#### **CAVALIER NOTES**

- •The Cavaliers are No. 6 in the current NCAA RPI rankings. The team is No. 8 in the IWLCA Coaches Poll, 7 in the Inside Lacrosse media poll and No. 5 in the USA Lacrosse Magazine poll, but are the No. 7 seed in the ACC Championship
- •The Cavaliers enter the tournament on the heels of a 19-9 win against Virginia Tech. Virginia Tech scored the first two goals of the game to jump out to an early lead, but the Cavaliers answered with six straight goals and never looked back, holding an 11-4 lead at halftime. The Cavaliers opened the second half by going on a 6-1 run to build up a 17-5 advantage before closing out the 19-9 victory
- Sophomore midfielder **Kate Galica** set both the UVA single-game and single-season draw control records in the contest. Galica had 17 draws, passing the old mark of 15. She came into the game 12 shy of passing Aubrey Williams' single-season total of 149 draws. Galica now has 155 this season
- Galica, who was named as one of 25 nominees for the Tewaaraton Award, leads the ACC and is 10th in the nation in draw controls per game (9.69)
- •In addition to her draw controls, Galica has also become one of the offensive leaders on the team, ranking second in goals (40). She has scored at least a hat trick in each of the last six games
- Sophomore attacker **Madison Alaimo** had six assists against Virginia Tech, her fourth time this season assisting on a half-dozen goals in a game. Alaimo is third in the ACC and 10th in the nation in assists per game (3.06)
- · Alaimo leads the team in points (68)
- Sophomore attacker **Jenna DiNardo** continues to lead the team in goals (44). DiNardo is 11th in the ACC in goals per game (2.75). Galica is 12th (2.50)
- DiNardo has scored a hat trick in 11 of 16 games this season, including five 4-goal games
- Sophomore attacker **Addi Foster** is the only Cavalier to have contributed points in every game this season. Foster is third on the team in goals (35) and points (50) after only having eight points her freshman year (3g, 5a)
- Foster ranks second in the ACC and 11th in the nation in shot percentage (.593)
- •All four of Virginia's top scorers are sophomores. Freshmen and sophomores have scored 187 of UVA's 226 goals this season (82.7 percent)
- Freshman **Livy LaVerghetta** scored her first career goal at Boston College. She is the ninth Cavalier to score her first career goal this season, joining grad student Lauren Pederson, junior Katie Kampel and freshmen Fiona Allen, Gabby LaVerghetta, Jayden Piraino, Alex Reilly, Payton Sfreddo, Corey White
- · Virginia has had 17 different players score goals this season

## **ACC CHAMPIONSHIP**

- · Virginia is the No. 7 seed in the ACC Championship, its highest-ever seeding
- The Cavaliers tied for sixth in the ACC standings, but lost the tiebreaker against Syrcause (head-to-head results) to garner the 7-seed
- · Virginia looks to return to the semifinals for the second straight year and for the third time in four sseasons
- Virginia has won five ACC titles, the last coming in 2008

#### **UVA VS BC**

- BC won the regular-season meeting 24-11
- · Virginia trailed 6-1 with 3:51 remaining in the first quarter but scored twice before the end of the period to cut the deficit to 6-3. The Eagles scored in the opening 30 seconds of the second quarter, but the Cavaliers strung together three straight goals, one apiece from freshman Gabby LaVerghetta and sophomores Addi Foster and Jenna DiNardo, to make it a 7-6 game. The Eagles scored seven straight to build up a 14-6 lead with 9:33 remaining in the third. Virginia rallied again with a goal from DiNardo sandwiched by a pair of scores from sophomore Kate Galica to cut the deficit to 14-9 with 4:31 remaining in the third, but that was as close as UVA would get. BC ended the game on a 10-2 run, including scoring the final five goals of the game.
- · Last season, the No. 11 Cavaliers stunned No. 3 Boston College with a 13-12 overtime win. Kate Galica and Madison Alaimo came through in the clutch for the Cavaliers combining for seven points and accounting for each of Virginia's last three goals including an overtime winner from Alaimo. Virginia led 8-4 at halftime, but the Eagles cameback to tie the game 10-10 with 7:50 remaining. The game was tied 11-11 when BC's Ryan Smith scored on a free postition shot with 51 seconds remaining. Galica scored with two seconds remaining in regulation to tie the game. On the opening draw of the final overtime period, Galica won the draw to Kate Miller to set up what would be the only possession Virginia would need. With less than two minutes remaining in overtime, Katia Carnevale found wide-open Alaimo on the crease who buried the finish to win the game 13-12
- · It was the Cavalier's first win against BC since 2016, snapping a streak of eight straight losses against the Eagles
- · Virginia leads the all-time series 15-11

- Attacker Madison Alaimo and midfielder Kate Galica were named to the First Team
- · Attacker Jenna DiNardo was named to the Second Team
- This is the first time any have been named to the All-ACC team. All three were named to the 2024 All-ACC Freshman Team with Galica voted the ACC Freshman of the Year
- · The conference 'of the year' awards will be announced at a later date

#### **MIDSEASON ACCOLADES**

- · Sophomore midfielder Kate Galica is one of the 25 nominees for the Tewaaraton Award
- · Galica was named a Nike Lacrosse Midseason All-American (presented by Inside
- · Sophomore attacker Madison Alaimo was added to the Tewaaraton Award Watch List, joining **Kate Galica** and **Kate Miller** who were named to the Watch List in the preseason

#### **INSEASON ACCOLADES**

- · Sophomore attacker Jenna DiNardo was named the USA Lacrosse National Player of the Week on March 18. Dinardo was a key piece to Virginia's 16-11 win over No. 13 Duke (March 15). The Cavaliers trailed by as many as seven goals in the second quarter but used a 12-1 scoring run that began in the final seconds of the first half and stretched into the opening minutes of the fourth. Dinardo scored or assisted on six of Virginia's 12 goals over that stretch including each of the first three.
- Dinardo finished the game with a career-high eight points on four goals and four assists to lead all players.

· Virginia was a consensus top-10 team in all three polls: UVA is No. 8 in the IWLCA Coaches Poll, No. 5 in the USA Lacrosse Magazine poll and No. 9 in the Inside Lacrosse media poll. The Cavaliers were picked to finish third in the Preseason ACC Coaches Poll

# **UVA IN THE IWLCA RANKINGS**

- · Virginia is one of five programs in the NCAA to be ranked at least once in every year of the IWLCA Coaches Poll. The poll was created in 1988, with Dartmouth, Maryland, Penn State and Princeton joining Virginia as the only programs to be nationally ranked every year.
- Of those five programs, Virginia is the only program to be ranked in every week of the IWLCA coaches poll, a span of 290-straight polls.
- Of those 292 polls. the Cavaliers have been ranked among the top-10 in the nation on 248 occasions, the secondmost among all NCAA programs.
- The Cavaliers have spent 15 weeks ranked No. 1. including the entire 1993 season
- Virginia debuted at No. 7 in the inaugural coaches poll on March 19, 1988. While the Cavaliers have climbed to a No. 1 ranking, the farthest they have ever fallen was to No. 19 on April 23, 2013. Virginia has only spent five weeks ranked outside the top-15.



#### **HEAD COACH SONIA LAMONICA**



LaMonica took over UVA's storied program for the 2023-24 season after serving as the head women's lacrosse coach at Towson for 13 seasons and one season at Mt. Saint Mary's. LaMonica enters her second season in charge of the Cavalier program in 2025 owning an all-time coaching record of 162-105.

LaMonica and her team cruised to a 14-6 victory over Liberty in her first game in charge and would go on to win nine of the first 10 games of the season—Virginia's best start to a campaign since the 2007 national runner-up season.

The Cavaliers would go on to stockpile some of the best wins of any team in the country including a road victory over No. 4 Notre Dame, and emphatic dispatching of No. 7 James Madison at home, and a thrilling overtime win over No. 3 Boston College on senior day.

Virginia went 6-3 in ACC play matching a single season program-high for wins in conference play while taking down the likes of Boston College for the first time in eight seasons. The pair of wins over opponents ranked in the top-four marked the first time Virginia accomplished such a feat in nine seasons. The Cavaliers would eventually avenge their regular-season loss to North Carolina with a 13-12 victory in the ACC quarterfinals—their first win over UNC since the 2014 season. UVA reached the ACC Semifinal before falling to Syracuse.

The Cavaliers earned the fifth overall seed in the NCAA Women's Lacrosse Championship, its highest since the 2008 season when Virginia was seeded fourth. The Cavaliers earned the right to host the first two rounds of the tournament for the first time since the 2019 season. The first round featured a 21-6 dispatching of LIU in which Virginia set a program record for most goals scored in an NCAA tournament game. The Cavaliers fell to No. 10 Florida in the second round of the championship.

LaMonica was named ACC Co-Coach of the Year, sharing the honor with former collegiate teammate Acacia Walker-Weinstein of Boston College. Five Cavaliers were named to the All-ACC teams while three were named to the All-Freshman team including ACC freshman of the Year Kate Galica.

#### Prior to Virginia

During her tenure at Towson, LaMonica led the Tigers to seven NCAA Tournament appearances and four Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) Tournament Championships. She has been named the CAA Coach of the Year five times.

Towson finished first or second in the CAA in 10 of her 14 seasons at the helm and made nine CAA tournament championship game appearances, including six-straight. LaMonica has coached six players to All-America honors and has had numerous All-CAA and All-Region honorees.

LaMonica consistently challenged her teams with tough schedules against top-ranked opponents. Towson finished .500 or better in 12 of the 14 seasons she oversaw the program, with one of the two being cut short due to the pandemic.

A native of Darlington, South Australia, LaMonica (pronounced La – MAHN – ick – uh) was named the 10th head coach in the history of the Towson women's lacrosse program after the 2010 season. She returned to lead the Tigers after a one-year stint as the head coach at Mount St. Mary's.

As the Mountaineers' head coach, LaMonica led Mount St. Mary's to an 8-9 record in 2010 and a berth in the Northeast Conference (NEC) semifinals. She coached five players who earned All-NEC honors.

Prior to becoming the Mountaineers' head coach, LaMonica spent two seasons as a member of Missy Doherty's staff at Towson and helped the Tigers win a pair of Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) championships.

Before joining the Tigers' staff, LaMonica was an assistant coach at the University of Denver, helping the Pioneers to a 15-5 record during the 2006 season. She coached the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) Player and Rookie of the Year along with three all-conference selections and the program's first IWLCA All-West/Midwest region honoree.

LaMonica also served as head coach of the Women's Professional Lacrosse League's (WPLL) Baltimore Brave. LaMonica led the Brave to the league championship in 2019 and guided the team to the title game in the inaugural season a year earlier.

In addition to her success as a coach, LaMonica is a member of the Australian National Team. She helped Australia win the gold medal at the 2005 World Cup Championship and a silver medal at the 2009 World Cup Championship. In the summer of 2013, LaMonica played a key role in helping Australia earn a bronze medal at the World Cup Championship in Canada.

Named to the 2005 IFWLA All-World Team, she was also a member of the U-19 Australian National Team that won the silver medal at the 1999 World Championships and was also the recipient of the U21 South Australian Sportswoman of the Year award.

A 2003 graduate of Maryland, LaMonica was a three-year starter for the Terrapins. She earned first team All-America honors and was a candidate for the Tewaaraton Trophy during her senior season after leading Maryland to the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) championship. A team captain during her senior season, she was a member of three ACC championship teams and helped the Terrapins win the 2000 and 2001 NCAA titles.

LaMonica scored 111 goals in her college career, including 49 goals as a senior, along with 55 assists.
