

Virginia 73, Virginia Tech 70

Team Notes

- The Cavaliers improved to 13-12 overall, 6-8 ACC
- Virginia earned a half point with the win in the Smithfield Commonwealth Clash, but the Cavaliers lead this year's Clash 6.0-3-0
- UVA is 4-7 away from home, including a 3-5 mark in ACC road games
- UVA has a three-game road win streak (Miami, Pitt, Virginia Tech)
- UVA shot 55.6 percent and made 7 of 15 3-pointers en route to a 40-33 halftime lead
- Virginia went on a 12-1 run to gain a 17-8 lead
- UVA (11 3-pointers) has made six or more 3-pointers in 23 games
- Virginia is 176-12 all-time when scoring 70 or more points since 2009-10 (8-1 in 2024-25)
- UVA won the rebound battle 30-28, improving to 10-1 when outrebounding its opponent

Series Notes

- UVA ended its four-game losing streak against the Hokies at Cassell Coliseum, winning for the first time since Feb. 26, 2020 (56-53)
- Virginia is 99-61 all-time vs. Virginia Tech, including a 24-34 mark in Blacksburg, in a series that dates to 1914-15
- Virginia Tech defeated Virginia 75-74 on Feb. 1
- Virginia's 73 points were its most against the Hokies at Cassell Coliseum since posting a 78-52 win on Jan. 3, 2018

Player Notes

- Double Figure Scorers: Isaac McKneely (22), Anthony Robinson (15), Dai Dai Ames (11)
- McKneely netted his sixth 20-point game (11 career)
- McKneely matched a career high with six 3-pointers
- McKneely reached double figures for the 19th time (45 career)
- McKneely (6 3-pointers) has made multiple 3-pointers in 18 games
- Ames reached double figures for the fourth consecutive game and eighth time this season (16 career)
- Robinson had career highs in points (15) and rebounds (7)
- Robinson reached double figures for the first time
- Robinson matched a career highs with two blocks
- Andrew Rohde registered his third straight game with nine assists
- Rohde's assist streak without a turnover ended at 34
- Rohde has 34 assists and two turnovers in his last four games
