## HOKIES HEAD TO LOUISIANA FOR FIRST-EVER SERIES AGAINST RAGIN' CAJUNS

**Tech in the state of Louisiana:** The Hokies return to the state of Louisiana for the first time since the 2018 season when they played in a tournament in New Orleans hosted by the Privateers in head coach John Szefc's first season with Tech. The team went 1-2, dropping a 10-inning game to Iowa on Feb. 23 by a 2-1 count, losing 4-2 to the hosts on Feb. 24 and beating Ball State 4-2 in the second game of the day. In total, Tech has played 18 games in the state and are just 5-13 in those games, including a 2-10 record on the road and a 3-3 against neutral opponents. The most common opponent for Tech has been Tulane and are 2-9 against them. The Hokies have played a total of 15 games in New Orleans, two in Baton Rouge and one in Hammond.

**Home Sweet Home in February:** Since the 2010 season, Tech is now 9-2 in home openers and have won five straight after its 10-3 victory Tuesday night over ETSU. In those five wins, the Hokies have outscored their opponents by a 40-8 count and have tossed two shutouts.

Tech's last home-opening loss was back on March 4, 2015 when they lost to the College of Charleston 8-3. The last time the Hokies lost a home opener in the month of February was in 2013, a 7-3 loss to Temple on Feb. 23.

Overall, in program history in February, Tech holds a 112-58 record (65.9%), but when it comes to playing in Blacksburg during the month, the team is far better.

The Hokies have posted a 28-3 record (90.3%) in home games played in the month. Tech has won 14 straight dating back to that 2013 home opener and included a program-tying best four wins last year (2009).

Lastly, Tuesday was the earliest home opener for the Hokies since their first ever season of baseball. Tech played Newports in Blacksburg on Feb. 2, 1892 and had not played a home game earlier than Feb. 21 before last year - which was a 9-3 win over ETSU on Feb. 19.

**2019 pitching staff turns in one of its best seasons ever:** Last year, the Hokies enjoyed one of their most successful pitching seasons ever turned in by a Tech staff in its history since the program joined the ACC (15 years). First, the team's final overall ERA of 3.98 was the best ever in that time frame. In fact, the Hokies had not posted a sub-4.00 ERA since 1984 (3.80) - the lowest since was 4.10 in 1995.

The team also finished second all-time in strikeouts (495), with the 2010 squad holding the top mark ever with 530. The previous high was 461 (1988). Below are other notables for the staff (since 2005):

**2019 team fielding sets records, too:** Tech fielded one of its best defensive teams ever at the school in 2019. Its fielding percentage of .975 was four points better than the previous school record of .971 set by the 2012 squad.

The Hokies' 49 errors were the fewest since the team has been playing in the ACC (2012, 62).

# #14 John Szefc

## Virginia Tech Head Coach - Third Season



Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock announced the hiring of Tech's 25th head baseball coach on June 9, 2017 and formally introduced John Szefc as the head coach of the baseball program at a press conference a few days later on June 15. The 2020 season will mark his third as the Hokies' head coach.

Szefc (pronounced SHEFF), who won his 400th career game on March 10, 2018 guiding the Hokies to a 3-1 victory over Pitt, accepted the position at Tech after leading Maryland to three NCAA appearances and a 180-122 (.596) overall record as the Terrapins' head coach. Before arriving in Blacksburg, Szefc owned a 392-259-3 (.602) career record in 12 seasons as an NCAA head coach, producing 10 campaigns with 30 or more wins.

In addition to ending a 43-year NCAA tournament drought and becoming the fastest coach to 100 career wins at Maryland, Szefc spent seven seasons (1996-2002) at the helm of the Marist College baseball program, where he led the team to four conference championships, four NCAA Regional appearances and a 212-137-3 (.607) overall mark. Szefc earned Northeastern Conference Coach of the Year honors in 1997 and was the American Baseball Coaches Associate Northeast Region Coach of the Year in 2001.

The first coach in Maryland history to ever take the Terrapins to an NCAA Super Regional, Szefc accomplished the feat twice in 2014 and 2015 as he guided the program to the first two 40-win seasons in school history and claimed Maryland's first two NCAA Regional crowns. Maryland achieved a final No. 14 ranking both seasons, the highest finishes in school history.

He guided the Terrapins to the ACC Tournament final for the first time in 38 years in 2014 and then took Maryland to the Big Ten tournament final in the school's initial season in that conference, winning a program-best 42 games in 2015.

Szefc has coached 107 players that have been drafted or signed professional contracts since 1997, including four in 2018 and five in 2019. Over the last seven drafts, 34 of his players have been selected, including the 45th pick of the 2014 draft Jake Stinnett, the highest pick of a Maryland player in almost a decade. Almost a dozen have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, including most recently, Mike Shawarzyn (Red Sox) and Lamonte Wade (Twins) in 2019. He has also helped develop 23 All-Americans, including 10 of the 20 players in Maryland history to earn that distinction.

The Middletown, N.Y. native arrived at Maryland after a two-year stint as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas State (2011-12) and a two-season stay as assistant head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas (2009-10). He also enjoyed a six-season tenure as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Louisiana (2003-08). Szefc began his coaching career as an assistant at Sacred Heart (1995) and at Drexel (1990-93).

Szefc managed the New York Generals in the Atlantic College Baseball League during the summers of 1995 and 1996. He led the club to a 47-28 record, earned two consecutive division titles and took the Generals to the ACBL title game in 1996.

Collegiately, he played two years at Connecticut before transferring in 1987 to Drexel. During his senior campaign for the Dragons, he was tabbed an All-East Coast Conference outfielder.

He graduated from Drexel University with a degree in corporate communications in 1989. He also holds a master's degree in sports administration from Temple University.

Szefc and his wife, Barbara, have a daughter, Anna, and two sons, John Michael and Sam.

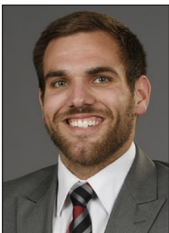

### WHAT IS A HOKIE?

Probably the most frequently asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics and the answer dates back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute.

With it came a contest held by the student body for writing a new cheer and senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull said the words had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention. "Hokie" soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics. Below is the "Old Hokie" yell:

**Hoki, Hoki, Hoki Hy!  
Tech! Tech! V.P.I.!  
Sola-Rex Sola-Rah  
Polytech-Vir-gin-i-a!!  
Rae, Ri, V.P.I.**

### JUST VIRGINIA TECH, PLEASE!

While the full name of the school is Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, the school is commonly referred to as "Virginia Tech."

Founded in 1872, as Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College, the university changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute in 1896.

Fans of the athletic department, as well as media covering the Hokies, shortened the name to VPI, but it eventually became Virginia Tech.

The "State University" was added in 1970 to bring the official title to what it is today.

Those covering Hokie athletics are asked to refer to the university as simply "Virginia Tech."

Virginia Tech University, VPI and SU, VPI&SU, VT or VA Tech are not **recognized names and should not be used.**

ENGLISH FIELD AT ATLANTIC UNION BANK PARK



On March 21, 2016, Virginia Tech renamed its baseball stadium to English Field at Union Park in recognition of a generous commitment of support to the athletics department from Union Bank & Trust. The stadium received substantial upgrading with help of \$3.5 million committed by the Richmond-based bank. On the date, Tech's Board of Visitors approved extending naming rights to the stadium to Union Bank for 10 years in recognition of the company's financial support. The stadium was later renamed English Field at Atlantic Union Bank Park on May 20, 2019 to align with the rebranding of Virginia's largest financial institution.

Located at the intersection of Southgate Drive and Duck Pond Drive, English Field at Union Park is an incredible new home for Virginia Tech baseball. Designed by Cannon Design and built by Whiting-Turner, the \$20 million renovation project added a new grandstand area - with new press-level premium suites - 1,132 permanent chair-back seats in concrete stands and a club level above the first-base dugout, along with a social picnic area down the right-field line. The terracing along the third-base line remains.

English Field was officially dedicated during a special ceremony on April 8, 1989 and is named for the late E.R. 'Red' English and his wife, Ruth, who provided financial support for its initial construction.

English, a native of Altavista, Va., played as an offensive and defensive guard on Tech's football team from 1930-33 and graduated in 1934. He contributed to Tech athletics for more than 50 years and was one of the founders of The Student Aid Association in 1949. He served as president of that organization two of its first three years. English received the most outstanding alumni award at Tech in 1984.

Through a generous gift from alumnus George Sampson, the home team dugout was named for long-time Tech baseball coach G.F. 'Red' Laird during a ceremony on April 12, 1991. Laird recruited and coached Sampson at Tech.

The team's year-by-year overall mark in its 32 seasons at here can be seen on the right. Prior, the Hokies played home games at Tech Park, where the team was 431-122-1 (.779) over 34 seasons. All-time, Tech is 1,276-586-12 (.684) in games played in Blacksburg.
