KEY STORYLINES

THE SERIES

- Virginia Tech has a 9-2 advantage in the all-time series with Radford.
- The two sides are meeting in back-to-back seasons for the third time in series history.
- Of the 11 games played in the series, 10 have been contested inside Cassell Coliseum (more on page 6).

A WIN WOULD...

- Be the Hokies' fourth straight in the series, which started in 1987-88.
- Put Tech at program win No. 1,498.
- Move the Hokies to 3-0 for the fourth consecutive season.

WHO TO WATCH

- Hunter Cattoor was lights out in Annapolis on Friday, going for a career-high 19 points on 7-of-10 shooting.
- He dialed up five 3-pointers for the second time in his career (UMES - 12/29/19).
- Through two games, Cattoor leads the Hokies in field-goal percentage at 64.3 percent, which is impressive considering 10 of his 14 attempts have come from beyond the arc.
- The junior from Orlando, Florida also leads Tech in assists per game (4.5), which ties for sixth in the ACC.

CLOSING IN ON 600

- Mike Young, who is in his 20th season as a college head coach, is one game away from reaching 600 games coached as the head whistle.
- He has compiled a 332-267 (.554) career ledger as a head coach.

BY THE NUMBERS

20

The 2021-22 season will be the **20th** of Mike Young's head coaching career. He has logged a 332-267 (.554) career record as the head whistle.

4

The Hokies have advanced to the NCAA Tournament a program-record **four** straight times. Tech has now earned 12 NCAA bids in school history.

3

Virginia Tech is **three** wins away from program win No. 1,500. The Hokies' all-time record stands at 1,497-1,243.

NOTEWORTHY

STORM WARNING

- Grad student Storm Murphy takes over the reins at point guard following the graduation of Wabissa Bede.
- The Wofford transfer averaged 17.8 points, 3.3 rebounds and 4.3 assists last season. He was one of only 11 players to average that stat line or better nationally.
- Murphy tallied double figures in 21 of 24 contests, including 10 20-point performances, and dished over five assists on eight occasions.
- He concluded his Wofford career with 1,315 points to finish 24th on the program's all-time scoring list.
- The First-Team All-SoCon selection will provide a scoring threat from outside, as he shot 40 percent from three last season.
- Murphy knocked down 70 3-pointers a year ago. In comparison, Bede connected on 12 with a 24.5 percent clip.
- With the addition of Murphy, Tech is able to stretch defenses even more now that opponents must respect the long range shot from the point guard position.

DANCIN' IN YEAR TWO

- In previous seasons in Virginia Tech history, the fastest head coach to make the NCAA Tournament was in Year Three. Those Hokies were Howie Shannon, Charlie Moir and Buzz Williams.
- Therefore, with Mike Young doing so in Year Two, he became the fastest Tech coach to make The Dance.

HOKIE CENSUS

- Tech has 13 players on the squad who represent eight states and two international countries (Netherlands, Nigeria).
- Florida leads the way with three players - Hunter Cattoor, Lynn Kidd and Jalen Haynes - while Maryland has two players - Keve Aluma and Darius Maddox.

BOUNCEBACK MENTALITY

- Young and the Hokies were 5-1 last season after a loss with their lone back-to-back losing skid coming at the end of the season to North Carolina in the ACC Tournament and Florida in the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2019-20, Young had five wins following a loss.

50 SPOT

- Tech shot over 50 percent in a game five times during the 2020-21 season - going 5-0.
- Since Young got to Blacksburg, the Hokies are 11-1 in contests shooting 50 percent or greater, with the lone loss coming to BYU on Nov. 27, 2019 in the fifth-place game of the Maui Jim Maui Invitational.
- Over the last decade (2010-11 season to present), Tech is 82-12 when shooting 50 percent or better.

LEADING AT THE BREAK

- Over the last two seasons, Tech is 14-2 when leading at halftime, with the two losses coming against North Carolina and Florida to end the 2020-21 season.
- The Hokies are 27-6 in the Mike Young era when up at half.

MOMENTUM ON OUR SIDE

- With its third-place finish in the regular-season standings in 2020-21, Tech has finished in the top five of the ACC two of the last three seasons.
- Placing third tied for the highest ACC finish in school history as the Hokies tied for third in 2006-07 and 2009-10.
- If Tech can post a top-five ACC finish this season, it would mark the third time in four years accomplishing that feat.

- The Hokies charted five top-five ACC finishes in seven years from 2004-05 to 2011-12.

GREEN-LIGHTED FROM THREE

- With the potential lineup of Storm Murphy, Hunter Cattoor, Nahiem Alleyne, Justyn Mutts and Keve Aluma, all five of those players have the green light from distance.
- The last team Coach Young had with this type of threat from deep was his 2018-19 Wofford squad, which ranked second nationally in 3-point accuracy (41.4). The Terriers finished 30-5 that season, including an unbeaten mark in SoCon action, and reached the second round of the 2019 NCAA Tournament.

RANKED WINS BECOMIN' COMMON

- Tech had four ranked wins last season, tying the most-ever in school history (set 2017-18).

GETTIN' TO THE CHARITY STRIPE

- Coach Young was not happy with how little the Hokies got to the free-throw line in 2019-20, with an average of 13.4 per game, which ranked second-to-last in the ACC and was in the bottom 25, nationally.
- So, now, with not being as dependent on the 3-ball and having more players that can get to the rim, Tech increased that average to 18.8 last season. That 18.8 average was fourth in the ACC, trailing North Carolina (21.5), Pitt (21.5) and Florida State (19.0).
- Last season, the Hokies had nine games (out of 22) of having 20 or more free-throw attempts. When doing so, they were 7-2, with the losses coming against Louisville and Florida.

REACH OUR POTENTIAL

- When asked how he'd define success for this season, Coach Young expressed he wanted the Hokies to reach their potential.
- "That will be a real success for me," he said, "And I'll get back to the mountains of North Carolina this spring and fish with a big smile on my face."

ACC POY CONVERSATION

- Keve Aluma is undoubtedly in the conversation for ACC Player of the Year heading into the 2021-22 season.
- The 6-foot-9 forward was a Second-Team All-ACC pick last season, four points behind Virginia's Sam Hauser for the final spot on the first team.
- With the entire All-ACC first team gone, Aluma is the leading returning point getter from the all-conference voting a year ago.

IT'S IN THE NAME

- Storm Murphy's first name comes from his Mom's maiden name - Storm, in addition to being born in January during a snowstorm in Wisconsin.

DEGREES ON DEGREES

- Storm Murphy and Justyn Mutts are both in grad school at Virginia Tech.
- Murphy graduated from Wofford with a finance degree in May 2021 and is currently pursuing a graduate degree in leadership studies within the Agricultural and Life Sciences program at Virginia Tech.
- Mutts graduated with a psychology degree from Delaware and completed his master's degree at Tech in agricultural and life sciences with a concentration in education in May 2021. He's currently pursuing his second master's degree in educational psychology.
- Keve Aluma earned his first undergraduate degree in human development from Virginia Tech in May 2021 and is currently working on his second undergraduate degree in sociology.

NOVEMBER SUCCESS

- Tech has won 20 of its last 23 games in the month of November for an 87 percent win clip.
- The Hokies are 32-7 (.821) since 2015 and 52-14 (.788) since 2011.
- Since 2011, Tech has only lost back-to-back games in November three times.
- In the past three seasons alone, the Hokies have registered two top-three wins in November (vs. No. 3 Villanova in 2020 and vs. No. 3 Michigan State in 2019).
- Tech is 11-2 under Coach Young in November.

PUT THE CLAMPS ON 'EM

- Through two games, the Hokies have held both their opponents below 60 points. Their 52.0 scoring defense average ranks first in the ACC and 34th nationally.

- The last time Tech opened the season holding its first two opponents below 60 points was the 2011-12 season (vs. ETSU - 64-53; vs. Monmouth - 91-46). If the Hokies can manage to hold Radford below 60 points Monday night, it would be the first time Tech has held its first three opponents below that mark since the 1998-99 season.
- In addition to their scoring defense, the Hokies rank third in the ACC in field-goal percentage defense (.357).

OWNING THE ARC

- The 3-point line has been under new management two games into the 2021-22 season. Tech has owned both sides of the arc, ranking first in 3FG% defense (.149) and tying for second in 3FG% (.425) among ACC programs. The Hokies are also tied for second in 3-pointers made per game (8.5).

WHAT A COINCIDENCE

- For the second straight game, Tech's next opponent played Virginia the game prior to facing the Hokies. Navy beat UVA, 66-58, last Tuesday before dropping its home opener to Tech, 77-57, on Friday.
- Similarly, Radford traveled to Charlottesville, but lost to the Cavaliers, 73-52, Friday night. Now, the Highlanders make the trip to Blacksburg to face their second straight ACC foe.

RADFORD REUNION

- It will be a Radford High School reunion of sorts Monday night when Radford first-year head coach Darris Nichols squares off with fellow Bobcat grad Mike Young for the first time. Young was present for Nichols' introductory press conference at the Dedmon Center on April 21.
- The two were on the same sideline for the 2013-14 season at Wofford where Young was the head coach and Nichols was an assistant coach. The Terriers who were picked to finish sixth in the league by the coaches that season, secured 20 wins and a Southern Conference Tournament championship, earning an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. In that NCAA Tournament game, Nichols was on the opposite bench from his former head coach at West Virginia, as Beilein's Michigan team topped 15th-seeded Wofford.
- In addition to Darris, older brother Shane Nichols has Coach Young and Radford ties as well. Shane played for Young at Wofford (2005-08) before joining his staff as an assistant coach (2010-12). Shane was on staff when the Terriers won the SoCon title and advanced to the 2011 NCAA Tournament.
- Radford University Director of Athletics Robert Lineburg is the cousin of Mike Young.
- All four (Young, Nichols bros and Lineburg) are in the Radford High School Hall of Fame.

REUNITED IN BLACKSBURG

- Keve Aluma, Storm Murphy and Coach Young spent two seasons (2017-19) together at Wofford, highlighted by their 2018-19 season that included a first-round win (84-68) over Seton Hall in the 2019 NCAA Tournament.
- Upon Aluma's and Young's departure from Wofford, Murphy stuck around in Spartanburg, South Carolina, guiding the Terriers to a 34-25 record.
- While together at Wofford, the trio combined for a 51-18 (.739) mark.

WHO IS THIS GUY?

- Keve Aluma only attempted one 3-pointer in his two seasons at Wofford. In Coach Young's words, "it wasn't even close."
- Fast forward two seasons and Aluma has become a post player with range from beyond the arc. He attempted 57 threes in his Hokie debut in 2020-21, knocking down 20 of them for a 35.1 percent clip.

JUSTYN TIME

- Coach Young has gone on record saying, "Justyn Mutts was probably the key to our year last year."
- The Delaware transfer was the Hokies' fourth-leading scorer from last season (9.5) and second-leading rebounder (6.4).
- From Dec. 29, 2020 through the end of the season, Mutts scored at least nine points in 11 of Tech's 14 games. The Millville, New Jersey native twice broke the 20-point plateau - at Miami (Fla.) (22) and vs. North Carolina (24) - during that stretch.

ABOUT RADFORD

- Radford gears up for its second ACC clash in as many games, after suffering its first setback of the season, 73-52, to Virginia on Friday night.
- RU opened with an 84-72 win over Emory & Henry at home last Tuesday in what was head coach Darris Nichols' first game at the helm of the Highlanders.
- Radford was picked to finish fourth in the Big South Conference's North Division.
- The Highlanders return four starters and nine letterwinners from a squad that finished 15-12 overall and 12-6 in Big South play. They advanced to the Big South Tournament semifinals before falling to No. 3 seed Campbell, 78-60.
- In addition to its returning core, Radford welcomes six newcomers headlined by Camron McNeil, who is second on the team in scoring at 10.5 points per game. The Spartanburg Methodist transfer averaged 18.2 ppg, 6.6 rpg and 4.3 apg in 2020-21.
- Bryan Hart, a graduate student from Hampton, Va., produces a team-best 11 points per game for RU.
- Radford averages 68 ppg and shoots at a 46.8 percent clip, including 40.5 from three.

LAST MEETING WITH RADFORD

- Keve Aluma scored a then-career-high 19 points in his Virginia Tech debut, and Nahiem Alleyne added 14, as the Hokies pulled away from Radford 77-62 in a nonconference game played Nov. 25, 2020 at Carilion Clinic Court at Cassell Coliseum.
- The game marked the season opener for both squads, and the Hokies beat Radford for the ninth time in 11 meetings. Tech also extended its homecourt nonconference winning streak to 33 games and won its fifth straight season opener. Tech now has won 19 of its past 21 season openers.
- Tech trailed for much of the first half, but managed to put together a run toward the end of the half to take the lead for good. A Justyn Mutts layup with 2:10 remaining gave Tech a 28-27 advantage, and then Alleyne scored the game's next seven points, pushing the Hokies' lead to 35-27 on two free throws with 48 seconds remaining.
- Radford did not come closer than six points the rest of the way. The Hokies used an 8-0 run late in the game – two Hunter Cattoor 3-pointers sandwiched around a Wabissa Bede jumper – to extend the lead to 69-52 with 6:22 left. That represented the largest lead of the game.
- Cattoor heated up in the second half, hitting all four of his 3-pointers in the final 20 minutes and finished with 12 points.
- Aluma, making his first appearance after sitting out last season following his transfer from Wofford, dominated Radford in the post. He hit 7 of 10 from the floor, including three 3-pointers, and he grabbed three rebounds and blocked two shots.
- The Hokies made 15 of their 26 shots in the second half (57.7%) and shot 48.3% from the floor for the game. They hit 11 of their 26 3-point attempts.
- Josiah Jeffers and Dravon Mangum led Radford with 12 points each.

CHALLENGING NON-CON

- Coach Young's non-conference scheduling philosophy is quite different from his predecessor - one in which should provide plenty of Quadrant 1 and Quadrant 2 opportunities for the NCAA Tournament resume.

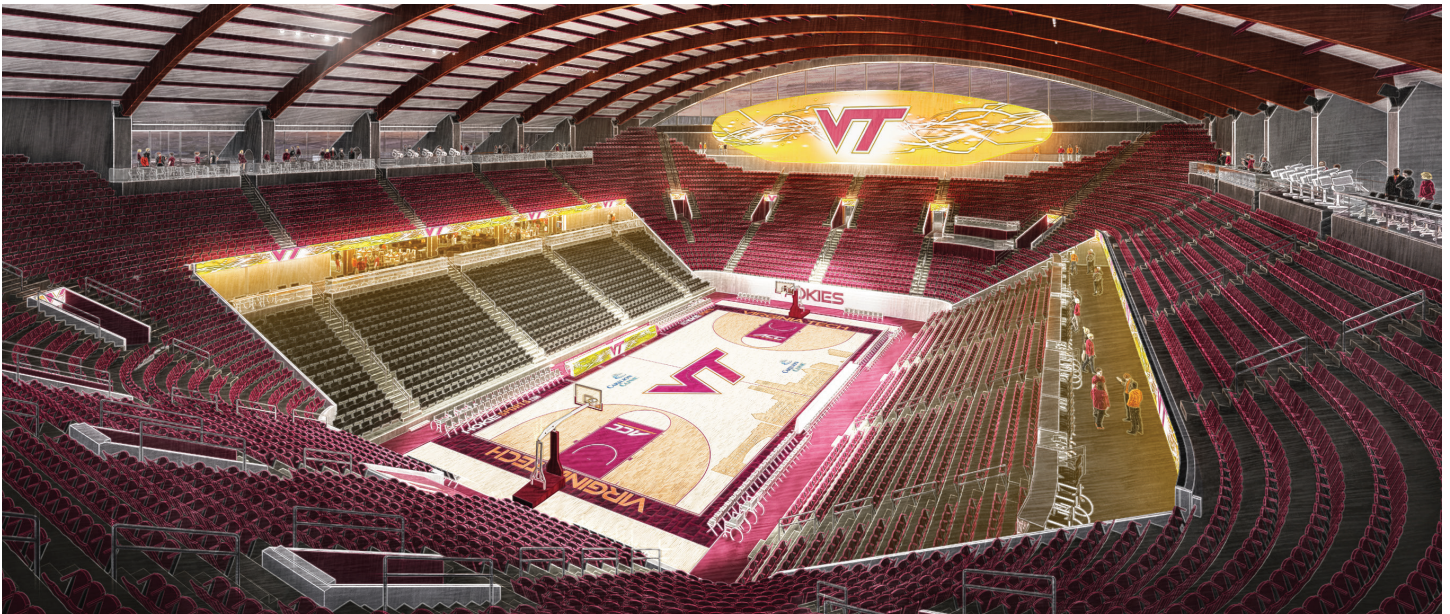

REACH FOR EXCELLENCE

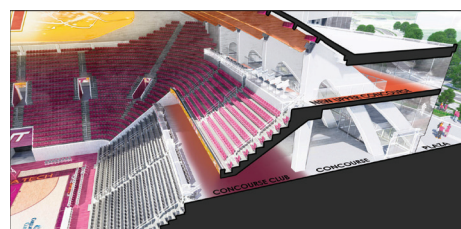
- Virginia Tech announced on April 20, 2021 a \$400 million fundraising campaign to propel Hokie sports to the forefront of the Atlantic Coast Conference, prepare generations of student-athletes for success in life, and raise the university's profile nationwide.
- The campaign will leverage the momentum of recent successes on the field and in fundraising, such as adding about 10,000 more Hokie Club members in the past five years and opening the Student-Athlete Performance Center, thanks to a record gift. Still, leaders acknowledged that the athletics enterprise needs an infusion of revenue in order to compete at the top of the ACC.
- The budget increase will support athletics in three primary areas: facilities, coaching, and the student-athlete experience.



- The Reach for Excellence campaign has five main pillars, which are:
 - A football enhancement fund to build a program that consistently competes at the top of the ACC, by allotting \$30 million over time for recruiting, assistant coaches' salaries, quality-control coaches, player development, and capital needs.
 - Renovations to improve Cassell Coliseum, with at least \$50 million to be raised privately.
 - The Drive for 25 initiative to increase Hokie Club membership to 25,000 and raise \$20 million annually for student-

athlete scholarships.

- Striving for comprehensive excellence for all sports by providing operating expenses, facility improvements, nutritional and strength and conditioning programs, and more.
- Increasing the number of student-athlete scholarship endowments to expand capacity to support students and broaden reach in recruiting.
- When it's filled with nearly 10,000 fans cheering the Hokies to victory in the last seconds of a basketball game, Cassell Coliseum is an amazing sight. But when it's empty, the home of Virginia Tech basketball, volleyball, and wrestling shows its age. Built in the early 1960s, the Coliseum is due for an extensive renovation.
- Plans call for a completely redesigned experience, including:
 - A new glass entrance along Washington Street
 - Extended concourse areas along both sides to allow fans easier access to different sections of the coliseum
 - The addition of high-end premium seating areas, including club seating and luxury suites on both sides
- This much-needed \$75 million-plus project, helped by at least \$50 million in private support, would create one of the best home venues in the ACC.

WHAT'S A HOKIE?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.



Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The official university school colors - Chicago Maroon and Burnt Orange - also were introduced in 1896. The colors were chosen by a committee because they made a 'unique combination' not worn elsewhere at the time. The official definition of "Hokie" is "a loyal Virginia Tech Fan."
