The Hokies enter the game 22-6 on the season and 11-5 in ACC play ... The Seminoles are 23-6 this season and 11-5 in the ACC ... The Hokies are 15th in the AP poll and 16th in the USA Today Coaches poll and Florida State is 14th in the AP poll and 13th in the coaches poll.

## Last Game:

## \#20/19 VT 77, \#3/2 Duke 72

The Hokies picked up a big conference and national win with a 77-72 victory over third-ranked Duke in Cassell Coliseum last Tuesday night ... The Hokies led almost the entire game, but found itself tied, 70-70 with under two minutes remaining ... Ty Outlaw hit a big three-pointer from the corner with 1:28 remaining and Nickeil Alexander-Walker and Kerry Blackshear Jr., made their free throws in the waning seconds to secure the win for Tech ... Blackshear led all scorers with 23 points and added 10 rebounds for his seventh double-double of the season ... Ahmed Hill had 17 points, Alexander-Walker had 13 points and Outlaw added 11 points in the win.

## Vs. Florida State

The Hokies are 22-33 all-time against Florida State ... Tech has lost the last three meetings, including a 91-82 loss in Cassell Coliseum last season ... Tech is $5-19$ on the road against the Seminols, and 4-16 in the Tucker Center ... Tech is 2-5 against FSU under Buzz Williams.

## That Would Be 11

The Hokies are 11-5 in ACC action this season ... That marks the most ACC wins in a season for the Hokies since joining the league in the 2004-05 season ... Tech had won 10 games in an ACC season five times previously, including each of the last three years.

## Being Ranked

The Hokies are currently ranked 15th in the AP poll... Tech is ranked for the 18th consecutive week (including the preseason poll), the longest streak in preseason and the regular season in school history ... Tech was ranked for 17 consecutive weeks in the 1995-96 season, plus the Final AP Poll of that season.

## KJ Reaches 1,000

In the home Virginia game, Kerry Blackshear Jr., scored his 1,000th career point ... Blackshear became just the 48th player in Virginia Tech history to reach 1,000 points ... He joins teammates Ahmed Hill and Justin Robinson on the 1,000-career point list at Tech ... He grabbed his 500th career rebound at Clemson ... The Hokies are one of only nine teams in Division I to boast three players with 1,000 career points ... Blackshear enters tonight's game with 1,047 career points.

## The Big 22 and 11

The Hokies won their 22nd game of the season on Feb. 26, at home against No. 3/2 Duke ... This is the earliest the Hokies have reached

Justin Robinson the 22-win mark in school history ... The previous earliest was on March 1, 1986, when the Hokies defeated Cincinnati in Blacksburg, 83-71 ... The Hokies also won their 11th ACC game in the win over Duke

## More About the Numbers

With the 22 wins this season, Tech has recorded four consecutive 20-win seasons, second-best in school history ... Tech recorded five consecutive 20-win seasons from the 1981-82 season through the 198586 season ... With the 11 conference wins, Tech will have a winning conference record for the fourth consecutive season ... That is the longest such streak since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season.

## More About KJ

Kerry Blackshear Jr. averaged 20.5 points and 9.4 rebounds per game in the month of February ... He has scored in double figures in the last eight games (all in February) and has scored at least 20 points in four straight games and five of the past seven games ... Blackshear played all 40 minutes against Duke for just the second time this season and the second time in the past three games.

## Wrapping Up the Duke Game Ty Outlaw hit three

 of the Hokies' eight 3-pointers and has hit at least three 3-pointers in 12 games ... The Hokies have now defeated Duke in Cassell Coliseum in each of the last three season, the first time that has happened ... Duke was ranked in the top 5 in each of those three games ... This is the first time a ranked Virginia Tech team has defeated a ranked Duke team.

## Heading to Charlotte

With the Hokies' win at Notre Dame on Feb. 23, Tech has clinched at least a bye in the first round of the New York Life ACC Tournament ... Tech can wind up anywhere between the fourth and sixth seed in the event ... This will mark the fourth consecutive season that Tech has earned a first round bye in the event and the eighth time in Tech's 15 years in the league.

## KJ Doubles

In the win over Central Connecticut State, Kerry Blackshear Jr. recorded his first double-double of the season, with 12 points and 13 rebounds ... It was the first for the Hokies this season and the first by any Hokie since Justin Robinson had 10 points and 12 assists at Boston College on Jan. 31, $2018 \ldots$ With his 23 points and 10 rebounds in the win over Duke, Blackshear now has seven double-doubles this season, including double-doubles in the last three games ... He has six of his double-doubles this season against ACC competition and has 11 double-doubles for his career ... This is the first time a Hokie has had doubledoubles in three consecutive games since Jeff Allen in the 2010-11 season.

## Climbing the Lists

Ahmed Hill is now in 21st place in career scoring at Virginia Tech with 1,378 career points ... Justin Robinson is 24th in career scoring at Virginia Tech with 1,347 points.

## Board Talk

Virginia Tech grabbed an ACC game season-high of 18 offensive rebounds at Notre Dame ... The last time Tech had more than 18 offensive rebounds in an ACC game was Feb. 27, 2010, when it grabbed 20 offensive rebounds at home against Maryland, in double overtime ... The school record for offensive rebounds in a regulation ACC game is 20, set on Jan. 26, 2008 at Boston College ... Tech grabbed a seasonhigh 49 rebounds at Notre Dame ... The last time Tech grabbed at least 49 rebounds in a non-overtime ACC game was on Feb. 17, 2005, 49 rebounds in a home win over Duke ... The last time the Hokies had more than 49 rebounds in a non-overtime ACC game was on Feb. 26, 2008, 50 rebounds in a road win at Boston College.

## From The Line

The Hokies have made 376 of 497 free throw attempts ( 75.7 percent) ... Tech is shooting 77.3 percent from the line in ACC competition ... Tech set a season high at Clemson, making 16 of 17 from the line for 94.1, bettering the game at North Carolina, when Tech was 15 of 16 from the line, for 93.8 percent ... The 94.1 percent is the second-highest free throw percentage for the Hokies in an ACC game and the best percentage when attempting at least 15 free throws ... The free throw percentages of both the Clemson and North Carolina games are in the Hokies' top ten in ACC games ... Tech has made better than 80 percent from the line in 10 games so far this season and six of its ACC games ... The school record for field goal percentage in a season is 75.0 percent in the 1980-81 season ... Tech is second in the ACC in free throw percentage overall and in conference games.

## Dishing It Out

In the home win over Georgia Tech, Kerry Blackshear Jr., led the Hokies with a career-high-tying eight assists (also his high in an ACC game)... Also in the game, Nickeil Alexander-Walker dished out seven assists ... It's the second time this season that Tech has had two players with at least seven assists in the same game.

In the home win over Georgia Tech, the Hokies assisted on 20 of the teams' 25 made baskets, for 80.0 percent ... That was the 10 th time this season that Tech had assisted on at least 60 percent of their field goals and the sixth time that number has exceeded 70 percent $\ldots$ Tech is averaging 60.1 percent for the season on assists per made field goals ... The Syracuse game (92.0) is the highest percentage by an ACC team this season ... Across the Power 6, only two other teams have done so ... Ohio State assisted on 26 of 28 made field goals ( 92.9 percent) versus UCLA, and Kansas State assisted at a 92-percent clip against Georgia State.

## More on KJ's Rebounds

Kerry Blackshear Jr., had 17 rebounds at North Carolina on Jan. 21 ... That is the third-highest rebounds in an ACC regular season game in school history ... Jeff Allen had 19 rebounds at Boston College on Feb. 5, 2011 and Coleman Collins had 18 rebounds in a win over Duke on Feb. 17, 2005 in Cassell Coliseum ... The 17 rebounds marks the first time a Hokie has had more than 15 rebounds in an ACC game in more than five years.

## More About 5

In the record-breaking night against Syracuse, Justin Robinson also set a new Tech record for three-point field goals in a game, with nine ... The nine 3 s is tied for fourth-best in ACC history ... That breaks the old mark of eight, set two seasons ago against Miami by teammate Ty Outlaw ... Robinson's 35 points is also a career-high and is tied for second in Virginia Tech school history for points in an ACC game, trailing on Malcolm Delaney's 37 points against Clemson in 2009 ... He is the first Hokie to score more than 30 points in a game since he scored 32 points in the win over NC State last year ... The 35 points is tied for the fourth-highest total by an ACC player this season and the nine three-pointers are the most by an ACC player this season.

## Getting on Track

In the win over Saint Francis, Ty Outlaw was 5-of-9 from three-point range ... Outlaw entered the game with just four made threepointers in the first four games ... Outlaw followed that by going 4 -of- 5 from behind the arc at Penn State and followed that with a 3-of-5 effort in the win over Central Connecticut State ... He was 6 -of-12 in the home win over Georgia Tech ... He is $120-$ of-254 in this Tech career, for 47.2 percent.

## Ah, Youth

Isaiah Wilkins is the 10th-youngest player in Division I basketball this season and the fourth-youngest among Power 6 players ... Wilkins was born on September 29, 2000.

## More About Wilkins

Isaiah Wilkins was 5-of-7 from threepoint range in the win over Gardner-Webb ... That is the most three-pointers in a game by a Virginia Tech freshman since Justin Bibbs was 5-of-6 from three-point range in a win over Miami of Ohio in the 2014-15 season ... The school record for threepointers in a game by a freshman at Virginia Tech is six, by Carlos Dixon against High Point on Dec. 30, 2000.

## Now Boarding

Ty Outlaw, who missed last season with a knee injury, averaged 2.8 rebounds per game in the 2016-17 season, but has increased that to 5.1 boards per game this year ... He grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds against VMI and an ACC-game high nine rebounds at Pitt last Saturday ... Outlaw had 93 rebounds in all of the 201617 season; he has 142 so far this season.

## The 40s

Virginia Tech has held its opponents to less than 50 points six times this season, for the first time since the 2007-08 season ... Tech opponents are averaging 60.2 points per game this season.

## That's a TO

Virginia Tech forced Gardner-Webb into 29 turnovers in the season-opener ... That is the most forced turnovers for the Hokies under Buzz Williams ... The 29 forced turnovers are the most by a Virginia Tech team since forcing UNC Greensboro into 29 turnovers on Nov. 21, 2010 in the Greensboro Coliseum ... The last time the Hokies forced 30-or-more turnovers in a game was 35 forced turnovers against Maryland-Eastern Shore on Nov. 23, 2004 in Cassell Coliseum ... The school record is 37 forced turnovers, twice, most recently against VMI in 1983.

## Call It a Comeback

In the win last season over No. 5 Duke, the Hokies came back from a 15 -point first half deficit ... It was the second-largest deficit Tech overcame, as the Hokies fought back from a 16-point second half deficit at Ole Miss ... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 91-87 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech's largest come-from-behind victory this season is 12 points against No. 23/22 Purdue.

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 526 consecutive games ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

## NAW on Offense in MIA

In the win at Miami, Nickeil AlexanderWalker scored 25 points, tying his careerhigh in an ACC game ... For the ninth time this season, Alexander-Walker dropped 20 or more points ... The nine 20 -point games is tied for third-most in the ACC on the season ... The Toronto native also had his best two-game stretch of distributing, with five assists at Miami and eight against Syracuse on Jan. 26, for a total of 13.

## Gimme That!

Virginia Tech recorded 16 steals in the win over Gardner-Webb ... That is the most steals in a game since Nov. 21, 2010, when Tech forced UNC Greensboro into 20 steals ... ## Head Coach Buzz Williams

Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad is in his fifth season in Blacksburg and has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach - "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now beginning his 12th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 249-152. Williams has compiled a 96-66 record, now in his fifth season in Blacksburg.

To cap off the 2017-18 season, the Hokies made a second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, the first time the school could claim that in more than three decades. The Hokies finished the season 21-12 overall and $10-8$ in the ACC. Tech made it three consecutive 20 -win season and three consecutive 10 -win ACC seasons.

The Hokies took care of business in the regular season. They defeated four nationally-ranked teams for the first time in school history, including three wins against top 10 programs. The Hokies also finished 11-2 in the nonconference regular season slate.

The 2016-17 season was their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned its first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 record in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the
end of the season, with just a handful of healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity - one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 13969 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season - the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regularseason title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2018-19 will mark his 12th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New

Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A\&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (200001 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A\&MKingsville (1998-99) and TexasArlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A\&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
