Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock announced the hiring of Tech's 25th head baseball coach on June 9, 2017 and formally introduced John Szefc as the head coach of the baseball program at a press conference a few days later on June 15. The 2020 season will mark his third as the Hokies' head coach.

Szefc (pronounced SHEFF), who won his 400th career game on March 10, 2018 guiding the Hokies to a 3-1 victory over Pitt, accepted the position at Tech after leading Maryland to three NCAA appearances and a 180-122 (.596) overall record as the Terrapins' head coach. Before arriving in Blacksburg, Szefc owned a 392-259-3 (.602) career record in 12 seasons as an NCAA head coach, producing 10 campaigns with 30 or more wins.

In addition to ending a 43-year NCAA tournament drought and becoming the fastest coach to 100 career wins at Maryland, Szefc spent seven seasons (1996-2002) at the helm of the Marist College baseball program, where he led the team to four conference championships, four NCAA Regional appearances and a 212-137-3 (.607) overall mark. Szefc earned Northeastern Conference Coach of the Year honors in 1997 and was the American Baseball Coaches Associate Northeast Region Coach of the Year in 2001.

The first coach in Maryland history to ever take the Terrapins to an NCAA Super Regional, Szefc accomplished the feat twice in 2014 and 2015 as he guided the program to the first two 40-win seasons in school history and claimed Maryland's first two NCAA Regional crowns. Maryland achieved a final No. 14 ranking both seasons, the highest finishes in school history.

He guided the Terrapins to the ACC Tournament final for the first time in 38 years in 2014 and then took Maryland to the Big Ten tournament final in the school's initial season in that conference, winning a program-best 42 games in 2015.

Szefc has coached 107 players that have been drafted or signed professional contracts since 1997, including four in 2018 and five in 2019. Over the last seven drafts, 34 of his players have been selected, including the 45th pick of the 2014 draft Jake Stinnett, the highest pick of a Maryland player in almost a decade. Almost a dozen have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, including most recently, Mike Shawaryn (Red Sox) and Lamonte Wade (Twins) in 2019. He has also helped develop 23 All-Americans, including 10 of the 20 players in Maryland history to earn that distinction.

The Middletown, N.Y. native arrived at Maryland after a two-year stint as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas State (2011-12) and a two-season stay as assistant head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas (2009-10). He also enjoyed a six-season tenure as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Louisiana (2003-08). Szefc began his coaching career as an assistant at Sacred Heart (1995) and at Drexel (1990-93).

Szefc managed the New York Generals in the Atlantic College Baseball League during the summers of 1995 and 1996. He led the club to a 47-28 record, earned two consecutive division titles and took the Generals to the ACBL title game in 1996.

Collegiately, he played two years at Connecticut before transferring in 1987 to Drexel. During his senior campaign for the Dragons, he was tabbed an All-East Coast Conference outfielder.

He graduated from Drexel University with a degree in corporate communications in 1989. He also holds a master's degree in sports administration from Temple University.

Szefc and his wife, Barbara, have a daughter, Anna, and two sons, John Michael and Sam.

## WHAT IS A HOKIE?

Probably the most frequently asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics and the answer dates back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute.

With it came a contest held by the student body for writing a new cheer and senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull said the words had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention. "Hokie" soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics. Below is the "Old Hokie" yell:

Hoki, Hoki, Hoki Hy! Tech! Tech! V.P.I.! Sola-Rex Sola-Rah Polytech-Vir-gin-i-a!! Rae, Ri, V.P.I.

### **JUST VIRGINIA TECH, PLEASE!**

While the full name of the school is Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, the school is commonly referred to as "Virginia Tech." Founded in 1872, as Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College, the university changed its named to Virginia Polytechnic Institute in 1896.

Fans of the athletic department, as well as media covering the Hokies, shortened the name to VPI, but it eventually became Virginia Tech.

The "State University" was added in 1970 to bring the official title to what it is today.

Those covering Hokie athletics are asked to refer to the university as simply "Virginia Tech."

Virginia Tech University, VPI and SU, VPI&SU, VT or VA Tech are not recognized names and should not be used.

On March 21, 2016, Virginia Tech renamed its baseball stadium to English Field at Union Park in recognition of a generous commitment of support to the athletics department from Union Bank & Trust. The stadium received substantial upgrading with help of \$3.5 million committed by the Richmond-based bank. On the date, Tech's Board of Visitors approved extending naming rights to the stadium to Union Bank for 10 years in recognition of the company's financial support. The stadium was later renamed English Field at Atlantic Union Bank Park on May 20, 2019 to align with the rebranding of Virginia's largest financial institution.

Located at the intersection of Southgate Drive and Duck Pond Drive, English Field at Union Park is an incredible new home for Virginia Tech baseball. Designed by Cannon Design and built by Whiting-Turner, the \$20 million renovation project added a new grandstand area – with new press-level premium suites – 1,132 permanent chair-back seats in concrete stands and a club level above the first-base dugout, along with a social picnic area down the right-field line. The terracing along the third-base line remains.

English Field was officially dedicated during a special ceremony on April 8, 1989 and is named for the late E.R. 'Red' English and his wife, Ruth, who provided financial support for its initial construction.

English, a native of Altavista, Va., played as an offensive and defensive guard on Tech's football team from 1930-33 and graduated in 1934. He contributed to Tech athletics for more than 50 years and was one of the founders of The Student Aid Association in 1949. He served as president of that organization two of its first three years. English received the most outstanding alumni award at Tech in 1984.

Through a generous gift from alumnus George Sampson, the home team dugout was named for long-time Tech baseball coach G.F. 'Red' Laird during a ceremony on April 12, 1991. Laird recruited and coached Sampson at Tech.

The team's year-by-year overall mark in its 32 seasons at here can be seen on the right. Prior, the Hokies played home games at Tech Park, where the team was 431-122-1 (.779) over 34 seasons. All-time, Tech is 1,276-586-12 (.684) in games played in Blacksburg.

## 2020 VIRGINIA TECH GAME NOTES - WEEKEND NO. 2



**S** Facing any ranked opponents: The chart on the left shows how the Hokies have fared against any ranked opponent in their history as a member of the ACC (since 2005).

Over the past two seasons, Tech has played 30 games versus ranked opponents and are a combined 5-25, which includes a 3-13 mark in 2019.

Entering the second weekend of 2020, there are six teams on the Hokies' schedule that are ranked in one of the five major polls, all ACC teams, for a total of 18 possible games against ranked opponents this year - which can obviously change over the course of 15 weeks.

**A number of new faces:** Tech, who featured 20 new players on the 2019 roster, has welcomed 20 new faces to the 2020 squad - 16 freshman and four transfers - while sporting just four seniors. The quartet of final-year players on this year's roster marks the fewest for a Tech squad since the 2014 season, when the Hokies had just two - pitchers Tanner McIntyre and Brad Markey.

**Starting streaks to open the year:** Two of those new faces from a season ago - Nick Biddison and Kevin Madden - return for their sophomore seasons and are the only two Hokies, of four, to start and play in 50 or more games in 2019.

Kerry Carpenter (53/53) and Nick Owens (52/52) are gone, which leaves Biddison (52/52) with the longest current consecutive starts streak on the team as he now stands at 49 straight, missing only the Feb. 26 start versus Radford. Madden (50/50) now has the second longest streak at 29 straight - all at third base, after last missing a start on March 30 versus Clemson.

Carpenter started every game last year (53 straight), while the next longest milestone streak to surpass is the 99 straight starts by *Jack Owens* from Feb. 17, 2017 through May 1, 2018.

The last Tech player to start more than 100 straight was Sam Fragale, who played 126 straight from April 23, 2016 through the end of his Tech career - May 19, 2018. Ryan Tufts did him one better, posting a 127 game streak started on April 15, 2015 and ending with the final game of his career - May 20, 2017.

**Tech's earliest start to a season:** The Hokies have opened a season just twice before Feb. 14, with the first one occurring during their first season of baseball at the school, which started in 1892. Tech played Newports in Newport, Va. on Feb. 1 and were victories, 18-8.

The same two teams faced off the next day in Blacksburg and the Hokies won again, 8-0, and concluded their season 2-0.

In 2015, Tech traveled to Macon, Georgia to take on the Mercer Bears in a three-game series that started on Feb. 13. The Hokies lost their season opener 9-1, but took the final two games of the set.

**Happy Opening Day:** For just the fourth time in program history, the Hokies will play a baseball game on Valentine's Day (Feb. 14). The first game played on Feb. 14 was back in 2003, when the Hokies beat Campbell, 6-4, in Buies Creek, N.C. In 2014, the Citadel defeated Tech 6-2 in Charleston, S.C. and the Hokies took care of Mercer 11-4 in 2015 in Macon, Ga.

**D1Baseball recognizes four Hokies:** Over a few weeks before the start of the season, D1Baseball announced the nation's top players by position and four Tech players were among those recognized. Zach Brzykcy was No. 14 among Top 50 relievers, Kevin Madden was No. 17 among top 30 third basemen, Nick Biddison was ranked No. 42 among the Top 100 outfielders and Ian Seymour was slotted at No. 41 among starting pitchers.

**Tech walk-off wins:** In his first home game as Tech head coach and his eighth game overall, John Szefc saw his team win in walk-off fashion in extra innings against Radford, 3-2 in 12 frames (Feb. 27, 2018). It took seven games in the 2019 season to see his team register another walk-off win, ironically enough, against Radford again (Feb. 26). *Luke Horanski* hit a two-run walk-off home run in the bottom of the ninth to give the Hokies the win.

Since joining the ACC (15 seasons), the Hokies have had 36 walk-off wins (15 in ACC games) - with the most occurring during the 2012 season, when they had seven.

The earliest walk-off in that span (by date) was Feb. 25, 2012 - a *Chad Morgan* sac fly in the bottom of the ninth gave Tech a 4-3 win over Iowa in Conway, S.C.

In the prior five seasons, the Hokies have 14 walk-off wins, eight against ACC opponents. Below is a list of Tech's walk-off victories the last five seasons.
