OPENING DRAW

GAME OVERVIEW

- Coming off its second loss of the season, No. 4 Virginia (10-2, 1-1) looks to bounce back as it concludes a two-game road stint on Saturday (April 20), when the Cavaliers travel to No. 7 Syracuse (10-4, 2-1).
- Opening faceoff from the JMA Wireless Dome is set for 2 p.m. as Jay Alter (play-by-play) and Paul Carcaterra (analyst) will have the call on ESPNU.

SEASON OVERVIEW

- Virginia is in its eighth season under **Lars Tiffany**, who boasts a 90-32 record as Cavalier head coach.
- The Hoos are coming off their third Championship Weekend appearance in the last four opportunities.

LAST TIME OUT

- This past Sunday (April 14), Virginia dropped its 19th consecutive regular-season matchup with Duke, 18-12, at Koskinen Stadium.
- **Anthony Ghobriel** (14-23 FO) and **Thomas Colucci** (6-11 FO) combined to finish 59 percent at the faceoff X, and the Cavaliers won the battle on the ground, 47-34.
- However, UVA only managed five saves in net and the Blue Devils, who entered Sunday's game shooting 34 percent on the season, scored on 43 percent of their shots.
- Offensively, UVA was led by **Payton Cormier**, who finished with a team-high three goals, and Connor Shellenberger (1g, 3a), who recorded a team-best four points.
- Duke's starting attack of Josh Zawada (5g, 1a), Brennan O'Neill (4g, 1a) and Dyson Williams (3g) combined for 12 of the Blue Devils' 18 goals.

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

SERIES HISTORY

- With its 19-12 victory over Syracuse at Klöckner Stadium last season, Virginia took the lead in the all-time series, which began in 1938, 21-20.
- The Hoos are currently riding a three-game win streak in the series.
- In 41 all-time meetings, UVA narrowly leads Cuse 547-537 in goals scored.
- The last time UVA lost to the Orange was on April 24, 2021, in a 13-11 decision at Klöckner Stadium.
- The last time the Cavaliers and Syracuse went head to head at the JMA Wireless Dome was when the Hoos defeated Cuse, 21-15, to clinch a share of the program's 19th ACC title.
- Additionally, UVA's 21 goals scored in the 2022 meeting tied for the most by a Syracuse opponent in The Dome since it opened in 1980.
- In the 2022 ACC opener at Klöckner Stadium, UVA dominated the Orange, 20-11, which marked its largest margin of victory in the series. Four Cavaliers notched hat tricks and Petey LaSalla set the program record for career faceoff wins.
- The two schools battled only three times between 1938-93, but have met at least once each season from 1994-2023 with the exception of 2020 due to COVID-19.
- The last time the two teams met in the NCAA Tournament was when Syracuse defeated the Cavaliers, 12-11, in a dramatic come-from-behind victory in the 2008 NCAA semifinals.
- The Orange victory snapped a five-game UVA win streak, the longest by either team in series history.
- Cuse went on to capture the national championship on Memorial Day.
- Virginia's loss in 2011 snapped a three-game win streak in The Dome over Syracuse, a feat boasted by no other Orange opponent at the time.
- In Syracuse's first-ever ACC game in 2014, James Pannell scored a career-high seven goals in a 17-12 UVA triumph at Klöckner Stadium.

TIFFANY-COACHED TEAMS KNOW HOW TO RESPOND AFTER A LOSS

- Since **Lars Tiffany** took over as UVA head coach in 2017, the Cavaliers are 23-2 in games immediately following a loss (in the same season).
- The Hoos have won their last 20 such contests, and have not suffered back-to-back losses since dropping the final two games of the 2017 season to Duke and Penn, respectively.

- Extend Virginia's win streak in the series with Syracuse to four games.
- Be UVA's second consecutive in the JMA Wireless Dome.
- Assure the Cavaliers of at least a .500 record in ACC play for the third consecutive year.

CAVALIERS AMONG THE NATION'S STATISTICAL LEADERS

- For games played through April 17, Virginia leads the nation in assists (9.75), caused turnovers (11.58) and ground balls (39.84). UVA is second in clearing (.930) and win percentage (.833), fourth in points (24.67), fifth in man-up offense (.500) and scoring offense (14.92), eighth in scoring margin (4.50) and 10th in shooting percentage (.326).
- Among all Division I players this season, **Payton Cormier** is currently No. 1 in goals (3.67) and 20th in points per game(4.50). **Connor Shellenberger** is seventh in assists (3.00) and 13th in points per game (4.75). **Matthew Nunes** is 11th in save percentage (.565) and 16th in goals-against (10.00) and **Cole Kastner** is 20th in caused turnovers per game (1.75).

HOOS WINNING FACEOFFS BY COMMITTEE

- This offseason, Virginia lost the program's most decorated faceoff specialist in Petey LaSalla – who was selected in the second round of the 2023 PLL Draft – to graduation.
- This year, Virginia has relied on **Anthony Ghobriel** (80-140/.571), **Thomas Colucci** (63-117/.538) and **Matthew DeSouza** (33-68/.485) at the center X.
- The combination of Ghobriel, Colucci, and DeSouza have guided UVA to finish above 50 percent at the faceoff X in **eight** of its **12** total games so far this year.
- **As of April 18**, nine of UVA's 14 total regular-season opponents are among the nation's top-25 leaders in faceoff win percentage.
- Additionally, Virginia LSM **Ben Wayer** (58 GBs) who was named an honorable mention midseason All-American according to Inside Lacrosse, has proven to be one of the nation's best faceoff wings.

KASTNER, SHELLENBERGER NAMED TEWAARATON AWARD NOMINEES

- Virginia captains Cole Kastner and Connor Shellenberger were named two of 25 Tewaaraton Award Nominees, the Tewaaraton Foundation announced April 18.
- The five finalists from the group of 25 nominees will be announce on May 9 after the conclusion of the regular season.
- Virginia is one of six schools nationally – four of which are also ACC members – to have at least two nominees.
- The Tewaaraton Award is recognized as the preeminent lacrosse award, annually honoring the top male and female college lacrosse player.

ON THE HORIZON

- The Cavaliers wrap up the regular season by hosting No. 1 Notre Dame (8-1, 2-0) on Saturday (April 27) in a rematch of the 2023 NCAA semifinals, when the Hoos lost 13-12 in overtime.
- Opening faceoff from Klöckner Stadium is set for 2 p.m.

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- No. 4 Virginia has been ranked in the top 5 of the USILA Coaches poll in 337 weeks all-time, including in the most recent edition of the poll.
- Virginia has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 70 all-time polls.
- UVA has been ranked in 529 out of 550 (.962) total USILA polls all-time.
- The USILA Poll began in 1973.

THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM

- Virginia owns a 179-46 (.796) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 6-1 record in 2024, and has won 22 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 6.8 goals.
- Virginia is 53-14 (.791) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach **Lars Tiffany**.
- UVA is also 14-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in NCAA Tournament contests.
- Lacrosse debuted in Klöckner Stadium in 1993.

CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE

- Virginia attackman **Connor Shellenberger** is in his final collegiate season in 2024.
- Shellenberger guided the Hoos to Championship Weekend last season after leading the nation in assists (3.38/gm).
- With **176** career assists, he is Virginia's all-time assist record holder, and currently leads all active Division I players.
- Shellenberger is one of just two Cavaliers to garner USILA First Team All-America honors, the other being former defenseman Ken Clausen.
- In addition to being a Tewaaronon finalist for the second time of his career in 2023, Shellenberger garnered NCAA All-Tournament honors after combining for 11 goals and 11 assists in the Cavaliers' three tournament games last season.
- Shellenberger was also the 2021 NCAA Tournament Most Outstanding Player after leading the Hoos to their seventh NCAA championship, also the program's ninth national championship overall.

CONNOR SHELLENBERGER RECORD WATCH

- With his second point of the day against UAlbany (March 19), **Connor Shellenberger** became UVA's all-time leader in career points.
- Shellenberger currently leads all active Division-I players in career assists and is one of just two active players (Matt Brandau, Yale) with at least **296** career points.

PAYTON CORMIER: VIRGINIA'S CAREER GOALS LEADER

- With his second goal at Richmond (Feb. 17), **Payton Cormier** became Virginia's all-time leading goal scorer.
- Cormier shattered Doug Knight's previous program record of 165 career goals, which Knight accomplished in 60 games.
- Cormier broke the record in just 57 career games.
- Now with **203** career goals, Cormier currently lead all active Division I players.
- Among all of UVA's 100-career goal scorers, Cormier is the only one to average at least **3.03** goals per game.
- Cormier is also the only player in program history to record a pair of 50-goal seasons, having scored 52 goals last year and 50 goals in 2022.
- He notched a career-high seven goals against Ohio State in 2023, which tied for No. 2 in UVA single-game history.
- This season Cormier has recorded multiple goals in all but one of UVA's games, six of which have been hat tricks.

- Nunes broke Alex Rode's 2021 program record of 212 saves, which Rode achieved in 16 games.

- In 2023, Nunes led all ACC goalies in save percentage (.551) among conference games only.

CHIZMAR NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- For his performance against North Carolina, short-stick defensive midfielder **Noah Chizmar** was named the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week on April 9.
- The announcement marked Chizmar's first career ACC weekly honor.
- He scored only 11 seconds in on the game's opening possession and again with 10:36 remaining in the first half, which proved to be the game-winning goal.
- On defensive end, Chizmar collected four ground balls and a pair of caused turnovers, one of which was while the Cavaliers were man-down.

CORMIER, NUNES SWEEP ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- For the performances in UVA's 13-10 comeback win at then-No. 16 Harvard (March 30), **Payton Cormier** and **Matthew Nunes** swept ACC's Offensive and Defensive player-of-the-week honors, respectively, the conference office announced April 2.
- The announcement marked Cormier's sixth career ACC weekly honor, including third this year. Nunes now has five ACC career weekly honors, including a pair this season.
- Cormier scored a game-high four goals and dished out one assist. His third goal of the day kickstarted a 7-0 run in the fourth quarter, which ultimately put the Hoos ahead to stay.
- Nunes scored the game-winning goal in dramatic fashion and recorded a game-high 16 against the Crimson.
- Amid a UVA clear with five minutes remaining, Nunes carried the ball end to end and fired a shot that bounced past the Harvard keeper to break a 10-10 tied score.
- Nunes' goal against the Crimson is the first by a UVA goalie since Adam Ghitelman scored in 2010 ACC Tournament semifinals against Duke.
- It's also the first score by an ACC goalie since Syracuse's Evan Molloy found the back of the net against Colgate in 2017.

CORMIER NAMED ACC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- For games played March 18-24, **Payton Cormier** was named ACC Offensive Player of the Week after averaging 5.5 goals in UVA's wins over UAlbany (March 19) and Drexel (March 23).
- Cormier's six goals against Drexel also propelled him into the top 10 of the NCAA Division I career goals list
- He is also the only ACC player to record at five three goals in three different games this season.

HEAD COACH LARS TIFFANY

OVERVIEW

Lars Tiffany was named Virginia's 17th head coach on June 21, 2016. He is currently in his seventh season at UVA and 19th season overall as head coach. Tiffany is Virginia's only head coach to win back-to-back national championships (2019 & 2021). Tiffany begins the 2024 season with 80 wins as UVA head coach, good for No. 3 all-time in program history behind only Jim "Ace" Adams (137) and Dom Starsia (274).

- For his performance against Ohio State (Feb. 25), **Matthew Nunes** was named the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week.
- He was also the first goalie to be named ACC Defensive Player of the Week this season.
- In addition to his 17 saves, which are the most by an ACC goalie this year, Nunes only surrendered seven goals against OSU.

CORMIER, WAYER NAB ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- For their performances against Richmond (Feb. 17), **Payton Cormier** and **Ben Wayer** were named ACC Co-Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week, respectively, the league office announced on Feb. 20.
- The announcement marks Cormier's fourth career ACC weekly honor and Wayer's first.
- Cormier scored three goals and set the program's all-time goals record in the win.
- For the second consecutive week, Wayer collected ground balls and added one caused turnover.
- Wayer also played a pivotal role in the Spiders' six failed clears, four of which occurred in the fourth quarter.
- Wayer was also a key contributor on UVA's faceoff unit, which won 15 of the game's 26 total faceoffs, including 10 of 14 in the second half.
- Additionally, UR's starting midfield line combined for just two goals.

ACC CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

- Virginia has claimed at least a share of 19 ACC championships, including two (2019 & 2022) under head coach **Lars Tiffany**.
- The Cavaliers won 11 titles (1962, 1964, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1975, 1980, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986) prior the ACC establishing a tournament from 1989-2019 to determine the champion.
- Virginia has won seven ACC Tournament championships: 1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2010 and 2019.
- In the last ACC Tournament, which was held in 2019 at Klöckner Stadium, UVA defeated Notre Dame 10-4 in the championship game.
- From 1989-2019, Virginia won 14 regular-season titles (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012 and 2019), more than any other ACC School.
- The ACC Tournament returns this season and will be contested at American Legion Stadium in Charlotte, N.C. on May 3 and 5.

2023 SEASON RECAP

- Virginia finished its 2023 season with an overall record of 13-4, marking the Cavaliers' seventh consecutive winning season.
- For the third time in their last four opportunities, the Cavaliers reached Championship Weekend after NCAA Tournament wins over Richmond and Georgetown.
- For the second consecutive year and 12th time in program history, **Connor Shellenberger** was named one of the nation's five Tewaaraton Finalists.
- Despite knocking off Notre Dame in both regular-season matchups last season, Virginia fell to the Fighting Irish in overtime, 13-12, in the NCAA semifinals at Lincoln Financial Field.
- Shellenberger combined for 11 goals and 11 assists in three tournament games and was named to the NCAA All-Tournament Team for the second time of his career.
- The Cavaliers did not return a total of 18 players from 2023 to this year.
- Virginia had arguably its most prolific season offensively in school history as the Cavaliers set program records in goals (293), assists (195) and points (488).
- Former UVA midfielder Thomas McConvey was named the program's seventh recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Award, which is given to the nation's top midfielder.
- Xander Dickson set the program's single-season goals record with 61 scores. He is UVA's only 60-goal scorer in a single season.

TRANSFERS ADD IMMEDIATE DEPTH

- This offseason, Lars Tiffany signed five transfers: **Jack Boyden** (Tufts), **Chase Yager** (Harvard), **Anthony Ghobriel** (Navy), **Thomas Colucci** (Colgate) and **Matthew DeSouza** (Binghamton).
- Boyden was the Division-III national player and attackman of the year in 2023. He logged 167 goals and 143 assists during his tenure (2020-23) with the Jumbos.
- Yager was a standout short-stick defensive midfielder at Harvard from 2020-23. Prior to his career with the Crimson, Yager attended Norfolk Academy. Yager was named a 2024 Inside Lacrosse Preseason All-American.
- Ghobriel, Colucci and DeSouza are all faceoff specialists. Ghobriel is a junior, while Colucci and DeSouza are graduate transfers.

VIRGINIA'S FIRST-YEAR (FRESHMAN) CLASS

- The Cavaliers' highly-touted signing class of 2023 consists of: **Chase Band** (Potomac, Md.), **Wills Burt** (Newtown Square, Pa.), **Caulley Deringer** (Alexandria, Va.), **Will Erdmann** (South Norwalk, Conn.), **Kian McCarthy** (Rye, N.Y.), **Henry Metz** (Bloomfield Hills, Mich.), **McCabe Millon** (Reisterstown, Md.), **Eli Petty** (Richmond, Va.), **Luke Pisani** (Jupiter, Fla.) and **Cole Webber** (Garden City, N.Y.).
- Additionally, the Cavaliers added first-year goalies **Bennet Yue** (Virginia Beach, Va.) and **Colin Hook** (Lutherville, Md.) this past Fall.

KASTNER, NUNES, SHELLENBERGER NAMED TEWAARATON AWARD WATCH LIST SELECTIONS

- **Cole Kastner** (defense), **Matthew Nunes** (goalie) and **Connor Shellenberger** (attack) were have been named Tewaaraton Award Watch List selections, the Tewaaraton Foundation announced Feb. 14.
- Only Duke (4), Virginia (3), Notre Dame (3) and Syracuse (3) had at least three selections in this year's initial list.

VIRGINIA'S SIX PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

- Six Cavaliers in **Connor Shellenberger** (first team), **Cole Kastner** (first team), **Payton Cormier** (third team), **Griffin Schutz** (third team), **Chase Yager** (third team) and **Noah Chizmar** (honorable mention) were named Inside Lacrosse Preseason All-Americans.
- Virginia's six honorees were third most among all programs nationally.

- Tiffany grew up near the Onondaga Nation, located just outside of Syracuse, N.Y.
- His Alfie Jacques' wooden stick is a close memento made for Tiffany's late father, Bradford.
- Tiffany often reflects on the roots of the game and admiration of the Onondaga in interviews and press conferences (via Inside Lacrosse).

KEVIN CASSESE NAMED ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

- Last summer, head coach Lars Tiffany announced the addition **Kevin Cassese** as the program's associate head coach and offensive coordinator.
- Cassese spent the previous 16 seasons as the head coach of Lehigh University, where he became the school's all-time winningest coach and guided the Mountain Hawks to three Patriot League titles.
- A total of 21 Lehigh players achieved USILA All-America status under Cassese's tutelage, including 2021 first-team faceoff specialist Mike Sisselberger, who set the NCAA Division-I single season faceoff win percentage record (79.5).
- Prior to serving as Lehigh head coach, Cassese was an assistant coach at his alma mater, Duke, from 2005-07. In 2007, Cassese and the Blue Devils reached the NCAA Championship game, which marked the program's second national championship appearance. He also served as Duke's interim head coach for part of the summer of 2006.
- In 2005, Cassese was an assistant coach and offensive coordinator at Stony Brook under Tiffany and conducted the nation's top man-up unit. Tiffany, Cassese and the Seawolves finished the season with a 10-6 overall record.
- A National Lacrosse Hall of Fame class of 2018 inductee, Cassese enjoyed an illustrious playing career at Duke from 2000-03, where he was twice team captain and Tewaaron Award finalist (2002-03), a three-time All-American (2001-03), and the recipient of the Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin Jr. Outstanding Midfielder award (2002). He was named ACC Player of the Year in 2001 and garnered All-ACC honors three times (2001-03).
- After his collegiate playing career, Cassese was selected second overall by the Rochester Rattlers in the 2003 MLL draft. He went on to play professionally for seven seasons and was a two-time all-star, including in 2006 when he was the game's MVP.
- Cassese represented the United States at the World Championships on four occasions, including as an assistant coach in 2014. As a midfielder, he helped the U.S. win gold in 2002 and 2010. He served as Team USA's captain in 2010.
- Cassese graduated from Duke in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in sociology. He was named a USILA Scholar All-American and named one of four ACC student-athletes conference wide to receive Weaver-James-Corrigan Honorary Award, which recognized student-athletes for outstanding athletic and academic achievement.
