Team Notes

- The Cavaliers improved to 12-12 overall, 5-8 ACC
- UVA is 9-5 at home, including a 3-4 mark in ACC contests
- UVA shot 49.2 percent from the field and 40.7 percent from 3-point range (11 of 27)
- UVA led 41-36 at halftime
- UVA started 3 of 3 from 3-point range and led 9-0
- Georgia Tech answered with an 8-0 run
- UVA (11 3-pointers) has made six or more 3-pointers in 22 games
- Virginia is 175-12 all-time when scoring 70 or more points since 2009-10 (7-1 in 2024-25)
- UVA won the rebound battle 38-24, improving to 9-1 when outrebounding its opponent

Series Notes

- Virginia is 50-40 all-time vs. Georgia Tech, including a 28-11 mark in Charlottesville, in a series that dates to 1947-48.
- The Cavaliers have a 13-game win streak in the series and 11-game home win streak against the Yellow Jackets
- Virginia is 21-2 in its last 23 games against Georgia Tech

Player Notes

- Double Figure Scorers: Isaac McKneely (20), Dai Dai Ames (18), Andrew Rohde (11)
- McKneely netted his fifth 20-point game (10 career)
- McKneely reached double figures for the 18th time (44 career)
- McKneely has made multiple 3-pointers in 17 games
- Ames reached double figures for the third consecutive game and seventh time this season (15 career)
- Rohde matched a career high with nine assists along with zero turnovers
- Rohde has 25 assists and zero turnovers in his last three games
- Rohde reached double figures for the sixth time (14 career)
- Blake Buchanan had a game-high 11 rebounds
- Elijah Saunders returned to the lineup after missing three games due to injury
