BY THE NUMBERS: IRISH VS HOKIES

1	Junior John Mooney leads all major conference players in rebounds per game in league action with a 12.5 average.
3	John Mooney is on pace to become the third Notre Dame player in the past four seasons to lead the ACC in rebounding in all games (currently at the top of the league with a 10.9 average). Zach Auguste (10.7, 2016) and Bonzie Colson (10.1, 2017) also led the ACC in rebounding. Should Mooney maintain his league-leading status, Notre Dame would become the first ACC program to have a player lead the league in rebounding three out of four seasons (and three out of six since ND joined the ACC) since Tim Duncan did it three straight years for Wake Forest from 1995-97.
3	Notre Dame is set to face three consecutive ranked teams (No. 20/18 Virginia Tech; No. 16/17 Florida State and No. 18/22 Louisville) in the regular season for the first time since 2010-11. The Irish went 2-1 against a three-game run of No. 9/9 Georgetown, No. 5/5 Syracuse and No. 8/9 UConn in 10-11.
6	John Mooney has grabbed 14 or more rebounds six times in ACC action - the most of any major conference player in league competition. Arizona State's Zylan Cheatham has four such games.
7	Freshman Prentiss Hubb is seventh in the country in playing time for a true freshman from a major conference team (see page 7 for more).
8	Prentiss Hubb is poised to become the eighth true freshman since 1972-73 to dish out 100 or more assists in a season (see page 7 for more). He would join Chris Thomas, Tory Jackson and Eric Atkins as the fourth Brey-era guard to reach 100 (or more) assists in their rookie season.
9.7	With a 9.7 average, Notre Dame is fifth in the country in turnovers committed per game.
12.6	John Mooney is averaging 12.5 rebounds per game in ACC competition - one of just five major-conference players to average 10 or more rebounds per game in league action. Should he maintain that average, he would be the first ACC player to average over 12.5 rebounds per game since Tim Duncan (14.9) in 1997 (see page 5 for more).
13.5	Notre Dame is committing just 13.5 personal fouls per game - the lowest average total in the country as of February 21. The Irish are ahead of Loyola Chicago (13.7) and Dayton (14.0).
16	John Mooney leads the ACC (no other player has more than 10) and is tied for eighth in the country with 16 double-doubles (he is tied for third in double-doubles among major conference players). He also paces the ACC in 10-rebound performances with 18 this season.
60	Junior T.J. Gibbs has scored 60 points in the past three games (20 vs. Georgia Tech; 17 at No. 4/4 Virginia; 23 vs. Wake Forest) while shooting .487 from the floor and .380 from three-point range.
200	John Mooney is the latest in a long line of juniors to make a significant leap in statistical performance during their third year in the Notre Dame program. He is on pace to become the ninth player to increase their scoring (among other statistics) 200 points or more during their junior season. See page 12 for a full breakdown.
2,025	Minutes played by the Notre Dame freshman class (Robby Carmody, Chris Doherty, Dane Goodwin, Prentiss Hubb, Nate Laszewski) - the most for any rookie class in the Mike Brey era. It is the fifth-most at Notre Dame since freshmen became eligible in 1972-73.

Nate Laszewski	A 'stretch four' with one of the best outside shots on the team • grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds in his first career start at Boston College • broke out at Georgia Tech (1/22/19) with a career-high 19 points
Chris Doherty	Had planned to redshirt this season, but front line injuries and transfers have thrust him into a key reserve role • made his Notre Dame debut vs. GT (1/22/19), scored first four career points against No. 3/3 Virginia (1/26/19)
Dane Goodwin	High basketball IQ allows easy fit into the ND rotation • rebounds well for his height and boasts a strong mid-range game • exploded for 17 of his 19 points in the second half against No. 17/16 NC State on Jan. 19

IRISH FACE REMATCH WITH VIRGINIA TECH ON ESPN

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball team (13-13, 3-10 ACC) looks for its first victory over a ranked team this season in a rematch of its first ACC game of the season with No. 20/18 Virginia Tech (20-6, 9-5) Saturday afternoon (4 p.m. ET) on ESPN.

MR. MOONEY ONE OF SIX MAJOR CONFERENCE PLAYERS AVERAGING A DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Junior forward John Mooney (dubbed Mr. Mooney by Notre Dame Basketball Radio Network Analyst Zach Hillesland) has compiled 15 double-doubles this season that have pushed his season averages to 14.1 (ppg) and 10.9 (rpg) - the only ACC player averaging a double-double. He joins five other players across the country from a major college basketball conference to average 10+ points and 10+ rebounds per game.

NOTRE DAME VS. VIRGINIA TECH SERIES HISTORY

- Notre Dame and Virginia Tech are meeting for the 12th time on Saturday afternoon and eighth time as ACC opponents. The Irish lead the all-time series 8-3 and 5-2 in ACC action.
- Notre Dame is 3-1 at Purcell Pavilion against Virginia Tech with the Hokies claiming their first win at Notre Dame last season 80-75 on January 27, 2018.
- In the 2018 ACC Championship second round meeting between Irish and Hokies, Notre Dame utilized a 45-18 run in the final 15 minutes of the game to erase a 21-point second-half deficit and defeat Virginia Tech 71-65 in the second round of the 2018 ACC Championship in the Barclays Center. The 21-point rally marked the greatest comeback victory in Notre Dame basketball history.
- Mike Brey is 9-4 all-time against Buzz Williams.

MOONEY LEADS ACC IN DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Junior forward John Mooney has raised his level of play to an all-conference level in 2018-19 and currently leads the ACC in rebounding (10.9 per game) and double-doubles (16 in 26 games played).

One of six major conference players averaging a double-double this season (14.1 ppg, 10.9 rpg), Mooney entered the season with 4.5 ppg and 3.3 rpg averages.

MOONEY'S 19-REBOUNDS IN HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

John Mooney's career-high 19 rebounds at No. 13/15 North Carolina on Tuesday, January 15, 2019, is tied for the fifth-most of the Mike Brey era at Notre Dame. A further breakdown of Mooney's big game:

- It is the most since Zach Auguste pulled down 22 rebounds in an overtime victory over Duke in the 2016 ACC tournament (3/10/16).
- It is the most in a non-overtime game since Luke Harangody had 22 rebounds in a loss to Washington State in the 2008 NCAA tournament (3-22-08).
- It is the most in a regular-season game since Torin Francis grabbed 20 rebounds against Bucknell in 2002 (11/22/02).
- It is the most in a regular-season conference game since Ryan Humphrey (current Irish assistant coach) put up 19 rebounds at Rutgers on Feb. 14, 2002.
- His 16 defensive rebounds mark the most by a Roy Williams-coached North Carolina team, besting Iowa State's Jard Homan's 15 in the 2088 NCAA tournament.
- His 19 rebounds matched the most by an opposing player in UNC's Smith Center (done twice in 2011 and 1989).

MOONEY BOASTS NOTABLE ACC-ONLY REBOUND AVERAGE

Entering this week's conference action, John Mooney is averaging 12.5 rebounds per game in ACC play. Should he maintain that average, he would be the first ACC player to average over 12.3 rebounds per game since Tim Duncan recorded a 14.9 average in 1997.

If Mooney can keep his rebound per game average above 12.0 - he would be the first ACC player to accomplish that since Sean May (12.3) in 2005.

FRESHMAN STARTING TRIO IS A BREY-ERA FIRST

Prentiss Hubb, Dane Goodwin and Nate Laszewski became the first trio of true freshman to start at game for a Notre Dame Mike Brey-coached team against Boston College (1/12/19) - and became the first such trio to post a victory in such a contest since LaPhonso Ellis, Elmer Bennett and Keith Tower claimed an defeated Portland 80-58 on January 9, 1989.

The most recent occurrence of three true freshmen in the starting lineup came in the 1999-2000 season under then-head coach Matt Doherty, when Matt Carroll, Ivan Kartelo and Jere Macura took the court against Miami (FL), suffering a 63-49 setback.

A three-freshman starting lineup is a rarity at Notre Dame, as prior to the aforementioned 1989 contest, the previous games with three freshman in the starting lineup occurred in the 1982-83 season, when Tim Kempton, Ken Barlow, Joe Price and Jim Dolan combined through various different iterations to start 14 games (though the Irish never reached a point where all four started the same contest).

FIVE SCHOLARSHIP FRESHMAN IN ACTION A BREY-ERA FIRST

When freshman Chris Doherty was activated against NC State (1/19/19), he became the fifth scholarship freshman to play for the Irish this season - a first in the Mike Brey era.

The last time Notre Dame saw five true scholarship freshmen see playing time in one season was in 1991-92, when Nathion Gilmore, Lamarr Justice, Malik Russell, Billy Taylor and Jason Williams all played for John MacLeod's first time at Notre Dame.

SIX NEWCOMERS MATCH HIGH OF BREY ERA

Notre Dame welcomes six new players who are eligible for competition this season - junior Juwan Durham (sat out the 2017-18 season after transferring from Connecticut) and freshmen Robby Carmody, Dane Goodwin, Prentiss Hubb, Nate Laszewski and Chris Doherty.

Only the 2009-10 season, when transfers Ben Hansbrough and Scott Martin joined freshmen Mike Broghammer, Joey Brooks, Jack Cooley and Tom Knight, experienced as many newcomers to a Mike Brey-coached Notre Dame roster.

DURHAM RIM PROTECTION MAKES AN IMPRESSION

Even though Juwan Durham is listed as a junior on the Notre Dame roster, he is really just experiencing the first significant minutes in a series of collegiate games this season. Durham saw limited minutes in his freshman season at UConn (2016-17) after sitting out his senior year of high school to recover from an ACL tear in his right knee. He also had wrist surgery while sitting out during his transfer season last year with the Irish.

In his first game in a Notre Dame uniform against UIC (11/6/18) he became the first Notre Dame player since 2012 to block six shots in a game. Durham also sparked the Irish with 10 points and five blocks in the second half of a victory over Illinois (11/27/18) and has 51 blocks in his first 18 games at Notre Dame.

During the Mike Brey era (2000-01 - present) only six other players have blocked five or more shots multiple times, putting the Tampa, Florida, native - with two full years of eligibility remaining after this season - among some noteworthy Irish players early in his career.

GIBBS REACHES A PROLIFIC NOTRE DAME SCORING MILESTONE

Junior T.J. Gibbs finished with 19 points at Boston College (2/2/19) to become the 63rd Notre Dame player to reach 1,000 points in career. The Irish entered the college basketball season with 62 1,000-point scorers which was tied for fifth all-time in NCAA history.

Break the number down further during the Mike Brey era and the 1,000-point scorers tell the story of player development at the University of Notre Dame.

Since 2000-01, Notre Dame is third behind Villanova and North Carolina with 24 players reaching 1,000 points since Mike Brey took over leadership of the Irish program. Since joining the ACC, Notre Dame has had seven 1,000-point scorers, trailing just North Carolina (8).

DJ HARVEY - THE RETURN

As one of the top rated recruits of the Mike Brey era, D.J. Harvey was poised to play a key role during his freshman season in 2017-18. With injuries to all-conference level performers Matt Farrell and Bonzie Colson, his role was only going to increase. But an injury suffered on January 16, 2018, derailed Harvey's rookie season and put his career in jeopardy.

The recovery from that moment, however, has been remarkable and capped by Harvey's return to the starting lineup for the team's 2018-19 season opener with UIC. Expected to be ready to fully contribute around the first of the year, Harvey has exceeded all expectations in his recovery from microfracture surgery. Here is a breakdown of his recovery timeline:

IRISH POST REMARKABLE SIX-PLAYER VICTORY IN FIRST MEETING VS. BOSTON COLLEGE

The Irish knew the bench would be limited in the game with Boston College (1/12/19) - junior Juwan Durham would be resting his injured ankle, Rex Pflueger and Robby Carmody are out for the year with injuries and freshman Chris Doherty hoped to retain a year of eligibility this season.

But 20 minutes before the game tipped off, the Irish found out that junior T.J. Gibbs would not be available due to a sudden illness - and instantly the Irish would enter the game with six scholarship players available.

Not only did the Irish hold strong to earn their first ACC victory of the year - they became the first Division I team to win a game this season playing only six players. It marks the second time a Mike Brey team has won a game playing six - as the Irish defeated American 78-74 on December 21, 2003.

CROSSROADS CLASSIC HISTORY

The Crossroads Classic was held on December 12, 2018, for the eighth consecutive season featuring Notre Dame, Butler, Indiana and Purdue. The Irish and Bulldogs rotate between facing the Hoosier and Boilermakers each season.

Butler and Indiana are 5-3 in the event, followed by Notre Dame (4-4) and Purdue (2-6).

PFLUEGER'S SEASON ENDS WITH AN ACL INJURY

Senior captain Rex Pflueger suffered a left ACL injury late in the victory over Purdue in the 2018 Crossroads Classic on Saturday, December 15, 2018. An MRI conducted on Monday, December 17, indicated the need for season-ending surgery. Pflueger announced his status on Instagram and Twitter:

“First of all, I want to thank everyone who has reached out to me with kind words and positivity for both my family and myself! I am saddened to find out that I did in fact tear my ACL in our last game against Purdue. . . But at least I didn't break any bones so that's awesome lol. This is just one of life's crazy tests that I have prepared myself for with the loving help of my family and my friends. I will continue to cheer and push my Notre Dame family to not only compete but to dominate for the rest of the season. We have an incredible group of players who will pick up right where we left off last game. I will not let this injury affect the person I am and will continue to stay positive for better times to come! Thank you Irish Nation.”

Notre Dame head coach Mike Brey reaction to the news:

“You develop a close relationship with your guys when you have them for four years. Rex Pflueger is like a son to me. I'm extremely disappointed that he won't be able to continue this season. He has been an unbelievable winner and leader for us. He has continually helped me endorse our culture here at Notre Dame. I look forward to him continuing to lead and giving me great feedback the rest of the season.”

The surgery will be conducted back in the Notre Dame area on January 11, 2019. Any discussion about a possible fifth year of eligibility for Pflueger has been tabled until later in the 2019 spring semester.

ELIJAH BURNS LEAVES PROGRAM, SEEKS GRADUATE TRANSFER

On Tuesday, November 20, senior Elijah Burns declared his intention to seek a graduate transfer and left the Notre Dame basketball team- effective immediately.

Glenn and Stacey Murphy Head Men's Basketball Coach Mike Brey -

“We fully support Elijah in his decision to move on from the University of Notre Dame following his graduation in December. We will provide any assistance he may need as he takes the next step in his academic and playing careers.

It is always tough when one of our guys doesn't end his career here, but we are proud that he will achieve the ultimate goal of any student-athlete that comes through our program - to leave Notre Dame with a degree from one of the top institutions in the country.”

WHITMORE INDUCTED INTO PURCELL PAVILION RING OF HONOR ON JANUARY 12, 2019

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball program inducted Bob Whitmore (1965-69) into the Purcell Pavilion Ring of Honor at halftime of the Boston College game on January 12, 2019.

The trailblazer for Notre Dame's legendary Washington, D.C. connection, finished with 1,508 career points in three full seasons (freshmen were ineligible under NCAA rules at that time) which ranked third all-time at Notre Dame when he graduated. His rebounding prowess was even more notable, as he hauled in over 1,043 missed shots to rank second at Notre Dame upon graduation. He is still one of only six players to collect over 1,000 rebounds in a career at Notre Dame.

D.C. AREA/NOTRE DAME CONNECTION CONTINUES WITH PRENTISS HUBB AND D.J. HARVEY

The Notre Dame men's basketball connection to the Washington, D.C., area began in 1965 with Brian Kelly (St. John's High School) and continues to this day with head coach Mike Brey (DeMatha), associate head coach Rod Balanis (DeMatha), sophomore D.J. Harvey (DeMatha) and freshman Prentiss Hubb (Gonzaga).

The D.C. pipeline is a Who's Who of Notre Dame men's basketball greats - Edward 'Monk' Malloy (Archbishop Carroll), Bob Whitmore (DeMatha), Austin Carr (Macklin), Collis Jones (St. John's), Sid Catlett (DeMatha), Adrian Dantley (DeMatha), Don Williams (Macklin), Tracy Jackson (Paint Branch, Maryland), Tom Sluby (Gonzaga), Cecil Rucker (Macklin), Monty Williams (Potomac), Eric Atkins (Mount Saint Joseph) and Jerian Grant (DeMatha). Those players combined to score over 17,800 points for Notre Dame, grab 6,844 rebounds and dish out 2,268 assists.

ACC ANNOUNCES FUTURE MEN'S BASKETBALL OPPONENTS

Any questions about the University of Notre Dame men's basketball Atlantic Coast Conference future opponent rotation have been answered - at least for the next three seasons. The ACC has released the conference opponent match ups for the 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 seasons, in anticipation of the league's shift to a 20-game schedule next year.

All 15 ACC teams will retain their designated annual home-and-home series (Boston College and Georgia Tech for Notre Dame), add four home-and-home opponents each season on a rotating basis, then face four conference teams on the road or on their respective home courts. The rotating cycle allows each team to face all other ACC teams (save their primary two rivals) in the same scenario over three seasons (home-and-home, away only, home only).

The 2019-20 season also will begin with an ACC game for 14 of the league's 15 teams (including Notre Dame). Confirmed by ACC Commissioner John Swofford at the league's media day in late October of 2018, the first days of the 2019-20 college basketball season will feature seven ACC games. One conference team will be participating in a high-profile that prohibits their participation in the seven-game start to the year.

Notre Dame's opponent and site for that 2019-20 season tip off game is yet to be determined, along with the dates and times for the announced opponents for that season. It is also expected that UCLA and Delaware will be making trips to Purcell Pavilion to finish off previously announced home-and-home series.

MIKE BREY, HEAD COACH

19th Season at ND | George Washington '82 | Career Record: 515-267 | ND Record: 416-215



In 19 seasons as the men's basketball coach at the University of Notre Dame, Mike Brey has guided the Fighting Irish to 416 victories and is the all-time winningest men's basketball coach in school history.

The Irish are enjoying a recent stretch of success that ranks among the best in the 114-year history of basketball under the Golden Dome. Notre Dame was the only school in the nation to make back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Championship Elite Eight at the end of the 2015 and 2016 seasons, claimed an Atlantic Coast Conference title in 2015 and has made two ACC title game appearances in four years of ACC competition.

Brey was named head coach at Notre Dame on July 14, 2000. In his first season with the Irish, his team claimed the 2001 BIG EAST West Division championship and returned to the NCAA Championship for the first time in 12 seasons. Notre Dame soon became a regular in the NCAA tournament by making 12 appearances in 17 seasons with Brey on the sidelines.

In 2011, Brey was the recipient of both the Associated Press and the Henry Iba/USBWA National Coach of the Year award. He was named BIG EAST Coach of the Year in 2007, 2008 and 2011 and three of his players have been named BIG EAST Player of the Year.

Before arriving at Notre Dame, Brey was the head basketball coach at the University of Delaware, where he compiled a 99-52 mark from 1995-2000 and won America East Co-Coach of the Year honors in 1998. Prior to his time at Delaware, he was an assistant coach at Duke University. During his eight years at Duke, the Blue Devils advanced to the Final Four six times and won back-to-back national championships in 1991 and 1992.

Brey graduated from George Washington University in 1982. He played for and coached with legendary high school coach Morgan Wootten at DeMatha High School.

Brey serves on the Coaches vs. Cancer National Council and has helped raise over three million dollars for the organization. He has also partnered with the American Heart Association to create the Men of Heart initiative, raising funds and awareness for men's heart health. Brey is on the National Advisory Board of the Positive Coaching Alliance. He has been inducted into the University of Delaware and George Washington University Halls of Fame.

CREDENTIALS

- Media and NBA scouts wishing to cover Notre Dame home games in 2018-19 should apply for credentials at und.com/credentials.
- Credential requests are due 48 hours before the posted tip time.
- Credentials will be issued on a game-by-game basis.
- Media space is limited and subject to availability.

INTERVIEW REQUESTS

- Throughout the season, Notre Dame student-athletes and coaches will be available at least one time per week before a designated practice time.
- Those opportunities will be communicated through Associate Athletics Communications Director Alan Wasielewski's media e-mail list serve. To be added to that list, or for special interview requests, you can contact Wasielewski at awasiele@nd.edu.
- All interviews with Notre Dame student-athlete or coaches must be arranged through the Athletic Communications Office.

GAME NOTES/STATISTICS/TEAM INFORMATION

- Updated team statistics, game notes, head shots and additional team information are available at und.com/pressbox.

GAME DAY PARKING

- Parking for all Notre Dame men's basketball games is free and open on a first-come first-served basis.

MEDIA ENTRANCE/CREDENTIAL WILL CALL

- Media Will Call will open two hours before the public game tip time.
- The University of Notre Dame has instituted a clear bag policy for fans attending events at men's and women's basketball games in 2018-19. This policy does not apply to credentialed media members covering the game.
- All credentialed media members must enter Gate 1 of the Joyce Center for access to the game.
- Entrance at Gate 1 is necessary for a proper security search and allows easy access to the press area and press meal room.
- Media members attempting to enter any other gate of the Joyce Center will be redirected to Gate 1 for entrance.

MEDIA SEATING

- All non-live-broadcast media seating is located in the press box of Purcell Pavilion. For access to the press box, enter Gate 1, take the stairs, then enter the arena through the double doors leading to Section 109.
- The entrance to the press box is to the left (see map for further details).

PHOTOGRAPHER SEATING/WORK AREA

- Purcell Pavilion offers two areas for photographers and videographers to shoot the game from the baseline. Please check for your assigned photo position at Media Will Call (Gate 1) and in the Photo Work Room.
- Due to the relocation of working media to the upper press box, photographers are asked to utilize the Photo Work Room, located between the Gate 10 and Gate 1 entrances, for equipment storage and post game uploading.
- To access the Photo Work Room from Gate 1, enter Purcell Pavilion through the doors on the first level, take the first right and the Photo Work Room will be on your left just past the tunnel access to courtside.

MEDIA MEAL

- A complimentary pre-game meal will be available for all credentialed media members starting 90 minutes before tip time.
- The meal will be located at the back of the Monogram Room on the upper concourse level of the Joyce Center. Exit the press box, take the double doors to your immediate right, turn right and the Monogram Club will be straight ahead. The entrance to the media meal room is in the back, walk around the right side of the Monogram Room back toward Rolfs Aquatic Center.
- The meal is only available before the game begins. Additional refreshments will be available in the press box during the game.

MEDIA WI-FI ACCESS

- Wi-Fi internet access is free throughout Purcell Pavilion. Sign on to the ND-guest network.

MEDIA LIVE STATISTICS

- The University of Notre Dame offers StatBroadcast for all of its men's basketball home games.
- The live statistics feed is accessible at und.com/mediastats.
- Ask any Notre Dame Athletics Communications representative for the password, which also is available on each credentialed member's seat card.
