RECORDS AND NOTABLES

- Virginia Tech improves 6-1 on the season and Coppin State falls to 1-6.
- Tech maintains its lead over Coppin State and is now 4-0 in the all-time series against the Eagles.
- Virginia Tech head coach Mike Young is now 3-0 versus Coppin State.
- Tech hit 20 3-pointers, marking the second most in school history and being one shy of the school record (21, Delaware State on Nov. 20).
- Attendance was 250.
- UP NEXT: The Hokies will play Longwood (1-6), taking on the Lancers at 8 p.m. ET on Monday, Dec. 21 on ACC Network.

TEAM NOTES

- Virginia Tech used the starting lineup of Nahiem Alleyne, Keve Aluma, Wabissa Bede, Justyn Mutts and Tyrece Radford. It marked the fourth straight game Tech has used that starting lineup and is 5-1 in those games when doing so.
- **KEY FIRST HALF RUN:** The Hokies maintained their lead over the Eagles through the entirety of the first half. Tech ended the first half with a 17-point lead. The Hokies contributed eight 3-pointers out of the last 29 points of the half. Tech left no room for Coppin State to take any runs.
- **KEY SECOND HALF RUN:** The Hokies had several runs throughout the second half and maintained a lead over Coppin State. At the 15:53 mark, the Hokies went on a 21-4 run behind Jalen Cone's nine points, including a four-point play.
- Tech shot 51.7 percent for the game (30-for-58), 54.1 percent from 3-point range (20-for-37) and 70.8 percent from the free-throw line (17-24).
- The Hokies have made a 3-pointer in 572 straight games. The last time they didn't hit a 3 in a game was on Feb. 1, 2003 versus Providence.

- Tech talled a season-high 97 points against Coppin State.
- Last year the Hokies scored 74 points against the Eagles for a 32-point advantage. This year Tech defeated Coppin State by 40 (97-57).
- Tech tallied a season high 20 3-pointers, topping its previous high of 11 (Radford, Nov. 25).
- The Hokies collected a season high 51-points off the bench.
- Tech obtained a season high 30-points off turnovers.
- All 13 of Tech's players made an appearance on the court (two players with their first appearance on the court, with walk-ons Grant Yates and Gill Williamson).

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

NAHIEM ALLEYNE

• Alleyne scored 18 points to tie the game high and collected his season-high five 3-pointers.

KEVE ALUMA

• Aluma scored 12 points for the Hokies and led the team in rebounds, collecting seven rebounds.

JALEN CONE

• Cone scored his season-high 18 points to tie the game high. He gained his season high of five 3-pointers, with being just one shy of his career high (six, UNC).
