Keydets Continue Road Swing at Virginia Tech

VMI basketball continues the month of December with the second contest of four consecutive road games pitting the Keydets against Virginia Tech Wednesday night. VMI will be visiting Cassell Coliseum for the first time since the 2016-17 season when they fell 88-72 to the Hokies.

Last Time Out: Longwood 65, VMI 45 (Sat., Dec. 1)

Looking for its second straight road victory, the VMI basketball team struggled to keep pace with host Longwood as the Lancers pulled away for a 65-45 win over the Keydets Saturday afternoon at Willett Hall in Farmville, Virginia. The Lancers' Lorenzo Phillips exploded in the second half with 23 points after not scoring at all in the opening half. Longwood was spurred with momentum on two separate occasions as the Lancers went on a 15-0 run in the first half and a 17-0 run in the second half. Longwood also logged 10 offensive boards in the game that led to 13 second chance points and shot 52 percent from the field in the second half while holding VMI to 23.5 percent shooting including a season low 18.2% from 3-point range.. VMI sophomore Myles Lewis led the Keydets with 11 points as the only one on the team in double figures. Fellow sophomores Sarju Patel and Bubba Parham scored eight and seven points, respectively.

Last Meeting with Virginia Tech: Nov. 19, 2016

The VMI Keydets reduced a 20-point deficit to 10 with 8:20 to go, but the Virginia Tech Hokies scored the next five points to pull back away en route to an 88-72 win in NCAA basketball action Nov. 19, 2016 at Cassell Coliseum in Blacksburg, Va. In a game that VMI had led for 10:24 of action in the first half, Virginia Tech) used aggressive moves to the basket, both on dribble drives and by slipping screens, to impose its will and take a 10-point lead to halftime. That margin then grew to 20, 69-49, with 11:55 remaining, but the Keydets responded with a 10-0 run to cut the lead to 10, 69-59. The Hokies pulled back away with five unanswered points and VMI got no closer than 13 the rest of the way. VMI was led in defeat by QJ Peterson, who had a game-high 29 points, including 23 in the second half. Peterson added eight rebounds and six assists, while Trey Chapman and Adrian Rich chipped in 10 markers apiece. Virginia Tech was paced by Zach LeDay, who had his second double-double in the season's first three games with a 23-point, 12-rebound night.

SERIES HISTORY – VMI vs. Virginia Tech

This will be the 136th meeting between the teams that first met in VMI's debut season of 1908-09. Virginia Tech leads 92-43. The Hokies are VMI's most frequent opponent all-time with Richmond (129 meetings) and William & Mary (117 meetings) the next most played series.

ON THE ROAD IN DECEMBER

The Keydets will be opening December on a four-game road swing with games at Longwood (Dec. 1), Virginia Tech (Dec. 5), Chattanooga (Dec. 9), and Presbyterian (Dec. 12). VMI does not return home to Cameron Hall until Dec. 21 against North Alabama.

BUBBA COOLS DOWN, FOR NOW

The Longwood Lancers held VMI sophomore guard Bubba Parham to a season-low seven points Saturday ending a torrid scoring run by the Snellville, Ga. native. Parham entered the Longwood contest with four straight 30+ point games, and became the first SoCon player to tally 30 or more points in four straight contests since Steph Curry of Davidson in 2008-09. Not just a scorer, Parham also garnered a career-high nine rebounds with a 30-point outing in VMI's win 87-79 OT win at Stetson. Parham started his blistering four-game scoring stretch when he scored a career-high 35 points and knocked down a school record 10 3-pointers in the 92-82 loss at #10 ranked Kentucky Nov. 18. It was the first time Parham had surpassed the 30+ point plateau in a game in his career and he followed it up two nights later with 33 points against Kentucky Christian at Cameron Hall. Parham, the 2018 SoCon Freshman of the Year as selected by the media, has 12 games of 20+ points in his career.

GILKESON, G. PARHAM SET HIGH MARKS

VMI guards Garrett Gilkeson and Greg Parham both turned in career numbers in last Tuesday night's game with American. Gilkeson set a new career mark in steals with five while Parham scored 14 points – equaling his 14-point effort set earlier this season against Goucher.

ROAD AND OVERTIME LOG

With an 86-79 overtime win at Stetson Nov. 23, VMI ended a two-game skid in extra play and won its first overtime game since February 21, 2015 when the Keydets prevailed 113-111 in 2OT at Western Carolina. The Stetson win was also VMI's first road win of the year and first since a 75-71 win at The Citadel on February 17, 2018.

LEWIS - A CAREER DAY

Sophomore forward Myles Lewis played a key role in VMI's win at Stetson with a career-high 15 points and career-high nine rebounds. Lewis also tied his career-mark in assists with three vs. the Hatters.

BOMBS AWAY

The Keydets hit double digits in 3-pointers made in five consecutive games (Nov. 14 through Nov. 23) with 68 treys over that stretch. VMI hit 19 threes at Kentucky Nov. 18 which was the most an opponent had ever made against UK in its long and storied basketball history. VMI also hit 15 threes against Goucher Nov. 11, 10 vs. USC Upstate Nov. 14, 12 vs. Kentucky Christian Nov. 20, and 12 at Stetson Nov. 23. The last time VMI drained 20+ treys in a contest was in a 113-111 win at Western Carolina on February 21, 2015. Through games of December 2, VMI is third in the SoCon with 10.4 3-pointers made per game.

JOIN THE SCORING PARTY

VMI placed six players in double figures for the second time this season in the 106-80 win over Kentucky Christian Nov. 20 at Cameron Hall. Previously, the Keydets had six reach double figures scoring in the 98-34 win over Goucher Nov. 11 at Cameron Hall. It had been the first time VMI had placed six with 10+ points in a game since February 27, 2016 when VMI outscored The Citadel 111-95.

HIGH OCTANE

The 106 points scored by the Keydets Nov. 20 vs. Kentucky Christian was first time VMI had hit the century mark in scoring in a game since February 11, 2017 when VMI dispatched The Citadel 101-78.

KEYDETS SHARP AT LINE

Through games of Dec. 2, VMI is ranked tied for third in the SoCon in free throw shooting with a 72.1% team mark (124-172).

GILKESON ON A HIGH

He was known as a dependable defender and rebounder heading into the season, but junior guard Garrett Gilkeson has stepped up his scoring as well and is averaging 9.7 points and shooting 46.4% from 3-point range (13-28). Gilkeson also tied his career-high with 10 rebounds against Kentucky Christian and added 15 points for his second career double-double.

STEADY GREG

VMI sophomore guard Greg Parham has scored in double figures eight games of nine and is second in team scoring with 11.0 PPG. Parham is the only Keydet besides Bubba Parham to tally in double figures in eight of nine games played.

CREAMMER DOUBLES UP

Fresh off a career-high 13 points scoring at Kentucky Nov. 18, junior forward/center Tyler Creammer posted his third career double-double with 12 points and 14 rebounds against Kentucky Christian Nov. 20.

STEPHENS ANOTHER CAREER NIGHT

His career was just four games long, but freshman forward center Jake Stephens made a big splash on November 14. The Bunker Hill, W.Va. native poured in a career-high 20 points on 6 of 7 floor shooting and 4 of 4 in three-pointers to help lead VMI to a 78-72 win over USC Upstate at Cameron Hall.

NEW FACES JOIN STAFF

Two new faces joined the VMI coaching and support staff in 2018-19 with Steve Enright being named assistant basketball coach in June and Tom Kiely becoming Director of Basketball Operations in September.

Enright came to VMI from nearby Bridgewater (Va.) College where he served three years on the Eagles coaching staff

and was promoted to associate head coach before the 2016-17 season. Enright previously served on head coach Dan Hurley's staff at Rhode Island where he was the Rams' assistant director of basketball operations. He also coached previously at Pfeiffer University, Mount Ida College, and Endicott College.

Kiely came to VMI from Seton Hall University where he served as a student manager for the men's basketball team for four years and served on the team staff that captured the 2016 Big East Tournament championship.

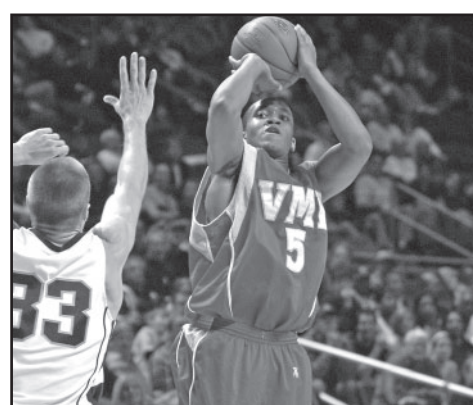
