#### **KEY STORYLINES**

#### **THE SERIES**

- Virginia Tech carries a twogame winning streak in the series into Sunday's clash with the Cardinals.
- The Hokies defeated Louisville, 71-54, on the road in the lone meeting last season
- UofL still leads the series, 36-10, which dates back to Jan. 28, 1979.
- The last time these two teams met in Blacksburg, VT snapped a 17-game losing skid to the Cards en route to a 75-43 victory – the most lopsided win by the Hokies in series history.
- Tech is 2-8 against Louisville as ACC foes.
- The Hokies are 4-16 against UofL in Blacksburg.

- VT is 8-11 all-time in ACC openers, including last season's 80-72 win over 18th-ranked North Carolina at home.
- Sunday will be the first time the Hokies will open ACC play against Louisville.

The Hokies rank sixth nationally in free-throw percentage, averaging 80.1%. They already have five games of at least 20 free throws made. VT had two such games last season.

**Mike Young's** last **two** shooting guards, **Hunter Cattoor** (VT: 274) and **Fletcher Magee** (Wofford: 509), have set their respective school's 3-point record. Magee ranks 3rd all-time nationally.

# **NOTEWORTHY**

#### **WE NEED THE BEST OF SEAN PEDULLA**

- Tech point guard Sean Pedulla struggled on The Plains Wednesday, going 0 for 9, a season-low four points and committing a career-high seven turnovers.
- "You know how good he is, you know how important he is to our team," Mike Young said of Pedulla. "I take a lot of responsibility there. I've got to get to him. He's tough. He has great intentions. He's pressing. He's struggling. We all go through tough spells as players. I went through more than others [at Emory & Henry]; I wasn't very good. I'll get him taken care of. He'll be in the gym [Thursday] working on it. We need the best of Sean Pedulla. We both know that."

#### **CHALLENGING STRETCH**

 Tech faced its third top-30 ranked team in less than a week, according to KenPom, at Auburn on Wednesday.

- When looking at adjusted defensive efficiency, lowa State (eighth) and Auburn (11th) are two of the top defensive teams the Hokies face this season.
- Against Auburn, Tech had its second-worst shooting performance (27.5%) and the most turnovers (21) of the Mike Young era. The Tigers converted those 21 miscues into a 30-5 advantage in points off turnovers.

#### **CRASHING THE GLASS**

- Mekhi Long has led the Hokies in rebounding each of their last three games.
- The 6-foot-7 forward pulled down eight boards against Iowa State, a game-high nine rebounds against FAU and seven rebounds at Auburn.
- Long has a knack for rebounding, which was one of the skills that led to the Tech coaching staff pursuing him in the transfer portal.
- He averaged 8.7 rebounds per game last season at Old Dominion.

#### **DOUBLING DOWN ON DEFENSE**

- The Hokies ramped up its defense down the stretch during their wins against Boise State and Iowa State.
- Against the Broncos, the Hokies converted

16 BSU turnovers into 27 points. Boise State shot 31.3% (5-16) over the final 15 minutes of the game.

- Against the Cyclones, VT held lowa State to 3 of 10 shooting over the final six minutes, including a 1 for 6 clip from beyond the arc.
- The Hokies entered the ESPN Events Invitational ranked 126th in adjusted defensive efficiency, according to Ken Pomeroy. Following its two wins, Tech climbed up to 101.
- "We defended very well," Mike Young said after the Iowa State win. "We were really good. We were really connected, really physical. And that's a pleasure to see this time of year."

#### **NOT KIDDING AROUND**

 Lynn Kidd is one of the breakout stories in the ACC early on. From a player who only saw action in seven games his freshman season at Clemson\*, to averaging 15.9 points and 8.0 rebounds per game as a senior at Virginia Tech, Mike Young and his staff have developed a force to be reckoned with down low.

- Against Wofford, Kidd produced 20 points, seven rebounds, three assists and zero turnovers.
- He became just the sixth Hokie to record that stat line in program history, joining Keve Aluma, Malcolm Delaney, A.D. Vassallo, Zabian Dowdell and Shawn Smith.
- Prior to this season, Kidd had never recorded a double-double. He produced two in the first three games. The senior posted 14 points and 11 rebounds against Coppin State in the season opener and career highs of 24 points and 15 rebounds against Campbell.
- Kidd became the first Tech men's basketball

player under Mike Young to record at least 15 rebounds; the last VT player to do it was Kerry Blackshear Jr., who had 16 against Duke in the Sweet Sixteen game in Washington, D.C., on March 29, 2019.

#### **HISTORY MADE IN HIS HOMETOWN**

 Hunter Cattoor surpassed A.D. Vassallo for the most 3-pointers made in a career in program history against Boise State on Nov. 23. The record came in Cattoor's hometown of Orlando and was achieved in nine fewer games than Vassallo.

- Sean Pedulla reached double-figure scoring in each of his first 18 games of the 2022-23 season. Pedulla was the first Hokie to do that since Erick Green scored double figures in all 32 games of the 2012-13 season.

#### **BREAKOUT YEAR LOADING?**

- MJ Collins was thrust into the starting lineup as a freshman a year ago, and while there were growing pains, head coach Mike Young knew it would pay off in the long run.
- "He is poised to have an even finer sophomore year. He's bigger and stronger. I've challenged him to be a go-to defender," Young said. "He's worked really hard on his perimeter shooting."
- In preparation for guarding the opponent's best perimeter player, Collins has been chasing around Cattoor in practice.
- "It's not only going to benefit him but benefit our team," Cattoor said of Collins. "Coach
  challenges him, I challenge him. Every time we're in practice and we're on separate teams, I
  always want him to come guard me. I want to make it as hard as possible for him. In practice, I
  want to guard him and make it as hard as possible for him. But it's going to help him grow.
- "He's a competitor, he's going to fight. He's not afraid to make mistakes, which is ultimately
  going to make him better. It's going to be good for us to slide me off of the best player and
  have him do it. ... He's taken great strides from last year and I'm excited for him this year."
- Going back to the experience Collins gained from his first season in Blacksburg, the Clover,
   S.C., native ranked seventh among freshmen in the ACC in minutes per game.

#### **SHENANDOAH VALLEY STAND UP!**

- Tyler Nickel hails from Harrisonburg, Va., in the Shenandoah Valley, the home region of two other Commonwealth basketball greats in Dell Curry and Ralph Sampson. Curry went on to play at Virginia Tech, finishing as the program's No. 2 all-time leading scorer with 2,385 career points and was drafted by the Utah Jazz in 1986. Sampson was a three-time national player of the year at Virginia, before being drafted as the No. 1 overall pick in the 1983 NBA Draft.
- However, it is Nickel who is the Virginia High School League's all-time leading scorer with 2,909 career points, passing the likes of Mac McClung, J.J. Redick, Moses Malone, Alonzo Mourning, Grant Hill and Allen Iverson on the way to the top.

#### **DANCIN' IN BACK-TO-BACK SEASONS**

- In previous seasons in Virginia Tech history, the fastest head coach to make the NCAA Tournament was in Year Three. Those Hokies were Howie Shannon, Charlie Moir and Buzz Williams.
- Therefore, with Mike Young doing so in Year Two, he became the fastest Tech coach to make The Dance.
- The Hokies have also never had a head coach lead them to the NCAA Tournament in two of their first three seasons.
- Mike Young becomes just the third head coach in program history to register multiple trips to the NCAA Tournament, joining Charlie Moir and Buzz Williams.

#### **ONE BIG FAMILY**

**Head Coach** 

- The camaraderie between the VT men's and women's basketball teams as described by Hunter Cattoor:
- "I'd say it's like a whole big family there. We play and practice in the same facility, so we see them every day, whether that's working out on our own time or during lift and practice. We see them all around. We're saying hey to them. I know Coach Brooks is doing a great job over there with that team. But I look at them as family. ... I think it's great for both programs to be together and support each other and want each other to do well."

#### **50 SPOT**

- Tech shot over 50% in a game five times during the 2020-21 season going 5-0.
- Since Young got to Blacksburg, the Hokies are 36-5 in contests shooting 50% or greater only losses: vs. BYU (11/27/19), vs.

- Miami (1/26/22), at College of Charleston (11/20/22), at Miami (1/31/23), vs. South Carolina (11/10/23).
- Since the 2010-11 season, Tech is 107-16 when shooting 50% or better.

#### **COACH HUNT**

- Mike Young had never let a player install a play before in his 38 years of coaching.
   He'd never had a player like Hunter Cattoor before, though.
- "He wants to be a coach," Young said on Oct. 3. "I had him install [a play] yesterday.
   I don't think I've ever done that in 38 years as a coach.
- "He commands a great deal of admiration and respect for what he's done here. [It] permeates throughout the program. I think he has embraced that and has done quite a good job thus far, and it'll be very important for this bunch."
- With defense being a point of emphasis for the entire Tech team heading into the season, Cattoor's tutelage will be crucial

   and the teaching role is one he hopes to continue into the future. H/T Jack

   Brizendine

#### **FOCUSED ON TEAM SUCCESS**

- As Cattoor wraps up his career in Blacksburg this season, his focus will be on getting the team back to the top of the ACC

   and he knows everyone's personal goals will come to fruition in the process.
- "At the end of the day, you want to go out on a high note. You want to compete for another ACC championship. You want to make it to the big dance and make a run," he said.
- "I think that's just the main thing to worry about — team success — and the individual success will come along." H/T Jack Brizendine

#### **BYERS BOUGHT IN ON DEFENSIVE END**

- J.D. Byers was hired as an assistant coach in April, bringing 13 years of experience at the Division I level with him to Blacksburg. He worked three stints with current Penn State head coach Mike Rhoades, most recently at VCU from 2017 to 2023.
- According to KenPom, VCU ranked 15th in adjusted defensive efficiency last season. Its three rankings the previous four seasons: seventh, 14th, 45th and seventh. Tech has only posted a top-40 defense five times since joining the ACC in 2004, the last time being 2019-20 under Buzz Williams (No. 20). H/T David Cunningham
- Though he wasn't necessarily the main reason why the Rams were so stingy on defense, Byers brought those lessons to Blacksburg. He watched Tech's games from last season through a unique lens since he wasn't involved, and the players said his feedback in specific areas has really helped.



# WHAT'S A HOKIE?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.

Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of

his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The official university school colors - Chicago Maroon and Burnt Orange - also were introduced in 1896. The colors were chosen by a committee because they made a 'unique combination' not worn elsewhere at the time. The official definition of "Hokie" is "a loyal Virginia Tech Fan."




