## LEADING OFF

- · Virginia enters the weekend series on a 12-game win streak dating back to a 7-6 win over No. 4 UCLA in the Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational.
- •The win streak is the longest since the 2001 season when Virginia had separate win streaks of 11 games, 12 games and 13 games on the way to 52 wins.
- · Junior RHP Eden Bigham threw a perfect game in her last outing against Hofstra (3/1) for the first perfect game by a Cavalier since Michelle Collins vs. Coastal Carolina (4/8/94).
- · Savanah Henley matched her UVA high in strikeouts with nine in Tuesday's win over
- Longwood, matching a mark set against No. 5 Texas A&M in an 8-inning complete game.
- · Bella Cabral and Jade Hylton were both tabbed by Softball America for the midseason power rankings with Bella (10) and Hylton (8) ranked at third and short, respectively
- Cabral isn't just about offense, however, as she ranks fifth nationally in assists and has the Hoos ranked in the top 50 nationally in double plays turned
- · Eight different Cavaliers have hit home runs this season with five of those hitting multiple home runs so far this season: MC Eaton (5), Jade Hylton (5), Bella Cabral (4), Macee Eaton (4) and Kelsey Hackett (2).
- •The Hoos have been efficient early in games, outscoring opponents 96-20 through the first three innings this season.
- · UVA has also been prone to scoring in bunches with Virginia scoring three or more runs in 26 innings, including a high of 13 runs in the third inning against Seton Hall (3/1).

## NOTING THE HOOS

#### THE SERIES WITH VIRGINIA TECH

- $\cdot$  Virginia and Virginia Tech have faced each other 78 times with the Hokies leading the series 54-24
- •The teams met in a midweek, non-conference matchups last season as the ACC rotation had the teams not face each other in a conference series
- •The Hokies won the last series in Blacksburg, 2-1, in the 2022 season as the Cavaliers won the middle game of the three game set and the finale went to extra innings

### **CAVALIERS BREAKING INTO NATIONAL RANKINGS**

- $\cdot$  Off to the 16-5 start, the Cavaliers have started breaking into the top 25 of multiple polls after four weekends
- · Virginia comes in at No. 23 in three polls this week Softball America, D1Softball and ESP.com/USA Softball
- ·The Hoos are receiving votes in the NFCA Coaches Poll

#### **HOOS IN THE NCAA STATISTICAL RANKINGS**

- $\cdot$  Bella Cabral has been solid at the hot corner, ranking fifth nationally in assists (55) entering the weekend
- $\cdot$  Macee Eaton ranks 20th nationally in RBI (29) as she paces the Hoos heading into ACC play
- Offensively, the Hoos have made a living with extra-base hits and UVA ranks first nationally in triples (19) and sixth nationally in doubles (42)
- · Jade Hylton and Kailyn Jones rank fourth nationally in triples (5) while Sarah Coon ranks 16th (3)

### HARDIN NOW SECOND AT UVA, APPROACHES 200 WINS

- · Virginia head coach Joanna Hardin moved into second all-time in wins at UVA in the fourth weekend of play
- $\cdot$  With the Hoos' win over Seton Hall on Friday night, Hardin picked up her 185th win at Virginia to pass Terry DeTuro for second most wins at UVA
- $\cdot$  Hardin has 189 wins as Virginia head coach entering the weekend at Virginia Tech

## CABRAL, HYLTON ON SOFTBALL AMERICA'S MIDSEASON POWER RANKINGS

- · Sophomore third baseman Bella Cabral and junior shortstop Jade Hylton both appearaned on Softball America's midseason power rankings
- $\cdot$  Cabral came in as the No. 10 third baseman nationally, while Hylton came in as the No. 8 shortstop

#### **HOOS SCORING EARLY AND OFTEN**

- $\cdot$  Virginia has been scoring early and often this season with big innings and lots of runs early in games
- •The Cavaliers have scored in the first inning of 14 games this season and seven of those have seen the Hoos score three or more runs
- · Scoring has been contagious as the Hoos often aren't scoring just one run in an inning and in fact 26 scoring innings this season have put three or more runs across
- $\cdot \text{The Hoos}$  are also outscoring opponents 96-20 through the first three innings of games this season

#### **HOOS SCORE PROGRAM-HIGH 13 RUNS VS. PIRATES**

- · Virginia pushed 13 runs across the plate in the third inning against Seton Hall (3/1)
- $\cdot$  The 13 runs scored in a single inning was the most in program history and was the second time in program history the Hoos pushed more than 10 runs across in an inning
- •The first time the Hoos scored 10 runs in an inning was last season at Georgia Tech (4/27) with an 11 run inning in a run-rule victory over the Yellow Jackets

#### HENLEY COMING ON STRONG IN FIFTH SEASON

- · Savanah Henley has been surging for the Hoos this season after missing a bulk of 2024 due to injury
- The grad student showed her stuff against No. 5 Texas A&M as she threw an eight-inning complete game and struck out nine batters her high as a Cavalier
- $\cdot$  Henley matched that nine strikeouts in her last outing against Longwood, fanning nine batters through five innings of work
- $\cdot$  She has struck out a team-leading 44 batters entering the weekend in 39.2 innings of work

### **CAVALIERS CHALLENGED EARLY WITH TOP FOES**

- · Virginia was challenged early in the season with a schedule featuring some of the top teams in the nation
- · After three weeks of play, Vrginia's schedule was rated as the toughest schedule in the nation
- · Virginia played two games at South Carolina in the opening weekend dropping a pair of one-run games in walkoff fashion to a team currently ranked in the top 11 · Virginia also faced No. 4 UCLA No. 5 Texas A&M and No.
- 4 UCLA in the Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational
- taking wins over the Wildcats and  $\,$  Bruins
- · All five opponents faced at the Clearwater Tournament were ranked in the top 25 following the tournament

#### **BIGHAM CLOSING IN ON SAVES RECORD**

- · Junior right-hander Eden Bigham has been a force in the circle in any role for the Cavaliers
- ·This season, Bigham has four saves entering the weekend and nine for her career
- •The nine career saves is one shy of tying the career mark (10) set by Madi Harris last season
- · Her four saves this season is also two shy of the singleseason record (6) also set by Harris in the 2022 sesason

#### HYLTON KEEPS IT IN THE PARK A SECOND TIME

- · Junior Jade Hylton opened up the Penn game on February 23 with a bang, hitting an inside-the-park home run to right field
- $\cdot$  It was her second inside-the-park home run in as many season as she also hit one last season against St. Thomas (2/18/24)

- $\cdot$  Ava Hodges was the No. 38 overall recruit and was the No. 26 pitcher in the class.
- · Reagan Hickey was ranked No. 45 overall and the No. 24 catcher
- Alex Call was tabbed the No. 12 general infielder in the class, while Addison Thompson was a three-time All-Region selection in Virginia

- $\cdot$  The Cavaliers got good news with the return of LHP Savanah Henley for the season

#### **CAVALIERS PLAYED STOUT SCHEDULE IN 2024**

- · Virginia played a stout schedule for the 2024 campaign with the No. 22 strength of schedule overall
- The Hoos played 17 games against teams in the NCAA Tournament with 11 of those outside of ACC play and 11 on the road with one at a neutral site as the Hoos faced Clemson in the ACC quarterfinals hosted by Duke
- · Virginia went 7-10 in those games against NCAA Tournament teams during the regular season
- · Included in those games against the NCAA field were two contests at national seeds Alabama (No. 14 seed) and the series at national seed Duke (No. 10 seed)

#### **HOOS SET PROGRAM HIGH WITH 15 ACC WINS**

- · With the series win at Georgia Tech to close the regular season, the Hoos set a program record for ACC wins (15)
- •The previous program record was 13 wins set in the 2010 season and matched in the 2022 season
- ·Virginia matched the 13-win mark for the third time with the series-clinching win at No. 3 Duke in the finale
- •The Hoos passed the mark with a Saturday win at Georgia Tech and hit the 15-win mark in the finale to clinch the series with the Yellow Jackets

#### THREE WAS THE CHARM FOR VIRGINIA OFFENSE

- $\cdot$  With the Virginia pitching staff, three runs has been the magic number for the Cavaliers when it comes to winning games this season
- · In 2024, the Hoos were 29-3 when scoring three runs or more
- •The three times Virginia dropped a game when scoring at least three runs were the Saturday game at Notre Dame (10-3), the Saturday game against NC State (10-9) and the series opener at Georgia Tech (6-5)

#### HOOS HIT 30-WIN MARK FOR SECOND STRAIGHT YEAR

- · With the series-clinching win over No. 3 Duke, the Cavaliers hit the 30-win mark for the second straight season
- •The Cavaliers hit 30 wins last year for the first time since the 2010 campaign

- · Eden Bigham set a new career high for strikeouts in the season opener when the freshman fanned 11 batters through her 5.0 innings of work
- · Bigham retired 12 of the first 13 batters faced with nine strikeouts across those batters faced

#### **BIGHAM FANS 14 MOUNTAIN HAWKS FOR CAREER HIGH**

- · Eden Bigham set a career mark of 14 strikeouts in her start against Lehigh (2/23) to open the Rawlings Classic
- She struck out the first 12 batters of the game and finished with the 14 strikeouts on 16 batters faced in the five inning victory
- · The 14 strikeouts is the most by a UVA pitcher since Melanie Mitchell's 16 strikeout performance against George Washington (3/20/13)

#### **BIGHAM NAMED WEEK 3 ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK**

- Eden Bigham was named ACC Pitcher of the Week (2/27) after striking out 23 batters in 11.0 innings of work
- $\cdot$  She picked up wins over Lehigh and Iowa State on the week to help the Hoos to an undefeated weekend
- · She struck out 14 in her start against Lehigh before fanning nine batters in 6.0 relief innings against the Cyclones

#### **CAVALIERS TAKE SERIES FROM NO. 11 CLEMSON**

- •The Hoos made another step forward with a series win over No. 11 Clemson by taking the Friday and Sunday games of the series
- •The Friday night win over the Tigers was the first win over Clemson in program history by the Cavaliers
- · Clemson was the final league team the Hoos didn't have a tally in the win column against in program history and they added that mark in emphatic fashion this season
- •The Sunday win, a 3-0 victory, marked the first time this season a team held Clemson off the scoreboard

#### **HOOS TAKE FIRST SERIES FROM SYRACUSE**

- The Cavaliers accomplished another first under head coach Joanna Hardin last weekend with a series win over the Syracuse Orange
- · Virginia won games two and three of the series to grab the series win - the first ever over the Orange

#### VIRGINIA SHOCKS NO. 3 DUKE WITH DH SWEEP

- · Virginia delieverd one of the biggest series wins in program history this past weekend at No. 3 Duke
- After dropping the opener 1-0 in 12 innings on Friday, the Cavaliers came back and swept a Saturday doubleheader Virginia won game one of the doubleheader 4-3 thanks to a Jade Hylton grand slam before taking game two of the doubleheader 3-2
- · Hylton hit a two-run shot in that series clinching win
- · It was a gritty outing from the Hoos played three complete games spanning 25.1 innings in less than 24 hours from first pitch to final out

#### **CAVALIERS CLAIM PROGRAM BEST SEVEN ACC SERIES**

- Virginia won seven of the eight ACC series played this season to mark the first time in program history the Hoos have won seven ACC series in a season

- College, Syracuse, No. 11 Clemson, Notre Dame, NC State, No. 3 Duke and Georgia Tech

#### HOOS COME THROUGH WITH BACKS AGAINST WALL

- · Virginia went to the rubber match in all eight ACC series last season and came through in game three in seven weekends to claim the series
- · Against BC, Syracuse, No. 3 Duke and Georgia Tech the Cavaliers dropped game one and then won the next two games to claim the series
- · Against No. 11 Clemson, Notre Dame and NC State, the Cavaliers won game one and then took game three to lock up the weekend
- •The lone series loss was at UNC when the Cavaliers took game one and then dropped a Sunday doubleheader after Saturday's game was rained out

#### **BIGHAM EARNS ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK AGAIN**

- · Sophomore right-hander Eden Bigham earned her second ACC Pitcher of the Week honor on Tuesday (4/16)
- · She went 2-0 in the series against NC State with a complete-game shutout in game one and worked a second complete-game in the finale to clinch the series
- · Bigham struck out 15 across the two games
- · It marked Bigham's third complete-game shutout in ACC play and her fourth complete game against an ACC foe this season

#### **BIGHAM EARNS 3RD ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK**

- Eden Bigham took home her third ACC Pitcher of the Week honor on Tuesday to earn the honor for the second straight week and third time this season
- · Bigham threw 9.0 innings of shutout softball in the series opener at No. 3 Duke with nine strikeouts in the 12.0 inning affair
- · She then came back in game two of the series to earn the save her third of the season as she worked the seventh and got out of a bases-loaded jam

## PALMER PARK

- Virginia opened its new stadium, Palmer Park, on March 3, 2020 against JMU. Palmer Park is named after former Cavalier pitcher Lisa Palmer and her mother Fran. The Palmers were the lead contributors to the stadium project.
- The Cavaliers hosted a dedication ceremony for Palmer Park prior to Virginia's matchup against Virginia Tech on Friday, March 6, 2020.
- Palmer Park is a state-of-the-art facility which houses all of the Cavaliers' needs. Within the confines of Palmer Park is the team locker room and lounge, athletic training room, meeting rooms and a brand new indoor facility.
- Lisa Palmer pitched for the Cavaliers from 1986-89, establishing school records in wins (74), innings pitched (861.2), complete games (102) and games started (112). She still holds the UVA single-season records for wins (27), shutouts (14) and assists (221).
- The 2022 season was the first time it will be open to the full public for a full season.


