SETTING THE SCENE

The Warriors head to Blacksburg to take on their first Division I opponent in school history on Sunday night. Merrimack will take on Virginia Tech after beating Lehigh in the first game to ever be played in Lawler Arena. With the win Merrimack improved their record to 3-2. The Hokies are 4-0 after beating Maine, Navy, Radford, and Saint Francis (PA).

SCOUTING THE HOKIES

Virginia Tech has four players that average double figures early on in the 2021-22 season. Redshirt senior Keve Aluma leads the team in points per game with 14.3. The Hokies have been burying their foes thus far. They have not won a game by less than 26 points. Virginia Tech is shooting close to 50% from the field on the season. The Warriors will need to prevent scoring at a rapid pace to stay close in this one.

LAST TIME OUT

For the first time in school history, basketball was played where ice usually sits at Merrimack College. The men's basketball team took down Lehigh University in its inaugural game played Lawler Arena, 55-45. Malik Edmead led the way for the Warriors with his season-high 15 points. Mikey Watkins chipped in with 10 points of his own in the victory.

THE MAKE CHAOS CREW

Head coach Joe Gallo prides himself on his defensive scheme which has been called the Syracuse zone on steroids. Gallo and co have been at the top of defensive rating chats since stepping onto the Division I scene. In the past two seasons the Warriors have caused 809 turnovers and have held opponents to under 32% from long range. The two players at the top of the zone this season Mikey Watkins and Mykel Derring have combined for close to 150 steals in their Merrimack career.

JOE GALLO

The eighth head coach in school history, Gallo completed a run of three NCAA Tournament appearances in three years in 2018-19 to put a bow on the program's Division II history. He also snapped a 19-year conference championship drought when he guided the program to the 2018-19 Northeast-10 Conference Championship. Gallo boasts a 81-45 (.643) career record, the most wins ever for a Merrimack head coach over their first four seasons. Gallo led Merrimack to win the 2019-20 NEC Regular Season Championship, becoming the first team ever to win a conference title in its first season of Division I membership.

BACK AND BETTER THEN EVER

The Warriors return 99% of their production from a season ago. Graduate student Devon Jensen will enter is fifth season with Merrimack. Senior Mikey Watkins will run point, his second season in the starting role. Jordan Minor and Ziggy Reid will be staples on the block for a Merrimack team that will look to get back to winning Northeast Conference regular season titles.

FRESH FACES

Newcomers Thomas Hall and Nick Filchner will look to make impacts out of the gate. Hall averaged 14 points in his final two seasons at Albertus Magnus High School in New York. Filchner who is listed at 6'7" averaged 18 points a game at Allentown Central Catholic in Pennsylvania, before transferring to IMG Academy for a graduate year. He played an important role in IMG's 26-1 record.

JERSEY BOYS

Joe Gallo has been a staple on the New Jersey recruiting scene for years now. In 2019-20 the Warriors three best players came from the Garden State. Juvaris Hayes, Jaleel Lord, and Idris Joyner all were products from New Jersey. This season, the Warriors feature four players from the state. Khalief Crawford, Mikey Watkins, Devin Jensen, and Jordan McKoy, all four were also on the 2019-20 roster.

THIRD TIME IS THE CHARM

The 2021-2022 season marks the third for the Warriors in their Division I transition. In year one, the Warriors won the Northeast Conference in their first year in transition. Merrimack is still unable to compete in the postseason conference tournament as well as the NCAA tournament.

COACHING STAFF

JOE GALLO Head Coach Sixth Season



Continuing a transformative era for the Merrimack College men's basketball program, Joe Gallo '04 begins his sixth season on the Warriors' sidelines in 2020-21, directing the program into its new Division I era as members of the Northeast Conference.

The eighth head coach in school history, Gallo completed a run of three NCAA Tournament appearances in three years in 2018-19 to put a bow on the program's Division II history. He

also snapped a 19-year conference championship drought when he guided the program to the 2018-19 Northeast-10 Conference Championship. Gallo boasts a 82-46 (.641) career record, the most wins ever for a Merrimack head coach over their first four seasons.



Gallo led Merrimack to win the 2019-20 NEC Regular Season Championship, becoming the first team ever to win a conference title in its first season of Division I membership. Merrimack's conference title came on the heels of being selected last in the conference's preseason poll, and the team went on to win 14 of 18 NEC contests to win the regular season crown in outright fashion. The 2019-20 season featured historic victories including the program's win at Northwestern, which was the team's first-ever Division I triumph, and the NEC's second victory ever over a Big Ten foe. The program added more non-conference wins against UMass Lowell, Jacksonville, Hartford, and Army. The conference slate featured a nine-game winning streak, the longest for any NEC team during conference play since 2014-15, and a conference-title-clinching win in the regular season finale against Central Connecticut.

Merrimack has won at least 19 games in all four seasons of Gallo's tenure to date, including three straight years of at least 20 wins. In 2019-20, Merrimack set a new NCAA record for wins by a program in its first year of reclassification to Division I following its 17th victory of the year at Saint Francis Brooklyn.

The 2019-20 campaign featured a myriad of media coverage as well, both regional and national. The Warriors made multiple appearances on ESPN throughout the year, and were featured in the Associated Press, Wall Street Journal, theScore Sports App and Forbes among other outlets. The team's "Make Chaos" mantra followed an effective defensive unit that led the NEC in scoring defense, 3-point field goal percentage defense, steals per game and turnover margin. Coach Joe Gallo received a litany of awards following the season including Jim Phelan NEC Coach of the Year, HoopDirt.com NCAA Div. I Coach of the Year, John McLendon Award (Top collegiate coach nationwide, ECAC Coach of the Year, NABC District Coach of the Year, and USBWA Coach of the Year

During the 2019-2020 season Coach Gallo helped Juvaris Hayes to an All-American season that included a NEC Defensive Player of the Year Award, all-conference first-team selection, and the Lefty Driesell Award as the top defensive player in the country

Other notable moments for Gallo came on the individual as multiple players had career seasons. Senior Juvaris Hayes put a bow on his historic career with a NEC Defensive Player of the Year honor, a spot on the all-conference first team and winning the Lefty Driesell Award, given to the top defensive player nationwide. Hayes finished his career as the NCAA's all-time steals leader while playing in Merrimack's 2-3 zone defense. Other individuals reached new heights in 2019-20 including junior Devin Jensen who set career highs in 3-pointers made and 3-point percentage. He was joined by Idris Joyner, who established career highs in scoring.

In 2018-19, Merrimack tied the school record for wins in a season with 22; the Warriors have now won 22 contests in a year five separate times. The Warriors also came away with the NE10 Championship in their last year to do so. Merrimack won 19 games in the regular season, and proceeded to best Adelphi (83-81), Le Moyne (84-77) and New Haven (51-46) to claim the program's third conference tournament title and first since the 1999-00 campaign. The semifinal win over Le Moyne and championship game triumph over New Haven came on the road with Merrimack topping the Southwest Division's top two seeds. Gallo became just the second coach in program history to win a conference title.

He also cemented himself as only the second head coach at Merrimack to guide the team to three consecutive NCAA Tournaments, and the only to do so over his first three years. Gallo's programs reached the regional semifinals (Round of 32) twice over the last three years, securing an opening-round upset in both the 2016-17 and 2017-18 seasons. The 2018-19 team earned the NCAA Division II East Region's second seed, the program's highest seed ever in the NCAA Tournament.

Other notable moments for Gallo over his first three seasons include a run of back-to-back 20-win seasons, accomplishing that feat for just the third time in school annals. Gallo has won at least 19 games in each of his first three seasons, serving as head coach in three of Merrimack's 13 seasons with at least 19 triumphs ever. Gallo has seen two players (Juvaris Hayes, Ryan Boulter) receive five total all-conference selections over the last three years. He has helped direct Hayes to consecutive All-American selections (2017-18, 2018-19), becoming just the sixth two-time All-American to ever suit up for the Warriors. Hayes also boasts NE10 Rookie of the Year (2016-17) and NE10 Defensive Player of the Year (2018-19) accolades under Gallo's tutelage.

On May 9, 2016, Gallo returned to campus as Merrimack's head man after serving as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Robert Morris University for the past four seasons. The Colonials posted 76 wins in Gallo's four years in Moon Township, Pennsylvania, winning the 2015 Northeast Conference Championship and earning a berth in the NCAA Tournament. In Gallo's first two years on the staff, Robert Morris won back-to-back NEC regular season titles and advanced to the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) both years.

From 2013-15, the Colonials won a postseason game each year, twice in the NIT and once in the NCAA Tournament. Robert Morris defeated Kentucky (2013) and Saint John's (2014) in the NIT before taking down North Florida (2015) in the NCAA First Four, the programs second-ever NCAA win. As recruiting coordinator, Gallo brought 2015 NEC Rookie of the Year Marquise Reed to the program as well as 2016 All-NEC First Team guard Rodney Pryor. Eight Colonials earned all-conference distinctions during Gallo's tenure, including 2014 NEC Player of the Year, Karvel Anderson.

From 2009-12, Gallo spent two years as an assistant coach at Dartmouth College and a one-year stint as the Director of Hoop Group Elite, the nation's largest basketball exposure camp for high school players. After a one-year hiatus at the conclusion of his playing career, the Milltown, New Jersey, native returned to campus in 2005 to begin a four-year period as an assistant with the men's basketball program. Gallo helped guide the program to its first NCAA Tournament appearance in eight years during the 2007-08 season, and followed that up with the school's first NCAA Tournament win in 18 years during the 2008-09 campaign.

Gallo was instrumental in recruiting former All-Americans Darren Duncan '10 and Darin Mency '11 to the program, who won consecutive Northeast-10 Rookie of the Year awards in 2007 and 2008, respectively. Both players went on to score over 2,000 points in their careers and were three-time NE-10 All-Conference selections, in addition to their All-America accolades. Gallo also brought Wayne Mack '12 to the program before departing in 2009, with Mack leaving his mark as a 1,000-point scorer and eventually became Gallo's third recruit to earn All-America recognition.

The alumnus graduated from Merrimack in 2004 after a successful playing career, earning a business degree with a concentration in management. He is currently working towards his masters in organizational leadership.

Gallo currently resides in Salem, N.H. with his wife Megan and their sons, Joseph Andrew Gallo Jr. and Trey Richard Gallo.

Micky Burtnyk Assistant Coach 13th Season

Burtnyk enters his 13th season on the men's basketball coaching staff following an illustrious career from 2004-08, in which he guided the Warriors to 54 total wins and a NCAA Tournament berth in his final year.

With the help of Burtnyk, the Warriors won the 2019-20 NEC Regular Season Championship, becoming the first team ever to win a conference title in its first season of Division I membership. Burtnyk helped Merrimack to 20 victories last year, the programs third straight season with at least 20 wins. Burtnyk helped senior Juvaris Hayes to an All-American season that included an NEC Defensive Player of the Year Award, all-conference first-team selection, and the Lefty Driesell Award as the top defensive player in the country.

The coaching staff also saw multiple student-athletes reach new heights as well. Idris Joyner established career highs in scoring. Devin Jensen set career highs in 3-pointers made and 3-point percentage.

The long-time Warrior was part of his first-ever conference championship in 2018-19, assisting the program to its first NE10 Championship since the 1999-00 season and third conference tournament title in school history overall. Burtnyk helped Merrimack to a school-record 22 victories, a number the program has now reached five times overall, and a No. 2 seed in the NCAA Tournament's East Regional, the highest seed for the program ever. Burtnyk saw junior Juvaris Hayes earn All-American status for the second straight year as well as receiving NE10 Defensive Player of the Year and NE10 All-Conference First Team accolades. Senior Ryan Boulter also was an all-league selection, landing on the third team. In the regular season, Merrimack won 14 NE10 games and finished second in the Northeast Division. Both marks tied the second most since the NE10 moved to a divisional format.

The 2017-18 campaign saw continued excellence for the program. Burtnyk helped the program to its first 20-win season in nearly a decade and ninth overall, reaching the NCAA Tournament for the second time in as many seasons. The assistant helped the Warriors to 14 Northeast-10 Conference wins, which were the most for the program since 2009-10. Merrimack finished second in the Northeast Division, the program's highest finish since the NE10 moved to a divisional format in 2013-14.

In 2016-17, Burtnyk contributed to the development of seven returning players along with compiling an impressive recruiting class that allowed the Warriors to shock many in the region. After being selected to finish second-to-last in the Northeast Division, the Warriors posted 12 league victories and 19 overall, earned a conference tournament berth and reached the program's ninth NCAA Tournament as an at-large selection. Merrimack went on to upset top-seeded Le Moyne as the No. 8 seed, the lone eighth seed to advance out of the regional quarterfinals nationwide.

Over the 10 years of Burtnyk's stint on the sidelines, the program owns a 162-125 record (.564) with four of the school's 10 NCAA Tournament berths in tow. The Warriors have finished above .500 in seven of his 10 seasons as part of the Merrimack staff.

Other highlights of Burtnyk's coaching resume include a debut season in 2009-10 that saw the Warriors win 21 games, reach the NCAA Tournament and total a program-record tying 16 NE10 wins. Merrimack also finished above .500 in 2011-12, 2014-15 and 2015-16.

In his playing career Burtnyk tallied 830 points and also holds the Merrimack standard for points in his collegiate debut with 26.

Burtnyk lives in Worcester, Mass. with his wife Erin their daughters Ellie and Emma.



Phil Gaetano Assistant Coach Fourth Season

Phil Gaetano joined the Merrimack College men's basketball staff as an assistant coach in the summer of 2018, and will start his third season on the Merrimack sidelines in 2020-21.

Gaetano's contributions were critical to the team's historic 2019-20 campaign, which resulted in winning the 2019-20 NEC Regular Season Championship. Merrimack became the first program to win a conference championship in its first season of Division I membership. Merrimack's accomplishments also included history such as the team's win over Northwestern - becoming the second NEC team ever to win against a Big Ten opponent - and the program's 17th victory of the year at St. Francis Brooklyn set a new wins record for a first-year program transitioning to Division I.

In terms of team accolades, Gaetano and the Merrimack coaching staff put together one of the top defensive units in the country. Merrimack led the conference in scoring defense, three-point field goal percentage, steals per game and turnover margin. Gaetano's work with Merrimack's backcourt helped senior guard Juvaris Hayes to a NEC Defensive Player of the Year honor, all-conference first team selection and the Lefty Driesell Award recipient as the top defensive player nationwide.

Enjoying an impactful debut season, Gaetano helped Merrimack win the 2018-19 NE10 Championship to claim the program's third conference title ever and first in 19 years. The Warriors won 22 games in total, tying the school record for wins in a season, with Gaetano being instrumental in the day-to-day success of the program. The Warriors reached their third straight NCAA Tournament as the East Region's second seed, the highest seeding the program ever received. The former Division I guard helped elevate Juvaris Hayes to win the NE10's Defensive Player of the Year, and aided sharp-shooting senior Ryan Boulter to the first season of at least 100 3-pointers made for a Merrimack player in 23 years.

Gaetano arrived at Merrimack after spending the 2017-18 academic year on staff at Coppin State University. His responsibilities included recruiting coordination, practice plan and scouting report development as well as leading individual and team film sessions. Prior to his time at Coppin State, Gaetano served as an assistant with the Maine Red Claws of the NBA Development League (G-League) in 2016-17. The Red Claws posted a 29-21 record that season and won the Atlantic Division.

As a student, Gaetano played at Sacred Heart University from 2011-15 and graduated as one of the most decorated point guards in program history. He remains the Pioneers all-time assists leader (730) in their Division I history as well as distributing the third most assists in Northeast Conference (NEC) history.

In addition to his on-court accolades, Gaetano became the first-ever three-time NEC Scholar Athlete of the Year (2013-15), graduating with a degree in business administration in 2014. He went on to earn his master's degree, also in business administration, in 2015. Gaetano and his wife, Blair, reside in Andover, Mass.
