Entries are to be done online beginning Monday March 11, 2019 at www.directathletics.com. Entry deadline is Monday April 1, 2019 at 12:00pm.

Team entry fee is \$450 per gender. Colleges and Universities may make checks payable to: THE UNIVERISTY OF GEORGIA ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (UGAA). Fees will be based on athletes entered not athletes who show up to compete. Team entry fees will be collected April 5, 2019.
