The Tip-Off

- ▶ Campbell embarks on its 48th season of division basketball.
- ▶ Senior guard Jasin Sinani was tabbed preseason all-CAA honorable mention. He averaged 12.9 points and 5.1 rebounds per game in CAA play last season.
- ▶ CU plays 14 games inside Gore Arena this season, five non-conference games and nine CAA contests.
- ▶ The Camels have won seven straight season-openers and 19 straight home-openers after beating Pfeiffer to open the season.
- ▶ Seven new faces join this year's squad with a six-man transfer class and one true freshman (Bragi Gudmundsson, Cam Gregory, Israel Yaw, Caleb Zurliene, Terren Frank, Eric Van Der Heijden, and Jacob Lawton).
- ▶ The transfer class features three players with power-conference experience, and four players that stand 6'8" or taller.
- ▶ The Camels went 8-10 in their inaugural CAA season, earning a split in eight of the nine league weekends.
- ▶ Campbell faces three power-conference foes this season (Ohio State, UVA, UNC), the most since the 2011-12 season.

SINANI PRESEASON ALL-CAA

- ▶ Jasin Sinani was tabbed preseason all-CAA honorable mention. He is Campbell's leading returner in points (10.4), rebounds (4.1), assists (2.3), 3FG% (.374), FT% (.887)
- ▶ His numbers ticked up in CAA play, averaging 12.9 points and 5.1 rebounds.
- ▶ He logged four 20-point games, with a career-high 27 against UNCW.
- ▶ Had nine games with at least three made 3-pointers.
- ▶ Notched a double-double with 14 & 11 against NC A&T.

SUPER SENIOR SEASON

- ▶ Gediminas Mokseckas returns for year 5 in Buies Creek.
- ▶ Has appeared in 108 games for Campbell. If he appears in every game this season, would become CU's all-time games-played leader, passing Jordan Whitfield (2017-22, 139 games).
- ▶ Averaged career-highs in points (6.3) rebounds (2.4) and assists (2.0) last season.

TRANSFER CLASS

- ▶ The six-man transfer class features two guards and four forwards.
- ▶ All four forwards stand 6-8 or 6-9, all would be taller than the tallest starter last season.
- ▶ Three bring power conference experience (Frank (TCU/Vandy), EVDH (Ole Miss), Gudmundsson (Penn State)).
- ▶ Gudmundsson, Gregory, and Yaw all have at least two years of eligibility remaining.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- ▶ Campbell got 60 points from its bench in the season opener vs Pfeiffer. Bragi Gudmundsson led all players with 15 points and six rebounds in just 17 min of action.
- ▶ Five players came off the bench to score at least seven points. Bench players accounted for all three of Campbell's made threes on the night, though Campbell largely lived at the rim.

SEASON OPENERS

- ▶ Campbell has won its last 19 home openers, including all 17 since Gore Arena opened for the 2008-09 season.
- ▶ CU Stands 29-19 in season openers since joining NCAA D1 in 1977
- ▶ Last five season openers:
 - Nov. 4, 2024 vs Pfeiffer (96-49)
 - Nov. 6, 2023 vs Navy (59-48)
 - Nov. 7, 2022 vs St. Augustine's (79-62)
 - Nov. 9, 2021 vs William Peace (85-50)
 - Nov. 30, 2020 vs St. Andrews (85-51)

- ▶ CU has won 16 of its last 19 season openers, with all three losses coming at "Power Four" opponents: 2010 at No. 21 VT (70-60), 2016 at Oklahoma St. (102-65), 2017 at Penn State (86-75)

PLAYING THE LONG GAME

- ▶ Campbell is 7-3 in games that reach 20T or longer (D1 era).
- ▶ 8 of those 10 games have come at home.
- ▶ Last five 20T (or longer) games.
 - Feb. 26, 2024 - W, 105-100 vs UNCW
 - Feb. 11, 2023 - L, 73-77 at GWU
 - Mar. 2, 2022 - W, 75-72 vs PC (BSC quarters)
 - Jan. 5, 2013 - W, 93-81 vs GWU (3OT)
 - Feb. 12, 2003 - W, 91-90 vs Lipscomb

FORCING TURNOVERS

- ▶ Campbell was fourth in the CAA in forced turnovers (11.8) in '23-'24
- ▶ CU forced 10+ turnovers 22 times, and twice forced 20+ (Hampton and Pfeiffer)
- ▶ The Camels forced 23 turnovers in the opener against Pfeiffer, the most since Jan. 2020, when UNCA committed 25 turnovers.

SUCCESS AT THE STRIPE

- ▶ Campbell went 29-36 at the stripe in the season opener, the sixth-most made threes in the nation on opening night.
- ▶ 29 made FTs are the most since Jan. 6, 2018 against Winthrop.
- ▶ FTs were a high point for Campbell last season, making 94 more FTs than opponents on a better percentage as well.

A NEW ERA IN THE CAA

- ▶ Campbell is now in its second season in the CAA
- ▶ The Camels were members of the Big South Conference for 12 years. Campbell went 95-112 in league play during that span.
- ▶ Campbell's conference history:
 - 1984-94 - Big South (charter member)
 - 1994-11 - ASUN
 - 2011-2023 - Big South
 - 2023-pres. - CAA

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

- ▶ Campbell's roster features players from five different countries (including the US) on this year's roster..
- ▶ This year's squad features players from the United States, England, Guyana, Iceland, and Lithuania.
- ▶ Campbell has had at least one international player every season since 2000-01 with only one exception (2014-15). 24 international players have suited up in the Orange and Black since 2000. Those 22 players come from 17 different countries with Lithuania and England have been the most common (3 each).

FROM DOWNTOWN

- ▶ Campbell has made at least one three-pointer in 367 consecutive games (since Dec. 4, 2012), a new program record. The new mark was set on Feb. 26 against UNCW.
- ▶ The previous program record was 363 straight (Dec. 27, 1996- Dec. 14, 2009).
- ▶ CU teammates Chris Clemons (10-14) and Marcus Burk (10-16) become the first teammates in D1 history to both knock down 10 threes in a game in a 94-85 win at Liberty on Jan. 23, 2018.

AT HOME IN GORE ARENA

- ▶ Campbell stands at 156-85 all-time at Gore Arena, which has served as Campbell's home since 2008 (8-6 in 2022-23).
- ▶ 3,095 seat Gore Arena has twice hosted the Big South Championship (2016, 2019)
- ▶ A record 3,351 fans packed the building on Mar. 2, 2019 for the regular season finale when Campbell defeated Radford 64-62 to claim the Big South crown.
- ▶ Chris Clemons owns the top five scoring performances in Gore Arena history going for 48, 44, 39, 39, and 37 at home.
- ▶ Gore Arena opened in fall of 2008 to replace 947-seat Carter Gym, which was home to Campbell hoops from 1953-2008. Carter, still home to CU intramurals, was the second-smallest capacity building in NCAA D1 at the time of the move to Gore.

MILLBROOK PIPELINE

- ▶ Coach McGehean has found success recruiting out of Millbrook HS in Raleigh, and has three players on this year's roster from there: Nolan Dorsey, Jacob Lawton, Eric Van Der Heijden
- ▶ Former CU standouts Chris Clemons and Jordan Whitfield are both Millbrook products as well.
- ▶ Clemons is the CU all-time leading scorer and fourth in NCAA D1 history (3,225 points)
- ▶ Jordan Whitfield is CU all-time games played leader (137 games)
- ▶ EVDH helped Millbrook to the 2021 North Carolina 4A State Title and was named championship game MVP.

PROHUMPS

- ▶ Campbell has 12 former players playing overseas.
- ▶ Chris Clemons resigned this offseason with SLUC Nancy Basket in the top French league.
- ▶ Milos Stajcic plays for Vojvodina NS in the top league in Serbia.
- ▶ Cedric Henderson Jr. Plays for PAOK in the top league in Greece.
- ▶ Eric Griffin plays for Hapoel in the top league in Israel.
- ▶ Others playing overseas: Alex Kotov (Russia), Jonathan Rodriguez (Puerto Rico), Jordan Whitfield (Cyprus), Ricky Clemons (England)

- ▶ The CAA Championship will be Mar. 7-11 at the Entertainment and Sports arena in Washington, D.C.
- ▶ The early rounds are broadcast on FloCollege, with the semifinals and championship on CBS Sports Network.
- ▶ The Camels lost their first game to Monmouth, 90-67, at last year's tournament.

Founded in 1887 as Buies Creek Academy, Campbell is a private, Christian liberal arts university located in the North Carolina Sandhills region between Raleigh and Fayetteville. Campbell operated as a junior college from 1926-61 before reaching senior college status in 1961 and university status in 1979. The University now includes College of Arts and Sciences, College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences, Divinity School, School of Education, Lundy-Fetterman School of Business, School of Engineering, Jerry M. Wallace Osteopathic Medicine, Catherine W. Wood School of Nursing, Wiggins School of Law. Campbell also maintains a degree program at the Tunku Abdul Rahman College in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

Former head coach Fred McCall and Wake Forest coach Bones McKinney founded the Campbell Basketball School in 1956 becoming the nation's oldest and largest summer basketball camp in continuous operation. The school has included guest coaches and instructors like John Wooden, Press and Pete Maravich, Michael Jordan, and five others on the NBA's all-time Top 50 list. The school grew to over 2,000 kids in a three-week period in gymnasiums throughout Harnett County.

A member of the Coastal Athletic Association since July 1, 2023, Campbell joined NCAA D1 as an independent in men's sports in the fall of 1977, and became a charter member of the Big South conference in 1983. Campbell moved to the ASUN in 1994 before rejoining the Big South in 2011. In 39 years as a D1 member, Campbell has won 114 conference titles, including 52 Big South Championships from 2011-23. Men's basketball claimed the 1992 Big South title to reach the NCAA tournament, and the women reached the NCAA tournament for the first time in 2000.

Campbell's Notable Alumni include the NCAA's fourth-leading scorer Chris Clemons, former Charlotte Hornets President and COO Fred Whitfield, MLB Players Jim and Gaylord Perry, Los Angeles Angels Shortstop Zach Neto, Baltimore Orioles centerfielder Cedric Mullins, Arizona Diamondbacks reliever Ryan Thompson, Atlanta Braves pitcher Allan Winans

Campbell unveiled a new visual identity on July 1, 2023 including new logos and wordmarks, a simplified color palette, and officially typography fonts. The evolution of Campbell Athletics reflects the strength and resiliency of the Fighting Camel, while honoring both the past and present. The new primary mark streamlines the Fighting Camel with an even stronger, bolder stance, allowing for improved functionality in application, while giving Campbell student athletes, coaches, staff, and fans alike a championship caliber look to match its program's achievements in competition.

The Chris Clemons Era

- Chris Clemons wrapped up his career at #3 on the NCAA all-time leading scoring list with 3,225 points (now fourth place).
- Clemons averaged 24.8 ppg during his four years in The Creek, and was a third team all-American in 2019.
- He led the nation in scoring in 2018-19, pouring in 30.1 ppg.
- He posted a career-high 51 in the Big South tournament against UNC Asheville on Mar. 2, 2017, and eclipsed 40 points five times.
- He did all this standing at just 5'9"
- His #3 has been permanently retired at Campbell.



Kevin McGeehan

12th season
Gettysburg, '95

Kevin McGeehan embarks on his 12th season at the helm as the Camels begin a new era in the CAA in 2023-24. McGeehan was named the seventh head coach in Campbell basketball history on April 11, 2013.

McGeehan has overseen the most successful period in program history. Campbell won 121 games from 2016-2023, a program record for a seven-year span. During that run, the Camels also claimed four Big South trophies. Campbell won the 2019

Big South regular season, and finished tournament runner-up in 2017, 2021, and 2023.

McGeehan was named the 2019 Big South Coach of the Year after guiding Campbell to the Big South regular season title. The Camels posed a 20-13, 12-4 mark that season to capture their first league title since 2010. Campbell made a third straight postseason appearance by earning a trip to the NIT for the first time in program history. The Camels took care of the rock that season, ranking among the top 20 in the nation in fewest turnovers and assist to turnover ratio.

His tenure presided over "the Chris Clemons Years," when Raleigh native Chris Clemons scored 3,225 career points. That mark was good for third in NCAA history when Clemons played his final game (now fourth all-time). Clemons averaged 24.8 ppg from 2015-2019, including averaging a national best 30.1 ppg as a senior in 2018-19. Clemons signed a FA deal with the Houston Rockets and made his NBA debut on Nov. 3, 2019, becoming the first Camel to appear in an NBA game since 1968.

McGeehan has coached 11 different players to all-conference honors. Clemons was the 2019 Big South Player of the Year and a first-team player. Chris Clemons, Ricky Clemons, Anthony Dell'Orso, Andrew Eudy, Cedric Henderson Jr., and Jordan Whitfield have all been all-conference second-team players under McGeehan. Marucs Burk and Henderson Jr., were each all-conference honorable mention. Chris Clemons and Anthony Dell'Orso were both named Freshmen of the Year, with Curtis Phillips also getting an all-freshmen team nod.
