About Tonight's Game

The Hokies enter the game 9-1 on the season and the Aggies are 4-6 this season ... The Hokies are ranked 13th in the AP poll and the USA Today Coaches poll.

Last Time Out: VT 73, Washington 61

The Hokies picked up another Power 6 victory, 73-61, over Washington in the Boardwalk Classic at Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, New Jersey on Saturday night ... Tech jumped out to a big lead and was up 39-21 at the intermission ... The Huskies were able to cut the lead to as few as seven points in the second half, but clutch plays gave Tech the victory ... **Nickeil Alexander-Walker**, who was limited to just eight minutes in the first half due to foul trouble, led Tech with 24 points and was named the game's MVP ... **Kerry Blackshear Jr., Justin Robinson** and **Ahmed Hill** all added 10 points.

Vs. NC A&T

The Hokies are 6-0 all-time against North Carolina A&T ... All six games have been played in Blacksburg ... Tech is 32-0 all-time against schools currently in the MEAC ... This is the second of three games this season against MEAC schools ... This game begins a four-game home stand for the Hokies.

Joining an Elite Group

In the win over Washington, **Justin Robinson** became just the fourth Virginia Tech men's basketball player to record 500 career assists and 1,200 career points ... He now joins **Bimbo Coles**, **Malcolm Delaney** and **Jamon Gordon** on that list ... Robinson is just 13 assists behind Gordon for third place in career assists at Virginia Tech.

When the Hokies tipped off Saturday, Dec. 15's game against Washington in Atlantic City, Tech starters were a rather unique group ... Four of the five starters, **Ty Outlaw**, **Ahmed Hill**, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, and **Justin Robinson** had all completed their requirements for graduation.

Milestones in the Snow

In the Hokies' 81-44 win over South Carolina State, **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** scored his 500th career point in just his 42nd career game ... After his 24-point performance in the win over Washington, he now averages 12.4 points per game for his career ... In the same game, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, grabbed his 400th career rebound.

Through 10

The Hokies enter tonight's game 9-1 on the season ... This is the third consecutive season the Hokies have started at least 9-1 ... The 9-1 start is tied for the best-ever for the Hokies since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season and since becoming a "Power 6" team in the 2000-01 season ... The last time the Hokies started a season 10-0 was the 1916-17 season, when Tech started 11-0 ... Tech has started two seasons all-time 11-0, as the Hokies finished the 1909-10 season 11-0.

That Holiday Feeling

Virginia Tech is currently 4-0 in December, with two games remaining ... Tech was 5-1 last December, with only a loss at No. 8 Kentucky marring the record ... The last time the Hokies had an undefeated December was the 2016-17 season, when the Hokies were 6-0 in the month, that included a home win on New Year's Eve over No. 5 Duke to open the ACC schedule.

Where It Counts the Most

While the Hokies have gotten off to a great start on the court, their fall semester in the class room was even better ... Ten Hokies recorded at least a 3.00 grade point average, as the team recorded a 3.22 overall GPA ... Two Hokies, **Ty Outlaw** and **Ahmed Hill** entered the semester with their undergraduate degrees and two more, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, and **Justin Robinson**, completed their requirements for graduation and will walk in Spring 2019 ceremonies.

Take a 3, Make a 3

Virginia Tech is fourth nationally and leads the ACC in three-point field goal percentage, at 44.1 percent ... Tech is leads the ACC and is seventh nationally in three-point field goals made per game, at 11.3 ... Tech has made at least 10 three-pointers in eight of the 10 games this season, including a school-record 18 made three-pointers in the win over Central Connecticut State ... Three of the top five individuals in three-point field goal percentage in the ACC are Hokies, led by Ty Outlaw, who leads the ACC in three-point field goal percentage.

Selling Out the Cassell

Virginia Tech announced on Dec. 17 that the home games against Duke, Syracuse and Miami have all sold out ... Less than 50 tickets remain for the home game against Virginia on Feb. 18 ... Earlier this season, the Central Connecticut State game was a sell out, the Hokies' first announced sell out of the season ... The Hokies sold out nine games in the 2017-18 season, including seven of the nine home Atlantic Coast Conference games ... Single game tickets and mini plans for Tech's other home games are still available ... Quantities are limited and the best available seats are going fast ... Virginia Tech's ACC single game tickets are on sale now.

KJ Doubles

In the win over South Carolina State, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, recorded his first double-double of the season, with 12 points and 13 rebounds ... Blackshear's double-double is the first for the Hokies this season and the first by any Hokie since **Justin Robinson** had 10 points and 12 assists at Boston College on Jan. 31, 2018 ... The 13 rebounds are the most by a Hokie this season.

Home Streak

Virginia Tech has won 22 consecutive home non-conference regular season games ... The school record is 23, set twice, once between Jan. 29, 1981 and Jan. 7, 1984 and from Nov. 13, 2005 and Nov. 26, 2009.

Much Improved

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is third-best among ACC players in improved scoring average from last year to this year ... The sophomore averaged 10.7 points per game as a freshman and is currently at 18.3 ppg, for an increase of 7.6 points per game ... He is the only one of the five listed players to have averaged double figures last season.

Lots to Get To

In the win over Central Connecticut State, the Hokies had quite the game ... The Hokies set a new school record by making 18 three-point field goals in the game, surpassing the former mark of 17 three-pointers made at Louisville on Feb. 8, 2017 ... The 94-40 final score marks the 11th time a **Buzz Williams**-coached Virginia Tech team has scored at least 94 points and the first time since defeating Radford, 95-68, in Cassell Coliseum on Dec. 6, 2017 ... The 54-point margin of victory is the most for the Hokies under Williams and the most since Tech defeated Mount St. Mary's, 99-34 (65 points) on Jan. 2011 in Cassell Coliseum.

Now Boarding

Ty Outlaw missed his first career double-double in the win over VMI by one point ... The sixth-year player grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds, the most boards by a Tech player this season ... Outlaw, who missed last season with a knee injury, averaged 2.8 rebounds per game in the 2016-17 season, but has doubled that to 5.7 boards per game this year.

Getting Better All the Time

In the win over VMI, **P.J. Horne** had, perhaps, his best game as a Hokie ... The sophomore scored a season-high 12 points on 6-of-6 from the field and added five rebounds in 26 minutes of action ... Horne was making his second consecutive start of the season ... Horne is shooting 55.6 percent from the field this season.

New Tech Record

In the win over Central Connecticut State, **Justin Robinson** dished out a career-high 13 assists, breaking the old school mark of 12 assists in a game, most recently set by Robinson at Boston College last season ... Others with 12 assists in a game include Dave Sensibaugh, Bimbo Coles and Troy Manns ... It is the fourth time he has had double figures in assists in a game ... Robinson accomplished the feat in just 28 minutes of action.

Keep It Low

The Hokies held St. Francis to 37 points ... That is the fewest points allowed by the Hokies under **Buzz Williams** and the fewest since allowing Mount St. Mary's 34 points in a 99-34 win over the Mountaineers on Jan. 2, 2011 in Cassell Coliseum ... It is the second-fewest points allowed by an ACC team this season ... Tech allowed SFU just 15 points in the second half, the fewest points allowed in a half under Williams and the fewest points allowed in any half since allowing Miami just 15 points in the first half on Feb. 15, 2014 ... The last time Tech allowed fewer than 15 points in a half was on Dec. 22, 2011, when Tech allowed Eastern Michigan just nine first half points ... Tech held Central Connecticut State to 40 points on Dec. 1 and South Carolina State to 41 points on Dec. 9.

Climbing the Lists

In the loss to Louisville last season, **Ahmed Hill** became the 47th player in Virginia Tech history to record 1,000 career points ... In the win over No. 5 Duke last year, **Justin Robinson** scored his 1,000th career point ... Robinson passed Dorenzo Hudson in the Washington game and is now 32nd on the career scoring list at 1,205 and Hill is now in 39th place with 1,138.

Getting on Track

In the win over Saint Francis, **Ty Outlaw** was 5-of-9 from three-point range ... Outlaw entered the game with just four made three-pointers in the first four games combined ... Outlaw followed that by going 4-of-5 from behind the arc at Penn State and followed that with a 3-of-5 effort in the win over Central Connecticut State ... Outlaw is 20-of-32 from three in the last six games, for 62.5 percent ... Outlaw holds the Virginia Tech record for most three-pointers in a game, with eight against Miami two years ago ... He is 81-of-162 in this Tech career, for 50.0 percent.

Tech in the Polls

The Virginia Tech Hokies are currently ranked 13th in the AP poll, the school's highest AP ranking since the 1995-96 season ... Tech peaked that season in late February at No. 8, its all-time highest ranking ... The last time the Hokies played a game ranked higher than 13th was on Feb. 25, 1996, a 57-41 loss at Temple when the Hokies were ranked 12th ... Tech is 13th in the USA Today Coaches poll.

Wrapping Up the UW Game

Nickeil Alexander-Walker posted his fifth game this season of 20 or more points, racking up eight in his young career ... Alexander-Walker earned Boardwalk Classic MVP honors for the VT-UW matchup ... Tech got to the charity stripe and made it count, making 81 percent of its free throws on 17-of-21 shooting. ... The Hokies have made at least 17 free throws in three games this season and are a perfect 3-0 in those games ... This was the Hokies' final regular season neutral court game, finishing 4-0 in those games.

That's a TO

Virginia Tech forced Gardner-Webb into 29 turnovers in the season-opener ... That is the most forced turnovers for the Hokies under **Buzz Williams** ... The 29 forced turnovers are the most by a Virginia Tech team since forcing UNC Greensboro into 29 turnovers on Nov. 21, 2010 in the Greensboro Coliseum ... The last time the Hokies forced 30-or-more turnovers in a game was 35 forced turnovers against Maryland-Eastern Shore on Nov. 23, 2004 in Cassell Coliseum ... The school record is 37 forced turnovers, twice, most recently by VMI in 1983 ... The Hokies forced Northeastern into 18 turnovers, forced 22 turnovers in the win over Saint Francis and 19 turnovers in the win over South Carolina State.

Ah, Youth

Isaiah Wilkins is the 10th-youngest player in Division I basketball this season and the fourth-youngest among Power 6 players ... Wilkins was born on September 29, 2000.

More About Wilkins

Isaiah Wilkins was 5-of-7 from three-point range in the win over Gardner-Webb ... That is the most three-pointers in a game by a Virginia Tech freshman since Justin Bibbs was 5-of-6 from three-point range in a win over Miami of Ohio in the 2014-15 season ... The school record for three-pointers in a game by a freshman at Virginia Tech is six, by Carlos Dixon against High Point on Dec. 30, 2000 ... In the win over Saint Francis, Wilkins came off the bench to lead the team with eight rebounds in just 13 minutes of action ... He earned his first career start in the win over Central Connecticut State and came off the bench to score 13 points in the win over VMI.

45s

Virginia Tech has held its opponents to less than 45 points three times this season ... This is the first season since the 1996-97 season, when Tech achieved that mark four times, that the Hokies have accomplished that feat ... Tech opponents are averaging 57.9 points per game this season.

Like Switzerland

With the win over Washington in Atlantic City, Tech is 4-0 in the neutral court games this season ... Tech is 9-5 in neutral site games under **Buzz Williams** ... The Hokies are 28-21 in neutral site games since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season and 31-25 since 2000-01, the season Tech joined the Big East Conference.

Sharing is Good

Virginia Tech recorded a season-high 28 assists on 36 made baskets in the win over Central Connecticut State ... Tech has had 20-or-more assists four times this season, plus two more games of 19 assists ... Tech reached the 20-assist mark eight times last year, including a school-record 36 assists in the win over The Citadel.

Gimme That!

Virginia Tech recorded 16 steals in the win over Gardner-Webb ... That is the most steals in a game by the Hokies since Nov. 21, 2010, when Tech forced UNC Greensboro into 20 steals ... The 16 steals is the most in a game for the Hokies under **Buzz Williams** and just the sixth time that Tech has had double figure steals in a game under Williams ... That number moved up to eight times with double-digit steals with the 13 steals in the win over South Carolina State.

Analytics and All

As of Dec. 18th, the Hokies are ranked ninth by Kenpom.com ... Tech leads the nation in defensive free throw rate, is second in defensive turnover percentage, third in effective field goal percentage and three-point percentage, fourth in raw offensive efficiency, sixth in adjusted offensive efficiency and seventh in raw defensive efficiency ... Tech is 10th in three-point field goal percentage, 11th in defensive three-point percentage, 20th in assist percentage and 26th in adjusted defensive efficiency ... **Ty Outlaw** is eighth in effective field goal percentage, 15th in true shooting percentage and 21st in three-point percentage.

The Hokies are 12-6 all-time on Dec. 19 ... Tech has won its last five games on this date, most recently a 63-55 win over Presbyterian in 2017 ... The Hokies are 11-2 in home games on Dec. 19 ... Tech has never played North Carolina A&T or any other MEAC school on this date ... Tech is 1-0 as a ranked team on Dec. 19.

Top Returner

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is one of only seven returning sophomores in the Power 6 to start every game during their rookie season and one of just two in the ACC, joining Oshae Brissett of Syracuse ... Last season, 30 freshmen in the Power Five and BIG EAST started 25 or more games for their squads, including Alexander-Walker ... Among that group, arguably the best sophomores in the country, Alexander-Walker had the third-best 3-point field goal percentage, trailing Stanford's Daejon Davis (.403) and Wigginton (.401).

Tech in NCAA Stats

As of Dec. 18th, the Hokies are fourth nationally in three-point field goal percentage and scoring margin, seventh in three-point field goals per game and scoring defense and ninth in turnover margin ... Tech is 12th in field goal percentage, tied for 21st in assists per game, 24th in assist turnover ratio and 36th in steals per game.

Radford to Redshirt

Virginia Tech head coach **Buzz Williams** announced on Nov. 4 that **Tyrece Radford** will redshirt the 2018-19 season ... The 6-2 freshman guard from Baton Rouge, Louisiana will have four years of eligibility beginning next season.

Defeating Ranked Teams

The Hokies are 1-0 against ranked teams this season ... The Hokies were 4-3 against ranked teams last season and 3-6 in the 2016-17 season ... The seven combined wins against nationally-ranked teams in the two previous seasons are the most in a two-year span in school history ... The wins over No. 10 UNC and No. 2 Virginia last season marked the first time Tech won two straight against top 10 teams since winning three straight against top 10 teams in 2007 ... The win at UVa was Tech's second-ever against a team ranked second and first since 1986 ... Tech's last previous road win against a ranked team was on Jan. 22, 2012, when Tech defeated No. 15 Virginia in John Paul Jones Arena.

Last season was the first year the Hokies had ever been part of the "Big Monday" package.

Preseason Rankings

Virginia Tech was ranked No. 15 in the AP Top 25 preseason poll ... The Hokies made the AP preseason poll for the first time since the beginning of the 2010-11 season when Tech was ranked No. 21 to open the season ... The No. 15 ranking tied the Hokies' best ever preseason ranking ... Tech was ranked 15th entering the 1984-85 season, while coming off a 22-13 season that saw Tech reach the semifinals of the 1984 NIT.

595 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 595-194 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .754 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011 was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech was 12-4 in Cassell Coliseum last season and is 5-0 this season on its home court.

This Was New

With the win over No. 5/3 Duke, the Hokies won four games against nationally-ranked teams last season ... It was the first time in school history that Tech had accomplished that feat ... Three of the victories came against top 10 teams, the second time in school history that had happened (2006-07 season, Tech defeated three top 5 teams).

Not Just "5", But Lots About Assists

Last season, **Justin Robinson** set a new school record for assists in an ACC season, breaking his record of 88 last season ... He finished the ACC season with 97 assists ... Robinson set a new school mark for assists as a junior, with 185 ... His total of 185 assists last season was the second-highest in school history, trailing only Dave Sensibaugh's 192 in the 1975-76 season ... Virginia Tech set a new school mark with 269 assists in an ACC season, breaking the old mark of 251, set last season.

Call It a Comeback

In the win over No. 5 Duke, the Hokies came back from a 15-point first half deficit ... It was the second-largest deficit Tech overcame last season, as the Hokies fought back from a 16-point second half deficit at Ole Miss ... The Duke comeback was the largest in an ACC game since coming back from a 16-point deficit to defeat NC State in the first conference game of the 2015-16 season ... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 91-87 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech's largest come-from-behind victory this season is 12 points against No. 23/22 Purdue.

About Attendance

Virginia Tech has increased percentage of capacity in each of the last four seasons ... Tech ranked seventh in percent of capacity in the ACC last season at 83 percent ... The year before, the Hokies were eighth at 76 percent ... This past season, the Hokies had an average attendance of 7,678, up from 7,476 the year before and 5,744 in the 2014-15 season ... Tech is second in average attendance growth in the ACC over the past four seasons, with a 34 percent increase in attendance, trailing only Miami ... Season ticket sales increased by more than 1,000 last season and has a 62 percent increase in sales in the past four seasons ... Tech had an all-time high of 6,107 season tickets sold last season ... The Hokies will see another increase in season tickets and individual tickets sold this year ... The Central Connecticut State game was sold out and Tech has announced that the Duke, Syracuse and Miami games are sold out ... Tech is averaging 7,508 in Cassell Coliseum this season.

Commonwealth Clashing

Virginia Tech won the Commonwealth Clash, the annual athletic competition between Virginia Tech and the University of Virginia last year for the second consecutive season ... The Hokies won last year's Commonwealth Clash 12.5-8.5, after winning on a tie-breaker the previous season, when the score was 11-11 ... Tech leads this season, 4-2 ... The Commonwealth Clash is sponsored by Virginia529, The Official College Savings Plan of Virginia Tech.

Home is Where the Wins Are

Since **Buzz Williams** arrived in Blacksburg for the 2014-15 season, Tech is 58-20 (.744) in Cassell Coliseum and is 48-11 (.814) since the beginning of the 2015-16 season ... Tech has won 22 consecutive home non-conference regular season games ... The nine non-con home wins last season are second-best at Virginia Tech since the Hokies joined the Metro Conference in 1978.

Working Overtime

The 61-60 overtime win at No. 2/2 Virginia was Tech's third overtime game last season, all three Tech victories ... Tech is now 68-49 overall in overtime games and 8-3 in overtime games under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech is 30-11 in home overtime games and 18-8 in overtime in ACC games ... Tech is 29-25 in road overtime games.

Wrapping Up The Purdue Win

Ahmed Hill, who only had five points in the first half on the Purdue win, exploded for 18 points in the second half on 6-of-10 shooting, including three 3-pointers and three free throws ... It was his most points in a game since Nov. 17, 2017, versus Washington when he had 23 ... The win over Purdue marks the first time that the Hokies have ever defeated a ranked Big Ten team ... Tech is the fifth ACC team to win the championship at the Charleston Classic, joining Clemson (2008), Miami ('09, '14) and Virginia ('15) ... It's been 10 years since the Hokies won a non-conference tournament, winning the Holiday Festival title in New York in 2008 ... This is the first three-game in-season tournament that Virginia Tech has ever won.

508 and Counting

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 508 consecutive games ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

They are Free

The Hokies enter tonight's game having made 110 of 155 free throw attempts (71.0) this season ... Two Hokies, **Ahmed Hill** (91.2 percent) and **Justin Robinson** (82.1 percent) are shooting better than 80 percent from the line ... Tech has made 34 more free throws than its opponent.

The head coach of the men's squad is in his fifth season in Blacksburg and has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now beginning his 12th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 236-147. Williams has compiled a 83-61 record, now in his fifth season in Blacksburg.

To cap off the 2017-18 season,

the Hokies made a second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, the first time the school could claim that in more than three decades. The Hokies finished the season 21-12 overall and 10-8 in the ACC. Tech made it three consecutive 20-win season and three consecutive 10-win ACC seasons.

The Hokies took care of business in the regular season. They defeated four nationally-ranked teams for the first time in school history, including three wins against top 10 programs. The Hokies also finished 11-2 in the non-conference regular season slate.

The 2016-17 season was their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned its first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 record in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of

healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2018-19 will mark his 12th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New

Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season

as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
