About Today's Game

The Hokies enter the game 11-1 on the season and the Fighting Irish are 10-3 this season ... This is the ACC opener for both teams ... The Hokies are ranked 10th in the AP poll and the USA Today Coaches poll.

Last Time Out: VT 85, UMES 40

The Hokies closed out the non-conference schedule with an 85-40 win over Maryland Eastern Shore in Cassell Coliseum on Friday night ... **Ahmed Hill** led four Hokies in double figures with 20 points ... **Wabissa Bede** scored a career-high 14 points, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, added 15 points and **P.J. Horne** scored 11 points ... Tech played without leading scorer **Nickeil Alexander-Walker**, who sprained his right ankle in practice during the week.

Vs. Notre Dame

The Hokies are 2-8 all-time against Notre Dame ... Tech is 0-4 in Blacksburg against the Fighting Irish ... The two teams split the two games played last season; Tech won in South Bend in the regular season and lost to Notre Dame in the ACC Tournament in Brooklyn ... Tech is 1-4 against Notre Dame in ACC regular season play ... Tech won the first meeting between the two schools, a 92-91 overtime win in the championship game of the 1973 NIT in Madison Square Garden, the first of two Virginia Tech NIT Championships.

Home Streak

Virginia Tech has won 24 consecutive home non-conference regular season games, setting a new school record ... The old mark of 23 consecutive home non-conference regular season games was set twice, once between Jan. 29, 1981 and Jan. 7, 1984 and the other between Nov. 13, 2005 and Nov. 26, 2009.

Happy New Year!

The Hokies open the 2018-19 ACC schedule today against Notre Dame ... This is just the third game the Hokies have ever played on Jan. 1 and the first since playing the Naval Training Station on Jan. 1, 1942 in Norfolk ... This will be the Hokies' first-ever home game on New Years Day and first ACC game (or any conference game) on Jan. 1.

Strong Night for Med

In the Hokies' win over Maryland Eastern Shore, **Ahmed Hill** had one of his best performances ... The fifth-year player led all scorers with 20 points and he tied a career-high with six made three-pointers, shooting 7-of-10 from the field, including 6-of-9 from beyond the arc.

Bede, Too

In the Hokies' win over Maryland Eastern Shore, **Wabissa Bede** recorded the best game of his collegiate career ... The sophomore earned the start and played a career-high 34 minutes ... He scored a career-high with 14 points and also recorded career-highs with seven rebounds and six assists ... His seven rebounds led the Hokies.

Assisting for the Score

In the Hokies' win over Maryland Eastern Shore, Tech had 22 assists on 29 made field goals, assisting on 75.9 percent of all baskets ... This is the sixth time this season that the Hokies have assisted on at least 60 percent of its made field goals and the third time that number has exceeded 70 percent ... In the win over Central Connecticut State, Tech assisted on 77.8 percent of its made baskets ... Tech is averaging 60.9 percent for the season on assists per made field goals.

Hot, Hot, Hot!

In the win over Maryland Eastern Shore, the Hokies shot a season-best 65.9 percent from the field ... The last time Tech shot better than 65.9 percent from the field was 68.6 percent in the win over The Citadel last season on Nov. 12, 2017 ... Tech is second in the ACC, shooting 51.2 percent from the field this season.

Joining an Elite Group

In the win over Washington, **Justin Robinson** became just the fourth Virginia Tech men's basketball player to record 500 career assists and 1,200 career points ... He now joins Bimbo Coles, Malcolm Delaney and Jamon Gordon on that list ... Robinson is just one assist behind Gordon for third place in career assists at Virginia Tech.

NAW on the List

Virginia Tech guard **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** has been named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Midseason Watch List ... Alexander-Walker is one of 20 players on the list and one of five ACC players on the watch list ... The trophy is given annually by the USBWA to the nation's top player.

Tech in the Polls

The Virginia Tech Hokies are currently ranked 10th in the AP poll, the school's highest AP ranking since the 1995-96 season ... Tech peaked that season in late February at No. 8, its all-time highest ranking ... The last time the Hokies played a game ranked 10th or higher was on Feb. 17, 1996, a 74-58 loss to UMass when the Hokies were ranked 10th ... Tech is 10th in the USA Today Coaches poll.

Hitting the Boards

Virginia Tech grabbed a season-high 42 rebounds in the win over North Carolina A&T, out rebounding the Aggies, 42-20 ... That's the most rebounds in a game for the Hokies since grabbing 42 rebounds in the win over Maryland-Eastern Shore on Dec. 10, 2017 ... The last time the Hokies had more than 42 rebounds in a game was 51 rebounds against The Citadel on Nov. 12, 2017 ... The 22-rebound difference also dates back to the win over The Citadel last season, when the Hokies out rebounded the Bulldogs, 51-24.

Milestones in the Snow

In the Hokies' 81-44 win over South Carolina State, **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** scored his 500th career point in just his 42nd career game ... After his 20-point performance in the win over North Carolina A&T, he now averages 12.6 points per game for his career ... In the same game, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, grabbed his 400th career rebound.

Through the Non-Con Slate

The Hokies finished with an 11-1 non-conference record ... This is the third consecutive season the Hokies have won 11 non-conference games ... The 11-1 start is tied for the best-ever through 12 games for the Hokies since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season and since becoming a "Power 6" team in the 2000-01 season.

December was a Good Month

Virginia Tech finished 6-0 in December ... Tech was 5-1 last December, with only a loss at No. 8 Kentucky marring the record ... The last time the Hokies had an undefeated December was the 2016-17 season, when the Hokies were 6-0 in the month, that included a home win on New Year's Eve over No. 5 Duke to open the ACC schedule.

Pomp and a Neat Circumstance

When the Hokies tipped off Saturday, Dec. 15's game against Washington in Atlantic City, Tech starters were a rather unique group ... Four of the five starters, **Ty Outlaw**, **Ahmed Hill**, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, and **Justin Robinson** had all completed their requirements for graduation.

Where It Counts the Most

While the Hokies have gotten off to a great start on the court, their fall semester in the class room was even better ... Ten Hokies recorded at least a 3.00 grade point average, as the team recorded a 3.22 overall GPA, the best semester in program history ... Two Hokies, **Ty Outlaw** and **Ahmed Hill** entered the semester with their undergraduate degrees and two more, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, and **Justin Robinson**, completed their requirements for graduation and will walk in Spring 2019 ceremonies.

Take a 3, Make a 3

Virginia Tech is fourth nationally and leads the ACC in three-point field goal percentage, at 43.5 percent ... Tech is leads the ACC and is seventh nationally in three-point field goals made per game, at 10.9 ... Tech has made at least 10 three-pointers in nine of the 12 games this season, including a school-record 18 made three-pointers in the win over Central Connecticut State ... Three of the top four individuals in three-point field goal percentage in the ACC are Hokies, led by **Ty Outlaw**, who leads the ACC in three-point field goal percentage.

Selling Out the Cassell

Virginia Tech announced on Dec. 17 that the home games against Duke, Syracuse and Miami have all sold out ... Less than 50 tickets remain for the home game against Virginia on Feb. 18 ... Earlier this season, the Central Connecticut State game was a sell out, the Hokies' first announced sellout of the season ... The Hokies sold out nine games in the 2017-18 season, including seven of the nine home Atlantic Coast Conference games ... Single game tickets and mini plans for Tech's other home games are still available ... Quantities are limited and the best available seats are going fast ... Virginia Tech's ACC single game tickets are on sale now.

KJ Doubles

In the win over South Carolina State, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, recorded his first double-double of the season, with 12 points and 13 rebounds ... Blackshear's double-double is the first for the Hokies this season and the first by any Hokie since **Justin Robinson** had 10 points and 12 assists at Boston College on Jan. 31, 2018 ... The 13 rebounds are the most by a Hokie this season ... KJ missed a second double-double by one rebound, with a 17-point, 9-rebound performance in the win over North Carolina A&T.

Much Improved

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is third-best among ACC players in improved scoring average from last year to this year ... The sophomore averaged 10.7 points per game as a freshman and is currently at 18.5 ppg, for an increase of 7.8 points per game ... He is the only one of the five listed players to have averaged double figures last season.

Lots to Get To

In the win over Central Connecticut State, the Hokies had quite the game ... The Hokies set a new school record by making 18 three-point field goals in the game, surpassing the former mark of 17 three-pointers made at Louisville on Feb. 8, 2017 ... The 94-40 final score marks the 11th time a **Buzz Williams**-coached Virginia Tech team has scored at least 94 points and the first time since defeating Radford, 95-68, in Cassell Coliseum on Dec. 6, 2017 ... The 54-point margin of victory is the most for the Hokies under Williams and the most since Tech defeated Mount St. Mary's, 99-34 (65 points) on Jan. 2011 in Cassell Coliseum.

Now Boarding

Ty Outlaw missed his first career double-double in the win over VMI by one point ... The sixth-year player grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds, the most boards by a Tech player this season ... Outlaw, who missed last season with a knee injury, averaged 2.8 rebounds per game in the 2016-17 season, but has doubled that to 5.6 boards per game this year.

Getting Better All the Time

In the win over VMI, **P.J.**

Horne had, perhaps, his best game as a Hokie ... The sophomore scored a season-high 12 points on 6-of-6 from the field and added five rebounds in 26 minutes of action ... Horne was making his second consecutive start of the season ... Horne topped that performance with 13 points and six rebounds in just 22 minutes of action in the win over North Carolina A&T, making 5-of-6 from the field ... Horne has made 23 of his last 28 field goal attempts, for 82.1 percent ... Horne is shooting 63.8 percent from the field this season.

New Tech Record

In the win over Central Connecticut State, **Justin Robinson** dished out a career-high 13 assists, breaking the old school mark of 12 assists in a game, most recently set by Robinson at Boston College last season ... Others with 12 assists in a game include Dave Sensibaugh, Bimbo Coles and Troy Manns ... It is the fourth time he has had double figures in assists in a game ... Robinson accomplished the feat in just 28 minutes of action.

Getting on Track

In the win over Saint Francis, **Ty Outlaw** was 5-of-9 from three-point range ... Outlaw entered the game with just four made three-pointers in the first four games combined ... Outlaw followed that by going 4-of-5 from behind the arc at Penn State and followed that with a 3-of-5 effort in the win over Central Connecticut State ... Outlaw is 23-of-38 from three in the last seven games, for 60.5 percent ... Outlaw holds the Virginia Tech record for most three-pointers in a game, with eight against Miami two years ago ... He is 84-of-168 in this Tech career, for 50.0 percent.

Keep It Low

The Hokies held St. Francis to 37 points ... That is the fewest points allowed under **Buzz Williams** and the fewest since allowing Mount St. Mary's 34 points in a 99-34 win over the Mountaineers on Jan. 2, 2011 in Cassell Coliseum ... It is the second-fewest points allowed by an ACC team this season ... Tech allowed SFU just 15 points in the second half, the fewest points allowed in a half under Williams and the fewest points allowed in any half since allowing Miami just 15 points in the first half on Feb. 15, 2014 ... The last time Tech allowed fewer than 15 points in a half was on Dec. 22, 2011, when Tech allowed Eastern Michigan just nine first half points ... Tech held Central Connecticut State and Maryland Eastern Shore to 40 points and South Carolina State to 41 points ... Tech is holding its opponents to 49.7 points per game in home games thus far this season.

Climbing the Lists

Justin Robinson passed Damon Watlington in the UMES game and is now 31st on the career scoring list at 1,227 and **Ahmed Hill** passed Dick Sayre and tied Rolan Roberts in 36th place with 1,169.

As of Dec. 31st, the Hokies are ranked ninth by Kenpom.com ... Tech leads the nation in defensive free throw rate, is second in effective field goal percentage, raw offensive efficiency and defensive three-point field goal percentage, third in three-point percentage, fifth in defensive turnover percentage and adjust offensive efficiency and sixth in raw defensive efficiency ... Tech is 14th in three-point field goal percentage, 20th in assist percentage, 2th in adjusted defensive efficiency and 32nd in two-point percentage ... **Ty Outlaw** is 15th in three-point percentage and 20th in effective field goal percentage ... **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** is 21st in steal percentage.

Like Switzerland

With the win over Washington in Atlantic City, Tech is 4-0 in the neutral court games this season ... Tech is 9-5 in neutral site games under **Buzz Williams** ... The Hokies are 28-21 in neutral site games since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season and 31-25 since 2000-01, the season Tech joined the Big East Conference.

Top Returner

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is one of only seven returning sophomores in the Power 6 to start every game during their rookie season and one of just two in the ACC, joining Oshae Brissett of Syracuse ... Last season, 30 freshmen in the Power Five and BIG EAST started 25 or more games for their squads, including Alexander-Walker ... Among that group, arguably the best sophomores in the country, Alexander-Walker had the third-best 3-point field goal percentage, trailing Stanford's Daejon Davis (.403) and Wigginton (.401).

45s

Virginia Tech has held its opponents to less than 45 points four times this season ... This is the first season since the 1996-97 season that the Hokies have accomplished that feat ... Tech opponents are averaging 56.6 points per game this season.

Tech in NCAA Stats

As of Dec. 31st, the Hokies are second nationally in scoring margin, fourth in three-point field goal percentage, fifth in scoring defense, sixth in three-point field goals per game and eighth in field goal percentage ... Tech is 14th in turnover margin, 17th in assists per game and in assist turnover ratio.

That's a TO

Virginia Tech forced Gardner-Webb into 29 turnovers in the season-opener ... That is the most forced turnovers for the Hokies under **Buzz Williams** ... The 29 forced turnovers are the most by a Virginia Tech team since forcing UNC Greensboro into 29 turnovers on Nov. 21, 2010 in the Greensboro Coliseum ... The last time the Hokies forced 30-or-more turnovers in a game was 35 forced turnovers against Maryland-Eastern Shore on Nov. 23, 2004 in Cassell Coliseum ... The school record is 37 forced turnovers, twice, most recently by VMI in 1983 ... The Hokies forced Northeastern into 18 turnovers, forced 22 turnovers in the win over Saint Francis and 19 turnovers in the win over South Carolina State.

That is the most three-pointers in a game by a Virginia Tech freshman since Justin Bibbs was 5-of-6 from three-point range in a win over Miami of Ohio in the 2014-15 season ... The school record for three-pointers in a game by a freshman at Virginia Tech is six, by Carlos Dixon against High Point on Dec. 30, 2000.

Sharing is Good

Virginia Tech recorded a season-high 28 assists on 36 made baskets in the win over Central Connecticut State ... Tech has had 20-or-more assists five times this season, plus two more games of 19 assists ... Tech reached the 20-assist mark eight times last year, including a school-record 36 assists in the win over The Citadel.

Gimme That!

Virginia Tech recorded 16 steals in the win over Gardner-Webb ... That is the most steals in a game by the Hokies since Nov. 21, 2010, when Tech forced UNC Greensboro into 20 steals ... The 16 steals are the most in a game for the Hokies under **Buzz Williams** and just the sixth time that Tech has had double figure steals in a game under Williams ... That number moved up to eight times with double-digit steals with the 13 steals in the win over South Carolina State.

Defeating Ranked Teams

The Hokies are 1-0 against ranked teams this season ... The Hokies were 4-3 against ranked teams last season and 3-6 in the 2016-17 season ... Virginia Tech has increased percentage of capacity in each of the last four seasons ... Tech ranked seventh in percent of capacity in the ACC last season at 83 percent ... Last season was the first year the Hokies had ever been part of the "Big Monday" package.

Preseason Rankings

Virginia Tech was ranked No. 15 in the AP Top 25 preseason poll ... The Hokies made the AP preseason poll for the first time since the beginning of the 2010-11 season when Tech was ranked No. 21 to open the season ... The No. 15 ranking tied the Hokies' best ever preseason ranking ... Tech was ranked 15th entering the 1984-85 season, while coming off a 22-13 season that saw Tech reach the semifinals of the 1984 NIT.

597 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 597-194 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .755 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011 was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech was 12-4 in Cassell Coliseum last season and is 7-0 this season on its home court.

This Was New

With the win over No. 5/3 Duke, the Hokies won four games against nationally-ranked teams last season ... It was the first time in school history that Tech had accomplished that feat ... Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now beginning his 12th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 238-147. Williams has compiled a 85-61 record, now in his fifth season in Blacksburg.

To cap off the 2017-18 season,

the Hokies made a second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, the first time the school could claim that in more than three decades. The Hokies finished the season 21-12 overall and 10-8 in the ACC. Tech made it three consecutive 20-win season and three consecutive 10-win ACC seasons.

The Hokies took care of business in the regular season. They defeated four nationally-ranked teams for the first time in school history, including three wins against top 10 programs. The Hokies also finished 11-2 in the non-conference regular season slate.

The 2016-17 season was their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned its first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 record in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of

healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2018-19 will mark his 12th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New

Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season

as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
