FOR OPENERS

- UVA is 3-0 vs. ranked opponents (Wisconsin, Maryland, Florida State).
- The Cavaliers have started 15-0 for the first time since starting 19-0 in 2014-15.
- The Virginia-Virginia Tech game is part of the Commonwealth Clash presented by Virginia529, which is a head-to-head, points-based competition between the athletic teams of the Cavaliers and Hokies.

UVA VS. THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

- UVA is 2-0 against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia, posting wins against VCU (57-49) and William & Mary (72-40).
- UVA has a 66-15 record against teams from Virginia since 1999-00.
- UVA has won 19 of its last 22 games against teams from Virginia.
- The Cavaliers went 3-1 vs. the Commonwealth last year.

ALL-TIME VS. VIRGINIA TECH

- Virginia is 91-56 all-time vs. Virginia Tech, including a 38-13 mark in Charlottesville, in the series that dates back to 1914-15.
- The Cavaliers' five-game winning streak against the Hokies in Charlottesville ended last season with a 61-60 overtime loss at JPJ.
- UVA posted a 78-52 win at Virginia Tech last season, marking its largest margin of victory against the Hokies in Blacksburg.
- UVA and VT have split the last six meetings with two of the six contests decided in overtime.
- The Cavaliers are 7-3 in their last 10 games vs. the Hokies.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 12-6 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.

LAST TIME VS. THE HOKIES

- Then-No. 2 Virginia fell 61-60 in overtime to Virginia Tech on Feb. 10, 2018 in a Commonwealth Clash match at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Kerry Blackshear rebound basket gave Tech the one-point lead, but Ty Jerome misfired on a 28-footer at the other end to secure the win for the Hokies.
- Justin Robinson led the Hokies with 20 points and seven assists, and Nickeil Alexander-Walker had 12 points.
- Devon Hall had 16 points for Virginia, but missed a pair of free throws in the final 31 seconds.
- De'Andre Hunter added 14 points and Kyle Guy 13 for the Cavaliers, who shot a season-low 34.4 percent, making 21 of 61 shots.

• As of Jan. 13, UVA ranks No. 2 in the KenPom.com overall and adjusted defense efficiency and No. 6 in adjusted offense efficiency. • UVA is shooting 47.4 percent (second best in Bennett era), 39.8 percent from 3-point range (second best in school history) and 77.2 percent from the free throw line (best in school history).

UVA RANKED NO. 4 IN AP POLL

- Virginia is ranked No. 4 in the AP poll for the fourth straight week and No. 1 in the Coaches Poll for the second straight week.
- The Cavaliers have been ranked in the top six in the AP poll for 10 consecutive weeks.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 26 straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in each of the past 21 polls.
- UVA was ranked No. 5 in the preseason polls and has been ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in four of the past five seasons. • In 2017-18, Virginia became the fourth team in the Top 25 era to earn a No. 1 ranking after being unranked in the preseason.

UVA IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICAL RANKINGS

• As of Jan. 14, UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense (51.2 ppg), turnovers per game (8.9), fewest turnovers (133), 3-point field goal percentage defense (24.5%) and winning percentage (100%), third in field goal percentage defense (36.6%) and scoring margin (22.6), fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.66), seventh in free throw percentage (77.2%), ninth in fewest fouls (230), 11th in 3-point field goal percentage (39.8%), 20th in personal fouls per game (15.3), 24th in turnover margin (3.9) and 27th in rebound margin (6.7).

CAVALER QUARTET AMONG ACC LEADERS

- As of Jan. 14, Kyle Guy ranks first in the ACC in 3-pointers (3.1), third in 3-point percentage (46%), ninth in minutes (33.1) and 12th in scoring (15.3).
- Ty Jerome ranks third in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.8), fourth in assists (4.4), eighth in 3-point percentage (39.7%), ninth in steals (1.9) and 22nd in minutes (30.8)
- De'Andre Hunter ranks eighth in free throw shooting (81%) and 20th in scoring (14.0).
- Braxton Key ranks 19th in rebounding (5.9).

- Kyle Guy scored 13 points to lead No. 4 Virginia to a 63-43 win at Clemson on Saturday, Jan. 12.
- De'Andre Hunter added 12 points and reserve Jay Huff chipped in 11 points and seven rebounds in the second half.
- UVA held Clemson to two points in the first 10:57 of the game.
- UVA went 10 of 23 from 3-point range, while Clemson was 3 of 19.
- The Cavaliers out-rebounded the Tigers 46-36, led by Braxton Key and Jack Salt with eight rebounds apiece.
- UVA held Clemson to 25.9 percent shooting as the Tigers were just 14 of 54 from the field.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 234-86 (.731) mark in 10 seasons at Virginia and 303-119 (.720)
- career mark in 13 seasons. • Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- In 2017-18, Bennett led Virginia to its eighth ACC regular-season title, third ACC Tournament championship, school-record 31 wins, ACC-record 17 league wins and ACC-record 9-0 mark on the road.
- · Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- Bennett also earned Division I National Coach of the Year honors from the AP, USA Today and NABC.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018). Bennett has guided UVA to five straight NCAA Tournament ap-
- pearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in three of the last five seasons and a school-record six straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best seven straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a then-school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- UVA is 126-35 (.782) in non-conference action, 108-51 (.679) in ACC play and 136-25 (.845) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks sixth all-time in winning percentage at .679, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

- UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense at 51.2 ppg.
- The Cavaliers have limited seven opponents to fewer than 50 points (Coppin State, Morgan State, Towson, Wisconsin, VCU, William & Mary and Clemson).
- UVA has held 12 opponents to 40 percent or less shooting from the field and 13 opponents to 33 percent or less shooting from 3-point
- UVA has out-rebounded 12 opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense five times and finished in the top-five nationally in nine of 12 seasons.

HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- Virginia is led by the quartet of Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, De'Andre Hunter and Jack Salt.
- Jerome, Guy and Hunter have started all 15 games, while Salt has started 12 and anchors UVA's defense.
- Jerome, Guy or Hunter have led or tied for the UVA scoring lead in each of its 15 contests, accounting for 58 percent of the Cavaliers'
- Alabama transfer Braxton Key is averaging 7.4 points and a teamhigh 5.9 rebounds, while Mamadi Diakite has averaged 6.8 points and 3.5 rebounds.
- Newcomer Kihei Clark has started four games and is second on the team in assists (2.5). Clark broke his left wrist against Morgan State, but hasn't missed a game while playing with a cast.
- Marco Anthony, Jay Huff, Kody Stattmann and Francesco Badocchi provide depth and Francisco Caffaro is redshirting the 2018-19
- · Manager Grant Kersey has appeared in seven home games.

TYING US TOGETHER

- UVA floor general Ty Jerome is averaging a career-high 13.1 points, 4.1 rebounds, 4.4 assists and 1.9 steals.
- Jerome has reached double figures in 10 games, including three 20-points efforts, highlighted by a season-high 25 at South Carolina.
- Jerome has handed out four or more assists in 11 games.
- Jerome is the first Cavalier to score 20 or more points in the first two games of a season since Sylven Landesberg in 2008-09 (28 vs. VMI

and 21 vs. USF).

- Jerome sank 10 of 14 3-pointers in UVA's first two games and is the first Cavalier to make 10 3-pointers in the first two games of a season since Curtis Staples (10 of 24) in 1997-98.
- Jerome was named to the Battle 4 Atlantis All-Tournament team.
- In 2017-18, Jerome earned All-ACC third-team honors after averaging 10.6 points and 3.9 assists.

THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- All-American Kyle Guy leads the team in scoring (15.3 ppg) and 3-pointers (46).
- Guy was named ACC Player of the Week on Jan. 7 after averaging 25.5 points and 6.5 rebounds in wins against Marshall and No. 9 Florida State.
- The 6-2 sharpshooter set a UVA school record with 11 consecutive 3-pointers over the two-game span.
- Guy has shot 56.7 percent from 3-point range (17 of 30) in the past four games and 52.2 percent (24 of 46) over the past five.
- He has scored 20 or more points nine times in his career, including 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) last season.
- Guy has made five or more 3-pointers in 11 games.
- Guy ranks fifth all-time in the ACC and is first at UVA with a 43.3 percent career 3-point shooting percentage.
- Guy is ninth all-time at UVA with 180 career 3-pointers.
- In 2017-18, Guy reached double figures in 28 games and led the Cavaliers in scoring in 15 contests.
- Guy averaged 16.7 points to earn ACC Tournament MVP honors.

DRE'S WAY

- De'Andre Hunter has led UVA in scoring in seven games, averaging 14 points and 5.3 rebounds.
- He earned Battle 4 Atlantis MVP honors and ACC Player of the Week accolades after averaging 19.3 points and 7.7 rebounds in the tournament
- Hunter has three 20-point games in 2018-19 (Coppin State, Dayton and Wisconsin), matching a career-high 23 points against Dayton.
- Hunter recorded a career-high nine assists vs. Middle Tennessee.
- Hunter recorded his second career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. Towson.
- He is shooting 51.1 percent from the floor, 44.1 percent from 3-point range and 81 percent from the charity stripe.
- Hunter averaged 9.2 points and 3.5 rebounds in 2017-18.
- Hunter fractured his left wrist during the ACC Tournament and missed the NCAA Tournament.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia has held seven opponents (7-0) to fewer than 50 points and is 83-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 108-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 23-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

THE ELECTRIC 70s, AWESOME 80s & DIVINE 90s

- Virginia has scored over 70 points in nine games and is 116-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett.
- UVA scored 100 points against Marshall for the first time under Tony Bennett and added 97 points against Coppin State.
- UVA is 4-0 all-time when scoring 90 or more points under Bennett. • UVA is 30-1 when scoring 80 or more points under Bennett with its
- lone loss a 93-81 decision at North Carolina in 2012-13
- Bennett was 4-0 when scoring 80 or more points in three seasons as head coach at Washington State.

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. Please request your parking pass during the online credential application process.

INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett, two Virginia student-athletes and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game, followed by two Virginia student-athletes or the visiting coach. Other Virginia players will be available upon request in the Courtside Club after the Virginia student-athletes press conference.

RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table for visiting radio crews.

GAME SERVICES

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-byplay sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Head coach and player quotes will be available after postgame interviews. A pregame meal is served for working members of the media in the press room on the event level of John Paul Jones Arena.


