Virginia Tech crossed the 100-point plateau in a season opener for the first time since 2017. It was the ninth time VT scored at least 100 points in a season opener in program history.

29

The Hokies' **29 assists** tied Purdue for the **fifth-most dimes** in the country on opening night. Tech last recorded at least **29 assists** on Nov. 20, 2019 (vs. Delaware State).



Sean Pedulla dished out a career-high 10 assists vs. Coppin State. He assisted on five of Lynn Kidd's six made field goals as both Pedulla and Kidd finished with double-doubles.

NOTEWORTHY

YOUNG, PARIS MEET AGAIN

- The head coaches for Tech and South Carolina have squared off five times prior to Friday night. Young is 5-0 in those meetings.
- Young (Wofford) and Paris (Chattanooga) battled each other four times while both were in the SoCon, then played again on Dec. 11, 2019 in Young's inaugural season in Blacksburg – a 63-58 win by the Hokies.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

- Sean Pedulla and Lynn Kidd combined for a pair of double-doubles in Monday's season opener.
- Pedulla finished with 15 points and a careerhigh 10 assists. His previous career high was eight against Delaware State in last year's season opener.
- Kidd tallied 14 points (tied his career high) and 11 rebounds (career high).
- They were the first Tech duo to post seasonopening double-doubles since 2007 vs. Elon (Jeff Allen and Deron Washington).

CHASING HISTORY

 Hunter Cattoor is currently fifth all-time in career 3-pointers made in VT history. He became the ninth Hokie to reach 200 for his career at Boston College in December 2022.

- For three games last season, Pedulla was the only available point guard (Cattoor and Rodney Rice injuries).
- With the addition of freshman Brandon Rechsteiner, the Hokies now have three players capable of running point.

BREAKOUT YEAR LOADING?

• MJ Collins was thrust into the starting lineup

as a freshman a year ago, and while there were growing pains, head coach Mike Young knew it would pay off in the long run.

- "He is poised to have an even finer sophomore year. He's bigger and stronger. I've challenged him to be a go-to defender," Young said. "He's worked really hard on his perimeter shooting."
- In preparation for guarding the opponent's best perimeter player, Collins has been chasing around Cattoor in practice.
- "It's not only going to benefit him but benefit our team," Cattoor said of Collins. "Coach challenges him, I challenge him. Every time we're in practice and we're on separate teams, I always want him to come guard me. I want to make it as hard as possible for him. In practice, I want to guard him and make it as hard as possible for him. But it's going to help him grow.
- "He's a competitor, he's going to fight. He's not afraid to make mistakes, which is ultimately
 going to make him better. It's going to be good for us to slide me off of the best player and
 have him do it. ... He's taken great strides from last year and I'm excited for him this year."
- Going back to the experience Collins gained from his first season in Blacksburg, the Clover, S.C., native ranked seventh among freshmen in the ACC in minutes per game.

HARRISONBURG. VA. STAND UP!

- Tyler Nickel hails from Harrisonburg, Va., the hometown of two other Commonwealth basketball greats in Dell Curry and Ralph Sampson. Curry went on to play at Virginia Tech, finishing as the program's No. 2 all-time leading scorer with 2,385 career points and was drafted by the Utah Jazz in 1986. Sampson was a three-time national player of the year at Virginia, before being drafted as the No. 1 overall pick in the 1983 NBA Draft.
- However, it is Nickel who is the Virginia High School League's all-time leading scorer with 2,909 career points, passing the likes of Mac McClung, J.J. Redick, Moses Malone, Alonzo Mourning, Grant Hill and Allen Iverson on the way to the top.

DANCIN' IN BACK-TO-BACK SEASONS

- In previous seasons in Virginia Tech history, the fastest head coach to make the NCAA Tournament was in Year Three. Those Hokies were Howie Shannon. Charlie Moir and Buzz Williams.
- Therefore, with Mike Young doing so in Year Two, he became the fastest Tech coach to make The Dance.
- The Hokies have also never had a head coach lead them to the NCAA Tournament in two of their first three seasons.
- Mike Young becomes just the third head coach in program history to register multiple trips to the NCAA Tournament, joining Charlie Moir and Buzz Williams.

ONE BIG FAMILY

Head Coach

- The camaraderie between the VT men's and women's basketball teams as described by **Hunter Cattoor:**
- "I'd say it's like a whole big family there. We play and practice in the same facility, so we see them every day, whether that's working out on our own time or during lift and practice. We see them all around. We're saying hey to them. I know Coach Brooks is doing a great job over there with that team. But I look at them as family. ... I think it's great for both programs to be together and support each other and want each other to do well."

- Since the 2010-11 season, Tech is 106-15 when shooting 50 percent or better.

COACH HUNT


- Mike Young had never let a player install a play before in his 38 years of coaching. He'd never had a player like Hunter Cattoor before, though.
- "He wants to be a coach," Young said on Oct. 3. "I had him install [a play] yesterday. I don't think I've ever done that in 38 years
- "He commands a great deal of admiration and respect for what he's done here. [It] permeates throughout the program. I think he has embraced that and has done quite a good job thus far, and it'll be very important for this bunch."
- With defense being a point of emphasis for the entire Tech team heading into the season, Cattoor's tutelage will be crucial — and the teaching role is one he hopes to continue into the future. H/T Jack Brizendine

FOCUSED ON TEAM SUCCESS

- As Cattoor wraps up his career in Blacksburg this season, his focus will be on getting the team back to the top of the ACC - and he knows everyone's personal goals will come to fruition in the process.
- "At the end of the day, you want to go out on a high note. You want to compete for another ACC championship. You want to make it to the big dance and make a run," he said.
- "I think that's just the main thing to worry about — team success — and the individual success will come along." H/T Jack Brizendine

BYERS BOUGHT IN ON DEFENSIVE END

- J.D. Byers was hired as an assistant coach in April, bringing 13 years of experience at the Division I level with him to Blacksburg. He worked three stints with current Penn State head coach Mike Rhoades, most recently at VCU from 2017 to 2023.
- According to KenPom, VCU ranked 15th in adjusted defensive efficiency last season. Its three rankings the previous four seasons: seventh, 14th, 45th and seventh. Tech has only posted a top-40 defense five times since joining the ACC in 2004, the last time being 2019-20 under Buzz Williams (No. 20). H/T David Cunningham
- Though he wasn't necessarily the main reason why the Rams were so stingy on defense, Byers brought those lessons to Blacksburg. He watched Tech's games from last season through a unique lens since he wasn't involved, and the players said his feedback in specific areas has really helped.





WHAT'S A HOKIE?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.

Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of

his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The official university school colors - Chicago Maroon and Burnt Orange - also were introduced in 1896. The colors were chosen by a committee because they made a 'unique combination' not worn elsewhere at the time. The official definition of "Hokie" is "a loyal Virginia Tech Fan."
