LEADING OFF

- UVA is on a six game winning streak dating back to a 9-2 win at No. 17 Virginia Tech in the series finale (3/9) and has won 18 of its last 20 games heading into the weekend series with Cal
- The Cavaliers have 36 home runs this season already, matching last year's season total, and have hit multiple home runs in 11 games this season
- Virginia has scored in the first inning of 18-of-29 games this season and has scored three or more runs in the first inning eight times
- The Cavaliers score in bunches with 29 innings in which Virginia has scored 3 or more runs seven of those times coming in the first inning
- Virginia is outscoring opponents 111-32 through the first three innings this season
- The Virginia offense ranks second nationally in triples and in the top 25 nationally in doubles and home runs - the Hoos have 19 triples and 48 doubles on the season to go along with 36 home runs
- Sophomore 3B Bella Cabral leads the Hoos at the plate with a .402 batting average, .732 slug and .454 on base percentage
- Sophomore 1B Macee Eaton leads the Hoos with eight home runs and 38 RBI after hitting one in each game against Boston College and holds a 16-game hit streak entering the weekend
- Jade Hylton is moving up the career charts at UVA and ranks fourth all-time at UVA in home runs (31) and ninth in steals (44) and also ranks in the top 10in multiple-hit games multiple-RBI games

- · Eaton led the Hoos at the plate last week, hitting at a .500 clip with three home runs and five RBI
- ·The sophomore homered in all three games against BC and leads the team with eight home runs and 38 RBI this season
- · Eaton enters the weekend series against Cal on a 16-game hit streak with double vs. GMU
- •The sophomore drove in the go-ahead runs in Friday's 3-1 win over BC and then gave UVA a lead back in the fourth with a HR

THE SERIES WITH CALIFORNIA

- · Virginia and Cal have faced each other five times in the history of the series with the Golden Bears holding a 5-0 lead in the series
- \cdot All five meetings have come in neutral site tournaments with the last coming in the 2004 season at the Capital Classic in Sacramento
- ·This is the first meeting not in California or Las Vegas

CAVALIERS BREAKING INTO NATIONAL RANKINGS

- \cdot Off to the 16-5 start, the Cavaliers started breaking into the top 25 of multiple polls after four weekends and came in at 23 in three of the four national polls
- · Virginia is receiving votes in three polls following the weekend series against Boston College and is ranked no. 23 in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll this week

HOOS IN THE NCAA STATISTICAL RANKINGS

- \cdot Bella Cabral has been solid at the hot corner, ranking second the ACC in assists and ranks 30th nationally (66)
- · Jade Hylton ranks third in the ACC with 61 assists and is 53rd nationally
- \cdot Macee Eaton ranks 15th nationally in RBI (38) as she paces the Hoos ands ranks third in the ACC
- Offensively, the Hoos have made a living with extra-base hits and UVA ranks second nationally in triples (19) and 24th nationally in doubles (47)
- \cdot Jade Hylton and Kailyn Jones rank sixth nationally in triples (5) and second in the ACC

HARDIN NOW SECOND AT UVA, APPROACHES 200 WINS

- · Virginia head coach Joanna Hardin moved into second all-time in wins at UVA in the fourth weekend of play
- \cdot With the Hoos' win over Seton Hall on Friday night, Hardin picked up her 185th win at Virginia to pass Terry DeTuro for second most wins at UVA
- \cdot Hardin has 195 wins as Virginia head coach entering the weekend against Cal

CABRAL, HYLTON ON SOFTBALLAMERICA'S MIDSEASON POWER RANKINGS

- · Sophomore third baseman Bella Cabral and junior shortstop Jade Hylton both appearaned on Softball America's midseason power rankings
- · Cabral came in as the No. 10 third baseman nationally, while Hylton came in as the No. 8 shortstop

HOOS SCORING EARLY AND OFTEN

- · Virginia has been scoring early and often this season with big innings and lots of runs early in games
- •The Cavaliers have scored in the first inning of 18 games this season and seven of those have seen the Hoos score three or more runs
- · Scoring has been contagious as the Hoos often aren't scoring just one run in an inning and in fact 29 scoring innings this season have put three or more runs across
- •The Hoos are also outscoring opponents 101-31 through the first three innings of games this season

HOOS SCORE PROGRAM-HIGH 13 RUNS VS. PIRATES

- · Virginia pushed 13 runs across the plate in the third inning against Seton Hall (3/1)
- \cdot The 13 runs scored in a single inning was the most in program history and was the second time in program history the Hoos pushed more than 10 runs across in an inning
- The first time the Hoos scored 10 runs in an inning was last season at Georgia Tech (4/27) with an 11 run inning in a run-rule victory over the Yellow Jackets

HENLEY COMING ON STRONG IN FIFTH SEASON

- \cdot Savanah Henley has been surging for the Hoos this season after missing a bulk of 2024 due to injury
- \cdot The grad student showed her stuff against No. 5 Texas A&M as she threw an eight-inning complete game and struck out nine batters her high as a Cavalier
- · Henley matched that nine strikeouts in her outing against Longwood, fanning nine batters through five innings of work
- \cdot She has struck out 56 batters entering the weekend in 54.1 innings of work

CAVALIERS CHALLENGED EARLY WITH TOP FOES

- · Virginia was challenged early in the season with a schedule featuring some of the top teams in the nation
- · After three weeks of play, Vrginia's schedule was rated as the toughest schedule in the nation
- · Virginia played two games at South Carolina in the opening weekend dropping a pair of one-run games in walkoff fashion to a team currently ranked in the top 11 · Virginia also faced No. 4 UCLA No. 5 Texas A&M and No.
- 4 UCLA in the Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational
- taking wins over the Wildcats and Bruins

 All five opponents faced at the Cleanwater
- · All five opponents faced at the Clearwater Tournament were ranked in the top 25 following the tournament

BIGHAM CLOSING IN ON SAVES RECORD

- · Junior right-hander Eden Bigham has been a force in the circle in any role for the Cavaliers
- ·This season, Bigham has four saves entering the weekend and nine for her career
- •The nine career saves is one shy of tying the career mark (10) set by Madi Harris last season
- \cdot Her four saves this season is also two shy of the single-season record (6) also set by Harris in the 2022 sesason

HYLTON KEEPS IT IN THE PARK A SECOND TIME

- · Junior Jade Hylton opened up the Penn game on February 23 with a bang, hitting an inside-the-park home run to right field
- \cdot It was her second inside-the-park home run in as many season as she also hit one last season against St. Thomas (2/18/24)

- · Bella Cabral and Jade Hylton each have a multiple home run game this season though not in the same game
- \cdot Cabral tallied two home runs against Delaware (2/23) for her second career game with two home runs
- \cdot Hylton tallied a pair of home runs as part of a three-hit game in the win over Longwood (2/24) for her second multiple home run game of her career
- · Hylton did it again against Boston College in the series finale (3/15) when she homered to leadoff the first for the Hoos and went yard again in the fifth inning

HACKETT'S FIRST HOME RUN IS A WALK OFF

- · Kelsey Hackett delivered her first career home run in the win over Longwood (2/24)
- The junior entered as a pitch hitter and sent the first pitch offered into the bullpen in left field for the walk-off victory

LAYNE TOSSES FIRST COMPLETE GAME

- · Junior Courtney Layne threw her first complete game in a 12-0 win over Saint Francis in the opening weekend
- •The left-hander struck out a career-high seven batters in that run-rule victory and held the Red Flash to only two hits in the outing

MACEE EATON NOTCHES HOOS' FIRST HR OF SEASON

- · Virginia played a stout schedule for the 2024 campaign with the No. 22 strength of schedule overall
- The Hoos played 17 games against teams in the NCAA Tournament with 11 of those outside of ACC play and 11 on the road with one at a neutral site as the Hoos faced Clemson in the ACC quarterfinals hosted by Duke
- · Virginia went 7-10 in those games against NCAA Tournament teams during the regular season
- · Included in those games against the NCAA field were two contests at national seeds Alabama (No. 14 seed) and the series at national seed Duke (No. 10 seed)

HOOS SET PROGRAM HIGH WITH 15 ACC WINS

- · With the series win at Georgia Tech to close the regular season, the Hoos set a program record for ACC wins (15)

- \cdot The 14 strikeouts is the most by a UVA pitcher since Melanie Mitchell's 16 strikeout performance against George Washington (3/20/13)

- Eden Bigham was named ACC Pitcher of the Week (2/27) after striking out 23 batters in 11.0 innings of work
- \cdot She picked up wins over Lehigh and Iowa State on the week to help the Hoos to an undefeated weekend
- · She struck out 14 in her start against Lehigh before fanning nine batters in 6.0 relief innings against the Cyclones

CAVALIERS TAKE SERIES FROM NO. 11 CLEMSON

- •The Hoos made another step forward with a series win over No. 11 Clemson by taking the Friday and Sunday games of the series
- •The Friday night win over the Tigers was the first win over Clemson in program history by the Cavaliers
- · Clemson was the final league team the Hoos didn't have a tally in the win column against in program history and they added that mark in emphatic fashion this season
- •The Sunday win, a 3-0 victory, marked the first time this season a team held Clemson off the scoreboard

HOOS TAKE FIRST SERIES FROM SYRACUSE

- The Cavaliers accomplished another first under head coach Joanna Hardin last weekend with a series win over the Syracuse Orange
- \cdot Virginia won games two and three of the series to grab the series win the first ever over the Orange

VIRGINIA SHOCKS NO. 3 DUKE WITH DH SWEEP

- · Virginia delieverd one of the biggest series wins in program history this past weekend at No. 3 Duke
- ·After dropping the opener 1-0 in 12 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers came back and swept a Saturday doubleheader ·Virginia won game one of the doubleheader 4-3 thanks to a Jade Hylton grand slam before taking game two of the doubleheader 3-2
- · Hylton hit a two-run shot in that series clinching win
- · It was a gritty outing from the Hoos played three complete games spanning 25.1 innings in less than 24 hours from first pitch to final out

- · Sophomore right-hander Eden Bigham earned her second ACC Pitcher of the Week honor on Tuesday (4/16)
- · She went 2-0 in the series against NC State with a complete-game shutout in game one and worked a second complete-game in the finale to clinch the series
- · Bigham struck out 15 across the two games
- · It marked Bigham's third complete-game shutout in ACC play and her fourth complete game against an ACC foe this season

BIGHAM EARNS 3RD ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- · Eden Bigham took home her third ACC Pitcher of the Week honor on Tuesday to earn the honor for the second straight week and third time this season
- · Bigham threw 9.0 innings of shutout softball in the series opener at No. 3 Duke with nine strikeouts in the 12.0 inning affair
- · She then came back in game two of the series to earn the save her third of the season as she worked the seventh and got out of a bases-loaded jam

PALMER PARK

- Virginia opened its new stadium, Palmer Park, on March 3, 2020 against JMU. Palmer Park is named after former Cavalier pitcher Lisa Palmer and her mother Fran. The Palmers were the lead contributors to the stadium project.
- The Cavaliers hosted a dedication ceremony for Palmer Park prior to Virginia's matchup against Virginia Tech on Friday, March 6, 2020.
- Palmer Park is a state-of-the-art facility which houses all of the Cavaliers' needs. Within the confines of Palmer Park is the team locker room and lounge, athletic training room, meeting rooms and a brand new indoor facility.
- Lisa Palmer pitched for the Cavaliers from 1986-89, establishing school records in wins (74), innings pitched (861.2), complete games (102) and games started (112). She still holds the UVA single-season records for wins (27), shutouts (14) and assists (221).
- The 2022 season was the first time it will be open to the full public for a full season.
