LEADING OFF

- •The Cavaliers are coming into the Party At Palmer Invitational on a six-game winning streak after taking all five games last weekend and dating back to a 7-6 walk-off win over No. 4 UCLA at the Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational
- Entering the week, the Cavaliers had played the toughest schedule in the nation among Division I softball teams with opponents posting a combined .741 win percentage (120-42)
- ·Virginia has played 7-of-15 games against teams currently ranked in the NFCA Coaches poll
- •The Cavaliers entered the top 25 of the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll at No. 25 this week
- Last weekend was a power outing for the Hoos as Virginia tallied nine home runs on the weekend from four different players Hylton (3), Bella Cabral (3), MC Eaton (2) and Kelsey Hackett (1). Hackett's home run was the first of her career.
- Eden Bigham's save against Delaware (2/22) was her fourth of the season and ninth of her career. She is one save away from tying the program record for career saves (10) set last season by Madi Harris.
- Bigham is also climbing the career charts in strikeouts, tallying 321 for her career which places her 10th all-time and she is six strikeouts away from ninth all-time at UVA
- Macee Eaton and MC Eaton have been poweful for the Hoos at the four and five spot in the lineup with the duo combining for 10 multiple-RBI games this season and 28 RBI
- · Jade Hylton enters the weekend with an active hit streak of seven straight games and she has reached base in nine consecutive games

- Paced the Hoos at the plate last weekend, hitting .571 with three home runs, two triples and a double in her eight hits

- · Hylton moved into eighth all-time at Virginia in home runs with 27 for her career

THE SERIES WITH SETON HALL

- ·Virginia and Seton Hall have faced off six times with the Pirates holding a 4-2 lead in the all-time series
- \cdot The teams last met in the 2018 season with the Hoos falling in a 9-7 battle in a tournament at UNC Greensboro

THE SERIES WITH HOFSTRA

- · Virginia and Hofstra have played each other 12 times with the Hoos holding a 9-3 lead in the series
- •The teams last met in the 2023 season at Palmer Park with the Hoos taking a pair of wins in the midweek doubleheader
- · Sarah Coon hit a home run and Eden Bigham struck out nine in a 2-0 shutout of game one in that doublheader

BIGHAM CLOSING IN ON SAVES RECORD

- · Junior right-hander Eden Bigham has been a force in the circle in any role for the Cavaliers
- $\cdot \text{This}$ season, Bigham has four saves entering the weekend and nine for her career
- •The nine career saves is one shy of tying the career mark (10) set by Madi Harris last season
- \cdot Her four saves this season is also two shy of the single-season record (6) also set by Harris in the 2022 sesason

HYLTON KEEPS IT IN THE PARK A SECOND TIME

- · Junior Jade Hylton opened up the Penn game on February 23 with a bang, hitting an inside-the-park home run to right field
- \cdot It was her second inside-the-park home run in as many season as she also hit one last season against St. Thomas (2/18/24)

CABRAL, HYLTON EACH GO YARD TWICE IN A GAME

- · Bella Cabral and Jade Hylton each have a multiple home run game this season though not in the same game
- \cdot Cabral tallied two home runs against Delaware (2/23) for her second career game with two home runs
- \cdot Hylton tallied a pair of home runs as part of a three-hit game in the win over Longwood (2/24) for her second multiple home run game of her career

HACKETT'S FIRST HOME RUN IS A WALK OFF

- \cdot Kelsey Hackett delivered her first career home run in the win over Longwood (2/24)
- The junior entered as a pitch hitter and sent the first pitch offered into the bullpen in left field for the walk-off victory

LAYNE TOSSES FIRST COMPLETE GAME

- · Junior Courtney Layne threw her first complete game in a 12-0 win over Saint Francis in the opening weekend
- •The left-hander struck out a career-high seven batters in that run-rule victory and held the Red Flash to only two hits in the outing
- \cdot Layne enters the weekend having allowed only two hits in each of her last two outings

MACEE EATON NOTCHES HOOS' FIRST HR OF SEASON

- \cdot Sophomore 1B Macee Eaton turned in the first home run of the season for the Hoos against South Carolina (2/7)
- •That shot, a three-run home run, tied her career high in RBI to match the mark of 3RBI set against #24 Miami (OH) in the NCAA Regional opener last season

THE EATONS (NO RELATION) MAKE FOR DYNAMIC DUO

- · Macee and MC Eaton (no relation) proved to be a potent duo in the lineup early this season
- The pair have been hitting in the four through six positions in the lineup through the first give games
- · The duo combined for nine RBI, seven hits and seven runs scored in the opening weekend of play

PAIR OF FRESHMEN NOTCH FIRST HITS FOR HOOS

- \cdot Freshmen Alex Call and Maddy Greene each notched their first collegiate hits in the opening weekend
- · Both came against Saint Francis in the weekend finale
- · Call delivered an RBI single, while Greene also delivered a single for her first career hit

COON TRANSITIONS TO MORE TIME BEHIND PLATE

- \cdot After spending most of her time playing a corner infield position or DH through her first three seasons, senior Sarah Coon is expected to transition to more time behind the plate in 2025
- \cdot Coon played three games at catcher in the opening weekend and led the team at the plate with a .357 average on the weekend
- \cdot She also posted a .471 on base percentage with three walks to go along with the five hits

HOOS GARNER ATTENTION IN PRESEASON

- · Virginia came in at No. 24 in the Softball America preseason poll to mark the first time that the Cavaliers enter a season ranked in one of the polls
- •The Cavaliers are receiving votes in the remainder of the polls D1Softball, NFCA and USASoftball

BIGHAM, HYLTON GRACE PRESEASON TOP 100 LISTS

- · Juniors Eden Bigham and Jade Hylton have been mainstays on preseaon top 100 lists this season
- \cdot Bigham was named the No. 39 player by D1Softball and the No. 41 player by Softball America
- \cdot Hylton was tabbed the No. 52 players by Softball America and No. 53 by D1Softball

CAVALIER DUO NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- · The duo of Bigham and Hylton were also named to the preseason All-ACC team by the league's coaches
- The pair, who finished the 2024 season as first-team All-ACC selections, continued to hold a prominent place in the league heading into 2025

VIRGINIA PICKED TO FINISH FIFTH IN ACC

- ·Virginia was picked to finish fifth in the ACC in that same vote of the league's coaches after finishing fourth in the league a year ago
- \cdot It's the highest predicted finish for the Hoos under head coach Joanna Hardin who has built the program of the previous eight seasons at the helm

BIGHAM MOVING UP CAREER PITCHING CHARTS

- Eden Bigham is quickly moving up the career pitching charts and has taken spots in the top 10 of two categories as her third season begins
- · Heading into the weekend, Bigham sits 10th all-time in career strikeouts (321) and is seventh all-time at UVA in career shutouts (12)
- · Bigham is also second in career saves with nine to date

HYLTON ALSO TAKING SPOTS AMONG CAREER LEADERS

· Shortstop Jade Hylton is also making a move on some of the career lists for offense and currently is tied for ninth in career home runs (24)

AYER A THREAT TO STEAL ON THE BASES

- · Senior outfielder Kelly Ayer has been a mainstay in the offense and poses a threat to steal whenever she's on the bases
- \cdot Ayer has 34 stolen bases to date and is five away from finding herself among the top 10 base stealers in program history.
- \cdot Last season, the offense didn't really on the steal as much, though Ayer went 8-for-8 in swipe attempts
- ·The previous season, Ayer took 22 bags on 23 attempts

HOOS WELCOME FIVE NEWCOMERS FOR 2025

- · Virginia welcomed five newcomers to Grounds for this season in a class that ranked No. 33 nationally
- •The class features four players ranked among the top 26 recruits nationally at their position and three among the top 100 players overall by ExtraInningSoftball
- \cdot Madison Greene was ranked the No. 34 overall recruit and the fifth-ranked third baseman
- \cdot Ava Hodges was the No. 38 overall recruit and was the No. 26 pitcher in the class.
- \cdot Reagan Hickey was ranked No. 45 overall and the No. 24 catcher
- · Alex Call was tabbed the No. 12 general infielder in the class, while Addison Thompson was a three-time All-Region selection in Virginia

HENLEY EXPECTED TO BOOST HOOS IN RETURN

- \cdot The Cavaliers got good news with the return of LHP Savanah Henley for the season

CAVALIERS PLAYED STOUT SCHEDULE IN 2024

- · Virginia played a stout schedule for the 2024 campaign with the No. 22 strength of schedule overall
- The Hoos played 17 games against teams in the NCAA Tournament with 11 of those outside of ACC play and 11 on the road with one at a neutral site as the Hoos faced Clemson in the ACC quarterfinals hosted by Duke
- · Virginia went 7-10 in those games against NCAA Tournament teams during the regular season
- · Included in those games against the NCAA field were two contests at national seeds Alabama (No. 14 seed) and the series at national seed Duke (No. 10 seed)

HOOS SET PROGRAM HIGH WITH 15 ACC WINS

- · With the series win at Georgia Tech to close the regular season, the Hoos set a program record for ACC wins (15)
- •The previous program record was 13 wins set in the 2010 season and matched in the 2022 season
- ·Virginia matched the 13-win mark for the third time with the series-clinching win at No. 3 Duke in the finale
- •The Hoos passed the mark with a Saturday win at Georgia Tech and hit the 15-win mark in the finale to clinch the series with the Yellow Jackets

THREE WAS THE CHARM FOR VIRGINIA OFFENSE

- · With the Virginia pitching staff, three runs has been the magic number for the Cavaliers when it comes to winning games this season
- · In 2024, the Hoos were 29-3 when scoring three runs or more
- •The three times Virginia dropped a game when scoring at least three runs were the Saturday game at Notre Dame (10-3), the Saturday game against NC State (10-9) and the series opener at Georgia Tech (6-5)

HOOS HIT 30-WIN MARK FOR SECOND STRAIGHT YEAR

- · With the series-clinching win over No. 3 Duke, the Cavaliers hit the 30-win mark for the second straight season
- •The Cavaliers hit 30 wins last year for the first time since the 2010 campaign
- This is the first time the Hoos have done consecutive 30-win seasons since UVA posted at least 30 wins each season from 2001-2005

BIGHAM OPENS 2024 WITH 11 K VS. UNCG

- · Eden Bigham set a new career high for strikeouts in the season opener when the freshman fanned 11 batters through her 5.0 innings of work
- \cdot Bigham retired 12 of the first 13 batters faced with nine strikeouts across those batters faced

BIGHAM FANS 14 MOUNTAIN HAWKS FOR CAREER HIGH

- · Eden Bigham set a career mark of 14 strikeouts in her start against Lehigh (2/23) to open the Rawlings Classic
- · She struck out the first 12 batters of the game and finished with the 14 strikeouts on 16 batters faced in the five inning victory
- The 14 strikeouts is the most by a UVA pitcher since Melanie Mitchell's 16 strikeout performance against George Washington (3/20/13)

BIGHAM NAMED WEEK 3 ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Eden Bigham was named ACC Pitcher of the Week (2/27) after striking out 23 batters in 11.0 innings of work
- · She picked up wins over Lehigh and Iowa State on the week to help the Hoos to an undefeated weekend
- \cdot She struck out 14 in her start against Lehigh before fanning nine batters in 6.0 relief innings against the Cyclones

CAVALIERS TAKE SERIES FROM NO. 11 CLEMSON

- •The Hoos made another step forward with a series win over No. 11 Clemson by taking the Friday and Sunday games of the series
- •The Friday night win over the Tigers was the first win over Clemson in program history by the Cavaliers
- · Clemson was the final league team the Hoos didn't have a tally in the win column against in program history and they added that mark in emphatic fashion this season
- •The Sunday win, a 3-0 victory, marked the first time this season a team held Clemson off the scoreboard

HOOS TAKE FIRST SERIES FROM SYRACUSE

- The Cavaliers accomplished another first under head coach Joanna Hardin last weekend with a series win over the Syracuse Orange
- · Virginia won games two and three of the series to grab the series win - the first ever over the Orange

VIRGINIA SHOCKS NO. 3 DUKE WITH DH SWEEP

- · Virginia delieverd one of the biggest series wins in program history this past weekend at No. 3 Duke
- After dropping the opener 1-0 in 12 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers came back and swept a Saturday doubleheader Virginia won game one of the doubleheader 4-3 thanks to a Jade Hylton grand slam before taking game two of the doubleheader 3-2
- · Hylton hit a two-run shot in that series clinching win
- · It was a gritty outing from the Hoos played three complete games spanning 25.1 innings in less than 24 hours from first pitch to final out

CAVALIERS CLAIM PROGRAM BEST SEVEN ACC SERIES

- Virginia won seven of the eight ACC series played this season to mark the first time in program history the Hoos have won seven ACC series in a season
- The 2010 season was the last time the Hoos won five ACC series with four of them a traditional three-game series and one being a doubleheader with Maryland
- The Hoos swept the twin bill with the Terps that season and also won the series with No. 22 UNC and NC State, while sweeping Virginia Tech and Boston College that year This season, the Hoos postd series wins over Boston
- College, Syracuse, No. 11 Clemson, Notre Dame, NC State, No. 3 Duke and Georgia Tech

HOOS COME THROUGH WITH BACKS AGAINST WALL

- Virginia went to the rubber match in all eight ACC series last season and came through in game three in seven weekends to claim the series
- · Against BC, Syracuse, No. 3 Duke and Georgia Tech the Cavaliers dropped game one and then won the next two games to claim the series
- Against No. 11 Clemson, Notre Dame and NC State, the Cavaliers won game one and then took game three to lock up the weekend
- •The lone series loss was at UNC when the Cavaliers took game one and then dropped a Sunday doubleheader after Saturday's game was rained out

BIGHAM EARNS ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK AGAIN

- · Sophomore right-hander Eden Bigham earned her second ACC Pitcher of the Week honor on Tuesday (4/16)
- · She went 2-0 in the series against NC State with a complete-game shutout in game one and worked a second complete-game in the finale to clinch the series
- · Bigham struck out 15 across the two games
- · It marked Bigham's third complete-game shutout in ACC play and her fourth complete game against an ACC foe this season

BIGHAM EARNS 3RD ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Eden Bigham took home her third ACC Pitcher of the Week honor on Tuesday to earn the honor for the second straight week and third time this season
- Bigham threw 9.0 innings of shutout softball in the series opener at No. 3 Duke with nine strikeouts in the 12.0 inning affair
- ·She then came back in game two of the series to earn the save her third of the season as she worked the seventh and got out of a bases-loaded jam

PALMER PARK

- Virginia opened its new stadium, Palmer Park, on March 3, 2020 against JMU. Palmer Park is named after former Cavalier pitcher Lisa Palmer and her mother Fran. The Palmers were the lead contributors to the stadium project.
- The Cavaliers hosted a dedication ceremony for Palmer Park prior to Virginia's matchup against Virginia Tech on Friday, March 6, 2020.
- Palmer Park is a state-of-the-art facility which houses all of the Cavaliers' needs. Within the confines of Palmer Park is the team locker room and lounge, athletic training room, meeting rooms and a brand new indoor facility.
- Lisa Palmer pitched for the Cavaliers from 1986-89, establishing school records in wins (74), innings pitched (861.2), complete games (102) and games started (112). She still holds the UVA single-season records for wins (27), shutouts (14) and assists (221).
- The 2022 season was the first time it will be open to the full public for a full season.


