About Today's Game

The Hokies enter the game 4-0 on the season and the Red Flash are 1-3 this season ... The Hokies are ranked 13th in the AP poll and 14th in the USA Today Coaches poll.

Last Time Out: VT 89, #23 Purdue 83

The Hokies defeated No. 23/22 Purdue, 89-83 to capture the championship in the Charleston Classic on Sunday night ... Nickeil Alexander-Walker led the Hokies with 25 points and Justin Robinson and Ahmed Hill scored 23 points each ... Kerry Blackshear Jr., added 13 points in just 17 minutes ... Tech trailed by 12 points in the first half, but went on a 22-6 run early in the second half and did not trail in the final 12:30 of the game.

Vs. St. Francis

This is the first-ever meeting between the two schools ... Tech is 7-1 all-time against schools currently in the Northeast Conference.

Big Week for NAW

Nickeil Alexander-Walker earned big props following his performance in the Charleston Classic ... In leading the Hokies to the championship, Alexander-Walker was named the Most Valuable Player in the event, joining teammate Justin Robinson on the alltournament team ... On Monday, Alexander-Walker was named the ACC Player of the Week for the first time in his career.

More About Nickeil

Nickeil Alexander-Walker's 25 points in the win over Purdue was his secondhighest career point total, trailing only his 29 points in a win over The Citadel last season ... His seven rebounds in the game was a season-high for him and also his second-best performance on the glass ... His seven assists in the win over Northeastern is a new careerhigh ... He has scored at least 20 points in all four games for the Hokies this season.

Up to 13th

The Virginia Tech Hokies are currently ranked 13th in tha AP poll ... That is the school's highest AP ranking since the 1995-96 season ... Tech peaked that season in late February at No. 8, it's all-time highest ranking ... The last time the Hokies played a game ranked higher than 13th was on Feb. 25, 1996, a 57-41 loss at Temple.

Ty Outlaw has been granted a sixth year of competition by the NCAA and has returned to the active roster for the 2018-19 season ... The wing from Roxboro, North Carolina missed the 2017-18 season following surgery on a torn ACL in his right knee ... He missed the 2015-16 season with a heart ailment.

Wrapping Up The Purdue Win Justin Robinson

finished the win over No. 23/22 Purdue in double figures for the 11th straight game, dating back to Feb. 17, 2018, versus Georgia Tech ... Ahmed Hill, who only had five points in the first half on the Purdue win, exploded for 18 points in the second half on 6-of-10 shooting, including three 3-pointers and three free throws. It was his most points in a game since Nov. 17, 2017, versus Washington when he had 23 as well ... The Hokies got to the lane with ease and made the Boilermakers pay, making more free

throws than Purdue attempted, as they made 19 of 26 compared to Purdue's 7-of-11 mark ... The win over Purdue marks the first time that the Hokies have ever defeated a ranked Big Ten team.

The Charleston Classic, Redux

Virginia Tech is the fifth ACC team to win the championship at the Charleston Classic, joining Clemson (2008), Miami ('09, '14) and Virginia ('15) ... It's been 10 years since the Hokies won a nonconference tournament, winning the Holiday Festival title in New York in 2008 ... This is the first 3-game in-season tournament that Virginia Tech has ever won.

A Gap

Virginia Tech opened the 2018-19 season with a home win over Gardner-Webb ... Tech returns to the Carilion Clinic Court at Cassell Coliseum today, Nov. 24 ... This is the longest game between home games in the non-conference portion of the schedule since a 16-day span in the 2016-17 ... Tech will play four-of-its-next-five games at home and eight-of-its-next-10 games at home.

No 2s

In the win over Northeastern in Charleston, the Hokies did not allow the Huskies a two-point field goal in the first half ... Tech did not allow NU any basket other than a three-pointer until the 6:12 mark of the first half.

Nickeil Notes

Among the Power

Five and BIG EAST conference. Nickeil Alexander-Walker leads all sophomores in points per game (21.8) out of 152 sophomores who have played this season ... Alexander-Walker is one of Alexander-Walker only 22 Power Six players to average more than 20.0 points per game ... He owns the 15th-best clip out of the group ... The Toronto native is one of only three players in the Power Six to own four or more 20-point games this season, as Purdue's Carsen Edwards has five and Duke's R.J. Barrett is tied with Alexander-Walker with four.

That's a TO

Virginia Tech forced Gardner-Webb into 29 turnovers in the season-opener ... That is the most forced turnovers for the Hokies under **Buzz Williams** ... The 29 forced turnovers are the most by a Virginia Tech team since forcing UNC Greensboro into 29 turnovers on Nov. 21, 2010 in the Greensboro Coliseum ... The last time the Hokies forced 30-or-more turnovers in a game was 35 forced turnovers against Maryland-Eastern Shore on Nov. 23, 2004 in Cassell Coliseum ... The school record is 37 forced turnovers, twice, most recently by VMI in 1983 ... The Hokies forced Northeastern into 18 turnovers in the win in Charleston.

Sharing is Good

Virginia Tech recorded 20 assists on 32 made baskets in the win over Gardner-Webb ... Tech reached the 20-assist mark eight times last year, including a school-record 36 assists in the win over The Citadel ... Tech had 21 assists on 36 baskets in the win over Northeastern.

Gimme That!

Virginia Tech recorded 16 steals in the win over Gardner-Webb ... That is the most steals in a game by the Hokies since Nov. 21, 2010, when Tech forced UNC Greensboro into 20 steals ... The 16 steals is the most in a game for the Hokies under **Buzz Williams** and just the sixth time that Tech has had double figure steals in a game under Williams.

Ah, Youth

Isaiah Wilkins is the 10th-youngest player in Division I basketball this season and the fourth-youngest among Power 6 players ... Wilkins was born on September 29, 2000.

More About Wilkins

Isaiah Wilkins was 5-7 from three-point range in the win over Gardner-Webb ... That is the most three-pointers in a game by a Virginia Tech freshman since Justin Bibbs was 5-of-6 from three-point range in a win over Miami of Ohio in the 2014-15 season ... The school record for three-pointers in a game by a freshman at Virginia Tech is six, by Carlos Dixon against High Point on Dec. 30, 2000.

Lots of People Watching 5

Justin Robinson is one of 20 players named to the 2018-19 Bob Cousy Award Watch List ... The award is given annually by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame to the top point guard in the nation ... He is one of 50 players named to the 2019 Citizen Naismith Trophy Men's Player of the Year watch list ... The award is given annually by the Atlanta Tipoff Club to the nation's top player ... Robinson is one of 50 players named to the 2019 John R. Wooden Award, presented by Wendy's Player of the Year watch list.

Analytics and All

The Hokies are ranked 17th by Kenpom. com ... Tech is third nationally in defensive turnover percentage and defensive three-point percentage, sixth in adjusted offensive efficiency, effective field goal percentage and raw offensive efficiency, 11th in two-point field goal percentage and 15th in steal percentage ... Kerry Blackshear Jr., is fourth nationally in offensive rating ... Isaiah Wilkins is tied for first in turnover percentage ... Nickeil Alexander-Walker is 20th in free throw percentage.

Tech in NCAA State

As of Nov. 23rd, the Hokies are 14th nationally in field goal percentage and 15th in turnover margin ... Tech is tied for 34th in three-point field goal percentage per game, tied for 37th in assist/turnover ratio and assists per game and 41st in scoring margin.

Defeating Ranked Teams

With the win over No. 23/22 Purdue, the Hokies are 1-0 against ranked teams this season ... The Hokies were 4-3 against ranked teams last season and 3-6 in the 2016-17 season ... The seven combined wins against nationally-ranked teams in the two previous season are the most in a two-year span in school history ... The wins over No. 10 UNC and No. 2 Virginia last season marked the first time Tech won two straight against top 10 teams since winning three straight against top 10 teams in 2007 ... The win at UVa was Tech's second-ever against a team ranked second nationally (the other was a 76-72 win over No. 2 Memphis State on Feb. 1, 1986) ... Tech's last previous road win against a ranked team was on Jan. 22, 2012, when Tech defeated No. 15 Virginia in John Paul Jones Arena ... Tech has defeated No. 5 Duke in Cassell Coliseum in each of the last two seasons.

Top Returner

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is one of only seven returning sophomores in the Power 6 to start every game during their rookie season ... The Toronto native is one of just two in the ACC, joining Oshae Brissett of Syracuse ... Of the seven players, Alexander-Walker owns the third-best points per game mark among the group, trailing Iowa State's Lindell Wigginton (16.7 ppg) and Brissett (14.9) ... He also has the second-most 3-pointers made (58) and 3-point field goal percentage (.392) ... Last season, 30 freshmen in the Power Five and BIG EAST started 25 or more games for their squads, including Alexader-Walker ... Among that group, arguably the best sophomores in the country, Alexander-Walker had the third-best 3-point field goal percentage, trailing Stanford's Daejon Davis (.403) and Wigginton (.401).

BIG Again This Season

The Hokies will once again host two ESPN "Big Monday" games ... The Feb. 4 game against Louisville and the Feb. 18 game against Virginia will both be part of the popular package ... In addition, the Hokies' game at North Carolina on Monday, Jan. 21 will also be a "Big Monday" game ... Tech was 2-0 in "Big Monday" games last season, both at home and both against top 10 teams ... Last season was the first year the Hokies had ever been part of the "Big Monday" package.

Preseason Rankings

Virginia Tech was ranked No. 15 in the AP Top 25 preseason poll ... The Hokies made the AP preseason poll for the first time since the beginning of the 2010-11 season when Tech was ranked No. 21 to open the season ... The No. 15 ranking tied the Hokies' best ever preseason ranking ... Tech was ranked 15th entering the 1984-85 season, while coming off a 22-13 season that saw Tech reach the semifinals of the 1984 NIT.

20-Plus-10

The Hokies reached the 20-win plateau again last season ... In doing so, Tech has now won 20-or-more games in three consecutive seasons ... This is the first time that has happened since a span of five such seasons that ended with the 1985-86 season ... Last season, the Hokies had a winning ACC record for the third consecutive season, the first time Tech has accomplished that since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season ... Tech had a winning home record and a winning road record in the same season for the first time since joining the ACC.

Not Just "5", But Lots About Assists

Last season, **Justin Robinson** set a new school record for assists in an ACC season, breaking his record of 88 last season ... He finished the ACC season with 97 assists ... Robinson set a new school mark for assists as a junior, with 185 ... His total of 185 assists last season was the secondhighest in school history, trailing only Dave Sensibaugh's 192 in the 1975-76 season ... Virginia Tech set a new school mark with 269 assists in an ACC season, breaking the old mark of 251, set last season.

Climbing the Lists

In the loss to Louisville last season, **Ahmed Hill** became the 47th player in Virginia Tech history to record 1,000 career points ... In the win over No. 5 Duke last year, **Justin Robinson** scored his 1,000th career point ... Robinson is now 38th on the career scoring list at 1,128 and Hill is 43rd at 1,072.

Tech in the NCAA Tournament

Virginia Tech made its 10th appearance in the NCAA Tournament in Pittsburgh last season ... Tech is 6-10 all-time in NCAA Tournament games ... The Hokies' furthest advancement in the NCAA was in their first appearance, as Virginia Tech reached the Elite Eight in 1967.

Outlaw Missed Season, but Earned His Degree

Redshirt senior **Ty Outlaw** missed the season following ACL surgery on his right knee ... Outlaw set a Virginia Tech record with eight three-pointers in the home win over No. 25 Miami last year ... Outlaw finished his degree requirements last season.

Tech is one of only five teams (Kansas State, Oregon State, St. John's and Washington) in the Power 6 conferences to have two 1,000-career point scorers returning ... **Justin Robinson** has now racked up 1,128 points and **Ahmed Hill** has collected 1,072 ... Of the four other teams, Tech will face one of them, Washington, this season during nonconference play on Dec. 15.

Radford to Redshirt

Virginia Tech head coach **Buzz**Williams announced on Nov. 4 that **Tyrece**Radford will redshirt the 2018-19 season
... The 6-2 freshman guard from Baton
Rouge, Louisiana will have for years of eligibility beginning next season.

Threes' Points

Virginia Tech made 15 three-point field goals in a game twice last season ... Tech individual players made at least three, threes in a game 36 times in the 2017-18 season ... **Ahmed Hill** was 11-of-15 from three-point territory in the two games in Madison Square Garden in the 2K Classic ... Hill and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** made at least four, three-pointers in a game six times last season ... Hill made four three-pointers in the win over No. 23/22 Purdue.

Justin Robinson tied a school record and established a new Virginia Tech ACC game mark with his career-high 12 assists in the win at Boston College last year ... He joins Dave Sensibaugh, Bimbo Coles and Troy Manns with 12 assists in a game and broke the ACC game record of 11 he previously held, along with former teammate Devin Wilson ... Robinson is fifth at Virginia Tech with 466 career assists and needs just three assists to pass Al Young into fourth place on the list.

Head Coach Buzz Williams

Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad is in his fifth season in Blacksburg and has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now beginning his 12th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 231-146. Williams has compiled a 78-60 record in his fourth season in Blacksburg.

To cap off the 2017-18 season,

the Hokies made a second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, the first time the school could claim that in more than three decades. The Hokies finished the season 21-12 overall and 10-8 in the ACC. Tech made it three consecutive 20-win season and three consecutive 10-win ACC seasons.

The Hokies took care of business in the regular season. They defeated four nationally-ranked teams for the first time in school history, including three wins against top 10 programs. The Hokies also finished 11-2 in the nonconference regular season slate.

The 2016-17 season was their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned its first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 record in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2018-19 will mark his 12th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New

Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. **UNO** claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season

as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
