BY THE NUMBERS: IRISH VS. HOKIES

1	Notre Dame and Virginia Tech are meeting in the first Atlantic Coast Conference game of the 2018-19 season on New Years Day. The second ACC game of the season will take place Thursday, January 3, when NC State travels to Miami.
3.25	Junior Juwan Durham leads the ACC in blocked shots per game with a 3.25 average (39 total in 12 games played). He has blocked three or more shots in eight of 12 games played this season - including 11 in the last two Notre Dame victories over Jacksonville (12/20/18) and Coppin State (12/29/18).
3	Notre Dame is the only ACC team with three players among the top 10 in the league for assist/turnover ratio. Junior T.J. Gibbs is second (3.50), senior Rex Pflueger is fifth (2.69) and freshman Prentiss Hubb is seventh at 2.26. The Irish are 13th in the nation in assist/turnover ratio at 1.58.
4	Notre Dame begins its sixth season of ACC competition this year and are 4-1 in conference openers and 3-2 in its first ACC road game of the season.
5	Only five major conference teams have completed a season with a free throw percentage over .742 six or more times since the start of the Mike Brey era. Villanova (10) and Arizona (9) lead the way, followed by Notre Dame, Michigan and Oregon with six seasons each. The Irish are .750 from the charity stripe this season.
6	Junior John Mooney leads the ACC in double-doubles (6) and has seven his career. Mooney also paces the ACC in 10-rebound performances with seven.
8	The Irish have lost three players out of the top 11 on their roster entering the season to transfer or injury. Senior Elijah Burns left the team in November (has since announced intention to transfer to Siena), senior guard Rex Pflueger tore the ACL in his left knee against Purdue on December 15, 2018, and freshman Robby Carmody will miss the remainder of the season with a left shoulder injury.
9	Irish head coach Mike Brey and Hokie head man Buzz Williams have met 12 times as head coaches - with Brey leading the all-time series between the two coaches 9-3.
10	The Irish have faced an Associated Press top-10 opponent four times under Mike Brey, posting a 2-2 record. Notre Dame will be looking to notch its first win over an AP top-10 team since the 2000-01 season on Tuesday afternoon.
11	Juwan Durham has 11 blocked shots in the last two Notre Dame games (5 vs. Jacksonville, 6 vs. Coppin State) and ranks sixth in the country in blocks-per-game at 3.25.
19	How eye-opening is Juwan Durham's block total this year (39)? He is already 19th on the single-season list at Notre Dame and just 13 away from the top 10 (full list on page 9 of this notes package). With assistant coach Ryan Humphrey ('02) on the Irish bench and Jordan Cornette ('05) as the ESPNU analyst, three of the top Notre Dame basketball shot blockers of all-time will be part of the game at Virginia Tech on Tuesday.
13.7	Notre Dame, on average, is committing just 13.7 personal fouls per game - ranked third in the nation behind Furman (13.3) and Michigan (13.4).
73.1	Since the start of the Mike Brey era (2000-01) Notre Dame is third among major-conference schools in team free throw percentage at .731. Villanova ranks first (.744), followed by Arizona (.731).
512	With 512 career wins, Mike Brey is the 11th active coach to reach 500 wins coaching at just one or two institutions.

T.J. Gibbs	Has scored in double figures in 11 of 13 games this season • loss of Pflueger pushes responsibility of defending best opponent perimeter player • after slow start, beginning to find 3FG stroke • 2nd in ACC in assist/TO ratio (3.50)
Juwan Durham	Emergence in middle of Notre Dame defense put him among most surprising players in the ACC • has blocked three or more shots in 8 of 12 games played this season • efficient in the post, shooting .618 from the field
Nikola Djogo	With loss of Pflueger and Carmody to injury, becomes a key guard off the bench • length on the perimeter provides the Irish with defensive flexibility • PG for 2nd team in practice, adept at handling the ball and running the offense
Nate Laszewski	One of the best freshman three-point shooters in the country • 8-for-13 from behind the arc over the past three games • has four double-digit scoring games this year, including his first two career outings
Chris Doherty	Plans to redshirt this season to maintain a year of eligibility, but is dressing for games in case of emergency • a hard worker in practice with a great future in the program
Dane Goodwin	Developing into one of the team's most consistent players • rebounds well for his height (21 rebounds last four games) and boasts a strong mid-range game • emerging as a reliable scoring threat over past four games (12.8 pg)
Robby Carmody	Started first two games of his career, but suffered a torn labrum early in the year that continued to affect his play and eventually underwent shoulder surgery on December 27, 2018 • will retain four years of eligibility
Liam Nelligan	Walk-on member of the program in his second year on the team as a Notre Dame graduate • talented practice player who provides leadership in the locker room and on the Irish bench.
John Mooney	Has stepped up his game to be among the best front line players in the ACC • paces Notre Dame and the league with six double-doubles • has a six-game streak of double-digit scoring games • capable of scoring at all three levels with a consistent 3FG shot (.452 this year), can turn and face (.530 FG) and score in the paint.

IRISH FACE TOP-10 VIRGINIA TECH IN FIRST ACC GAME OF THE YEAR

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball team (10-3, 0-0 ACC) travels to Blacksburg, Virginia, for a New Years Day meeting with #10/10 Virginia Tech (1 p.m. ET, ESPN). The Irish and Hokies are not only kicking off 2019, they are competing in the first ACC game of the season.

NOTRE DAME VERSUS VIRGINIA TECH

- Notre Dame and Virginia Tech are meeting for the 11th time on Tuesday afternoon and seventh time as ACC opponents. The Irish lead the all-time series 8-2 and 5-1 in ACC action (see page 8 for a complete list of the entire series).
- In the last meeting between the Irish and Hokies, Notre Dame utilized a 45-18 run in the final 15 minutes of the game to erase a 21-point second-half deficit and defeat Virginia Tech 71-65 in the second round of the 2018 ACC Championship in the Barclays Center. The 21-point rally marked the greatest comeback victory in Notre Dame basketball history.
- Notre Dame is 4-0 at Cassell Coliseum, including a victory in the program's first visit to Blacksburg on February 24, 2001. That 85-61 win delivered Notre Dame its first conference title, as the Irish earned the BIG EAST West Division Championship in that game. Current Irish coaching staff members Ryan Humphrey (12 pts, 7 rebs, 5 asts) and Harold Swanagan (2 pts, 11 min played) both appeared in that contest.
- Mike Brey is 9-3 all-time against Buzz Williams.

NOTRE DAME ON NEW YEARS DAY

Through 113 seasons of Notre Dame basketball the Irish have played on New Years Day just three times - and on only two dates. The 1908-09 team embarked on an epic 13-game road swing and a double header sweep over the Mobile YMCA in Mobile, Alabama, helped ring in the New Year in 1909.

The Irish also faced Syracuse on New Years Day in 2011, falling 70-58 to the fifth-ranked Orange.

MOONEY LEADS ACC IN DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Junior forward John Mooney has raised his level of play to an all-conference level in 2018-19 and currently stands third in the ACC in rebounding (9.3 per game) and leads the league in double-doubles (six in 13 games played).

Close to averaging a double-double this season (12.8 ppg, 9.3 rpg), Mooney entered the season with 4.5 ppg and 3.3 rpg averages.

DURHAM SHOT BLOCKING MAKES EARLY IMPRESSION

Even though Juwan Durham is listed as a junior on the Notre Dame roster, he is really just experiencing the first significant minutes in a series of collegiate games this season. Durham saw limited minutes in his freshman season at UConn (2016-17) after sitting out his senior year of high school to recover from an ACL tear in his right knee. He also had wrist surgery while sitting out during his transfer season last year with the Irish.

In his first game in a Notre Dame uniform against UIC (11/6/18) he became the first Notre Dame player since 2012 to block six shots in a game. Durham also sparked the Irish with 10 points and five blocks in the second half of a victory over Illinois (11/27/18) and has 39 blocks in his first 12 games (has one DNP-CD this year) at Notre Dame.

During the Mike Brey era (2000-01 - present) only six other players have blocked five or more shots multiple times, putting the Tampa, Florida, native - with two full years of eligibility remaining after this season - among some noteworthy Irish players early in his career.

DURHAM AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS IN BLOCKED SHOTS

Piling up 11 blocked shots in the last two Notre Dame games, junior Juwan Durham has moved up the list in national leaders for blocks-per-game, currently sitting at sixth in the country (as of December 30, 2018). He joins Oregon State's Kylor Kelley as the only power-five conference player in the nation's top six in the statistical category.

DJ HARVEY - THE RETURN

As one of the top rated recruits of the Mike Brey era, D.J. Harvey was poised to play a key role during his freshman season in 2017-18. With injuries to all-conference level performers Matt Farrell and Bonzie Colson, his role was only going to increase. But an injury suffered on January 16, 2018, derailed Harvey's rookie season and put his career in jeopardy.

The recovery from that moment, however, has been remarkable and capped by Harvey's return to the starting lineup for the team's 2018-19 season opener with UIC. Expected to be ready to fully contribute around the first of the year, Harvey has exceeded all expectations in his recovery from microfracture surgery. Here is a breakdown of his recovery timeline:

January 16, 2018	Bone Bruise suffered in left knee vs. Louisville
February 16, 2018	Recovery setback during practice at Boston College

D.C. AREA/NOTRE DAME CONNECTION CONTINUES WITH PRENTISS HUBB AND D.J. HARVEY

The Notre Dame men's basketball connection to the Washington, D.C., area began in 1965 with Brian Kelly (St. John's High School) and continues to this day with head coach Mike Brey (DeMatha), associate head coach Rod Balanis (DeMatha), sophomore D.J. Harvey (DeMatha) and freshman Prentiss Hubb (Gonzaga).

The D.C. pipeline is a Who's Who of Notre Dame men's basketball greats - Edward 'Monk' Malloy (Archbishop Carroll), Bob Whitmore (DeMatha), Austin Carr (Macklin), Collis Jones (St. John's), Sid Catlett (DeMatha), Adrian Dantley (DeMatha), Don Williams (Macklin), Tracy Jackson (Paint Branch, Maryland), Tom Sluby (Gonzaga), Cecil Rucker (Macklin), Monty Williams (Potomac), Eric Atkins (Mount Saint Joseph) and Jerian Grant (DeMatha). Those players combined to score over 17,800 points for Notre Dame, grab 6,844 rebounds and dish out 2,268 assists.

WHITMORE TO ENTER PURCELL PAVILION RING OF HONOR ON JANUARY 12, 2019

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball program has announced that Bob Whitmore (1965-69) will be the next alumnus to enter the Purcell Pavilion Ring of Honor at halftime of the Boston College game on January 12, 2019.

The trailblazer for Notre Dame's legendary Washington, D.C. connection, finished with 1,508 career points in three full seasons (freshmen were ineligible under NCAA rules at that time) which ranked third all-time at Notre Dame when he graduated. His rebounding prowess was even more notable, as he hauled in over 1,043 missed shots to rank second at Notre Dame upon graduation. He is still one of only six players to collect over 1,000 rebounds in a career at Notre Dame.

2018-19 SCHEDULE FEATURED FOUR FIRST-TIME OPPONENTS

Notre Dame's 2018-19 non-conference schedule featured four match ups with teams the program had never faced before. UIC (W, 84-67), Radford (L, 60-63) and Jacksonville (W, 100-74) visited Purcell Pavilion and the Irish played on Oklahoma (L, 80-85) in the Jimmy V Classic in Madison Square Garden.

Mike Brey is 46-5 (.901) at Notre Dame in games featuring first-time program meetings. He also is 131-39 (.771) against all first-time opponents at Notre Dame.

PFLUEGER'S SEASON ENDS WITH AN ACL INJURY

Senior captain Rex Pflueger suffered a left ACL injury late in the victory over Purdue in the 2018 Crossroads Classic on Saturday, December 15, 2018. An MRI conducted on Monday, December 17, indicated the need for season-ending surgery. Pflueger announced his status on Instagram and Twitter:

"First of all, I want to thank everyone who has reached out to me with kind words and positivity for both my family and myself! I am saddened to find out that I did in fact tear my ACL in our last game against Purdue... But at least I didn't break any bones so that's awesome lol. This is just one of life's crazy tests that I have prepared myself for with the loving help of my family and my friends. I will continue to cheer and push my Notre Dame family to not only compete but to dominate for the rest of the season. We have an incredible group of players who will pick up right where we left off last game. I will not let this injury affect the person I am and will continue to stay positive for better times to come! Thank you Irish Nation."

Notre Dame head coach Mike Brey reaction to the news:

"You develop a close relationship with your guys when you have them for four years. Rex Pflueger is like a son to me. I'm extremely disappointed that he won't be able to continue this season. He has been an unbelievable winner and leader for us. He has continually helped me endorse our culture here at Notre Dame. I look forward to him continuing to lead and giving me great feedback the rest of the season."

The surgery will be conducted back in the Notre Dame area on January 11, 2019. Any discussion about a possible fifth year of eligibility for Pflueger has been tabled until later in the 2019 spring semester.

ELIJAH BURNS LEAVES PROGRAM, SEEKS GRADUATE TRANSFER

MIKE BREY, HEAD COACH

In 19 seasons as the men's basketball coach at the University of Notre Dame, Mike Brey has guided the Fighting Irish to 413 victories and is the all-time winningest men's basketball coach in school history.

The Irish are enjoying a recent stretch of success that ranks among the best in the 114-year history of basketball under the Golden Dome. Notre Dame was the only school in the nation to make back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Championship Elite Eight at the end of the 2015 and 2016 seasons, claimed an Atlantic Coast Conference title in 2015 and has made two ACC title game appearances in four years of ACC competition.

Brey was named head coach at Notre Dame on July 14, 2000. In his first season with the Irish, his team claimed the 2001 BIG EAST West Division championship and returned to the NCAA Championship for the first time in 12 seasons. Notre Dame soon became a regular in the NCAA tournament by making 12 appearances in 17 seasons with Brey on the sidelines.

In 2011, Brey was the recipient of both the Associated Press and the Henry Iba/USBWA National Coach of the Year award. He was named BIG EAST Coach of the Year in 2007, 2008 and 2011 and three of his players have been named BIG EAST Player of the Year.

Before arriving at Notre Dame, Brey was the head basketball coach at the University of Delaware, where he compiled a 99-52 mark from 1995-2000 and won America East Co-Coach of the Year honors in 1998. Prior to his time at Delaware, he was an assistant coach at Duke University. During his eight years at Duke, the Blue Devils advanced to the Final Four six times and won back-to-back national championships in 1991 and 1992.

Brey graduated from George Washington University in 1982. He played for and coached with legendary high school coach Morgan Wootten at DeMatha High School.

Brey serves on the Coaches vs. Cancer National Council and has helped raise over three million dollars for the organization. He has also partnered with the American Heart Association to create the Men of Heart initiative, raising funds and awareness for men's heart health. Brey is on the National Advisory Board of the Positive Coaching Alliance. He has been inducted into the University of Delaware and George Washington University Halls of Fame.

- Updated team statistics, game notes, head shots and additional team information are available at und.com/pressbox.

GAME DAY PARKING

- Parking for all Notre Dame men's basketball games is free and open on a first-come first-served basis.

MEDIA ENTRANCE/CREDENTIAL WILL CALL

- Media Will Call will open two hours before the public game tip time.
- The University of Notre Dame has instituted a clear bag policy for fans attending events at men's and women's basketball games in 2018-19. This policy does not apply to credentialed media members covering the game.
