St. John's Readies for Mississippi State in NCAA Charlottesville Regional

- The third-seeded St. John's baseball team will open the 2024 NCAA Tournament at the Charlottesville Regional against second-seeded Mississippi State on Friday.
- First pitch from Ted Davenport Field at Disharoon Park on the campus of the University of Virginia is slated for 7 p.m.
- ESPN+ will carry Friday's contest with Richard Cross and Todd Walker providing broadcast coverage all week.

Red Storm Baseball Quick Hits

- The Red Storm, picked to finish sixth in the preseason coaches poll, defied the odds to secure its conference-leading 10th BIG EAST championship and received the automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament. The Johnnies will make their 38th appearance in the national tournament, tying four teams for 11th most in college baseball history. St. John's will also make its third trip to Charlottesville in the NCAA premier postseason slate, visiting Virginia in 2010 and 2011 before making its lone Super Regional appearance in 2012.
- The Johnnies are among the nation's top teams with 21 triples (11th) and 31 sacrifice flies (38th). St. John's pitching has emerged as a steady contender among top teams in Division I, boasting a 4.26 ERA (16th in NCAA). Mario Pesca has been lethal as the Red Storm's Sunday starter with a 2.94 ERA, good for 36th in the country. Xavier Kolhosser is tied for 16th in Division I pitchers with nine wins this season. He has started in three of the Red Storm's four shutouts (24th in NCAA) in 2024. The Red Storm has protected the field defensively with a .978 fielding percentage, sitting 30th in the country.
- St. John's earned 11 wins against teams with an RPI of 75 or better this season, including singular wins over then-No. 2 Florida (30) and UConn (41), and a trio of victories over Xavier (40), Georgetown (59) and Creighton (66). The Johnnies enter the weekend slate ranked No. 51 in RPI, as of Thursday. Two of the remaining three teams in the Charlottesville Regional have RPIs under 30 Mississippi State (26), Virginia (12) and Penn (180)
- Reliever Tim Cunningham moved into sole possession of second place all-time in career relief appearances with 101 during his tenure. He became the third Johnnie to reach 100 appearances with the Red Storm, joining Thomas Hackimer (124, 2013-16) and Turner French (100, 2016-19). The Davie, Fla., product also tallied his 100th outing and 100th strikeout against Georgetown in the opening game of the BIG EAST Tournament.
- St. John's has only faced one of its three NCAA Regional opponents, going 3-4 all-time
 against Virginia with a 2-2 mark in the national tournament. The Red Storm has never
 matched up with Mississippi State and Penn in its history. The Johnnies will also face an SEC
 opponent for the fourth straight NCAA Regional.

2024 IN REVIEW

- St. John's opened the season with a bang, earning its highest-ranked regular season victory in program history with a 9-5 victory over 2023 National Runner-up Florida. It also marked just the second season-opening loss for the Gators under 17-year Head Coach Kevin O'Sullivan.
- The Johnnies saw continued success through the early going, securing a win over Houston before taking two of three games at Sam Houston. With its 6-5 extra-inning victory over the Bearkats, the Red Storm jumped out to a 13-game winning streak, its longest stretch since earning 15 straight victories in 2015. Furthermore, St. John's logged its fourth-longest unbeaten streak at home to open a season, going 15 games without a setback. St. John's went 17-2-1 in the month of March.
- St. John's opened conference play with three road wins over Villanova, outscoring the Wildcats, 27-8, with an 11-0 shutout in game two. The Red Storm also picked up a win at UConn the following weekend.
- After taking its first home league series of the season against Butler, the Johnnies
 registered two wins at Xavier on April 25-27. Head Coach Mike Hampton earned his 100th
 career victory with a 9-3 triumph in game two, becoming the fourth manager in program
 history to reach the century mark in wins.
- The Johnnies rolled past Creighton with 7-3, 3-2 and 7-1 victories in Queens on May 3-4. St. John's swept the Bluejays at home for the first time since 2018.
- The Red Storm clinched its spot in the BIG EAST Tournament with a pair of wins at Seton Hall (May 10-12) before earning the second seed with a 6-4 victory against the Hoyas on May 17. The Red Storm went on to win 11 series in 2024, featuring sweeps over Hofstra, Rider, Villanova and Creighton.
- St. John's swept the field in the BIG EAST Tournament for the sixth time in 10 championship runs, earning a win over Xavier and a pair of victories, including the title game, against Georgetown.

10 FOLD - BIG EAST CHAMPIONS

- St. John's captured its BIG EAST-leading 10th conference tournament title with a 4-2 win
 over the Hoyas on Saturday afternoon, two years to the day since legendary St. John's
 patriarch Jack Kaiser passed away. Since the conference moved its postseason slate to
 Prasco Park in 2018, The Red Storm earned two titles in three appearances.
- The Johnnies have the most tournament titles (10) since the conference secured baseball in 1985. Head Coach Mike Hampton has been on staff for five tournament championships. Assistant coach John Valente has earned one as an assistant coach and two titles as a player, capturing the 2015 title before earning the 2018 crown during his BIG EAST Player of the Year run. Pitching coach George Brown earned his second since joining the staff prior to the 2018 season.
- Sophomore catcher Jimmy Keenan earned the Jack Kaiser Most Outstanding Player
 Award following a 7-for-14 showing at the dish with six RBIs. The White Plains, N.Y.,
 native walked off on the Hoyas in game one with a two-run homer in the ninth to steal
 an 11-9 contest. The following day, Keenan belted another two-run blast to put the Red
 Storm ahead 8-7 against the Musketeers through eight innings.
- Evan Chaffee, Xavier Kolhosser, Luke Orbon and Garrett Scavelli all picked up All-Tournament honors following the BIG EAST Baseball Championships. The tandem of Chaffee and Kolhosser shut down the Hoyas in the championship game, surrendering just two runs on three hits with a combined eight strikeouts.
- St. John's is one of 11 Division I teams to secure 10 or more league tournament titles within the same conference Army, Bethune Cookman, Coastal Carolina, Kent State, LSU, Ohio State, Oral Roberts, Southern, Western Carolina, Wichita State.

RED STORM IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- St. John's and Mississippi State will meet for the first time in program history, despite both teams making their 38th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. The two squads are tied for 11th in college baseball history alongside Stanford and Texas A&M. Since 2004, the Red Storm has appeared in the NCAA Tournament 10 times.
- The Johnnies will make their third appearance in the Charlottesville Regional after previously playing in Virginia during the 2010 and 2011 seasons. St. John's is 4-4 in Charlottesville in the postseason, including a 1-1 record against the SEC. The Red Storm pulled out a 20-16 slugfest to Ole Miss on June 6, 2010. Matt Wessinger had five RBIs and finished a home run shy of the cycle, part of a 4-for-5 day at the dish. Jimmy Brennan went 4-for-6 with four RBIs while Joe Panik and Paul Karmas had three RBIs apiece in the contest.
- The Red Storm is in search of its first NCAA Tournament win under Head Coach Mike Hampton and first since an 11-5 win over Morehead State on June 2, 2018. Wyatt Mascarella unloaded the program's first multi-homer game since 2010, knocking in three runs on the day.
- The Johnnies advanced to the Super Regionals on one of those occasions, winning three straight games, including two over the host Tar Heels, at the 2012 NCAA Chapel Hill Regional. Danny Bethea hit a walk-off home run in the Johnnies' first win against North Carolina.
- The Johnnies have made the College World Series on six occasions with the last of those appearances coming in 1980. 1988 AL Cy Young winner Frank Viola and John Franco, who ranks fifth on MLB's all-time saves list (424), were teammates on 1980 College World Series squad.

HURLERS GONNA HURL

- The Red Storm pitchers have emerged as one of the top staffs in the country with a 4.26 ERA, good for 16th in the nation. Additionally, the team has tossed four shutouts this season, tied for 17th in the country. Entering the conference tournament, the Johnnies are one of 11 teams at the Division I level that has three pitchers with six or more wins this season Xavier Kolhosser (9, 16th in NCAA), Mario Pesca (6), Louis Marinaro (6).
- Of BIG EAST pitchers to toss at least seven innings this season, the Red Storm had four of the
 conference's top 10 pitchers in ERA at season's end, including Jed Boyle (2.00 ERA, 3rd), Tim
 Cunningham (2.02, 4th), Louis Marinaro (2.44, 8th) and Mario Pesca (2.54, 9th).
- Kolhosser is looking to become the just the sixth Johnnie in program history and first since Sean Mooney (11-3, 2018) to record double-digit victories on the mound. The right-hander has nine wins on the season and will look to join the likes of Frank Viola (10 / 1980, '81), Michael O'Connor (10 / 1977), Tim McCormick (11 / 2015) and Tom Sowinski (11 / 1968).
- Mario Pesca has been lethal for the Red Storm all season long, going 6-1 in 14 starts with a 2.94 ERA, the best among St. John's starters. The opposition has hit .227 against the right-hander this season while he has logged 51 strikeouts in 70.1 innings of work. Pesca's best outing of the season came in game two of its doubleheader sweep against Creighton on April 27. The 6-foot-8 hurler blew past the Bluejays with a BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week honor with seven strikeouts across a career-high seven innings of work. Pesca also earned All-BIG EAST First Team honors.
- Evan Chaffee has been a revelation for the Johnnies in his first season in Queens, boasting fantastic conference numbers as the team's Saturday starter. Logging two of his three wins in conference play, the southpaw managed a 3.69 ERA and 28 punchouts across 39.0 innings of work. The Johnnies' redshirt freshman finished the year strong, recording a team-best and career-high 7.1 innings of work at Seton Hall on May 11, earning BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week after striking out three batters and surrendering just one run. Chaffee propelled the Red Storm to its 10th conference title after allowing one run on two hits with seven strikeouts in six innings of work.

YOU CAN'T RUN ON HIM

- Catcher Jimmy Keenan has been on a tear behind the plate, throwing out BIG EAST-leading 25
 runners trying to steal. His 25 successful caught stealing attempts are the most in the last 20 seasons,
 surpassing the previous high mark of 20 set by Tyler Sanchez in 2014 and Joe Witkowski in 2010.
- Keenan is currently one shy of the most overall among BIG EAST schools in the last 10 years, closing in on Xavier's Dan Rizzie with 26 in 2014.
- The Red Storm's catcher will also be chasing Seton Hall's Frank Esposito (29, 2011) and Louisville's Derrick Alfonso (30, 2007) for the conference's top mark in the last 20 seasons.
- Offensively, the sophomore plate protector has been equally as good with a .341/.410/.615 slash line. Keenan paces the team with 70 hits, 55 RBIs, 11 homers and 19 doubles.
- The BIG EAST First Team selection propelled the Johnnies to their 10th BIG EAST Tournament, smacking a pair of go-ahead home runs and driving in six runs en route to a Jack Kaiser Most Outstanding Player Award.

HOME SWEET HOME

- The Red Storm was stellar at Jack Kaiser Stadium with a 21-6-1 record, marking the most wins at home since the 2019 season (21). The 2024 squad is just the seventh team to produce a 20-win season at home since the current ballpark opened in 2001. It also marks the fifth time in seven chances the Red Storm has made the NCAA Regionals having won 20-plus games at home.
- It also marks just the sixth time since the team renamed its home field in honor of the late Jack Kaiser in 2007 that the team has secured at least 20 victories in Queens. St. John's, who had not lost at home in 15 straight games and secured 14 consecutive wins at The Jack to start the 2024 campaign, posted the fourth-longest unbeaten streak in Queens to open a season in program history, trailing only the 1962 and 1981 teams (16-0) and the 1977 squad (18-0), led by former Minnesota Twins player and coach Scott Ullger.
- St. John's slashed .303/.417/.464 as a team. The Red Storm pitching staff has also posted a 3.29 ERA and held the opposition to a .231 batting average against.
- Six starters with 20 or more games played are batting .300 or better inside the friendly confines
 of Jack Kaiser Stadium with Garrett Scavelli leading the surge with a .352 mark at the dish. Jimmy
 Keenan paces the team with 30 RBIs and 17 extra-base hits. The sophomore plate protector has
 also mashed a team-best five home runs while teammate Jackson Tucker has unloaded 12 doubles.
- Eight pitchers are recording ERA's under three with Jed Boyle (0.00) and Louis Marinaro (0.74) leading the charge. Marinaro has been efficient with a 5-0 record, 26 strikeouts and a .133 batting average against across 24.1 frames of work.
- Boyle has made nine appearances at The Jack this season, holding the opposition to just one hit
 and punching out 14 batters in nine innings.
- Tim Cunningham has also been lethal in his 16 appearances at The Jack with 24 strikeouts to just four walks in 19.2 innings of work.
- Pesca picked up his fifth win at home after plowing through Creighton with a career-high seven innings pitched to go with seven strikeouts on Saturday afternoon. The 6-foot-8 hurler has registered 27 strikeouts and a 1.96 ERA across 36.2 innings of work. The Bronx native has pestered his seven opponents with a .183 batting average against.



MARCH MADNESS

- The Red Storm boasted a 17-2-1 record in the month of March, starting with a series win at red-hot Sam Houston to close out the team's Texas road trip.
- Upon their arrival home, the Johnnies rattled off 13 straight wins, its longest winning streak since 2015. St. John's remains unbeaten at Jack Kaiser Stadium, holding a 14-0-1 record in Queens.
- Through its 20 games in March, the Johnnies slashed .326/.436/.515 with 9.2 runs per game. St. John's third baseman **Blake Mayberry** swung the most efficient bat through the month with a .459 batting average and a .573 on-base percentage in 19 appearances.
- Five players logged 20 or more runs scored, including Jackson Tucker (27), Ben Beauchamp (26), Anthony Brienza (21), Luke Orbon (20) and Mayberry (20). Jimmy Keenan led the team with 28 RBIs in March while Mayberry chipped in 22 of his own.
- St. John's starters **Xavier Kolhosser** and **Mario Pesca** combined for nine of the team's 17 wins and allowed just 11 earned runs and 22 walks across 58.2 innings of work.

LIVE FROM NEW YORK, IT'S BIG EAST LIVE

- The Johnnies secured 17 BIG EAST Weekly Awards in 2024, seeing Jimmy Keenan lead the way with four honor roll nods (Feb. 19, March 11, April 15, May 13) and one BIG EAST Player of the Week selection (March 18). After helping the Red Storm to its highest-ranked regular season victory over No. 2 Florida with a 2-for-4 day with an RBI, the Johnnies' catcher secured his second honor roll selection with a .563/.588/.813 slash line to go with eight RBIs and four runs in a 4-0 week for the Johnnies. A month later, he unloaded a .450/.500/1.100 slash line in five wins, rattling off 13 RBIs and seven runs scored while seven of his nine hits went for extra bases for Player of the Week honors. He secured his third honor roll of the season on April 15 after a steady weekend against UConn, slashing .417/.500/1.000 with five hits, including two homers and a double. Keenan also chipped in seven runs scored and four RBIs against the Huskies. He earned his final Honor Roll selection logging a team-best .375 to go with six RBIs and four runs scored.
- Ben Adams captured BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week with three shutout innings against
 the nation's second-ranked team, Florida. The southpaw struck out two batters and
 allowed just two hits and a walk in his outing. The No. 2 team in the nation swung
 .182 against the left-hander who threw 48 pitches on Friday.
- Xavier Kolhosser earned an honor roll selection (3/4) following his six shutout innings at Sam Houston. The righty allowed just six hits in the outing, striking out five batters along the way. The Wappinger Falls, N.Y., native also earned BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week (3/25) after tossing seven shutout frames against Fordham, logging five strikeouts in the win. Kolhosser followed up with another Pitcher of the Week (4/1) performance with a career-high 10 strikeouts in seven shutout innings against Winthrop.
- Louis Marinaro also earned an honor roll selection after tossing 5.2 innings of shutout baseball last week. The southpaw logged a win, struck out seven and surrendered no walks in his two appearances. The opposition also swung .143 against Marinaro. The Croton on Hudson, N.Y., product found himself on the the conference's final weekly honor roll following a career-high four innings of shutout work against Georgetown on May 16. He also struck out four batters and allowed just one hit.
- Jed Boyle earned a BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll selection on April 8 after The Syracuse, N.Y., native picked up his first career BIG EAST weekly accolade following his two dominant appearances in Plymouth Meeting, Pa. Boyle secured his third save of the season in the Johnnies' 13-7 victory on April 5. He followed up with seven strikeouts in 2.1 innings of work to steal a 3-1 victory in 13 innings on April 7.
- Graduate student Marty Higgins earned back-to-back BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll selections after three straight multi-hit games against Butler (4/22) and a pair of three-RBI games in the team's series win over Xavier (4/29).
- The tandem of Mario Pesca and Evan Chaffee exchanged BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week honors to open May. Pesca picked up Pitcher of the Week on May 6 following seven strikeouts across a career-high 7.0 innings of work against Creighton. Chaffee also earned an Honor Roll selection that week with a no-hit bid through five innings against the Bluejays
- Chaffee captured his first BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week following a team-best and career-high 7.1 innings of work in the Johnnies' postseason-clinching 7-3 victory in game two of Saturday's doubleheader split at Seton Hall. The southpaw struck out three batters and retired the side in order on four different occasions.
- The Red Storm was predicted to finish sixth for the second-straight year in the BIG EAST's Preseason Coaches' Poll. Connecticut was picked to win the league for the fourth consecutive year, followed by defending BIG EAST Champions Xavier. Seton Hall earned a third-place mark, while Creighton and Georgetown secured matching 29 points for fourth. Butler and Villanova rounded out the conference poll in seventh and eighth, respectively.
- St. John's was picked to finish second in 2020 and fourth in both 2021 and 2022 after claiming the top spot in five consecutive preseason polls from 2015-19.

THE BOYS ARE BACK IN TOWN

- The Johnnies returned 22 players from last season and expect to make an immediate impact in 2024. Coming into the 2024 campaign, the Red Storm return 49.0 percent of its run scoring and 53.0 percent of RBI production from a year ago. Among the returners are program veterans Marty Higgins, Paul Orbon and Jackson Tucker.
- Higgins, a former BIG EAST First Team selection, was one of seven players that registered a batting average over .300 last season, boasting a .310 mark at the dish to go with 32 runs and 32 RBIs for the Red Storm.
- Orbon joined Higgins in the .300 batting average club last year, ranking fifth on the team with a .338 mark to go with 33 RBIs and 24 runs scored.
- Tucker entered his third season with the Johnnies and produced a steady 2023 campaign with 25 stolen bases and 37 runs scored.
- The Johnnies will look to veteran hurlers Joe Mascio and Ben Adams to bolster the load and help Xavier Kolhosser and Mario Pesca take the next step in their second playing season with St. John's.
- Mascio, who earned the program's Howie Gershberg Award for the top pitcher in 2023, provided stability as the Saturday starter. Going 3-3 in 13 starts, the left-hander struck out 63 batters in 65.1 innings of work.
- Adams produced a career year in 2023, making 19 relief appearances and boasting a 4-0 record out of the bullpen. Across 36.1 innings of work, the Ottawa, Ontario native punched out 28 batters while holding the opposition to a .189 batting average against.
- Kolhosser made a statement in his first season back from Tommy John surgery. The
 redshirt sophomore dominated in his nine starts last season, going 3-0 with a 2.56
 ERA. He also struck out 30 batters in 31.2 innings of work.
- Pesca is expected to make a massive jump as a sophomore and saw glimpses of his
 dominance towards the end of the 2023 slate. The sophomore hurler put forth six
 innings of shutout ball against Rutgers, forcing 11 groundouts and seven flyouts.
- The Johnnies will also look to rely on Tim Cunningham and Chuck Sanzio out of the pen while looking to Jace Jeremiah and Luke Orbon as key contributors.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- The Red Storm's new-look roster for 2024 has several transfers and a dozen freshmen, including an NJCAA Championship runner-up in Sam Mettert and East Coast Conference Player of the Year Garrett Scavelli.
- Mettert produced one of the most dominant seasons with Wabash Valley in 2023, logging a 3-0 record with nine saves, a 1.09 ERA and 42 strikeouts across 33.0 innings of work. The right-hander tossed 3.0 innings or more in three outings last season, earning a win and two saves in such games.
- Scavelli played three seasons at Molloy (Division II), slashing a career .357/.458/.562 with 121 runs, 92 RBIs and 80 walks. The Franklin Square, N.Y., native set career-high marks in batting average (.391), on-base percentage (.481), slugging percentage (.624), hits (79), runs (60), RBIs (46), doubles (19), triples (5), home runs (6), and stolen bases (15) during his Player of the Year run.
- The Johnnies will also look to transfer pitchers Jed Boyle (Le Moyne) and Evan Chaffee (Alabama), as well as infielder Aries Samek (Florida Southwestern St.) to make an immediate impact.
- St. John's welcomed in 12 freshmen for the 2024 season, featuring Adam Agresti, Chris Batuyios, Cristian Bernardini, Brady Clark, Chad Falcon, Cole LeClair, Jayder Raifstanger, Nelson Rosa, Jacob Ruiz, Grant Russo, Zaine Toneske and TJ Winn Jr.

HAMPTON RETURNS JOHNNIES TO PROMINENCE

- Fifth-year head coach Mike Hampton saw his team produce the best season (37-16-1) since he took over the program in 2020. His team opened the 2024 campaign with the program's highest-ranked victory in the regular season with a 9-5 victory over No. 2 Florida. The Johnnies finished its road trip taking two of three games against Sam Houston, jumpstarting a 13-game winning streak upon their return home. Hampton secured his 100th career win on April 27 at Xavier. His 14 wins in conference play were also the most since taking over the Red Storm, en route to first BIG EAST Coaching Staff of the Year.
- On January 6, 2020, ABCA Hall of Famer Ed Blankmeyer announced his resignation from St. John's to pursue a professional opportunity within the New York Mets organization.
- Blankmeyer, who managed the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2021, had recently completed his 24th season at the helm of the Red Storm baseball team, a span that featured 23 winning seasons. He won 829 games, five BIG EAST Tournament titles and six BIG EAST Regular Season crowns. He turned in a career-winning percentage of .623, guided the Red Storm to nine 40-win seasons and saw his team earn an NCAA bid 11 separate times.
- Blankmeyer handed over the reins to assistant coach Mike Hampton, who was initially named the interim head coach before having that tag removed over the summer.
 Hampton is in his 23rd season at the University and has played a key role in the continued growth of the St. John's baseball program.
- The Johnnies' longtime recruiting coordinator and hitting instructor, Hampton was a member of all but one of Blankmeyer's BIG EAST Tournament Championship and NCAA Tournament teams while playing a part in all six BIG EAST Regular Season titles.

Scouting the Competition

No. 2 Mississippi State

St. John's will square off with Mississippi State for the first time in program history when the two teams meet in the opening round of the NCAA Charlottesville Regional on Friday. St. John's will look to take down its first SEC opponent in the postseason since June 6, 2010, knocking off Ole Miss, 20-16. The Bulldogs are defensively sound with a .982 fielding percentage (4th in NCAA) while boasting a 4.15 ERA (12th). Mississippi State is also ranked eighth in the country with a 2.92 strikeout-to-walk ratio. Dakota Jordan paces the team offensively with 63 RBIs, 17 home runs and a .643 slugging percentage.

No. 1 Virginia

Virginia is the nation's second-ranked team in the nation with a .341 batting average. The Cavaliers also rank top 10 with 9.7 runs per game (3rd), 691 hits (4th), 138 doubles (7th) and 113 homers (9th). Bobby Whelen leads the team with a .403 batting average, good for second in the ACC and 13th in Division I. Virginia also has four other players ranked inside the conference's top 20 in batting average. St. John's is 2-2 against the Cavaliers in the NCAA Tournament, looking for its first win against them since a 6-5 triumph on June 6, 2010. Jeremy Baltz smacked a pair of two-run homers to give the Johnnies its program-record 43rd win of the season against top regional seed Virginia. Cavaliers' Head Coach Kevin Mc-Mullan previously spent three seasons at St. John's under Head Coach Ed Blankmeyer, helping the team to three BIG EAST championship appearances, a BIG EAST title and an NCAA Regional berth in 1997.

No. 4 Penn

Penn secured its second consecutive lvy League title after avoiding elimination with an 11-9 game one victory, followed by a 12-6 win in the championship game. Wyatt Henseler, who was named lvy League Player of the Year, earned the tournament's Most Outstanding Player after going 9-for-24 with three homers and 10 RBIs. St. John's and Penn have never met before. The Red Storm has not faced an lvy League opponent in the NCAA Tournament since the infamous May 21, 1981 game against Yale. Frank Viola tossed 11 innings of scoreless work against the Bulldogs while Yale's Ron Darling carried a no-hitter into the 12th before Steve Scafa scored the winning run to lift St. John's to a 1-0 triumph in 12 frames.




