BOSTON COLLEGE VS. VIRGINIA TECH - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game marks the 31st meeting between the two schools.
- Boston College is 18-12 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.
- In ACC play, the Eagles are 12-10 versus the Hokies.
- BC is 7-7 all-time at Cassell Coliseum against Virginia Tech.
- From 2000-04, both teams were members of the Big East.
- Boston College was 6-1 against Virginia Tech in Big East play.
- The Eagles have lost their last four matchups vs. the Hokies.
- In the last meeting, BC lost, 85-80, in OT at home on Feb. 1, 2018
- BC's last win over VT was on March 2, 2015 at Cassell Coliseum.

BOSTON COLLEGE IN ACC PLAY

- Boston College is 77-143 in 13 seasons in the ACC.
- The Eagles finished with a 7-11 record in ACC play last year - the most conference wins since the 2012-13 season.
- The Eagles' best ACC mark came in its inaugural season, going 11-5 in conference play in 2005-06 en route to a third place finish.
- BC tied for third in 2006-07 (10-6) and fourth in 2010-11 (9-7).
- Boston College is 7-6 all-time in ACC openers.
- The Eagles won their ACC opener in 2017-18 with an 89-84 win over #1 Duke at Conte Forum on Dec. 9, 2017.

KY BOWMAN: THE NATION'S MOST DYNAMIC GUARD

- **Ky Bowman is the only player in the country averaging at least: 20.9 points, 7.8 rebounds, 3.5 assists, 1.6 steals, and 0.9 blocks per game.**
- **It is the most well-rounded stat line in 26 years of Division I basketball.**
- In 1992-93, Penny Hardaway of Memphis posted at least that stat line (21.0 ppg/8.5 rpg/6.4 apg/2.5 spg/1.2 bpg).
- Last year, Bowman was the only player in the country to average at least 17.6 points, 6.8 rebounds, and 4.7 assists per game.
- Since the 1990-91 season, only 10 players have registered at least those season averages.
- *One of those players was National Player of the Year - Denzel Valentine of Michigan State in 2016.*
- *Three were top three NBA Draft picks:* Ben Simmons, LSU (#1, 2016); Evan Turner, Ohio State (#2, 2010); and Hardaway, Memphis (#3, 1993).
- *Five were first round NBA Draft picks:* Simmons; Turner; Hardaway; Valentine (#14, 2016); Bob Sura, FSU (#17, 1995).
- *Seven were named their conference's Player of the Year:* Valentine (2015-16); Hardaway (1991-92); Turner (2009-10); Trenton Hassell, Austin Peay (1999-2000); Ricky Minard, Morehead State (2002-03); T.J. Cline, Richmond (2016-17); Patrick Cole N.C. Central (2016-17).
- *Nine of the 10 earned Associated Press All-American honors.*

WYNSTON TABBS: ADDING ANOTHER DYNAMIC TO BOSTON COLLEGE BACKCOURT

- Wynston Tabbs is the only freshman nationally to average 14.6 points, 4.3 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and 1.2 steals/game.
- He is one of 32 players nationally and four in the ACC - Ky Bowman, Marquise Reed (Clemson), and Nickeil Alexander-Walker (VT) to post that stat line.
- The Suitland, Md. native ranks fifth in the ACC and 28th nationally among all freshmen in scoring.
- In each of the nine games which Tabbs has reached double figures, he has scored at least 15 points.
- Tabbs scored 13 of his 15 at DePaul in the second half, including 10 straight points during a 1:54 stretch as BC took its first lead.

KY BOWMAN GOES FOR 44 POINTS VS. HARTFORD, PT. I

- Ky Bowman poured in a career-high 44 points (14-23 FG; 5-8 3FG; 11-14 FT) vs. Hartford on Dec. 31.
- It is the sixth-highest single-game scoring performance in Boston College history. It was also the 13th 40-point game in BC history.
- The 44 points were the second-most in Conte Forum history, bested only by Tyrese Rice's 46 points vs. UNC on March 1, 2008.
- Bowman's 44 points were the most by a BC player since Jerome Robinson went for 46 points at Notre Dame on Feb. 6, 2018.
- His 14 FG made tied for the second-most in a game by a BC player, trailing Robinson's 15 from last season's at Notre Dame.
- Since the ACC's inaugural season in 1953-54, there have been 108 40-point games by 58 different players.

KY BOWMAN GOES FOR 44 POINTS VS. HARTFORD, PT. II

- In addition to his 44 points vs. Hartford, Ky Bowman tallied his fourth double-double of the season by grabbing 10 rebounds.
- It is the first 44/10 game nationally since Davidson's Peyton Aldridge had 45 and 12 at St. Bonaventure on Feb. 27, 2018.
- Since the 1996-97 season, 24 total players have had at least 44 points and 10 boards in a single game.
- Bowman also registered a career-high five steals and blocked two shots in 45 minutes of play in the Hartford game.
- **Dating back to the 1996-97 season, he is the only player to post that statistical line in a box score.**

TODAY'S BOSTON COLLEGE NOTE(S) YOU CAN'T LIVE WITHOUT

- Ky Bowman is one of three players in the ACC to rank among the top 10 in scoring (2nd, 20.9) and rebounding (9th, 7.8).
- Zion Williamson of Duke (4th, 19.8ppg; 2nd, 9.4 rpg) and Jordan Nwora of Louisville (7th, 17.8 ppg; 5th, 8.3 rpg) are the others.
- Boston College is the only school in the ACC with three players averaging 7.5 rebounds per game or more.
- Wynston Tabbs (44-52, 84.6%), Jordan Chatman (31-37, 83.8%), and Ky Bowman (61-74, 82.4%) are shooting a combined 83.4% (136-163) from the free throw line this season. The rest of the team is connecting at a 54.9% clip (89-162).

ON THIS DATE: JANUARY 5

- Boston College is 10-12 all-time and 0-1 in ACC play in games played on the January 5 calendar date.
- The January 5 calendar date also marks the dual celebration of National Bird and National Whipped Cream Day.
- Several historic events occurred on January 5 - 1886: Robert Louis Stevenson's "Curious Case of Dr. Jekyll & Mr. Hyde" published; 1903: the San Francisco-Hawaii telegraph opens for public use; 1925: Nellie Taylor Ross becomes the first female governor of a U.S. state (Wyoming); 1930: Bonnie Parker first meets Clyde Barrow; 1933: work begins on the Marin County side on the construction of the Golden Gate Bridge.
- Notable January 5 birthdays: actor Bradley Cooper; choreographer Alvin Ailey; actress Diane Keaton; former U.S. Vice President Walter Mondale.

FOR THE ANALYTICS CROWD

- So far this season, Boston College has had four single-game efficiency ratings of 30 or more.
- Efficiency rating is calculated using the following formula: $(PTS + REB + AST + STL + BLK - Missed Shots - TO)$
- Ky Bowman set the season high-mark vs. Hartford, with an efficiency rating of 45.
- Wynston Tabbs held the previous season high, with an EFF rating of 38 against Sacred Heart on Nov. 29.
- Versus Columbia, both Nik Popovic (32) and Bowman (30) recorded at least a mark of 30.

MEN'S BASKETBALL LAUNCHES THE MANDARIN MINUTE

- Boston College men's basketball is proud to introduce a new video series called "The Mandarin Minute."
- Hosted by manager Siqi Wang and guard Jordan Chatman, the Mandarin Minute provides the latest Boston College men's basketball news in the most widely spoken dialect in China. Wang is a communications major and native of Shanghai.
- Chatman learned Mandarin as part of his two-year mission in Taiwan with the Church of Jesus Christ and Latter-day Saints. It is the language he primarily speaks at home with his wife Chelsea.
- Chatman: "It's always special anytime I have the opportunity to speak the Mandarin language knowing the struggles it took to learn it. This is a fun opportunity for me to share BC basketball with my Mandarin-speaking friends in Asia, the U.S., and many others."
- Enrollment of Chinese students at Boston College currently stands at 469 undergraduates and 927 total, including graduate programs. Chinese students make up close to 50% of BC's total international student population.

CHRIS HERREN JR. AWARDED SCHOLARSHIP

- Following the Eagles' practice on Thursday, Dec. 20, head coach Jim Christian freshman Chris Herren Jr. a full scholarship.
- Jim Christian on Herren Jr.: "I was happy to award Chris a scholarship because he has proven to be a high-caliber young man who fits the culture of our program to a tee. It has as much to do with way he carries himself off the court as the way he has played on the court. I am so proud of him."
- Herren Jr., who enrolled at Boston College in July, had previously been classified a walk-on.
- Through 11 games this season (three starts), Herren Jr. is averaging 5.5 points and leads the team in 3FG% (43.3).
- The Portsmouth, R.I. native scored a season-high 22 points (8-13 FG; 4-7 3FG) against Fairfield on Dec. 16.
- As a starter (four games), Chris Herren Jr. is averaging 11.3 points and 3.0 rebounds while shooting 34.8% from 3-point land.

I'LL TAKE "BUCKET GETTERS," FOR \$200, ALEX

- Boston College has had three different players score at least 28 points in a game in each of the last three seasons.
- So far this season, Ky Bowman, Jordan Chatman, and Wynston Tabbs have registered at least one 28-point performance.
- Bowman had 38 vs. Wyoming and 44 vs. Hartford, Tabbs 28 vs. Sacred Heart, and Chatman 28 against Providence.
- During 2016-17 and 2017-18, Bowman, Chatman, and Jerome Robinson each had at least 28 points in a single game.

DOUBLE DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- Nik Popovic and Ky Bowman have each registered double-doubles in the same game on three occasions.
- Last time out vs. Hartford, Bowman (44 pts/10 reb) and Popovic (13 pts/10 reb) each recorded a double-double.
- Against Columbia, Popovic and Bowman became the first BC pair to tally a double-double in the same game in 12 years.
- Popovic registered career-highs in points (22) and rebounds (14), while Bowman added 24 points and 10 boards.
- In BC's next game vs. Fairfield, Bowman had 19 points and 12 boards, while Popovic had 11 points and 10 rebounds.
- Entering this season, the last time two BC players had a double-double in the same game happened on Dec. 28, 2006.
- Sean Marshall (30 pts/10 reb) and Sean Williams (19 pts/10 reb) had double-doubles for BC vs. Duquesne.

STEFFON MITCHELL STILL STUFFING STAT SHEETS AS A SOPHOMORE

- Steffon Mitchell has led Boston College in at least one statistical category in eight of the 10 games in which he has appeared.
- The sophomore has led the team in rebounding six times, including a season-high 14 boards vs. Milwaukee on Nov. 6.
- Boston College is 5-1 this season - and 14-10 over the past two years - when Mitchell is the team's top rebounder.
- Mitchell has led the Eagles in steals on four occasions, including a career-best five swipes vs. Providence on Dec. 4.
- The Shakopee, Minn. native has been BC's blocked shots leader four times so far in 2018-19.
- Last year as a freshman, Mitchell led BC in at least one statistical category - scoring, rebounding, assists, blocks, or steals - in 31 of 34 games.

STEFFON MITCHELL: CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARDS

- In 43 career games, Steffon Mitchell has grabbed double-digit rebounds on 18 occasions. BC is 11-7 in those games.
- He ranks fourth in the ACC - and 46th nationally - in rebounding, at 9.2 boards per outing.**
- Last season, Mitchell became the first true freshman in BC history to average better than 8.0 rebounds per game.
- The Shakopee, Minn. native pulled down 8.3 rebounds per game and is the ACC's third-leading returning rebounder.
- Mitchell has four double-doubles so far in 2018-19 and six for his career.

DOUBLE-DIGIT DEFICITS

- Boston College erased an 12-point first half deficit at DePaul to emerge with the 65-62 win on Dec. 22.
- The Eagles trailed 32-20 with 3:11 left in the first half. BC took its first lead with 35 seconds remaining.
- It is the second time this season that BC bounced back to win after trailing by 10+ points: 14 vs. Milwaukee on Nov. 6.
- The Eagles trailed 26-12 with 8:46 left in the first half and 40-27 with 19:31 remaining in regulation.
- BC outscored Milwaukee, 46-13, the rest of the way - marking its largest second half comeback since Nov. 22, 2017.
- In that game, BC trailed by 14 points to Colgate at home before coming back to win, 83-79.
- Thru the 2017-18 season, the Eagles trailed by 10 or more points 12 times before coming back to tie or take the lead.
- Last season, Boston College came back from double-digit deficits en route to victory on five occasions.

WYNSTON TABBS WINS ALL OF THE WEEKLY ROOKIE AWARDS

- Wynston Tabbs earned three major weekly awards after an outstanding two-game stretch for Boston College.
- On Dec. 17, Tabbs earned ACC Rookie of the Week honors - the first BC player to do so since Ky Bowman (Jan. 3, 2017).
- The next day, CBS Sports and the USBWA named him the Wayman Tisdale National Freshman of the Week.
- Tabbs was also selected as the National Jesuit Basketball Player of the Week on Wednesday.
- The Suitland, Md. averaged 19.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 4.5 assists in a 2-0 week for Boston College from Dec. 10-16.

TABBS IN RARE COMPANY, PT. I: SINGLE-GAME

- Wynston Tabbs' stat line vs. Sacred Heart - 28 points, seven rebounds, five assists, and three steals - puts him in rare company.
- Since 1996-97, only 11 players in the ACC have produced at least that stat line in a single game.
- The last ACC player to do so: Ky Bowman vs. Fairfield, Dec. 21, 2016 - 33 points, eight rebounds, five assists, three steals.
- Tabbs' 28 points was the most by a BC freshman since Bowman had 29 vs. Notre Dame on Feb. 14, 2017.

- Since 1996-97, only two freshmen in the ACC have posted at least that stat line over a two-game span.
- From Dec. 31, 2016-Jan. 4, 2017, NC State's Dennis Smith Jr. averaged 24.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg, 8.0 apg, 3.5 spg.
- Chris Paul of Wake Forest posted 26.5 ppg, 6.5 rpg, 6.0 apg, 3.5 spg over a two-game span from Feb. 15-18, 2004.
- The last BC player to do so was Ryan Sidney, from Nov. 28-Dec. 1, 2001: 25.0 ppg, 13.5 rpg, 6.0 apg, 3.0 spg.

JAIURUS HAMILTON ANNOUNCING PRESENCE WITH AUTHORITY

- Jaiurus Hamilton scored a season-high 13 points against Providence, making 5-of-8 shots from the floor and 3-of-3 from the FT line.
- He has scored in double figures on three occasions and grabbed a season-high 10 rebounds vs. Hartford.
- Hamilton nearly registered his first collegiate double-double vs. Sacred Heart, with 10 points and nine rebounds.
- The Charlotte native is shooting 56.4% on his two-point field goals (22-29) this season.

JARED HAMILTON MAKES BOSTON COLLEGE DEBUT AT DEPAUL

- Jared Hamilton made his Boston College at DePaul after sitting out the first nine games due to NCAA transfer regulations.
- Hamilton scored four points and logged a steal in close to 15 minutes of action in the win over the Blue Demons.
- The 6-4, 190 lb. guard transferred to BC from Georgia Southern last year during the mid-semester break.
- He played eight games during the 2017-18 season at Georgia Southern, averaging 6.5 points and 2.5 rebounds.
- Hamilton began his college career at Jacksonville State in 2015-16, averaging 9.0 points and 4.9 rebounds in 30 starts.
- At JSU, he was a three-time Ohio Valley Rookie of the Week and was the conference's fifth-leading freshman scorer.
- A native of Charlotte, N.C., he is the older brother of Eagles freshman Jaiurus Hamilton.
- The Hamiltons are one of six pairs of brothers at the Division I level to play on the same team. (h/t Scott Kuykendall)

KY BOWMAN ON THE NATIONAL AWARDS WATCHLISTS: COUSY, NAISMITH, WOODEN, AND OLSON

- Ky Bowman has been named to the preseason watchlist for four of college basketball's most prestigious awards.
- Bowman was one of 20 players named to the national preseason watchlist for the Bob Cousy Award, while also earning a spot on the 50-player watchlists for the Citizen Naismith Trophy and John R. Wooden Award.
- The Nation's Most Dynamic Guard was one of 40 players named to the preseason watchlist for the Lute Olson Award.
- The Bob Cousy Award is presented annually to the top point guard in the country.
- By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players will be narrowed down to 10 players. Five finalists will be announced in March.
- The Citizen Naismith Trophy honors the Player of the Year in college basketball annually.
- The list will be trimmed to 30 on Feb. 13, while the 10 semifinalists and four finalists on March 4 and March 19, respectively.
- The John R. Wooden Award is bestowed upon the nation's best basketball player at an NCAA Division I university who has proven to his or her university that he or she meets or exceeds the qualifications set forth by Coach Wooden and the Wooden Award Steering Committee, including making progress towards graduation and maintaining at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- The Lute Olson Award is presented to the nation's top Division I men's basketball player.
- The 2019 award will be presented at the College Insider awards event at the NCAA Final Four in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

RECORD BOOK RESET

- Ky Bowman is 21st on the all-time scoring list (1,323 points) and needs 42 to pass Roger McCready '86 (1,365) for 20th.
- Jordan Chatman needs 80 points to reach 1,000 for his college career; 175 to score 1,000 points at Boston College; 16 more 3-pointers to crack Boston College's top 10 career 3FGM list.
- Jim Christian needs one more win to reach 300 for his career.

POPOVIC PERFECT

- Nik Popovic registered the fourth-best single-game shooting performance in BC history, going 9-for-9 vs. Minnesota.
- It is the fourth time a BC player attempted at least nine field goals without a miss.
- The last BC player to go at least 9-for-9 from the floor was Corey Raji, who was 12-for-12 vs. Maine on Dec. 23, 2008.
- Martin Clark (13-for-13) holds the record, set on Dec. 13, 1982 vs. Bentley.
- Craig Smith was 10-for-10 from the floor on Dec. 4, 2002 against St. Bonaventure.
- Through games of Dec. 29, Popovic is one of 18 players nationally to go at least 9-for-9 from the floor without a miss.

PUT IT ON MY TABBS

- Wynston Tabbs is the first freshman in BC history to score at least 15 points in his first three games.
- Tabbs scored 16 points in his Boston College debut on Nov. 6 against Milwaukee.
- It was the most points scored by a BC frosh in his debut since Nov. 14, 2015 (Jerome Robinson - 19 pts vs. St. Francis Brooklyn).
- He had 15 points vs. IUPUI and scored 14 of his 15 points in the second half in a win over St. Francis Brooklyn.

JORDAN CHATMAN: ONE OF THE TOP SHOOTERS IN THE COUNTRY

- Jordan Chatman returns for his final season of college basketball and is one of the top long-range shooters in the nation.
- During the preseason, Chatman was tabbed as the 27th-best shooter nationally by Haslametrics.com.
- Entering 2018-19, he was one of 10 active players to make at least 145 3FG and shoot better than 40% from 3FG.
- Last year, BC was 7-3 when Chatman hit at least four 3FG and 5-0 when he made at least five 3FG.
- The Vancouver, Wash. native tallied double-figures in scoring in 17 of the Eagles' 19 victories a season ago.
- He enters the 2018-19 season ranked sixth among all active players in career FT% - 90.4% (113-125).
- Andy Katz of NCAA.com tabbed Chatman as one of his 11 under-the-radar players to keep an eye on this season.
- Chatman is poised to become the 44th member of BC's 1,000 point club. He has 823 points in a Eagles' uniform.
- For his college career, including his freshman year at BYU (2015-16), he has totaled 918 total points.
- Chatman is tied for the BC single-game record for 3FG made with nine, set at Virginia Tech on Jan. 29, 2017.
- With 159 3-pointers made in a BC uniform, Chatman should crack the school's top 10 list for career 3FG makes.

NIK POPOVIC: POISED TO BECOME ONE OF THE TOP BIG MEN IN THE ACC

- Nik Popovic has registered three double-doubles in 2018-19 - including career-highs of 22 points and 14 boards vs. Columbia.
- He leads the Eagles in FG% (58.8) and is third in rebounding (7.2 rpg). In the ACC, he ranks fourth and 11th, respectively.
- Last season, Popovic posted career-highs averages in scoring (9.9), rebounding (6.2), and assists (1.3).
- He averaged nearly 13.0 ppg over the final nine games of 2017-18, including a career-high 20 points (8-11 FG) in the opening round win over Georgia Tech in the ACC Tournament
- In his career, when Popovic grabs at least seven rebounds in a game, the Eagles are 15-8.
- When Popovic grabs 10 or more rebounds, Boston College is 6-1.

POINT OUT THE BOUNCE

- During summer vertical leap testing, Vin Baker Jr. reached the highest height on the Heights.
- The sophomore wing cleared the Vertec machine at 144 inches (12 feet) on the running approach.
- Baker Jr. and Jaius Hamilton tied for the highest standing leap, at 135 inches (11 feet, 3 inches).
- Jared Hamilton posted the highest approach vertical leap, at 42 inches, while Avery Wilson checked in at 40 inches.
- Rounding out the top six high-flying Eagles: Ky Bowman (39 inches), Ervins Meznieski (38 inches), Baker Jr. (37.5 inches), and Wynston Tabbs (36.5 inches).
- Vertical jump is calculated by the standing/approach leap number, minus standing reach.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE: BOSTON COLLEGE WINS INAUGURAL FORT MYERS TIPOFF TITLE

- With its 78-66 win over Loyola Chicago, Boston College won the Fort Myers Tipoff tournament.
- It was the first championship in an MTE/in-season tournament since 2005, when the Eagles won the Las Vegas Invitational.
- It was BC's first appearance in a trophy/t-shirt game since the 2006 ACC Tournament Championship (L, 76-78 vs. Duke).
- Ky Bowman was named the tournament's MVP, averaging 25.0 ppg in the two games held at Suncoast Credit Union Arena.
- The Nation's Most Dynamic Guard poured in a career-high 38 points (14-22 FG; 7-12 3FG) vs. Wyoming on Nov. 19.
- In the four Fort Myers Tipoff games, Bowman averaged 22.5 points, 6.3 rebounds, 3.3 assists, and 1.5 blocks.
- Jordan Chatman also earned all-tournament honors, averaging 16.3 points, 3.6 boards, and 1.8 assists in the four games.

- Against Wyoming, Chris Herren Jr. and Vin Baker Jr. combined for 10 points in the second half.

- Jick is also sponsoring a similar charity donation in conjunction with BC's women's basketball team and its FT percentage.

KY BOWMAN NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC FIRST TEAM; EAGLES PICKED 12TH ON PRESEASON POLL

- Ky Bowman - The Nation's Most Dynamic Guard - was named to the Preseason All-ACC First Team.
- He became the first BC player since Tyrese Rice (2008-09) to be named to the preseason All-ACC first team.
- Bowman was the only player in the ACC to rank among the top 11 in the league in scoring, rebounding, and assists in 2017-18.
- Among all returning players in the ACC in 2018-19, he ranks second in scoring, fifth in rebounding, and fourth in assists.
- His six double-doubles in points and rebounds were most by a point guard in the ACC in 2017-18.
- The junior guard was an All-ACC honorable mention and was a second team All-ACC Tournament selection a season ago.
- Boston College was picked to finish 12th on the preseason poll. The Eagles finished 12th last year.
- Duke, Virginia, North Carolina, Syracuse, and Virginia Tech round out the top five.

- The Eagles erased an 11-point deficit with 3:57 left in regulation before falling, 85-80, in overtime to Virginia Tech.
- Trailing 66-55 with 3:57, BC closed out regulation on a 16-5 push. Jerome Robinson keyed the run, scoring the Eagles last seven points - including five from the charity stripe with 22 seconds to play to tie it at 71-71.
- Robinson's potential game-winning 3-pointer with :02 left rattled in-and-out, forcing the five extra minutes.
- In OT, Virginia Tech connected on 5-of-7 from the floor, including two 3-pointers, outscoring Boston College, 14-9.
- Both teams played an even first five minutes to start the game before Robinson scored BC's next 11 points - including a stretch of three consecutive 3-pointers.
- Boston College led by as many as eight points in the first half, after a 3-pointer by Ky Bowman made it 24-16 with 7:29 left.
- The Hokies' 6-0 run over the final 40 seconds of the half helped them to a 34-29 halftime lead as BC shot 1-of-7 from the floor to close the half.
- In the second half, the Hokies opened up an 11-point lead - 42-31 - with 16:47 to play. But BC would counter with a 16-6 push, capped by a Jordan Chatman jumper, and cut it to one - 48-47 - with 13:01 to play.
- Virginia Tech countered with a 14-4 run and held a comfortable lead until the BC run to close out regulation with less than four minutes left.
- Jerome Robinson led all scorers with 32 points. Robinson also had five rebounds, five assists, and two steals.
- Ky Bowman narrowly missed a triple-double with 22 points, nine rebounds, and eight assists in 44 minutes of play.
- Bowman scored 12 of his 22 in the second half - including nine straight during BC's run to close out regulation.
- Nik Popovic had 11 points and nine boards, while Steffon Mitchell scored nine points to go with a game-high 12 boards.
- BC committed 16 turnovers, which VT converted into 19 points. BC tallied 20 points on 10 TO by the Hokies
- There were eight ties and 10 lead changes in the game - BC's second overtime affair of the season.

JIM CHRISTIAN THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Jim Christian enters his fifth season on the Heights in 2018-19. Named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Boston College in April, 2014, Christian has helped inspire a turnaround in the Eagles program on and off the court.

In 2017-18, Christian helped guide BC to a 19-win season - the most victories since the 2010-11 season - and a return to the postseason. The Eagles' season was highlighted by a win over top-ranked Duke in December, a trip to the quarterfinals of the 2018 ACC Championship, and a bid to the National Invitation

Tournament.

Under Christian's tutelage, Jerome Robinson became Boston College's fifth All-American and first-ever NBA Lottery Pick. Runner-up for 2017-18 ACC Player of the Year, Robinson was selected 13th overall in the first round by the Los Angeles Clippers. In his 13 seasons as a head coach, Christian has coached five All-Americans and 34 all-conference selections and has guided his teams to the postseason on nine occasions.

Christian and his staff developed one of the top scoring backcourts in the country in 2016-17. The duo of Jerome Robinson (17.4 ppg) and Ky Bowman (17.4) combined to average 34.8 points per game in ACC play which ranked fifth in the country among the major conferences. Robinson finished fourth in the conference in scoring (18.7) and earned All-ACC Honorable Mention accolades. Bowman was named to the All-ACC Freshman Team after averaging 14.3 points per game. He was also the only ACC freshman to rank in the top 10 in seven different categories in league play.

In his first season at Boston College, Christian guided guard Olivier Hanlan to First Team All-ACC and honorable mention All-America honors. Hanlan was the leading scorer in the ACC (19.5) which ranked 22nd in the country. He also led all major conference players in scoring average during league play (21.9). In addition, Hanlan led the ACC in 3-point percentage (.436). He was drafted by the Utah Jazz in the second round (42nd overall) of the 2015 NBA Draft.

Prior to moving to Chestnut Hill, Christian spent two seasons as head coach at Ohio, leading the Bobcats to a 49-22 record in that time. He is the Mid-American Conference's all-time leader in winning percentage (.700) and reached 20 wins in eight seasons as a head coach in the conference. His .731 winning percentage in league games (101-37) is second-best in MAC history. Christian also spent six seasons at Kent State from 2002-08.

In his first season at Ohio in 2012-13, the Bobcats went 24-10 and earned a bid to the NIT. Ohio captured the MAC regular season title - the school's first since 1994 - and tied the program record with 14 league wins and seven road victories. He was named the NABC District 14 Coach of the Year.

Ohio led the nation in assists per game (17.5) in 2012-13 and ranked seventh in the country in turnover margin (+4.7). Under Christian's guidance, guard D.J. Cooper ranked seventh in the nation in assists and was the first MAC Player of the Year from Ohio since 1995.

In 2013-14, the Bobcats went 25-12 and advanced to the quarterfinals of the College Insider Tournament. It was just the third time in school history that an Ohio team reached 25 wins.

Prior to his time at Ohio, Christian was the head coach at TCU from 2008-12. While in Fort Worth, he led the Horned Frogs to their first postseason appearance since 2005 when they played in the 2012 College Basketball Invitational.

He coached six All-Mountain West players while in Fort Worth, including guard Hank Thorns, Jr. - a first team All-MWC honoree who was the only player in the country to rank in the top 12 in both assists and assist/turnover ratio in 2010-11.

Christian began his head coaching career at Kent State where he compiled a record of 138-58 (.704). He led the Golden Flashes to five postseason appearances in his six seasons at the helm. He earned MAC Coach of the Year accolades in 2006 and 2008, both times leading Kent State to the conference title and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament. The Golden Flashes earned NIT berths in each of his first three seasons.

Kent State won at least 20 games every year with Christian at the helm. He guided the Golden Flashes to the program's first-ever top 25 ranking in both the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today polls. Kent was No. 23 on the Associated Press poll and 24 on the USA Today/Coaches poll, released on Feb. 25, 2008.

The 2007-08 season was one of the best in Kent State history. The Golden Flashes finished 28-7, including a school-record 25 regular season wins. Kent won both the MAC regular season and tournament championships and earned a program-best no. 9 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

While in Kent, Christian mentored two All-Americans (Antonio Gates, DeAndre Haynes), two MAC Players of the Year (DeAndre Haynes, Al Fisher), three MAC Defensive Players of the Year (Demetric Shaw, John Edwards, Haminn Quaintance), one MAC Sixth Man of the Year (Kevin Warzynski) and a total of 19 All-MAC selections, including six first teamers. Gates signed with the San Diego Chargers of the National Football League and has put forth one of the finest careers as a tight end in pro football history.

Christian served as an assistant coach at Kent State in 2001-02, when the program advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight. Prior to Kent, Christian was an assistant at four different programs.

While at Pittsburgh from 1996-99, Christian guided the development of Vonteego Cummings, a two-time All-Big East player who went on to play for the Philadelphia 76ers and Golden State Warriors. During the 1995-96 season, Christian was part of the Miami (Ohio) program that posted a 21-8 overall record - including a 12-6 mark in MAC play - en route to a trip to the NIT.

He served two stints as an assistant at Western Kentucky, including the highly-successful 1994-95 season in which the Hilltoppers went 27-4, including a 17-1 record in the Sun Belt Conference, en route to a conference championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. The 27 wins were the fourth-most in program history.

Christian's first full-time assistant coaching position came at St. Francis (Pa.) from 1992-94.

From 1999-2001, Christian was a college basketball talent evaluator at Octagon Sports Marketing and Management.

A native of Bethpage, N.Y., Christian was an all-state guard at St. Dominic High School while playing under Ralph Willard. Christian was recruited by Hall of Fame head coach Rick Pitino to Boston University where he played two seasons. Christian played his final two campaigns under Tom Penders at Rhode Island where he helped the Rams reach the Sweet Sixteen in the 1988 NCAA Tournament.

The standout guard led the Rams to victories over Missouri and Syracuse before losing a 73-72 game to Duke for the right to advance to the Elite Eight. After graduation, Christian spent one season playing professionally in Australia for the Sydney City Comets.

Christian earned his bachelor's degree in consumer affairs from the University of Rhode Island in 1988. He and his wife, Patty, have three children, MacKenzie, Zach and Jay.
