OPENING KICK

► MT is playing in the state of Virginia for the first time since 2018 when it defeated ODU, 51-17. Overall, the Blue Raiders are 2-1 in the state of Virginia with the lone loss coming in 1994 at James Madison.

► QB **Bailey Hockman** is no stranger to Lane Stadium. The southpaw started for NC State when the Wolfpack visited Blacksburg in 2020. That game was played in front of no fans due to COVID-19.

► **Four** players made their first collegiate start in a Blue Raider uniform last week: QB Bailey Hockman, OG Netori Johnson, RB Amir Rasul and LB Jurriente Davis.

► MT has **14** current players on its roster competing with a degree in hand. The student-athletes are Amir Rasul, Reed Blankenship, Jarrin Pierce, Will Gilchrist, Alex Ustry, Cody Smith, Eric Magwood, Martell Pettaway, Raheme Fuller, Ja'Kerrius Wyatt, Wayne Parks, Chase Cunningham, CJ Windham and Joeseeph Sewell.

► MT is **38-24** all-time in C-USA play (does not include 2018 title game) and is averaging 189.0 yards rushing per game.

► **Consecutive Start Leaders:** DQ Thomas (34), Jarrin Pierce (11), Greg Grate (11), and Reed Blankenship (10).

► Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have been involved in 27 games that were decided in the final minute of regulation or overtime. The team is 16-11 in those games and have won 12 of the last 17.

► Rick Stockstill is third on the school's all-time wins list with **95** victories.

► In 187 games under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders are **+21** in turnover margin.

► MT has scored 30 or more points **82** times in 187 games under Rick Stockstill.

► The 2021 season is the **107th** for Blue Raider football and the 23rd at the FBS level.



DE Jordan Ferguson got the 2021 season started in fine fashion last week. The junior added **2.0 TFLs, a sack, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery** to lead the Blue Raider defense.

BLANKENSHIP ON PACE

Reed Blankenship has enjoyed a strong Blue Raider career. The safety enters his final season on pace to become the school's all-time leading tackler.

A LOOK AT THE SERIES

► Saturday's football game between Middle Tennessee and Virginia Tech will mark the first meeting on the gridiron between the two schools. The two teams were scheduled to play in Murfreesboro last season but that meeting was canceled due to COVID-19.

RAIDERS VS ACC

► Middle Tennessee will be playing its **16th** game against a team from the Atlantic Coast Conference when it travels to Virginia Tech on Saturday. The Blue Raiders are 4-11 in games played against ACC members with the most recent meeting being in 2019 at home against Duke. Two wins have come against Maryland with MT winning at Floyd Stadium in 2008 and then upsetting the Terps in College Park in 2009. The third victory came in 2012 in Atlanta over Georgia Tech and win number four was at Syracuse in 2017. The Blue Raiders lost in the final seconds to Virginia in 2007, and have also fallen to NC State (1989 & 2005), Maryland (2000 & 2006), Clemson (2003 & 2009), Georgia Tech (2010 & 2011), UNC (2013) and Duke (2019).

RAIDERS AND RANKED FOES (based on VT possibly being ranked Tuesday)

► Since joining the FBS ranks in 1999, the Blue Raiders have faced **20** teams ranked in the nation's Top 25. Middle Tennessee has faced a Top 20 team in each of the last three years, including five total during that span. VT will enter Saturday's contest ranked in the Top 25 nationally by the AP. The Blue Raiders have faced nine teams ranked in the Top 10, including at No. 7 Michigan in 2019. MT has never beaten a ranked opponent.

SCORING IN ALL PHASES

► A huge key to success in college football is to be sound in all three phases of the game - offense, defense and special teams. The Blue Raiders were just that in last week's season opener by scoring a TD in all three phases for the first time since **Aug. 30, 2014** against Savannah State. Along with five offensive scores, the Blue Raiders registered a 70-yard punt return for a TD and also a 44-yard interception return to secure the trifecta.

CAREER NIGHT FOR LANE

► Jaylin Lane enjoyed a career night in the season opener against Monmouth. He was outstanding on special teams, returning a punt for a TD, and also excelled as a pass catcher. Lane turned in career bests for receptions (4), yards (91), longest play (35 yards) and was responsible for a pair of Blue Raider TDs - a 70-yard punt return and a 32-yard reception. The 70-yard punt return was the first for a TD by a Blue Raider since 2018 and the longest since Kevin Byard went 76 yards for a score against Old Dominion in 2014.

STRONG DEBUT FOR HOCKMAN

► After starting nine games for NC State in 2020, left-handed quarterback Bailey Hockman brought his services to the Blue Raiders in 2021. Hockman, who started his career at Florida State, completed 17 of 22 passes for 215 yards and three TDs in his MT debut. Hockman is the third southpaw to start under Stockstill and the previous two accounted for five of the eight bowl appearances.

"SUPER SENIORS"

► With the NCAA granting student-athletes another year of eligibility due to the pandemic, Middle Tennessee welcomes back 10 "Super Seniors". These are 2020 seniors who elected to return for another year. The list is comprised of Brad Anderson, Reed Blankenship, Will Gilchrist, Eric Magwood, Jimmy Marshall, Martell Pettaway, Jarrin Pierce, Amir Rasul, DQ Thomas and CJ Windham.

PIERCE KEEPS PRODUCING

► WR Jarrin Pierce, who finished **20th** nationally last year in receptions per game, continues to elevate his play for the Blue Raiders. In his debut year in 2019, Pierce was second on the team with 42 catches then led MT a year ago with 59 (16th most nationally). With **105** career receptions, Pierce needs just **10** more to join Malcolm Beyah in **10th** place on the Raiders' all-time list.

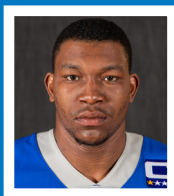

GRATE-NESS

► Junior safety **Greg Grate** is coming off his best year as a Blue Raider. The Miami, FL native ranked second on the team with a career-best 74 tackles to go with three forced fumbles, three pass breakups and four interceptions. He finished **8th** nationally in total interceptions, including the game-winner at FIU. Dating back to 2020, Grate has averaged 8.7 tackles in his last six games to go with three interceptions and a fumble return for a TD.

THE DISRUPTOR

► Senior linebacker **DQ Thomas** has done an excellent job during his career of disrupting opponent offenses. Thomas currently ranks in the top **10** all-time at Middle Tennessee in both sacks and tackles for loss. Thomas owns **15.5 sacks** to rank **5th** all-time and needs two more to move past Khalil Brooks for 4th. He is tied for **3rd** in tackles for loss with **38.0** and needs two more to tie for 2nd.

BLANKENSHIP EYEING MORE INT'S

► Senior Reed Blankenship, who ranks **7th** all-time at MT in interception return yards, is trying to break into the top eight in career interceptions. Blankenship owns **eight** career picks and needs just two more to tie for 8th all-time at MT.

RED ZONE SUCCESS

► Dating back to 2019, Middle Tennessee has scored **51** times in their last **57** red zone appearances. The Blue Raiders ended 2019 with **25** straight red zone scores before failing in their lone appearance at Army in the 2020 season opener.

10 of 15

► In 15 years under Rick Stockstill, Middle Tennessee has reached bowl eligibility **10** times and nine times in the last 12 years. The Blue Raiders have been bowl eligible under Stockstill in 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018.

WINNING TURNOVER BATTLE

► Winning the turnover battle is critical in collecting victories in football. Under Rick Stockstill, MT has a mark of **62-18** when winning the turnover battle and is **48-7** during bowl eligible years (2006, 2009, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018). Over the last **109** games (since 2012), MT is **37-7** when winning the turnover battle.

LOOKING FOR 100

► During its history, Middle Tennessee owns an impressive **175-58-1** (.753) record when a back gains 100 or more yards rushing. Under Rick Stockstill, a Blue Raider has reached the 100-yard mark **64** times and the team has a **53-11** mark in those games.

30 IS MAGIC

► Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders are **72-10** when scoring 30 or more points. The 10 losses came at Louisville in 2007 when the Raiders fell 58-42; at Troy in 2011, 38-35; at home against WKU in 2011, 36-33 (2OT); against W. Michigan in the Bahamas Bowl in 2015 (45-31); at home against WKU in 2016 (44-43); against Hawai'i in the Hawai'i Bowl (52-35); at WKU (41-38 3OT) in 2017; at UNT (33-30) in 2019, at UTSA in 2020 (37-35) and vs UNT (52-35) in 2020.

GIANT KILLERS

► Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have a knack of knocking off Power 5 opponents. With the win at Syracuse in 2017, MT now has five wins over Power 5 foes under Stockstill. MT owns wins over Maryland (2008, 2009), Georgia Tech (2012), Missouri (2016) and Syracuse (2017) with six others being decided by a TD or less.

► Rick Stockstill seems to have a little magic going in tight games. Under his direction, the Blue Raiders are an impressive **7-2** in games decided by one point.

► New receivers coach **Brent Stockstill**, new quarterback **Bailey Hockman** and sixth-year wide receiver **CJ Windham** have a very unique connection. Stockstill was Windham's college quarterback from 2016-18 and is now his position coach. Hockman was Windham's high school quarterback at McEachern where they both played for Hockman's dad, Kyle. In 2015, Windham and Hockman had a special Friday night when they both played key roles in up-setting state champ Buford and stopping a 42-game winning streak. Stockstill and Hockman are two of three lefthanded signal-callers in the Rick Stockstill era.

► The last time Middle Tennessee scored a TD on its opening possession came against ODU in 2019.

► MT has registered over **5,000** yards of total offense in a season nine times in its history, and seven of those have come under Rick Stockstill, including four in the last five years.

► The Blue Raiders have rushed for 200 or more yards in a game **56** times under Rick Stockstill, including **11** times over 300 yards.

► Since joining C-USA in 2013, MT has rushed for **11,666** yards in **62** league games. That averages out to **189.1** yards a game.

► If WR **CJ Windham** qualifies for a letter in 2021, it will be the sixth of his career and a Blue Raider record.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

► **Defensive Scores:** Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raider defense has scored **35** defensive touchdowns, and **30** have come since 2009. Of the 35 scores, 23 have been interceptions and 12 have come by way of fumble returns. The Raiders already have one defensive score in 2021 after only having two in 2020.

► **27 Times Under Shafer:** Middle Tennessee's defense has held the opposition to under 400 yards of total offense in 27 of 49 games under Scott Shafer. MT did it nine times in 2017, nine times in 2018, three times in 2019, five times in 2020 and once in 2021.

► MT owns two shutouts since entering C-USA play in 2013. MT defeated FIU 48-0 in 2013 and downed Alabama A&M in 2016, 55-0.

► LB **DQ Thomas** has **181** tackles for loss yards to rank second all-time at MT. Dennis Mix (1979-82) is the all-time leader with **244** yards.

► The four forced turnovers by the defense against Monmouth matched the most by the Blue Raiders since also collecting four against FIU in 2019.

► The **29** points scored off turnovers by the Blue Raiders against Monmouth was the most by Middle Tennessee since scoring 31 against Charlotte in 2015 - a span of **72** games.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

► Jaylin Lane's 70-yard punt return for a TD against Monmouth was the longest by the Blue Raiders since Kevin Byard went 76 yards for a score against ODU in 2014.

► Punter **Kyle Ulbrich**, a Ray Guy Watch List candidate, average **43.76** yards a punt last season which went down as the second-best single-season average in school history.

► Ulbrich boomed a career long 75-yard punt at FIU in 2020 which went down as the fifth longest in school history. For his career, Ulbrich has 20 punts of 50 or more yards.

► MT has at least one blocked kick each year under Stockstill.

► Middle Tennessee opens the 2021 season not having a single player on the roster who has attempted a field goal in a collegiate game as a Blue Raider.

- ▶ The top-scoring quarter in the Rick Stockstill era is the second quarter. Here is a combined total for each quarter: 1st - **1,252** points; 2nd - **1,556** points; 3rd - **1,018** points; 4th - **1,329** points; and **76** in overtime.
- ▶ When both teams are held under 20 points, the Blue Raiders are **3-1** under Rick Stockstill.
- ▶ As a FBS (I-A) member (266 games), the Raiders have scored 50 or more points 24 times.
- ▶ The Blue Raiders are **99-18** in the FBS era when leading at the half and are **107-13** when leading a game entering the 4th quarter.
- ▶ When trailing at the half, the Blue Raiders are just 23-108 in the FBS (I-A) era.
- ▶ The Blue Raiders saw their streak of scoring in 90 consecutive games come to an end at Army in 2020. However, MT has scored in **135** straight home games (last shutout was 9/23/1995 vs Murray State).
- ▶ Largest margin of victory in the I-A era: 59 points vs Charlotte 9/19/15 (73-14) ... Largest margin of defeat in the I-A era: 59 points vs Oklahoma 9/23/06 (59-0).
- ▶ **Raiders in the NFL:** MT currently has **five** players on NFL rosters: Chandler Brewer (Rams), Kevin Byard (Titans), Darius Harris (Chiefs), Charvarius Ward (Chiefs) and Robert Jones (Dolphins).
- ▶ **Academics are top priority:** Academic success at MT has been a high priority for 16th-year coach Rick Stockstill. Under his reign, the Blue Raiders have seen 96 percent of student-athletes earn their degree entering the 2021 season. MT, who has also been impressive with APR scores under Stockstill, has been publicly recognized by the NCAA for APR success twice. Also under Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have taken home six Academic All-District honors and produced an Academic All-American. The 2020 GSR scores had MT with a record 95 which ranked tied for No. 3 nationally.

Johnny “Red” Floyd Stadium

► Officially named Johnny “Red” Floyd Stadium/Horace Jones Field in 1968, Floyd Stadium is hosting its **86th** season of Blue Raider football with the 2021 campaign. Set on the northwest end of campus, Johnny “Red” Floyd Stadium has one of the top settings in the region and Conference USA.

During the summer of 2014, a new synthetic surface was installed to replace the turf that was installed in 2006. The surface is by Shaw Sports Turf and the brand used is Legion 46, which combines a high-performance monofilament fiber with a durable slit film fiber to provide a soft and resilient playing surface.

The Blue Raiders are **301-126-13** all-time at Floyd Stadium.

The stadium opened its doors on October 14, 1933, with a scoreless tie against Jacksonville State.

Originally built as two sideline grandstands on either side of an outdoor track, it was enlarged in 1940, 1960, 1968, and most recently in 1998 to bring it to its current configuration as an octagonal bowl.

The move to NCAA Division I-A (FBS) football was the catalyst for the 1998 renovation to Floyd Stadium. On August 24, 1995, the University announced plans for a \$25 million renovation, which was approved by the State Building Commission. After a lengthy bid process, ground was officially broken for the stadium in January of 1997 with Turner Construction handling the project.

Upon completion, the stadium featured 30,788 seats with only the east side grandstands remaining from the original structure. The old press box gave way to a five-story tower including luxury suites on the third level, a large press area and suites on the fourth level, and a camera deck on the fifth level. The renovation also included the addition of more chair-back seats as well as a club level.

The stadium is also equipped with 16 indoor suites and 38 outdoor boxes.

The first game in the renovated stadium took place on Sept. 5, 1998. The game, in which Middle Tennessee hosted local rival Tennessee State, drew a school record at the time 27,568 fans.

The Blue Raiders set a new stadium attendance record with 30,502 seeing the home team face Georgia Tech on Sept. 10, 2011.

- **1948:** Permanent concrete stands added to Horace Jones Field to bring capacity to 6,200.
- **1960:** Horace Jones Field expanded to 10,000 seats and a press area was added.
- **1968:** Facility officially becomes Johnny “Red” Floyd Stadium/Horace Jones Field.
- **1968:** Seating capacity expanded to 14,000. In addition, a larger press box was added.
- **1971:** Artificial turf was installed and natural grass became a thing of the past. First game on the new turf was Oct. 2, 1971, against Chattanooga.
- **1979:** On Nov. 3, stadium is officially dedicated and press box sign unveiled.
- **1998:** \$25 million renovation expands seating capacity to 30,788 and the old press box gave way to a five-story facility with a club level, suites, press floor, and a camera deck.
- **2006:** A new synthetic surface was installed to give the Blue Raiders one of the top surfaces in the country.
- **2007:** A new state-of-the-art video board with an 18’x32’ display was installed.
- **2011:** A new fence was installed around the perimeter of the stadium.
- **2012:** The Jeff Hendrix Stadium Club debuted on the west side of the stadium.
- **2014:** New synthetic surface was installed, along with a new design.
- **2017:** New ribbon video boards installed on east side
- **2019:** Debut of the Blue Raider Beer Garden in the south end zone.

Winning on the field, off the field and having a first-class football program from top to bottom is the goal of any university at the highest level of intercollegiate athletics. That is exactly what Middle Tennessee has as a result of the leadership of head coach Rick Stockstill.

In his 16th season at the helm of the Blue Raiders, Stockstill is the fifth-longest tenured coach in the country and third-longest in MT history. With his long tenure have come numerous achievements and accolades, including:

- Six-time Coach of the Year (2006 SBC, 2009 co-SBC, 2018 C-USA, 3-time TSWA)
 - 2018 C-USA East Division champions
 - 2006 Sun Belt co-champions
 - 2009 New Orleans Bowl and 2017 Raycom Media Camellia Bowl champions
 - 94 wins, 3rd all-time in program history
 - Ranks 9th nationally in most wins by an active FBS coach all coming at the same school
 - Eight bowl appearances and bowl eligible 10 times
 - Two NCAA awards for APR success (2011, 2012)
 - American Football Coaches Association's 2017 Academic Achievement Award
 - Back-to-back eight-win seasons in 2012-13 for first time in 21 years
 - Four straight bowl appearances from 2015-18 for first time in program history
 - Six of the top eight crowds in Floyd Stadium history, including top three
 - Eight All-Americans, including one Academic All-American
 - One overall conference player of the year and three defensive players of the year
 - Produced 41 First Team All-Conference honors
 - Four bowl game MVPs
 - Six NFL Draft picks and a pro bowler
 - Produced the school's all-time leader in passing yards, catches, sacks and interceptions
- The leader of the Blue Raiders was crowned

the 2018 C-USA Coach of the Year and the TSWA Coach of the Year after winning the East Division title and making the C-USA Championship game. MT advanced to the New Orleans Bowl for its school-record fourth straight post season appearance.

Stockstill and the Blue Raiders went to Montgomery, Alabama and took down Arkansas State for the Raycom Media Camellia Bowl championship in 2017, the first time in program history they played in bowl games in three successive seasons. It was also the seventh bowl game for MT under Stockstill's guidance and second win, joining the 2009 New Orleans Bowl title.

The first of the four-year bowl streak came in 2015, when MT held a 7-6 record and Popeyes Bahamas Bowl berth. The Blue Raiders had to show a tremendous amount of grit to become bowl eligible, winning all four games in November.

Prior to the three years finishing in bowl games, Stockstill led Middle Tennessee to three straight second-place finishes in the C-USA East Division from 2012-14, including a berth in the Bell Helicopter Armed Forces Bowl in 2013 against Navy.

Some regard the 2012 season as his best coaching job after leading the Blue Raiders to the nation's biggest win improvement from the previous year. They won just two games in 2011, but Stockstill turned the 2012 MT squad around, finishing with an 8-4 record that included an FBS school-record five road wins. They also received votes in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll three straight weeks, another school record, and upset ACC Coastal Division Champion Georgia Tech. Along the way, he produced a Freshman All-American, eight all-conference players and a national offensive player of the week.

MURFREESBORO - Middle Tennessee Football rode the momentum of two second-quarter takeaways to take charge in the season opener, converting two Monmouth fumbles into touchdowns to power the Blue Raiders to a 50-15 win at Johnny "Red" Floyd Stadium.

Jaylin Lane got the scoring started in the second quarter, returning a punt 70 yards for his first career punt return touchdown to give Middle Tennessee an early 7-0 lead.

After the Hawks tied the game, Jordan Ferguson forced the first fumble of the night with a sack on Monmouth's Tony Muskett with 2:47 to go in the second quarter, where Richard Kinley's recovery set up a 29-yard TD pass from Bailey Hockman to DJ England-Chisolm.

Ferguson recovered a fumble the very next defensive series, forced by Marley Cook, with 57 seconds left in the half, leading to a 32-yard pass from Hockman to Jaylin Lane to put the Blue Raiders up 21-7 at halftime.

The second half would see a 10-yard Wildcat touchdown run from Chaton Mobley in the third quarter and an interception returned 44-yards for a touchdown by Teldrick Ross in the fourth to help ice the game for MT. Ross' pick-6 was the Blue Raiders' first since 2019.

Hockman would connect with his old high school wideout, CJ Windham, for his third touchdown of the night to finish his evening at quarterback.

Jurriente Davis would make an impact play in his Blue Raider debut late in the fourth quarter, recovering a fumble forced by Jordan Starling in the red zone, setting up a Martell Pettaway touchdown run.

It marked the first time since 2014 (August 30, 61-7 over Savannah State) the Blue Raiders scored a touchdown via all three facets of the game.
