1972 & 2003).
- Sunday's game marks the first meeting between the two teams in the tournament since 2015.
- The Hoos are 2-1 all-time against Hopkins in the quarterfinals and 1-0 since the tournament moved to a 16-plus team format in 2003, also the same year the Cavaliers defeated Hopkins in the championship game.
- In the 1988 quarterfinals, unseeded Virginia defeated the second-seeded Blue Jays in overtime, 11-10, at Homewood Field after Chase Monroe tallied his fifth goal of the game and Peter Sheehan recorded 25 saves. Hopkins had won 14 of the previous 16 matchups entering the 1988 quarterfinals.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE BLUE JAYS

- Johns Hopkins scored three goals on the first three possessions of the fourth quarter to take the lead and held on to win 16-14 over the Cavaliers at Klöckner Stadium on March 2.
- With the win, Hopkins reclaimed the Doyle E. Smith Cup and snapped UVA's three-game win streak in the series.
- Virginia attackman **Connor Shellenberger** (4g, 2a) notched a game-high six points. Defensively, the Hoos were led by **Ben Wayer** (5gb, 3ct).
- Blue Jay goalie Chayse Ierlan notched a game-high 16 saves, and midfielders Matt Collison (4g, 1a) and Jonathan Peshko (4g, 1a) tallied five points each.
- Without **Anthony Ghobriel** (injury), Virginia struggled at the faceoff X, finishing 14-34.

LAST TIME OUT

- **Payton Cormier** scored eight goals and **Connor Shellenberger** (2g, 5a) recorded seven points to propel the Hoos to a 17-11 first round victory over Saint Joseph's at Klöckner Stadium last Saturday (May 11).
- In the win, Cormier set the NCAA Division I all-time goals record, along with the program's single-season goals record, single-game goals record in the NCAA Tournament, and tied for the all-time single-game record.
- Shellenberger passed Steele Stanwick on UVA's career points list in the NCAA Tournament.
- The win snapped UVA's four-game losing skid, its first since 2013.
- Cavalier LSM **Ben Wayer** tied his career-high of eight ground balls and added two assists. **Anthony Ghobriel** (12-23) and **Thomas Colucci** (5-8) helped UVA finish 17 for 31 at the faceoff X.

CAVALIERS AMONG THE NATION'S STATISTICAL LEADERS

- For games played through May 12, the Cavaliers lead the nation in caused turnovers (11.75) and ground balls (38.19).
- Virginia is second in man-up offense (.586), sixth in assists (9.06), clearing (.899) and points (23.50), eighth in scoring offense (14.44), 11th in shot percentage (.321) and 14th in opponent clear percentage (.827).
- **Payton Cormier** leads all Division I players in goals (3.94) and is 11th in points (4.69) and 14th in man-up goals (6). **Connor Shellenberger** is third in assists (3.13) and seventh in points (4.88), and **Cole Kastner** is 16th in caused turnovers (1.81).

HOOS WINNING FACEOFFS BY COMMITTEE

- This offseason, Virginia lost the program's most accomplished faceoff specialist in Petey LaSalla, who was selected in the second round of the 2023 PLL Draft.
- This year, Virginia has relied on **Anthony Ghobriel** (129-228/.566), **Thomas Colucci** (74-147/.503) and **Matthew DeSouza** (33-73/.452) at the center X.
- Virginia is currently 243-466 (.521) on faceoffs this year, and the combination of Ghobriel, Colucci, and DeSouza have guided the Hoos to finishing above 50 percent at the faceoff X in **10** of its **16** total games so far this year.
- **As of May 12**, UVA has faced **nine** teams that are among the nation's top-25 leaders in faceoff win percentage.
- Additionally, Virginia LSM **Ben Wayer** (81 GBs), who was named a USA Lacrosse Honorable Mention All-American, has proven to be one of the nation's best faceoff wings.

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- No. 5 Virginia has been ranked in the top 5 in 61 percent of USILA coaches polls all-time, including the most recent edition of the poll.
- Virginia has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 70 all-time polls, good for 13 percent all-time.
- UVA has been ranked in 532 out of 553 (96.2) total USILA polls all-time.
- The USILA poll began in 1973.

THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM

- Virginia owns a 180-47 (.793) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 7-2 mark in 2024, and has won 21 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 6.1 goals.
- Virginia is 54-15 (.783) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach **Lars Tiffany**.
- UVA is also 15-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in NCAA Tournament contests.
- Lacrosse debuted in Klöckner Stadium in 1993.

ON THE HORIZON

- The winner of Virginia-Johns Hopkins advances to Championship Weekend and takes on the winner of No. 2 seed Duke (13-5) and No. 7 seed Maryland (9-5) on Saturday (May 25) at Lincoln Financial Field (Philadelphia, Pa.).
- Semifinals start times will be announced upon the conclusion of Sunday's quarterfinal between the Cavaliers and Hopkins.

THREE-TIME TEWAARATON AWARD FINALIST CONNOR SHELLENBERGER

- For the third consecutive year, Virginia attackman **Connor Shellenberger** was named one of five Tewaaraton Award Finalists.
- Shellenberger is UVA's only three-time Tewaaraton Award Finalist and one of eight among all collegiate programs since the inception of the award in 2001.
- With **190** career assists, he is the ACC's all-time assists record holder, and currently leads all active Division I players.
- In 2023, Shellenberger guided the Hoos to Championship Weekend last season after leading the nation in assists (3.38/gm).
- Shellenberger is one of just two Cavaliers in school history to garner USILA First Team All-America honors three times, the other being former defenseman Ken Clausen.
- In addition to being a Tewaaraton Finalist in 2023, Shellenberger garnered NCAA All-Tournament honors after combining for 11 goals and 11 assists in the Cavaliers' three tournament games last season.
- Shellenberger was also the 2021 NCAA Tournament Most Outstanding Player after leading the Hoos to their seventh NCAA championship, also the program's ninth national championship overall.

PAYTON CORMIER: THE NCAA DIVISION I CAREER GOALS LEADER

- With his eighth goal of the day in Virginia's NCAA First Round win over Saint Joseph's (May 11), **Payton Cormier** became the NCAA Division I all-time goals leader.
- Cormier shattered Mac O'Keefe's (Penn State) previous record of 221 career goals. Cormier currently stands at **222** career goals.
- In the win over the Hawks, Cormier (**63 goals**) also set UVA's single-season goals record, shattering Xander Dickson's record of 61 goals, which he achieved in 2023.
- Cormier's eight goals also set the Virginia's single-game goals record in an NCAA Tournament game and tied the school's all-time single-game record.
- Cormier is the only player in school history to record three 50-goal seasons, having scored **63** goals in 2024, 52 in 2023 and 50 in 2022.
- Among all of UVA's 100-career goal scorers, Cormier is the only one to average at least **3.13** goals per game.
- Earlier this season, Cormier shattered the Virginia and ACC career goals records.
- Cormier was recently signed by the PLL's New York Atlas, joining **Connor Shellenberger**, who was selected second overall in the 2024 PLL Draft, and Xander Dickson who was taken by the Atlas in the 2023 draft.
- Cormier is one of three 2024 quarterfinal participants riding a 19-game goal streak, joining Hopkins' Garrett Degnon (45 games) and Duke's Brennan O'Neill (46 games).

VIRGINIA IS A GROUND BALL MACHINE

- In 2023, UVA led the nation in ground balls per game (39.65) for the ninth time since 2009.
- It also marked the eighth consecutive year the Cavaliers finished in the top-2 nationally in ground balls.

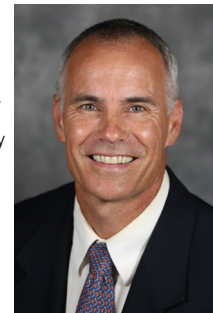
THE RESURGENCE OF BEN WAYER

- After taking a year off in 2023, LSM **Ben Wayer** has stood out as one of the nation's best LSMs.
- Wayer leads the Cavaliers in ground balls (**81**) and has **seven** goals and **five** assists.
- He is the only LSM in the nation with at least **81** ground balls and **12** points.
- The last UVA LSM to record at least 80 ground balls in a single season was 2021 MacLaughlin Award winner Jared Conners (85 GBs).

HEAD COACH LARS TIFFANY

OVERVIEW

Lars Tiffany was named Virginia's 17th head coach on June 21, 2016. He is currently in his seventh season at UVA and 19th season overall as head coach. Tiffany is Virginia's only head coach to win back-to-back national championships (2019 & 2021). Tiffany begins the 2024 season with 80 wins as UVA head coach, good for No. 3 all-time in program history behind only Jim "Ace" Adams (137) and Dom Starsia (274).

A Biology concentrator, Tiffany played on two Brown teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament (1987 & 1990). He was Co-MVP of the Brown squad that captured its first-ever NCAA playoff victory in 1990 (12-9 vs. UMass). Tiffany capped his career by playing in the North-South Senior All-Star game.

MCCABE MILLON'S STELLAR FRESHMAN CAMPAIGN

- Attackman **McCabe Millon**, the nation's No. 1 prospect in his class, has had one of the best freshman seasons in UVA history.
- Millon is second on the team in both goals (**36**) and assists (**22**).
- As of May 13, Millon is four goals shy from tying UVA's freshman goals record and his 58 points are tied for second all-time by a UVA freshman.
- Additionally, his 58 points are the most among all Division I freshmen, and his 36 goals are the most among all ACC freshmen and second nationally.
- Millon has registered at least one point in all 16 possible games this season, and has logged multi-goal efforts in 10 games this season, seven of which were hat tricks.
- Millon has tallied a season-high five goals in two games this year: Virginia's season opener against Michigan (Feb. 10) and UAlbany (March 19).

MATTHEW NUNES: ONE OF UVA'S MOST ELITE GOALIES

- Junior goalie **Matthew Nunes** set the Virginia single-season program record with 213 saves in 17 games last season.
- Nunes broke Alex Rode's 2021 program record of 212 saves, which Rode achieved in 16 games.
- During his freshman season in 2022, Nunes broke Tillman Johnson's program freshman record with 159 saves.
- In 2023, Nunes led all ACC goalies in save percentage (.551) among conference games only.
- He finished second overall in the ACC in goals-against average (11.95) and saves per game (14.33) last season.
- Nunes has been at his best in the biggest of games (see table below).

ACC CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

- Virginia has claimed at least a share of 19 ACC championships, including two (2019 & 2022) under head coach **Lars Tiffany**.
- The Cavaliers won 11 titles (1962, 1964, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1975, 1980, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986) prior the ACC establishing a tournament (1989-2019) to determine the champion.
- Virginia has won seven ACC Tournament championships: 1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2010 and 2019.
- In the last ACC Tournament, which was held in 2019 at Klöckner Stadium, UVA defeated Notre Dame 10-4 in the championship game.
- From 1989-2019, Virginia won 14 regular-season titles (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012 and 2019), more than any other ACC school.
- The ACC Tournament returns this season and will be contested at American Legion Memorial Stadium (Charlotte, N.C.) on May 3 and 5.

CAVALIERS IN THE PLL

- There are currently 18 Cavaliers on PLL rosters (see below).
- In the 2024 PLL College Draft, **Connor Shellenberger** was selected second overall by the New York Atlas and the California Redwoods traded up to select **Cole Kastner** (Palo Alto, Calif.) with the eighth pick in the fourth round.
- **Payton Cormier** (Atlas) and **Chase Yager** (Redwoods) were claimed off waivers just days after the draft.

2023 SEASON RECAP

- Virginia finished its 2023 season with an overall record of 13-4, marking the Cavaliers' seventh consecutive winning season.
- For the third time in their last four opportunities, the Cavaliers reached Championship Weekend after NCAA Tournament wins over Richmond and Georgetown.
- For the second consecutive year and 12th time in program history, **Connor Shellenberger** was named one of the nation's five Tewarraton Finalists.
- Despite knocking off Notre Dame in both regular-season matchups last season, Virginia fell to the Fighting Irish in overtime, 13-12, in the NCAA semifinals at Lincoln Financial Field.
- Shellenberger combined for 11 goals and 11 assists in three tournament games and was named to the NCAA All-Tournament Team for the second time of his career.
- The Cavaliers did not return a total of 18 players from 2023 to this year.
- Virginia had arguably its most prolific season offensively in school history as the Cavaliers set program records in goals (293), assists (195) and points (488).
- Former UVA midfielder Thomas McConvey was named the program's seventh recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Award, which is given to the nation's top midfielder.
- Xander Dickson set the program's single-season goals record with 61 scores. He is UVA's only 60-goal scorer in a single season.

TRANSFERS ADD IMMEDIATE DEPTH

- This offseason, Lars Tiffany signed five transfers: **Jack Boyden** (Tufts), **Chase Yager** (Harvard), **Anthony Ghobriel** (Navy), **Thomas Colucci** (Colgate) and **Matthew DeSouza** (Binghamton).
- Boyden was the Division-III national player and attackman of the year in 2023. He logged 167 goals and 143 assists during his tenure (2020-23) with the Jumbos.
- Yager was a standout short-stick defensive midfielder at Harvard from 2020-23. Prior to his career with the Crimson, Yager attended Norfolk Academy. Yager was named a 2024 Inside Lacrosse Preseason All-American.
- Ghobriel, Colucci and DeSouza are all faceoff specialists. Ghobriel is a junior, while Colucci and DeSouza are graduate transfers.

LARS TIFFANY LEADS HAUDENOSAUNEE NATIONAL TEAM AT 2023 WORLD LACROSSE CHAMPIONSHIPS

• Last summer, Virginia head coach **Lars Tiffany** guided the Haudenosaunee national team to a third-place finish at the 14th World Lacrosse Games, which were held in San Diego, Calif.

• The Haudenosaunee roster featured star attackman Lyle Thompson and Zed Williams '17, who played close defense instead of his natural position, attack.

• UAlbany head coach Scott Marr served as Tiffany's assistant at the 2023 World Lacrosse Championships.

• Tiffany grew up near the Onondaga Nation, located just outside of Syracuse, N.Y.

• His Alfie Jacques' wooden stick is a close memento made for Tiffany's late father, Bradford.

• Tiffany often reflects on the roots of the game and admiration of the Onondaga in interviews and press conferences (via Inside Lacrosse).

KEVIN CASSESE NAMED ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

• Last summer, head coach Lars Tiffany announced the addition **Kevin Cassese** as the program's associate head coach and offensive coordinator.

• Cassese spent the previous 16 seasons as the head coach of Lehigh University, where he became the school's all-time winningest coach and guided the Mountain Hawks to three Patriot League titles.

• A total of 21 Lehigh players achieved USILA All-America status under Cassese's tutelage, including 2021 first-team faceoff specialist Mike Sisselberger, who set the NCAA Division-I single season faceoff win percentage record (79.5).

• Prior to serving as Lehigh head coach, Cassese was an assistant coach at his alma mater, Duke, from 2005-07. In 2007, Cassese and the Blue Devils reached the NCAA Championship game, which marked the program's second national championship appearance. He also served as Duke's interim head coach for part of the summer of 2006.

• In 2005, Cassese was an assistant coach and offensive coordinator at Stony Brook under Tiffany and conducted the nation's top man-up unit. Tiffany, Cassese and the Seawolves finished the season with a 10-6 overall record.

• A National Lacrosse Hall of Fame class of 2018 inductee, Cassese enjoyed an illustrious playing career at Duke from 2000-03, where he was twice team captain and Tewaaraton Award finalist (2002-03), a three-time All-American (2001-03), and the recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Outstanding Midfielder award (2002). He was named ACC Player of the Year in 2001 and garnered All-ACC honors three times (2001-03).

• After his collegiate playing career, Cassese was selected second overall by the Rochester Rattlers in the 2003 MLL draft. He went on to play professionally for seven seasons and was a two-time all-star, including in 2006 when he was the game's MVP.

• Cassese represented the United States at the World Championships on four occasions, including as an assistant coach in 2014. As a midfielder, he helped the U.S. win gold in 2002 and 2010. He served as Team USA's captain in 2010.

• Cassese graduated from Duke in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in sociology. He was named a USILA Scholar All-American and named one of four ACC student-athletes conference wide to receive Weaver-James-Corrigan Honorary Award, which recognized student-athletes for outstanding athletic and academic achievement.

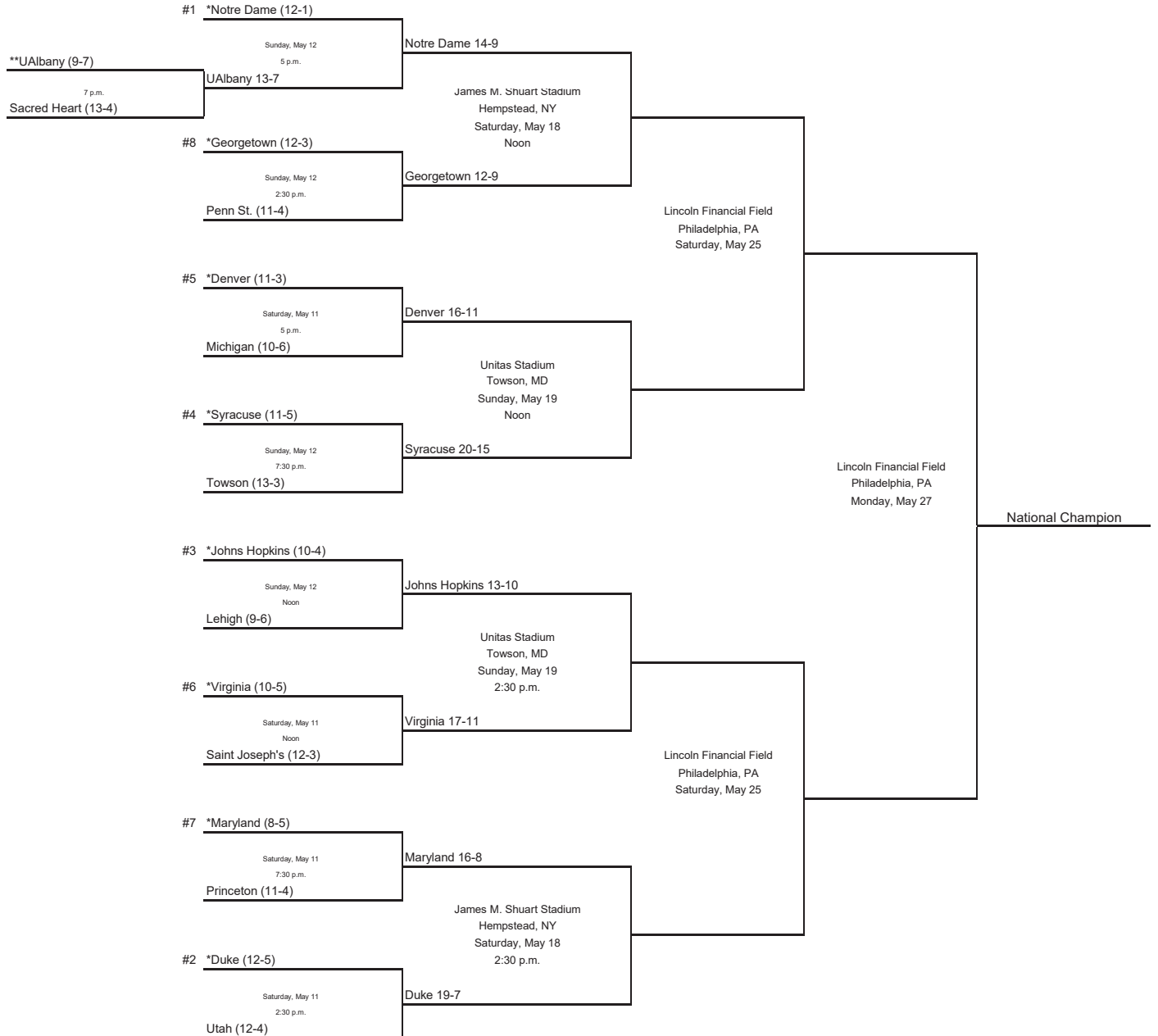
