Team Notes

- UVA (3-0) scored its most points since scoring 100 vs. Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018
- Ryan Odom is the third UVA coach to start his tenure 3-0, joining Henry Lannigan (1905-06, 4-0) and Ron Sanchez (2024-25, 3-0)
- UVA scored 80 or more points in three straight games for the first time since 2015, when the Cavaliers scored 80 or more in four straight game (Bradley, Long Beach State, George Mason and Lehigh)
- UVA has scored 80 or more points in its first three games for the first time since 2006, when the Cavaliers scored 80 or more in four straight games (Arizona, Morgan State, UNC Asheville and UMES)
- UVA is 43-10 in its last 53 home contests
- UVA is 107-11 at JPJ in non-conference play since 2009-10
- UVA forced two shot clock violations (3 in 2025-26)
- UVA had a pair of 10-0 runs to gain a 47-19 halftime lead
- UVA shot a season-high 50 percent from 3-point range (11 of 22)
- UVA (49 rebounds) has 48 or more rebounds in each game

Series Notes

- UVA is 10-0 all-time against Hampton in the series that dates back to the 1998-99 season
- The Cavaliers are 8-0 vs. the Pirates in Charlottesville
- Head coach Ryan Odom is 1-0 vs. Hampton

Player Notes

- Double Figure Scorers: Ugonna Onyenso (18), Chance Mallory (16), Sam Lewis (13), Malik Thomas (11), Jacari White (10)
- Onyenso scored a career-high 18 points
- Onyenso added 10 rebounds for his second career double-double
- Onyenso had 12 points (2 3-pointers), six rebounds and three blocks in the first half
- Onyenso reached double figures for the second time at UVA (4 career)
- Onyenso made his first two career 3-pointers
- Onyenso and Johann Grünloh each had four blocks, marking the first time since Dec. 22, 1998, a pair of UVA teammates each had four or more blocks (Kris Hunter 5, Chris Williams 4)
- Mallory reached double figures for the second time
- Mallory has made two 3-pointers in each of UVA's three games
- Lewis reached double figures for the third time (36 career)
- Thomas reached double figures for the second time (57 career)
- Dallin Hall (7 assists) has five or more assists in all three games
- UVA started Hall, Thomas, Lewis, Grünloh and Thijs De Ridder for the third straight game
