About Today's Game

The Hokies enter the game 14-2 on the season and 3-1 in ACC play ... The Demon Deacons are 8-8 this season and 1-3 in the ACC ... The Hokies are ranked ninth in the AP poll and seventh in the USA Today Coaches poll.

Last Game: #4/1 UVa 81, #9/7 VT 59

The Hokies dropped their first ACC game at No. 4/1 Virginia, 81-59, on Monday night ... **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** led the Hokies with 19 points and **Ahmed Hill** added 14 points ... Tech was out rebounded 27-19 and the Cavaliers made 13 three-pointers in the game.

Vs. Wake Forest

The Hokies lead the all-time series against Wake Forest, 34-31 ... Tech has won the last two meetings with the Demon Deacons and five of the last six ... Tech won the lone meeting last season, 83-75, in the Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum in Winston-Salem on Jan. 10 ... Tech is 22-11 at home against the Deacs and 14-8 in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech is 5-2 against Wake Forest under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech is 11-7 against Wake Forest in ACC regular season games and 1-1 in ACC Tournament games ... Tech is 14-18 all-time on Jan. 19 and 2-3 in ACC games on this date ... Tech is 8-3 in home games on Jan. 19 ... Tech is 1-0 against Wake Forest on this date, a 66-65 win in Cassell Coliseum in 2013.

More About VT-WF Series

Along with Blacksburg and Winston-Salem, the Hokies and Demon Deacons have played in Greensboro, Roanoke, Tampa, Raleigh and Wake Forest, North Carolina ... Wake Forest is geographically the closest ACC school to Blacksburg.

Getting Closer

In the win over Notre Dame, **Justin Robinson** moved past Jamon Gordon into third place in career assists at Virginia Tech ... He and Gordon, along with Bimbo Coles and Malcolm Delaney, are the only Virginia Tech players with 500 career assists ... He now has 531 career assists and trails Delaney by 12 assists for second place and Coles by 16 assists for first place on the all-time list.

Winning Low

When the Hokies defeated Georgia Tech, 52-49, on Jan. 9 in Atlanta, it marked the fewest points for the Hokies in an ACC regular season victory since defeating Miami, 52-45 in Blacksburg on Feb. 2014 ... The last time the Hokies scored fewer than 52 points in an ACC victory was on Jan. 22, 2012, when the Hokies won 47-45 over No. 15 Virginia in Charlottesville ... The Georgia Tech win was just the third time the Hokies have won an ACC regular season game with 52 points or fewer.

They are Free

The Hokies enter tonight's game having made 190 of 256 free throw attempts (74.2 percent) ... Tech has made 129 of its last 166 attempts (77.7 percent) ... In the win over BC, the Hokies made 21 of 25 from the line, for 84.0 percent, season highs in all three categories ... Two Hokies, **Ahmed Hill** (93.3 percent) and **Justin Robinson** (80.0 percent) are shooting better than 80 percent from the line ... Tech has made better than 80 percent from the line in six of 16 games so far this season ... Tech is shooting 78.8 percent from the line in ACC games ... Tech has made 66 more free throws than its opponent and three more free throws than its opponents have attempted.

Wrapping Up the 1st UVa Game

The 46 total rebounds in the game was the lowest rebound total in a Virginia Tech game this season and the lowest total in a Tech game since Tech and Boston College combined for 45 rebounds on Feb. 25, 2017 ... Tech is now 1-1 this season against ranked teams ... The Hokies shot 82.4 percent (14-of-17) from the free throw line, third time in four ACC games Tech has shot better than 80 percent from the line.

NAW on the Lists

Virginia Tech guard **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** has been named to both the Lute Olson Award and John R. Wooden Award Midseason Watch Lists ... He is also on the Oscar Robertson Trophy Midseason Watch List ... He was named to *The Sporting News'* Midseason All-American third team ... The awards are given annually to the nation's top player.

Much Improved

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is third-best among ACC players in improved scoring average from last year to this year ... The sophomore averaged 10.7 points per game as a freshman and is currently at 17.9 ppg, for an increase of 7.2 points per game ... He is the only listed player to have averaged double figures last season.

Take a 3, Make a 3

Virginia Tech is fourth nationally and leads the ACC in three-point field goal percentage, at 41.8 percent ... Tech leads the ACC and is 18th nationally in three-point field goals made per game, at 10.0 ... Tech has made at least 10 three-pointers in 10 of the 16 games this season, including a school-record 18 made three-pointers in the win over Central Connecticut State ... The top individual in three-point field goal percentage in the ACC is **Ty Outlaw**.

Assisting for the Score

In the win at Georgia Tech, the Hokies assisted on 12 of the teams 17 made baskets, for 70.6 percent ... This was the seventh time this season that the Hokies had assisted on at least 60 percent of their made field goals and the fourth time that number has exceeded 70 percent ... In the win over Central Connecticut State, Tech assisted on 77.8 percent of its made baskets ... Tech is averaging 60.2 percent for the season on assists per made field goals.

The 40s

Virginia Tech has held its opponents to less than 50 points five times this season ... This is the first season since the 2007-08 season that the Hokies have accomplished that feat ... Tech opponents are averaging 58.8 points per game this season.

Climbing the Lists

Justin Robinson passed Sumner Tilson in the UVa game and is now in 29th place on the career scoring list at 1,265 and **Ahmed Hill** passed Dorenzo Hudson in the win at Georgia Tech and is in 33rd place with 1,219.

Selling Out the Cassell

Virginia Tech has announced in the last week that the home games against Virginia and Wake Forest have sold out ... Games against Duke, Syracuse and Miami have also sold out ... Earlier this season, the Central Connecticut State game was a sell out ... The Hokies sold out nine games in the 2017-18 season, including seven of the nine home ACC games ... Single game tickets for Tech's other home games are still available ... Virginia Tech's ACC single game tickets are on sale now.

Vs. Ranked Teams

The Hokies are 1-1 against ranked teams this season ... The Hokies were 4-3 against ranked teams last season and 3-6 in the 2016-17 season ... The seven combined wins against nationally-ranked teams in the two previous season are the most in a two-year span in school history ... The wins over No. 10 UNC and No. 2 Virginia last season marked the first time Tech won two straight against top 10 teams since winning three straight against top 10 teams in 2007 ... The win at UVa was Tech's second-ever against a team ranked second and first since 1986 ... Tech's last previous road win against a ranked team was on Jan. 22, 2012, when Tech defeated No. 15 Virginia in John Paul Jones Arena.

Where It Counts the Most

While the Hokies have gotten off to a great start on the court, their fall semester in the class room was even better ... Ten Hokies recorded at least a 3.00 grade point average, as the team recorded a 3.22 overall GPA, the best semester in program history ... Two Hokies, **Ty Outlaw** and

and **Ahmed Hill** entered the semester with their undergraduate degrees and two more, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, and **Justin Robinson**, completed their requirements for graduation and will walk in Spring 2019 ceremonies.

Pomp and a Neat Circumstance

When the Hokies tipped off at Georgia Tech in its most recent game, Tech starters were a rather unique group ... Four of the five starters, **Ty Outlaw**, **Ahmed Hill**, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, and **Justin Robinson** had all completed their requirements for graduation.

Now Boarding

Ty Outlaw missed his first career double-double in the win over VMI by one point ... The sixth-year player grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds, the most boards by a Tech player this season ... Outlaw, who missed last season with a knee injury, averaged 2.8 rebounds per game in the 2016-17 season, but has increased that to 5.0 boards per game this year.

Hitting the Boards

Virginia Tech grabbed a season-high 42 rebounds in the win over North Carolina A&T, out rebounding the Aggies, 42-20 ... That's the most rebounds in a game for the Hokies since grabbing 42 rebounds in the win over Maryland-Eastern Shore on Dec. 10, 2017 ... The last time the Hokies had more than 42 rebounds in a game was 51 rebounds against The Citadel on Nov. 12, 2017 ... The 22-rebound difference also dates back to the win over The Citadel last season, when the Hokies out rebounded the Bulldogs, 51-24 ... Tech grabbed 39 rebounds in the win over Boston College, the most rebounds for the Hokies in an ACC game since grabbing 41 rebounds in a home overtime win against Virginia on Feb. 12, 2017 ... The last time Tech grabbed more than 39 rebounds in a non-overtime ACC game was on Feb. 3, 2015, when Tech grabbed 40 rebounds at Syracuse.

Analytics and All

As of Jan. 18th, the Hokies are ranked seventh by Kenpom.com ... Tech second nationally in defensive three-point field goal percentage, third in three-point percentage, fourth in effective field goal percentage, defensive free throw rate and raw offensive efficiency and seventh in adjusted offensive efficiency ... Tech is 10th in raw defensive efficiency and defensive turnover rate, 21st in steal percentage and 23rd in assist percentage ... **P.J. Horne** is 28th in two-point percentage ... **Ty Outlaw** is 38th in three-point percentage and 46th in effective field goal percentage ... **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** is 50th in steal percentage.

Buzz Williams Facts

Buzz Williams is in his fifth season at Virginia Tech ... He has a record of 241-148 in his 12th season as a collegiate head coach ... He is 88-62 at Virginia Tech ... With the 88 wins, Williams is now tied with Don DeVoe for sixth in career wins at Virginia Tech.

KJ Doubles

In the win over South Carolina State, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, recorded his first double-double of the season, with 12 points and 13 rebounds ... Blackshear's double-double is the first for the Hokies this season and the first by any Hokie since **Justin Robinson** had 10 points and 12 assists at Boston College on Jan. 31, 2018 ... The 13 rebounds are the most by a Hokie this season ... He had his second double-double of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds in the win at Georgia Tech.

Getting on Track

In the win over Saint Francis, **Ty Outlaw** was 5-of-9 from three-point range ... Outlaw entered the game with just four made three-pointers in the first four games combined ... Outlaw followed that by going 4-of-5 from behind the arc at Penn State and followed that with a 3-of-5 effort in the win over Central Connecticut State ... Outlaw holds the Virginia Tech record for most three-pointers in a game, with eight against Miami two years ago ... He is 91-of-188 in this Tech career, for 48.4 percent.

Commonwealth Notes

Virginia Tech is 433-318 (.577) all-time against schools from Virginia ... Tech is 1-1 against Virginia schools this season and was 2-1 last season ... The Hokies have played 14 schools from the state all-time ... The only state Division I school that Tech has not played is Hampton ... Tech holds winning records against 10 of the schools and even records against two others ... The win over VMI on Dec. 5 was the 750th all-time game against Virginia schools.

That's a TO

Virginia Tech forced Gardner-Webb into 29 turnovers in the season-opener ... That is the most forced turnovers for the Hokies under **Buzz Williams** ... The 29 forced turnovers are the most by a Virginia Tech team since forcing UNC Greensboro into 29 turnovers on Nov. 21, 2010 in the Greensboro Coliseum ... The last time the Hokies forced 30-or-more turnovers in a game was 35 forced turnovers against Maryland-Eastern Shore on Nov. 23, 2004 in Cassell Coliseum ... The school record is 37 forced turnovers, twice, most recently against VMI in 1983 ... Tech has forced its opponents into double figure turnovers in all but one game this season.

Tech in NCAA Stats

As of Jan. 18, the Hokies are fourth nationally in three-point field goal percentage and scoring defense and fifth in scoring margin ... Tech is 12th in assist turnover ratio and turnover margin, 17th in field goal percentage and 18th in three-point field goals per game ... **Ahmed Hill** is 31st in three-point field goal percentage ... **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** is 41st in steals per game ... **Justin Robinson** is 40th in assists per game.

Tech in the Polls

The Virginia Tech Hokies are currently ranked ninth in the AP poll, the school's highest AP ranking since the 1995-96 season ... Tech peaked that season in late February at No. 8, its all-time highest ranking ... The last time the Hokies played a game ranked ninth or higher was on Jan. 27, 1996, an 81-57 win over Fordham in Cassell Coliseum when the Hokies were ranked eighth ... Tech is seventh in the USA Today Coaches poll.

New Tech Record

In the win over Central Connecticut State, **Justin Robinson** dished out a career-high 13 assists, breaking the old school mark of 12 assists in a game, most recently set by Robinson at Boston College last season ... Others with 12 assists in a game include Dave Sensibaugh, Bimbo Coles and Troy Manns ... It is the fourth time he has had double figures in assists in a game ... Robinson accomplished the feat in just 28 minutes of action.

BIG Again This Season

The Hokies will host two ESPN "Big Monday" games ... The Feb. 4 game against Louisville and the Feb. 18 game against Virginia will both be part of the popular package ... In addition, the Hokies' game at North Carolina on Monday, Jan. 21 will also be a "Big Monday" game ... Tech was 2-0 in "Big Monday" games last season, both at home and both against top 10 teams ... Last season was the first year the Hokies had ever been part of the "Big Monday" package.

Ah, Youth

Isaiah Wilkins is the 10th-youngest player in Division I basketball this season and the fourth-youngest among Power 6 players ... Wilkins was born on September 29, 2000.

More About Wilkins

Isaiah Wilkins was 5-of-7 from three-point range in the win over Gardner-Webb ... That is the most three-pointers in a game by a Virginia Tech freshman since Justin Bibbs was 5-of-6 from three-point range in a win over Miami of Ohio in the 2014-15 season ... The school record for three-pointers in a game by a freshman at Virginia Tech is six, by Carlos Dixon against High Point on Dec. 30, 2000.

Hot, Hot, Hot!

In the win over Maryland Eastern Shore, the Hokies shot a season-best 65.9 percent from the field ... The last time Tech shot better than 65.9 percent from the field was 68.6 percent in the win over The Citadel last season on Nov. 12, 2017 ... Tech is second in the ACC, shooting 51.8 percent from the field this season ... The 65.9 percent is the best by an ACC school this season.

Hot, Hot, Hot!, Part II

Virginia Tech shot 60.0 percent from the floor, including 61.1 percent from three-point range in the win over Notre Dame ... That is the highest field goal percentage against ACC competition since Tech shot 63.5 percent in a home win over NC State last season ... The 61.1 percent from three-point range is the highest against ACC competition since the Hokies shot 66.7 percent from three in the win at Boston College on Feb. 25, 2017.

Hokies' Non-Con

The Hokies' 11 non-conference wins in the last three seasons are tied for the best at Virginia Tech since the ACC went to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2012-13 season.

Virginia Tech head coach **Buzz Williams** announced on Nov. 4 that **Tyrece Radford** will redshirt the 2018-19 season ... The 6-2 freshman guard from Baton Rouge, Louisiana will have four years of eligibility beginning next season.

514 and Counting

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 514 consecutive games ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

Working Overtime

The 61-60 overtime win at No. 2/2 Virginia was Tech's third overtime game last season, all three Tech victories ... Tech is now 68-49 overall in overtime games and 8-3 in overtime games under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech is 30-11 in home overtime games and 18-8 in overtime in ACC games ... Tech is 29-25 in road overtime games.

Gimme That!

Virginia Tech recorded 16 steals in the win over Gardner-Webb ... That is the most steals in a game since Nov. 21, 2010, when Tech forced UNC Greensboro into 20 steals ... The 16 steals are the most in a game for the Hokies under **Buzz Williams** and just the sixth time that Tech has had double figure steals in a game under Williams ... That number moved up to eight times with double-digit steals with the 13 steals in the win over South Carolina State.

Big Week for NAW

Nickeil Alexander-Walker earned big props following his performance in the Charleston Classic ... In leading the Hokies to the title, Alexander-Walker was named the Most Valuable Player, joining teammate **Justin Robinson** on the all-tournament team ... On Monday, Nov. 19, Alexander-Walker was named the ACC Player of the Week for the first time in his career ... His 25 points in the win over Purdue was his second-highest career point total.

Preseason Rankings

Virginia Tech was ranked No. 15 in the AP Top 25 preseason poll ... The Hokies made the AP preseason poll for the first time since the beginning of the 2010-11 season when Tech was ranked No. 21 to open the season ... The No. 15 ranking tied the Hokies' best ever preseason ranking ... Tech was ranked 15th entering the 1984-85 season, while coming off a 22-13 season that saw Tech reach the semifinals of the 1984 NIT.

Home is Where the Wins Are

Since **Buzz Williams** arrived in Blacksburg for the 2014-15 season, Tech is 61-20 (.753) in Cassell Coliseum and is 52-11 (.825) since the beginning of the 2015-16 season ... Tech has won a school-record 24 consecutive home non-conference regular season games ... The nine non-con home wins last season are second-best at Virginia Tech since the Hokies joined the Metro Conference in 1978.

About Attendance

Virginia Tech has increased percentage of capacity in each of the last four seasons ... Tech ranked seventh in percent of capacity in the ACC last season at 83 percent ... The year before, the Hokies were eighth at 76 percent ... This past season, the Hokies had an average attendance of 7,678, up from 7,476 the year before and 5,744 in the 2014-15 season ... Tech is second in average attendance growth in the ACC over the past four seasons, with a 34 percent increase in attendance, trailing only Miami ... Season ticket sales increased by more than 1,000 last season and has a 62 percent increase in sales in the past four seasons ... Tech had an all-time high of 6,107 season tickets sold last season ... Tech is averaging 7,430 in Cassell Coliseum this season.

Call It a Comeback

In the win over No. 5 Duke, the Hokies came back from a 15-point first half deficit ... It was the second-largest deficit Tech overcame last season, as the Hokies fought back from a 16-point second half deficit at Ole Miss ... The Duke comeback was the largest in an ACC game since coming back from a 16-point deficit to defeat NC State in the first conference game of the 2015-16 season ... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 91-87 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech's largest come-from-behind victory this season is 12 points against No. 23/22 Purdue.

December was a Good Month

Virginia Tech finished 6-0 in December ... Tech was 5-1 last December, with only a loss at No. 8 Kentucky marring the record ... The last time the Hokies had an undefeated December was the 2016-17 season, when the Hokies were 6-0 in the month, that included a home win on New Year's Eve over No. 5 Duke to open the ACC schedule.

Getting Better All the Time

In the win over VMI, **P.J. Horne** had, perhaps, his best game as a Hokie ... The sophomore scored a season-high 12 points on 6-of-6 from the field and added five rebounds in 26 minutes of action ... Horne was making his second consecutive start of the season ... Horne topped that performance with 13 points and six rebounds in just 22 minutes of action in the win over North Carolina A&T, making 5-of-6 from the field ... Horne has made 24 of his last 29 field goal attempts, for 82.8 percent ... Horne is shooting 64.6 percent from the field this season ... Horne's dunk in the win over Notre Dame was a viral sensation on the internet.

Top Returner

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is one of only seven returning sophomores in the Power 6 to start every game during their rookie season and one of just two in the ACC ... Last season, 30 freshmen in the Power Five and BIG EAST started 25 or more games for their squads, including Alexander-Walker ... Among that group, arguably the best sophomores in the country, Alexander-Walker had the third-best 3-point field goal percentage, trailing Stanford's Daejon Davis (.403) and Wigginton (.401).

Keep It Low

The Hokies held St. Francis to 37 points ... That is the fewest points allowed under **Buzz Williams** and the fewest since allowing Mount St. Mary's 34 points in a 99-34 win over the Mountaineers on Jan. 2, 2011 in Cassell Coliseum ... It is the second-fewest points allowed by an ACC team this season ... Tech allowed SFU just 15 points in the second half, the fewest points allowed in a half under Williams and the fewest points allowed in any half since allowing Miami just 15 points in the first half on Feb. 15, 2014 ... The last time Tech allowed fewer than 15 points in a half was on Dec. 22, 2011, when Tech allowed Eastern Michigan just nine first half points ... Tech held Central Connecticut State and Maryland Eastern Shore to 40 points and South Carolina State to 41 points ... Tech is holding its opponents to 49.7 points per game in home games thus far this season.

Through the Non-Con Slate

The Hokies finished with an 11-1 non-conference record ... This is the third consecutive season the Hokies have won 11 non-conference games ... The 11-1 start is tied for the best-ever through 12 games for the Hokies since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season and since becoming a "Power 6" team in the 2000-01 season.

Head Coach Buzz Williams

Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad is in his fifth season in Blacksburg and has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now beginning his 12th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 241-148. Williams has compiled a 88-62 record, now in his fifth season in Blacksburg.

To cap off the 2017-18 season,

the Hokies made a second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, the first time the school could claim that in more than three decades. The Hokies finished the season 21-12 overall and 10-8 in the ACC. Tech made it three consecutive 20-win season and three consecutive 10-win ACC seasons.

The Hokies took care of business in the regular season. They defeated four nationally-ranked teams for the first time in school history, including three wins against top 10 programs. The Hokies also finished 11-2 in the non-conference regular season slate.

The 2016-17 season was their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned its first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 record in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of

healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2018-19 will mark his 12th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New

Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season

as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
