AT THE RIM

- Playing at home for the first time in over two weeks, the No. 20/19 Virginia Tech men's basketball team will play host to its in-state rival on Saturday at 6 p.m. in No. 8/8 Virginia.
- The Hokies and Cavaliers played each other twice last season, with UVA coming out on top both times, including winning in Blacksburg thanks to a clutch game-winner. (More on page 5)
- Tech, which is 56-95 in the all-time series with UVA, is 25-9-1 when against UVA at home.
- The two schools have played each other only four times when they both are ranked and the Hokies are 1-3 in those matchups.
- Tech's Mike Young is 0-3 against UVA's Tony Bennett, losing 74-39 in 2012 in Charlottesville when he was at Wofford and twice last season.

WHO TO WATCH



- Turning in his third double-double of the season, Keve Aluma got back to his ways after a two-game skid of not scoring in double figures.
- The redshirt sophomore had 14 points and tied his career high for rebounds with 12.

- Nahiem Alleyne picked up where he left off at Syracuse, leading the team in scoring for the second game with a team-high 15 points at Notre Dame.
- The guard also almost had the first double-double of his career, grabbing a career-high nine rebounds.



LAST TIME OUT

- Holding Notre Dame to a season-low 51 points, the Hokies picked up their second road win of the season in a 62-51 victory on Wednesday at Purcell Pavilion.
- Tech had four players score in double figures and held the Irish to shooting 35.7 percent.

A WIN WOULD

- Give the Hokies for their best start through nine ACC games in school history, topping the previous best start of 6-3 during the 2006-07 season.
- Be revenge for getting swept last year by UVA and make coach Mike Young 1-3 versus the Cavaliers and coach Tony Bennett.
- Extend Tech's winning streak to two games and then snap its four-game skid to UVA, dating back to Feb. 10, 2018, a one-point overtime road win.
- Be just Tech's second win in a ranked-ranked game with UVA, and then its third ranked win this season (No. 3/3 Villanova, No. 24/RV Clemson, No. 19/23 Duke).

BEST IN THE COMMONWEALTH

- The Hokies and Cavaliers both typically aren't ranked in the AP Top 25 poll when they face each other twice a year, but have seen that trend change in recent years.
- Only four times has it happened and this Saturday will be the third time in just the last three seasons.
- Tech has only been ranked higher once in the previous four ranked-ranked outings, with that coming in 1995, an eight-point win.

TRUST YOUR FIVE

- Tech, which typically relies on its bench for scoring 20-plus a night, didn't get that on Tuesday at Notre Dame, with its total being 12 bench points.
- Due to that, coach Mike Young had his starters out there longer than normal and had four starters play more than 30 minutes.
- That marked the just the fourth time that's happened in a non-overtime game since he's taken over the Hokies, with the other three instances happening last year in 2019 (Chattanooga, No. 3/3 Michigan State, BYU).

NOTRE DAME TIDBITS

- Tech held the Fighting Irish to zero 3-pointers in the second half and also held them to shooting 35.7 percent for the game, which is a season low for Tech's opponent this season.
- The Hokies owned the boards, getting 46 rebounds, including 38 of those being defensive, which is a season high.

THE BOARDS

- Last season, Tech was the second-shortest high-major team in the land (Utah) and consistently got outrebounded night in and night out.
- It was such a norm, that in of Tech's 21 games against ACC opponents last year, it only outrebounded them three times.
- Now, with an added presence down low in 6-foot-9 Keve Aluma and 6-foot-7 Justyn Mutts, Tech has been able to win the glass a whole lot more.
- Tech outrebounded Notre Dame by 10 (46-36) on Tuesday and has done so three times this year against an ACC team, already tying last year's total with way less games.

FINDING HIS GROOVE

- Freshman David N'Guessan wasn't seeing the floor too much early on this season, averaging nine minutes per game through his first 11 appearances.
- And during that 11-game stretch, he racked up a total of 19 points to average 1.7 points a contest.
- So his two games after that he scored 23 points and only missed one shot, going 9 of 10 from the field.
- The forward is averaged 11.5 points and 13 minutes against Wake Forest and Syracuse – pretty efficient.

YOU SEE A TREND?

- The Hokies have three losses on the season, with two of those being blowouts (double-digit losses).
- Ironically in both of those setbacks that got out of hand, Tech allowed its opponent to shoot better than 50 percent, with Penn State (50.0%) and Syracuse (50.9%) doing so, as well at Tech shot under 37 percent in each game.
- In its other loss, a two-point game, 73-71, at then RV/No. 25 Louisville, Tech let the Cardinals shoot 47.3 percent. But, Tech was able to counter with being over the 40-percent mark (42.6%).
- Since coach Mike Young has gotten to Blacksburg, his teams have allowed six opponents to shoot greater than 50 percent and he's 1-5 in those games. The lone win was against Miami (Fla.) this past December when it shot 53.6 percent.

'BOUT TIME

- When Tech won at Wake Forest on Jan. 17, it snapped a seven-game losing streak on the road for the Hokies.
- The last time Tech won on the road was at, ironically, Wake Forest on Jan. 14, 2020, an 80-70.
- During that seven-game stretch, Tech's average margin of defeat was 12.0 points per game. It squeaked out a four-point win to end it, 64-60.

NA STAYIN' STEADY

- Sophomore Nahiem Alleyne, who has led the team in scoring in two straight games (Syracuse, ND), has been pretty steady this season from downtown.
- The guard had made at least one triple in all but three games this year, with those coming against Louisville, Notre Dame and VMI, out of 15 contests.
- If you remember last season, the Georgia native made a 3 in 13 consecutive games, which tied for the fifth-longest of any ACC player last year. And of that group, only him and Syracuse's Buddy Boeheim returned this season.
- This season, Alleyne ranks 13th in the ACC in 3-point field-goal percentage (38.2%) among players that have hit at least 25 triples.

NOT SO FAST, MY FRIEND

- After scoring 10 or more fastbreak points in four straight games for the first time in the Mike Young era, Tech was held to a then-season-low two fastbreak points at Louisville (Jan. 6) and hasn't really recovered.
- Over its last six games, it has only cracked double figures in fastbreak points once (15 vs. Duke), including four games of only one bucket (only 2 at Notre Dame).
- Tech, which averaged 8.1 fastbreak points versus ACC opponents last year and is averaging 8.0 against ACC teams this season, is averaging only 5.2 over its last six games.

What's a Hokie?



The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.

Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The official university school colors - Chicago Maroon and Burnt Orange - also were introduced in 1896. The colors were chosen by a committee because they made a 'unique combination' not worn elsewhere at the time. The official definition of "hokie" is "a loyal Virginia Tech Fan".

WHERE THEY AT

- Tech has 15 players on the squad who represent 10 states and two international countries (Netherlands, Nigeria), making it tied for eighth in the country for most states and countries represented on a roster this season.
- Virginia leads the way with three players – Joseph "Joe" Bamisile, Gill Williamson, Grant Yates – while Maryland has two players – Keve Aluma and Darius Maddox.
- New Mexico, Penn and UT Martin are No. 1 nationally with 15 players from different states and countries, while in the ACC, Boston College (13) is first and Florida State is tied with the Hokies for the second most in the league with 12.
- Of the 23 schools that have 12 or more players from different spots, nine are from high-major conferences, including BC, Kentucky, Butler, FSU, Iowa State, Nebraska, Tennessee, Tulane and the Hokies.

'19 CLASS OF HIGH-MAJOR COACHES

- Out of the seven high-major conferences (ACC, American, BIG EAST, B1G, Big 12, Pac-12 and SEC), there were 14 head coaches hired for the 2019-20 season.
- Virginia Tech coach Mike Young was just one of six coaches that were a mid-major coach to jump up to the big leagues, joining Alabama's Nate Oats (Buffalo), Arkansas' Eric Musselman (Nevada), Tulane's Ron Hunter (Georgia State) and Washington State's Kyle Smith (San Francisco).
- Of the 14 new coaches, Young was the longest-tenured coach to leave, following his 17-year stint as the head guy at Wofford.
- The NBA saw three of its coaches jump into the college ranks, with Michigan's Juwon Howard (Miami Heat), Nebraska's Fred Hoiberg (Chicago Bulls) and Vanderbilt's Jerry Stackhouse (Memphis Grizzlies).
- In this cycle, only one assistant coach was promoted from within and that was Temple's Aaron McKie, who served as an assistant under Fran Dunphy for five seasons in Philadelphia.
- Former Hokie coach Buzz Williams, who is at Texas A&M, was one of just two coaches to jump ship and go high-major for high-major, with UCLA's Mick Cronin (Cincinnati) being the other.
- A full breakdown of the 14 coaches in the cycle is below, with the SEC welcoming the most among the seven leagues with four. The Big 12 was the lone conference not make coaching change heading into the 2019-20 season.

LAST TIME vs. VIRGINIA RECAP

- Trailing by as many as 15 points, the Hokies went to work and began to chip away at the deficit and ended up tying the game at 53-all with 11 seconds remaining after a clutch runner in the lane by Tyrece Radford, but UVA responded with a clutch play itself, as Kihei Clark hit a game-winning 3-pointer with two ticks left to win.
- Tech didn't do itself any favors early, scoring as little as 11 points in the first half, which was the lowest ever in either half since it joined the ACC in 2004-05, thanks to shooting just 20.8 percent from the field. But a better second half (51.9 FG%) paved the way to make it a game.
- The Hokies' bench shined once again, outscoring UVA's bench 36-10 with Jalen Cone (8 points) and Hunter Cattoor (6) combining for 14 of those 36.

SCOUTING No. 8/8 VIRGINIA

- Virginia is coming off a 23-point victory at home over Syracuse (9-5, 3-4) this past Monday, winning 81-58 thanks to two players scoring 21 points each (Sam Hauser, Jay Huff) and preseason All-ACC pick Kihei Clark dishing out a game-high nine assists.
- Bennett enters his 11th season as the head coach in Charlottesville, following his three-year stint at Washington State where he led the Cougars to consecutive NCAA Tournaments for the first time in school history. At UVA, Bennett has earned three National Coach of the Year awards and won the '19 NCAA title.
- The Cavaliers are led by Clark, who is averaging 9.7 points and 4.5 assists per game, and Hauser, a Marquette transfer who is in the conversation for winning ACC Player of the Year, owns a team-high 15.0 points and team-best 7.4 rebounds per game.
- Committing only 8.2 turnovers a game, the Cavaliers rank second nationally and first in the ACC in that category, while they also play fundamental defense with sitting eighth nationally and first in the conference in points allowed per game at 59.6.



GETTIN' TO THE CHARITY STRIPE

- Coach Young was not happy with how little the Hokies got to the free-throw line last year, with an average of 13.4 per game, which ranked second-to-last in the ACC and was in the bottom 25 nationally.
- So, now, with not being as dependent on the 3-ball and having more players that can get to the rim, Tech has increased that average to 20.1 this season. That 20.1 average ranks third in the ACC, trailing Pitt (23.7) and North Carolina (22.7).
- Last year, the Hokies only had eight games (out of 32) of having 20 or more free throw attempts. When doing so, they were 7-1, with the lone loss being against Miami (Fla.) in triple overtime.

PUTTIN' ON THE CLAMPS

- Tech accomplished something for the first time since it joined the prestigious ACC (2004-05), with holding an opponent to two made field goals in a half versus the Fighting Irish on Jan. 10.
- The feat topped the previous best of holding its foe of three made shots in a half, which came against NC State in 2019, Arkansas Pine Bluff in 2015 and Eastern Michigan in 2011.

ONE OF THE BEST DOW LOW

- Keve Aluma certainly has made his presence felt at Tech and has does so especially down low.
- The Wofford transfer leads the ACC in free throws made at 55 and is third in free throws attempted at 80.
- Aluma is shooting 68.8 percent from the charity stripe this season, which is up from 48.3 percent clip his final season in Spartanburg.

SWAT CITY

- Tech had a season-high nine blocks at Wake Forest on Jan. 17, marking the most for the Hokies since 2014 (Morgan State). To make it even more impressive, they did it by halftime.

ON THE BLOCK

- Tech racked up 36 points in the paint against No. 19/23 Duke, marking the second-highest paint point total in the Mike Young era during a regulation game.
- The high? Ironically, it came against Duke as well, when the Hokies had 40 paint points on Dec. 6 in Blacksburg.
- Including overtime games, Tech had 38 versus Miami (Fla.) at home in triple overtime.

STRONGER TOGETHER

- At Louisville, the Hokies had four players score in double figures, showcasing a balanced attack, and still ended up losing.
- That marked just the second time in the Mike Young era in which that happened, with the other instance being Tech's setback to BYU (90-77) in the fifth-place game at the Maui Jim Maui Invitational last season.
- The Hokies are 10-2 under Young when having at least four players score in double digits, and it was only just the second time that Tech had four or more players do so in an ACC game (Wake Forest, Jan. 14, 2020; an 80-70 win).

CLOSE, BUT NO CIGAR

- Tech lost a close one at Louisville, 73-71, coming up short for the fifth time in the Mike Young era in a game decided by four points or less.
- The Hokies are 4-5 in those types of games over the last two seasons, winning their most recent one, a four-point win at Wake Forest on Jan. 17.
- Last year, the Hokies had four contests in league play that were decided by four points or less, with winning at Syracuse by four (67-63), beating UNC in double overtime at home (79-77), losing to Boston College in overtime at home (77-73) and falling to in-state rival Virginia at home (56-53) for a 2-2 clip.

JACK OF ALL TRADES

- Displaying his versatility to close 2020, Keve Aluma put together one of the better games this season by any player nationally.
- Aluma against Miami (Fla.) put together a 26-point, six-rebound, four-assist, three-block outing, making him the lone high-major player to have at least that stat line in a game and just one of four players in all of DI.

CHECKING IN ON NET

- The first NET rankings came out on Monday, Jan. 4 and the Hokies came in at No. 34, the fourth best in the ACC.
- In the first NET rankings of the 2019-20 season, the Hokies were at No. 62. Tech went 3-7 against quadrant I teams last year and went 4-9 the year before that.
- Tech's best win of the season came against then-No. 3/3 Michigan St, which finished seventh in NET.
- Tech finished the 2019-20 season ranked No. 92.
- In 2018-19, the Hokies, after making a run to the Sweet 16, finished in the final NET rankings at 12th.
- Ironically, Wofford, which was coached by Mike Young at the time, came in two spots below (14).

DOUBLE TROUBLE

- Forwards Keve Aluma and Justyn Mutts sure came to play against Miami (Fla.), carrying Tech to a victory with not its best play out of its guards in some time.
- The two combined for quite the stat line: 41 points, 15 rebounds, six assists, four steals and three blocks.
- In doing so, the two set some career and season highs, including Aluma's career high in points (26), assists (4, tied) and blocks (3, tied) and Mutts' career best in 3s made (3) and season highs for points (15), rebounds (9, tied) and steals (3).

CAUSING HAVOC DEFENSIVELY

- Tech forced Miami (Fla.) into committing 19 turnovers on Dec. 29, which was a season high for the 'Canes, as well as a season high forced by Tech.
- Over the last seven seasons, Tech has only done that (forced 19 or more TOs against an ACC team) five times, making it a first in the Mike Young era and for the first time since 2017.

FINDING A WAY TO GET IT DONE

- Tech, as most teams, doesn't do well in the win column when it allows its opponent to shoot better than 50 percent from the field.
- Since coach Mike Young has gotten here, the Hokies are 1-5 in games when its opponents shoot better than 50 percent.
- Before its game against Miami (Fla.) to close 2020, Tech was 0-4 in those situations, until it pulled out the win, which shot 53.6 percent from the field.

80 THE SWEET SPOT

- The Hokies are 8-1 when scoring 80 or more points in the Mike Young era.
- Tech dropped 80 on Miami, marking only the third time its scored 80 or more against an ACC team the last two seasons, and just the second in a regulation game (80 vs. WF, 95 vs. Miami in 3OT).
- Therefore, Tech tied its ACC high in the Young era for a regulation game.

WAS A FUN RIDE

- Tech played all of its December games in the friendly confines of Cassell Coliseum, taking on six foes in total.
- December treated the Hokies well, winning five of those six contests, with its lone loss coming to Penn State in the ACC/B1G Challenge.

DUNK CITY

- The rim was rocking quite a bit in Tech's last game, with the Hokies tallying seven dunks against Longwood on Dec. 21.
- The seven dunks marked the most in the Mike Young era, topping the previous high of five set against Maryland Eastern Shore last year (Dec. 29).
- Keve Aluma had multiple dunks (2x) and then Nahiem Alleyne, David N'Guessan, Hunter Cattoor, Tyrece Radford and Justyn Mutts all had one and joined in on the 'dunk party' as well.
- To put it in perspective of how rare that instance was, Tech had three games this early this year (Coppin St, Villanova, USF) that it didn't get a single dunk.
- Last year, Tech had five games of three dunks, six games of two dunks and 11 games of just one.

DON'T MAKE 'EM LIKE ME ANYMORE

- Keve Aluma has been arguably Tech's best player so far this season, with being the team's leading scorer and rebounder, and put it all together in Tech's against Longwood on Dec. 21.
- Against the Lancers, the redshirt junior put together quite the stat line, registering 14 points, four rebounds, three blocks, two steals and an assist in just 24 minutes of action.
- Because of that outing, he is just one of five ACC players and only 13 high-major guys, including Iowa's Luka Garza, to do that stat line or better.

SOMETHING 'BOUT THOSE TWO

- When you look at the shortest players on the rosters for Virginia Tech and Miami (Fla.), it's not your typical 6-foot walk-on, as Tech's Jalen Cone (5'10") and Miami's Chris Lykes (5'7") are pretty short considering DI averages.
- But, despite their challenges of that, the two have formed a bond with one another and consider each other friends off the court.
- The two text regularly and Lykes has given Cone tips on best practices of overcoming his lack of height in the ACC, with Lykes being a couple of years older than Cone and sharing words of wisdom of what has worked for him over the years.

SMALL BUT MIGHTY

- Among high-major conference teams, there are only 35 players that are less than six feet tall, including Tech's Jalen Cone, standing at 5-foot-10.
- Of those 35, 19 of them are walk-ons, while the other 16 are on scholarship.
- In the ACC, Cone is one of eight players shorter than six feet, and is just one of five scholarship players in the league.
- Cone will go against two of the more famous shorter guys in the league, including Miami (Fla.)'s Chris Lykes and UVA's Kihei Clark.

UPTICK IN SHARING THE ROCK

- Sophomore guard Hunter Cattoor has improved his ball handling and decision making from last year, and it really has showed here the last couple of games for the Hokies.
- With Cartier Diarra opting out of the season (since Dec. 15), Cattoor has filled in as the secondary point guard, spelling Wabissa Bede, and did a nice job, as he turned in eight assists in the two games immediately following Diarra's departure.
- That two-game stretch of eight dimes is his best two-game stretch yet as a Hokie, topping his previous high of seven assists last season versus Delaware State on Nov. 20 and then-No. 3 Michigan State on Nov. 25.
- Versus Coppin State on Dec. 19, he dished out a career-high five assists – not bad for a guy who is known as a catch-and-shoot specialist.

20-ASSIST PLATEAU

- Tech has had six games of 20 or more assists in the Young era and is 5-1 in those games, with the lone loss coming to Syracuse at home last year in a close one, 80-78.
- The Hokies had 20 assists against Coppin State for a season high, with three players owning at least four, including Wabissa Bede (5 ast.), Hunter Cattoor (5) and Jalen Cone (4).

TOP ITEMS IN YOUNG ERA

- To give perspective on how well the Hokies were clicking on all cylinders against Coppin State on Dec. 19, here are how some key items that stand out in the Mike Young era.
- Tech's bench exploded for 51 points, which is the most in the Young era, topping the previous high of 49, which was set twice - Delaware State (Nov. 20) and Maryland Eastern Shore (Dec. 29).
- Tech's 20 3s were the second most in school history, as well as the Young era (21 vs. Delaware St).
- The 97 points were the second most in the Young era, topping the triple OT game against Miami (Fla.) last year of 95 points, but being a triple short of the Delaware State game's 100-point outing.
- Also, Tech had eight players make a 3 versus Coppin State, which hasn't happened at Tech since Nov. 21, 2017 against Houston Baptist (8 as well).

NOT GREAT, BOB - OH WAIT

- Tech had not been shooting the ball well from downtown early in the season, making just five 3s versus then-No. 24/RV Clemson, six 3s against Penn State, four triples versus VMI and only five the one before that (USF) for a combined 20-of-81 clip (24.7%).
- In the Mike Young era, that was the fewest 3s made in a four-game stretch.
- So, after hitting just 20 3s its last four games heading into Coppin State, Tech ripped off the exact amount in just one game.

FALLING BUT WINNING THE GLASS

- Tech coach Mike Young is 15-2 at Tech when his Hokie team out-rebounds the opponent, with one of those two losses another happening versus Penn State (39-33) on Dec. 8.
- It marked just the second loss when his group has outrebounded its opponent, with the only other loss coming last season against Boston College on Feb. 8, 2019, with a +1 differential.
- In fact, out of Tech's 20 ACC games last year, it only out-rebounded its league opponent three times, with two of those being versus Clemson.

RARE, LIKE MR. CLEAN WITH HAIR

- Justyn Mutts, who doesn't have a bad hairdo himself, became just the fifth Hokie in the last decade to have a 10-point, nine-rebound, six-assist or better stat line and the first since 2019 (Nickeil Alexander-Walker) when he did so vs. VMI.
- Mutts is just one of two in the ACC players in the ACC to do so this year (Louisville's Carlík Jones).

PUTTIN' ON THE CLAMPS

- Tech gave up less than 59 points in back-to-back games against USF and VMI, marking just the third time in the Mike Young era.
- The previous two times were a four-game stretch (Chattanooga, Gardner-Webb, VMI and Maryland Eastern Shore; Dec. 11-29) and a three-game stretch (Coppin State, USC Upstate and Lehigh; Nov. 8-16).

'ROUND THE BLOCK

- With more of an intentionality of scoring inside this season with the added presence down low compared to last year, Tech showcased that vs. USF with 42 points in the paint, which is the Mike Young era.
- The previous high was 40 points against then-No. 10/8 Duke on Dec. 6 in Cassell, a 77-63 lost.

NBA & G-LEAGUE

NAW IN YEAR 2

- Nickeil Alexander-Walker has left his mark on Virginia Tech and is working on making a name for himself at the next level with the New Orleans Pelicans.
- A first-round draft pick in 2019, the Toronto native played in 47 games for the Pels in the 2019-20 NBA season. On Feb. 26, he was moved down to the Erie Bayhawks, then came back up when the bubble in Orlando started.
- His best game his rookie year came on Nov. 16, 2019, when he scored a then-career-high 27 points against the Miami Heat. So far this season, his top one came on Jan. 13 at the Clippers, owning a career-high 38 points and eight rebounds.
- This season, NAW has played in 14 games for the Pelicans and is averaging 20.7 minutes.

- Robinson, who signed as an undrafted free agent after the NBA Draft concluded with the Washington Wizards, was waived on Jan. 4.
- Hill signed with the Hornets this summer on a two-way deal, but was released in early November. However, he landed nicely on his feet, with now playing on the NAZ Suns, the G-League affiliate of the Phoenix Suns.
- Justin Bibbs, who plays for the Boston Celtics' affiliate (Maine Red Claws), hit a game-winner on Jan. 19, 2019, finishing with 15 points and six assists.

STARTIN' OUT HOT

- The Hokies have started the season out on a strong note, with defeating their opponent by 10 or more points twice through five games.
- In Young's final season at Wofford (2018-19), that was a norm, with his Terriers having 22 games of winning by double digits.
- Last season, though, Tech only won by 10 or more 10 times, including just four times against a high-major conference opponent.

MORE ON THE DECK

- Sophomore Hunter Cattoor was a more balanced player in high school he shared recently, with doing a little bit of everything (3s, mid-range, floaters) at all three levels.
- Since his arrival to Blacksburg, he's been more of a catch-and-shoot player and is looking to buck that trend.
- So, against USF, the guard set a career-high eight free throw attempts and cashed in six of those. Cattoor last year, out of 31 games, only got to the line in eight games for a total of 22 free throw attempts. So expect more times than not he will put it on the deck and attack the rim.

LEVELIN' UP

- The grad transfer from Iowa, Cordell PemsI, stepped up in a big way against USF, subbing in for Keve Aluma when he picked up his second foul early in the first half.
- PemsI came in and made some big plays, playing 12 minutes and recording eight points and four rebounds alone in the first half.
- He would go on to finish with 10 points and six rebounds - not bad for a role player who had 13 minutes, one point and two rebounds combined the first two games.

BENCH MOB HEATIN' UP

- In the USF win, the Hokies had five players score in double figures, which was a first this year and only the third time in the Mike Young era (UMES, Michigan St.; both with five players).
- Of those five players Sunday, two did so coming off the bench, respectively, in Cartier Diarra and Cordell PemsI. Last season, that happened just eight times, with half of those in ACC play.

THAT'S A FIRST

- Tech basketball under the direction of Coach Young is known for being a quality 3-point shooting team, with the Hokies finishing with the most 3s made last year in the ACC with 315.
- So when they are having an off shooting night from downtown, it's tough to overcome it and get a win.
- Last year, Tech had three instances when it made five or less 3s and went 0-3 in those games.
- This year, with not being as reliant on the deep ball, Tech made only five triples versus USF, but still earned a blowout win, a first in the Mike Young era.

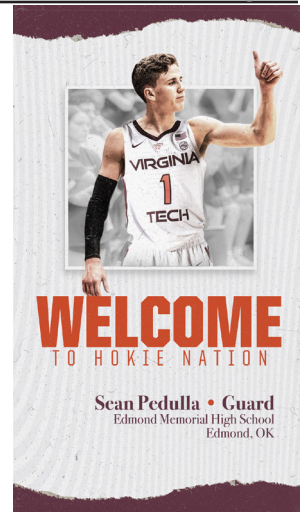

Having just three players returning who saw minutes the previous year in 2018-19 on the team, Young had to act quickly when hired on April 7, 2019 and build a roster to compete in the best conference in the nation. Adding a staff and six scholarship players in a hurry, Young's first season in Blacksburg started off with a bang, as the Hokies went down to South Carolina and defeated Clemson in style to give Young his first Hokie and ACC win, as well as his 300th career victory.

Another big-time W came at the prestigious Maui Jim Maui Invitational against then-No. 3 Michigan State. On ESPN2 with Dan Shulman and Jay Bilas on the call, the young Hokies (7 of the 9 rotation players were underclassmen) pulled off one of the bigger upsets of the season with a 71-66 win. With the upset of Sparty, it marked the first time since 1964 that Tech beat a top-five team in nonconference play.

Despite being the shortest and second-youngest squad among high-major conference teams, Young and Co. tallied 16 wins to make it the most victories by a first-year head coach at Tech since 1999-00 and tied for the fifth-most wins ever by a first-year Hokie coach. He also became the first coach to win two of his first three road ACC games in school history.

Leaning on a mix of young and old in his first season, Young developed junior Wabissa Bede into one of the finer point guards in the country, as Bede would go on to finish with the sixth-best assist-to-turnover ratio nationally (3.34) and first in the ACC. And under Young's tutelage, redshirt freshman Tyrece Radford blossomed into one of the better all-around players in the league, with being one of only two players in the ACC to average 10 points, six rebounds and shoot over 60 percent from the field.

Under the direction of Young, the Hokies put together some new records during the 2019-20 season. On Nov. 20 versus Delaware State, Tech racked up 21 3-pointers, marking the most in school history and the most ever by an ACC team. Speaking of 3s, the 315 hit last season were the second-most in school history.

Four freshmen hit 49 or more 3-pointers, which was the most by any program in over the last 25 years. Behind the young bucks, Tech finished 13th nationally in 3-pointers made per game with 9.9 triples a contest, which was the most in school history.

Utilizing its freshmen on the offensive end last year, Tech finished with its freshmen averaging 50.7 points per game, which is the fourth-most in ACC history behind Duke's 2018-19, 2017-18, 1982-83 teams.

Making sure his team played the game the right way by limiting miscues, Young's prowess showed on Dec. 29 when Tech committed only two turnovers against Maryland Eastern Shore to tie a school record. The Hokies would go on to finish fourth in the nation in fewest turnovers committed per game (9.9).

The Radford, Virginia native joined the Hokies after a record-setting 17-year tenure as the head coach at Wofford. The Terriers posted a 30-5 overall record in 2018-19, including a perfect 18-0 mark in Southern Conference play, and registered a convincing 84-68 win over Seton Hall in the first round of the 2019 NCAA Tournament.

The 2019 Sporting News Coach of the Year, Young built the Terriers into one of the Southern Conference's preeminent programs and a perennial NCAA Tournament participant. He guided Wofford to five NCAA Tournament berths over the past 10 seasons and five Southern Conference championships.

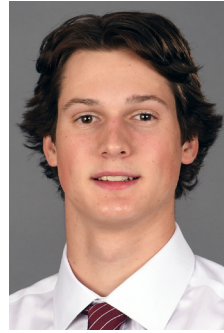
