Evaluations	
Evaluation Period	 168 evaluation days at the institution's discretion from April 15 – May 31 Days must be on file in AD's office (Jordan, please email like in past) Quiet period days while not evaluating Limited to two evaluations per prospect (one academic and one athletics) If both an academic and athletic evaluation occur on the same day, it is considered an academic evaluation Coaches may conduct a second athletic evaluation on another day Each institution may visit a school no more than two calendar days Includes visits in which only contact with a signed prospect is made Any visit to a PSA's school counts as an evaluation for all prospects Evaluation for PSAs at a school is not counted if the coach watches competition at school between PSAs that don't attend that school 10 countable assistant coaches can be on the road during this period
Restrictions	 Direct contact with a prospect or their family members is impermissible: No "bumps"/conversations, posing for pictures, autographs, etc. No more than 2 coaches may visit a school on any calendar day Cannot attend workouts at training facilities Cannot be involved in conducting drills with coaches or prospects Cannot provide expenses for high school coaches (e.g., lunch, dinner)
Locations	 Regularly-scheduled HS, prep school, & junior college contests & practices Regular scholastic activities involving prospects enrolled only in the school at which the scholastic activities are taking place Events organized and conducted solely by the state high school, prep school, or JUCO athletics associations
Telephone Calls	April 15 – May 31, 2023: 2023 PSAs = Calls at the institution's discretion 2024 PSAs = One call total 4-Year/2-Year Transfer PSAs = One call per week

Head Football Coach Restrictions

- May not engage in any off-campus recruiting activities. This prohibition includes:
 - o In person, off-campus recruiting contacts with prospects (including signees)
 - o Participation in off-campus coaching clinics
 - Visit a prospect's school for <u>any</u> reason
 - Meet with a prospect's coach at an off-campus location

Banquets During Evaluation Period

- Coaches may speak at banquets without using an evaluation provided:
 - Request is initiated and conducted by the high school or third party host
 - Coach does not make recruiting presentation
 - Coach does not have direct contact with prospects or their family members
 - No evaluation activities occur
 - Banquet/meeting at PSA's school where PSAs are in attendance counts as once-per-week visit to school

REMINDER: Not otherwise permissible for staff member to attend banquet. Please check with Compliance.
