### KEY STORYLINES

#### THE SERIES

- Virginia Tech will be looking to snap a two-game losing skid in the Georgia Tech series Saturday.
- The Hokies lead the all-time series, 20-8.
- The first game of the series was played on Feb. 16, 1921 in Blacksburg - a 31-15 win for the Hokies.
- Virginia Tech last defeated the Yellow Jackets on Feb. 13, 2019 in Blacksburg (76-68).
- The two sides met once during the 2020-21 season, following the Hokies' 17-day pause due to health and safety protocols. GT won that game, 69-53.
- Prior to dropping the last two matchups, Virginia Tech

had won six in a row in the series.

- The Hokies are 10-2 all-time against GT in Blacksburg and 15-6 since joining the ACC.

#### A WIN WOULD...

- Mark the Hokies second straight ACC win.
- Be Coach Young's first win over the Yellow Jackets as head coach of the Hokies.
- Hand the Yellow Jackets their second straight loss of the season and third on the road (2-2).
- Snap the Hokies' two-game losing streak against GT.
- Improve Tech to 7-3 at home this season.

#### HOKIE HEADLINES

- Hunter Cattoor and Sean Pedulla stole the show Saturday evening in Tallahassee, combining for 47 points on 16 of 23 shooting to lead the Hokies to their first win at Florida State in 32 years.
- Tech drilled 18 of its 25 3-pointers (72 percent) to set a program record for most 3-pointers made in an ACC game.
- Justyn Mutts (996) and Keve Aluma (980) are both on track to reach 1,000 career points this season.
- Tech is shooting 41.1 percent from three this season, which is on pace to break the school record of 40.3 set in the 2016-17 season.

## NOTEWORTHY

### TALLAHASSEE TRIUMPH

- Tech earned a victory against Florida State in Tallahassee for the first time since an 84-74 win on Feb. 14, 1990.
- It was Coach Young's first win against the Seminoles as a head coach (1-1).
- It also marked the first time since the 1979-80 season that both the Virginia Tech men's and women's basketball teams won in Tallahassee in the same season.
- Entering last Saturday, FSU had won 28 of its last 29 ACC home games. The one loss came against Syracuse on Dec. 4, 2021, which snapped the Seminoles' 25-game winning streak in ACC home games - one shy of the ACC record set by Duke (26).

### STEP(BACK) BROS

- With their career days, Hunter Cattoor and Sean Pedulla accounted for 55 percent of Tech's scoring on Saturday.
- The two made 15 of the Hokies' 18 3-pointers, which were the most by an ACC duo in the last 25 seasons.
- Per @collegebb\_ref on Twitter, it was the first time in the last decade two players had combined to shoot above 80 percent from beyond the arc (min. of 18 attempts).
- Pedulla set a career high in minutes (23), while he and Cattoor also set career highs in points and 3-point field goals made.
- Pedulla became the first Tech freshman to score 20 points since Feb. 19, 2020.
- Cattoor set a program record for consecutive 3-pointers made (nine). After missing his first two attempts from beyond the arc, the junior guard nailed his last nine from deep to finish 9 for 11.
- He also tied Justin Robinson for the most 3-pointers made in a single game (nine).

### ON A ROLL

- Not many in the country have played better than Keve Aluma.
- The redshirt senior had scored double figures in 15 straight games entering the Florida State game on Jan. 29. He scored a season-low four points against the Seminoles.
- It was the longest double-digit scoring streak by a Hokie since Zach LeDay put together 23 straight during the 2016-17 season.

### GOTTA FINISH

- Virginia Tech has struggled to close out games down the stretch. Of Tech's 10 losses, six have been decided by five points or less.
- In five of the Hokies' losses, they've led with under five minutes remaining in the game.

### JUSTYN MUTTS: ELITE PASSER

- Mutts had a career-high eight assists against Miami, the most of any Tech player in a single game this season.
- They were the most assists in a game by a Virginia Tech player since Wabissa Bede had eight against Longwood on Dec. 21, 2020.
- Bede was also the last player to record eight or more assists in an ACC game (nine at Wake Forest on Jan. 14, 2020).

### PILLAR OF THE PROGRAM

- When asked about his assessment of Hunter Cattoor and the impact on the program, Coach Young responded, "Pretty damn good. Couldn't imagine life without him. He's a pillar of this program. He's one that we have built this program with. He may not pass the eye test at times, but you know what you're going to get. He's brilliant, just a smart basketball guy."

### GET IT IN THE PAINT

- In Tech's two games against Notre Dame and NC State, the Hokies produced over 30 points in the paint, leading to two wins.
- When Tech scores 30 points in the paint, the team has a 6-2 record. The lone two losses were to Duke and North Carolina.

### MUTTS-SEE TV

- Justyn Mutts is one of the most dynamic players on the Tech roster. That was on full display vs. the Irish where Mutts dialed up a season-high 24 points. It tied for the most points he's scored in a Tech uniform (3/11/21 vs. North Carolina).
- However, rewind to Wednesday when he

finished the UVA game with two points on 1-2 shooting, that didn't sit well with Coach Young.

- The two met prior to Thursday's (1/13) practice where Young asked Mutts what he needed of his head coach and what he could do to get Mutts going. "He's a terrific passer and he becomes so set in that and making the right pass instead of [having the mindset of] lay your ears back and go play," Young offered.
- In other words, when Mutts is the aggressor and more assertive, good things happen.

### DOUBLE-DOUBLE KEVE

- Keve Aluma leads the Hokies with four double-doubles this season.

- Aluma has reached double-figure scoring in 18 of Tech's 20 games and double-figure rebounding in four games.

### MOMENTUM ON OUR SIDE

- With its third-place finish in the regular-season standings in 2020-21, Tech has finished in the top five of the ACC two of the last three seasons.
- Placing third tied for the highest ACC finish in school history as the Hokies tied for third in 2006-07 and 2009-10.
- If Tech can post a top-five ACC finish this season, it would mark the third time in four years accomplishing that feat.

- The Hokies charted five top-five ACC finishes in seven years from 2004-05 to 2011-12.

### BENCH PRODUCTION

- Through 21 games, the Hokies' reserves are averaging 15.4 points per game.
- Tech has gone over the 30-point threshold four times, with a season-high 36 points coming against Maine and Cornell.
- The Hokies only managed 21 points in their

five ACC games before going off for 17 at NC State.

- Tech is coming off a season-high 32 bench points vs. an ACC foe (at Florida State, 1/29/22). Sean Pedulla led the way with a season-high 20 points.

## DEGREES ON DEGREES

- Storm Murphy and Justyn Mutts are both in grad school at Virginia Tech.
- Murphy graduated from Wofford with a finance degree in May 2021 and is currently pursuing a graduate degree in leadership studies within the Agricultural and Life Sciences program at Virginia Tech.
- Mutts graduated with a psychology degree from Delaware and completed his master's degree at Tech in agricultural and life sciences with a concentration in education in May 2021. He's currently pursuing his second master's degree in educational psychology.
- Keve Aluma earned his first undergraduate degree in human development from Virginia Tech in May 2021 and is currently working on his second undergraduate degree in sociology.

## PUT THE CLAMPS ON 'EM

- Through the first five games of the season, the Hokies held each of their opponents below 60 points. Their 62.10 scoring defense average ranks second in the ACC and 27th nationally.

- The last time Tech opened the season holding its first five opponents below 60 points was the 1946-47 season. That season, the Hokies held their first 18 opponents below the 60-point threshold.
- In addition to their scoring defense, the Hokies rank seventh in the ACC in field-goal percentage defense (.423).
- Tech held its first six opponents of the season below 40 percent shooting before Xavier shot 47.8 percent against the Hokies on Nov. 26.

## OWNING THE ARC

- The 3-point line has been under new management 21 games into the 2021-22 season. Tech has owned both sides of the arc, ranking second in 3FG% defense (.305) and first in 3FG% (.411) among ACC programs. The Hokies are also second in 3-pointers made per game (9.0).

## WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

- Through 21 games this season, Tech has won the turnover battle 14 times, posting a 9-5 record.
- The Hokies rank sixth in the ACC and 35th nationally in turnovers per game (11.0).

## TECH SIGNS NO. 26 CLASS IN THE COUNTRY

- Coach Young announced the signing of three standout recruits during the early signing period, which began on Nov. 10. The Hokies are set to welcome MJ Collins (Rock Hill, S.C.), Patrick Wessler (Matthews, N.C.) and Rodney Rice (Clinton, Md.) to Blacksburg next summer as part of Tech's 26th-ranked recruiting class according to 247Sports.

## REUNITED IN BLACKSBURG

- Keve Aluma, Storm Murphy and Coach Young spent two seasons (2017-19) together at Wofford, highlighted by their 2018-19 season that included a first-round win (84-68) over Seton Hall in the 2019 NCAA Tournament.
- Upon Aluma's and Young's departure from Wofford, Murphy stuck around in Spartanburg, South Carolina, guiding the Terriers to a 34-25 record.
- While together at Wofford, the trio combined for a 51-18 (.739) mark.

## WHO IS THIS GUY?

- Keve Aluma only attempted one 3-pointer in his two seasons at Wofford. In Coach Young's words, "it wasn't even close."
- Fast forward two seasons and Aluma has become a post player with range from beyond the arc. He attempted 57 threes in his Hokie debut in 2020-21, knocking down 20 of them for a 35.1 percent clip.
- After going 2-16 through Tech's first eight games this season, Aluma knocked down four of his seven attempts from long range vs. Wake Forest.

## JUSTYN TIME

- Coach Young has gone on record saying, "Justyn Mutts was probably the key to our year last year."
- The Delaware transfer was the Hokies' fourth-leading scorer from last season (9.5) and second-leading rebounder (6.4).
- From Dec. 29, 2020 through the end of the season, Mutts scored at least nine points in 11 of Tech's 14 games. The Millville, New Jersey native twice broke the 20-point plateau - at Miami (Fla.) (22) and vs. North Carolina (24) - during that stretch.

## LOGGING THE MINUTES

- Storm Murphy logged 3,723 minutes in his career entering this season, which is the 16th-most of anyone in the country returning for 2021-22.
- He ranked ninth in that category among point guards.

### ABOUT GEORGIA TECH

- Georgia Tech is coming off a 73-62 defeat to Miami on Saturday, the last contest in a four-game homestand for the Yellow Jackets.
- With the loss, Georgia Tech sits alone at the bottom of the ACC with a 2-7 league record.
- Leading the way on the court and stat sheet for the Yellow Jackets is senior guard Michael Devoe, a two-time All-ACC selection and the 2021 ACC Tournament MVP. Devoe is one of two players in the ACC (Alondes Williams, Wake Forest) that averages more than 18 points and five rebounds.
- Of the Yellow Jackets' nine league games, only two have been on the road - losses to Duke and North Carolina. GT plays seven of its final 11 ACC games on the road.
- Georgia Tech has played eight of its first nine ACC games against teams in the top half of the current ACC standings.
- The Hokies will need to take care of the ball against the Yellow Jackets. Georgia Tech is No. 2 in the ACC in turnovers forced (14.3) and steals (9.3) in league games.
- Josh Pastner is in his sixth season as head coach at Georgia Tech. In 2021, the Yellow Jackets earned their first NCAA Tournament berth under Pastner after winning the ACC

Tournament.

### LAST TIME VS. GEORGIA TECH

- Virginia Tech and Georgia Tech last faced off on Feb. 23, 2021 when the Yellow Jackets downed the No. 16 Hokies in Blacksburg, 69-53.
- The game was Virginia Tech's first game back following a 17-day pause and the Hokies' three-game home win streak against Georgia Tech was snapped. The Yellow Jackets were amid an eight-game win streak that led to an ACC Tournament championship.
- Both teams exchanged buckets throughout the first half and went into the break tied at 24. However, a 17-4 run to start the second half by Georgia Tech proved to be an insurmountable blow for the Hokies.
- The Yellow Jackets shot 62 percent from the field in the second half, including 5-9 from beyond the arc. For the game, Georgia Tech shot 52 percent from the field, which was the second-highest number that Virginia Tech gave up in the regular season.
- Michael Devoe had a game-high 26 points, more than twice as many as any Tech scorer (Alleyne and Aluma, 12). To accompany his scoring performance, Devoe hauled in 10 boards for a double-double.



## CHALLENGING NONCON

- Coach Young's nonconference scheduling philosophy is quite different from his predecessor - one in which should provide plenty of Quadrant 1 and Quadrant 2 opportunities for the NCAA Tournament resume.
- The Hokies have the potential to play up to six Quadrant 1 or 2 games in their nonconference slate, highlighted by games vs. Memphis, vs. Xavier, at Maryland and vs. St. Bonaventure.
- It's important to note, Tech secured two Quadrant 1 wins all of last season (vs. Villanova and vs. Virginia).
- Six of the Hokies' 11 nonconference games will be played either on the road or at neutral sites.
- Three of Tech's nonconference opponents appeared in the AP preseason poll: No. 12 Memphis, No. 21 Maryland and No. 23 St. Bonaventure.

## HOKIES IN PRIMETIME

- If you're a night owl, then the Hokies' 2021-22 schedule will be right up your ally.
- Tech is set to appear in at least 11 games this season with an official start time of 8 p.m. or later. Seven of those games will tip at 9 p.m. or later.

## PROGRAM WIN NO. 1,500

- Virginia Tech earned its 1,500th program win Nov. 21 vs. Merrimack, becoming the 90th men's basketball program in Division I history to achieve the mark.
- Tech joined ACC counterparts North Carolina, Duke, Syracuse, Notre Dame, NC State, Louisville, Virginia, Pitt and Wake Forest as the 10 conference programs that have reached the milestone.

**NOTEWORTHY**

**STORM WARNING**

- Grad student Storm Murphy takes over the reins at point guard following the graduation of Wabissa Bede.
- The Wofford transfer averaged 17.8 points, 3.3 rebounds and 4.3 assists last season. He was one of only 11 players to average that stat line or better nationally.
- Murphy tallied double figures in 21 of 24 contests, including 10 20-point performances, and dished over five assists on eight occasions.
- He concluded his Wofford career with 1,315 points to finish 24th on the program's all-time scoring list.
- The First-Team All-SoCon selection will provide a scoring threat from outside, as he shot 40 percent from three last season.
- Murphy knocked down 70 3-pointers a year ago. In comparison, Bede connected on 12 with a 24.5 percent clip.

**DANCIN' IN YEAR TWO**

- In previous seasons in Virginia Tech history, the fastest head coach to make the NCAA Tournament was in Year Three. Those Hokies were Howie Shannon, Charlie Moir and Buzz Williams.
- Therefore, with Mike Young doing so in Year Two, he became the fastest Tech coach to make The Dance.

**HOKIE CENSUS**

- Tech has 13 players on the squad who represent eight states and two international countries (Netherlands, Nigeria).
- Florida leads the way with three players – Hunter Cattoor, Lynn Kidd and Jalen Haynes – while Maryland has two players – Keve Aluma and Darius Maddox.

**BOUNCEBACK MENTALITY**

- Tech doesn't lose back-to-back games as it did against Memphis and Xavier, often.
- Young and the Hokies were 5-1 last season after a loss with their lone back-to-back losing skid coming at the end of the season to North Carolina in the ACC Tournament and Florida in the NCAA Tournament.
- In 2019-20, Young had five wins following a loss.

**50 SPOT**

- Tech shot over 50 percent in a game five times during the 2020-21 season - going 5-0.
- Since Young got to Blacksburg, the Hokies are 17-2 in contests shooting 50 percent or greater - only losses: vs. BYU (11/27/19) and vs. Miami (1/26/22).
- Over the last decade (2010-11 season to present), Tech is 88-13 when shooting 50 percent or better.

**LEADING AT THE BREAK**

- Over the last two seasons, Tech is 22-5 when leading at halftime, with two of the losses coming against North Carolina and Florida to end the 2020-21 season.
- The Hokies are 35-9 in the Mike Young era when up at half.

**GREEN-LIGHTED FROM THREE**

- With the potential lineup of Storm Murphy, Hunter Cattoor, Nahiem Alleyne, Justyn Mutts and Keve Aluma, all five of those players have the green light from distance.
- The last team Coach Young had with this type of threat from deep was his 2018-19 Wofford squad, which ranked second nationally in 3-point accuracy (41.4). The Terriers finished 30-5 that season, including an unbeaten mark in SoCon action, and

reached the second round of the 2019 NCAA Tournament.

**RANKED WINS BECOMIN' COMMON**

- Tech had four ranked wins last season, tying the most-ever in school history (set 2017-18).

**REACH OUR POTENTIAL**

- When asked how he'd define success for this season, Coach Young expressed he wanted the Hokies to reach their potential.
- "That will be a real success for me," he said, "And I'll get back to the mountains of North Carolina this spring and fish with a big smile on my face."


**ACC POY CONVERSATION**

**REACH FOR EXCELLENCE**


- Virginia Tech announced on April 20, 2021 a \$400 million fundraising campaign to propel Hokie sports to the forefront of the Atlantic Coast Conference, prepare generations of student-athletes for success in life, and raise the university's profile nationwide.
- The campaign will leverage the momentum of recent successes on the field and in fundraising, such as adding about 10,000 more Hokie Club members in the past five years and opening the Student-Athlete Performance Center, thanks to a record gift. Still, leaders acknowledged that the athletics enterprise needs an infusion of revenue in order to compete at the top of the ACC.
- The budget increase will support athletics in three primary areas: facilities, coaching, and the student-athlete experience.



- The Reach for Excellence campaign has five main pillars, which are:
  - A football enhancement fund to build a program that consistently competes at the top of the ACC, by allotting \$30 million over time for recruiting, assistant coaches' salaries, quality-control coaches, player development, and capital needs.
  - Renovations to improve Cassell Coliseum, with at least \$50 million to be raised privately.
  - The Drive for 25 initiative to increase Hokie Club membership to 25,000 and raise \$20 million annually for student-

athlete scholarships.

- Striving for comprehensive excellence for all sports by providing operating expenses, facility improvements, nutritional and strength and conditioning programs, and more.
- Increasing the number of student-athlete scholarship endowments to expand capacity to support students and broaden reach in recruiting.
- When it's filled with nearly 10,000 fans cheering the Hokies to victory in the last seconds of a basketball game, Cassell Coliseum is an amazing sight. But when it's empty, the home of Virginia Tech basketball, volleyball, and wrestling shows its age. Built in the early 1960s, the Coliseum is due for an extensive renovation.
- Plans call for a completely redesigned experience, including:
  - A new glass entrance along Washington Street
  - Extended concourse areas along both sides to allow fans easier access to different sections of the coliseum
  - The addition of high-end premium seating areas, including club seating and luxury suites on both sides
- This much-needed \$75 million-plus project, helped by at least \$50 million in private support, would create one of the best home venues in the ACC.

WHAT'S A HOKIE?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.



Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The official university school colors - Chicago Maroon and Burnt Orange - also were introduced in 1896. The colors were chosen by a committee because they made a 'unique combination' not worn elsewhere at the time. The official definition of "Hokie" is "a loyal Virginia Tech Fan."







