KEY STORYLINES

SCOUTING NC STATE

- On the season, the Wolfpack is 9-6, with a 3-1 mark in ACC play. Most recently, NC State swept Florida State and defeated Miami 3-1
- Other notable wins include TCU (3-0), Indiana (3-0) and Sam Houston (3-2)
- Freshman Ava Brizard earned her second ACC Freshman of the Week honor this week after recording 26 kills on the weekend with 3.71 per set, ending the weekend with a .257 hitting percentage.
- Brizard currently leads the team with 171 kills and 3.61 points per set. She has 191.5 points on the season
- Defensively, the Pack leads opponents with 823 digs compared to 775 from opponents. Priscilla Hernandez

- leads the team with 229 digs, averaging 4.24 per set
- Riley Shaak also helps out NC State defensively with 74 total blocks. She is averaging 1.40 per set. Jada Allen also adds 51 blocks
- Kristen McDaniel and Naomi Cabello are the assists leaders for the Pack, with 282 and 236, respectively

SCOUTING NORTH CAROLINA

- The Tar Heels are also 9-6 on the year, recording a 1-3 start in ACC play. Most recently, UNC fell to Miami (3-1) and Florida State (3-2)
- Notable wins for the Heels include Virginia (3-2), Michigan State (3-0), Arizona (3-2) and South Carolina (3-0)
- Offensively, North Carolina

- leads opponents with 726 kills, compared to 691 put up by opponent. The Heels are averaging 13 kills per set and allowing 12.3 kills per set from opposing teams
- The Tar Heels also have the edge at the service line, recording 103 total service aces and allowing only 58 from opponents
- The kills leader for the Tar Heels is Mabrey Shaffmaster with 196. She is averaging 4.10 points per set and 3.77 kills per set
- Parker Austin is the ace leader with 26 so far on the season, .51 aces per set
- Three different Tar Heels have over 100 digs with Maddy May (188), Shaffmaster (135) and Charley Niego (132)

LAST TIME OUT

- The Hokies went 1-1 last weekend in ACC play, defeating Boston College 3-0 on Friday but falling to Syracuse 3-1 on Sunday
- Against the Eagles, Sydney Petersen led the way with 11 kills and a hitting percentage of .526. Maddie Slagle recorded nine digs and five different players had at least two blocks, as Cara Lewis led the team with four total
- Throughout the match, the Hokies recorded just eight attack errors, compared to 26 from the Eagles who hit just .085, a credit to the Hokie defense.
- Seven different Hokies had a kill in the win, while Brie Postema added nine assists to go along with Hanna Borer's 21.
- Against the Orange, Cara Lewis finished with 11 kills and a hitting percentage of .364

OFFENSIVE SUCCESS

- The Hokies had one of their best offensive performances against the Tigers last week, hitting .249, including a .387 clip in the first set with 14 kills.
- Sydney Petersen led the team to open ACC play with 21 kills on 39 attempts, averaging 2.63 per set and an impressive .462 kill percentage in the two games.
- The Hokies followed that up with their best hitting percentage of the season against Boston College, hitting .353 over three sets, as Petersen recorded a .526 hitting percentage

ACC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

- Freshman setter Hanna Borer was named the ACC Freshman of the Week for the first time in her career following the opening weekend of ACC play
- This is Virginia Tech's first Freshman of the Week honor since Kaity Smith earned the award in 2017.
- The freshman recorded her fifth double-double of the season in the win over Clemson with 34 assists and 14 digs. She helped the Hokie attack hit at a .249 clip with 68 kills.
- Tech hit over .200 in every set except for one against the Tigers, with a match-high .387 in the first set. Borer also recorded an ace in the win.
- Against No. 13 Georgia Tech, Borer added 18 assists for the Hokies as well as six digs
- On the weekend, Borer totaled 52 assists, averaging 6.50 assists per set and helping the Hokies hit .210 over the weekend. She added 20 digs defensively, with 2.50 per set, as well as adding an ace to her weekend point total.

TOUGH TRANSFERS

- The 2022 roster for the Hokies features six transfers: Cara Lewis, Maddie Slagle, Reagan Goeke, Sydney Petersen, Jenna Appel and Ava Francis

- Lewis, a transfer from Maryland, ranked first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set. Totaled 126 total blocks which also led the team
- Another Big Ten transfer, Slagle posted 760 digs in her career with Iowa, finishing with 1.959 digs per set, as well as 52 aces
- Goeke and Petersen will also join the Hokie block as transfers, with Goeke coming from Pepperdine and Petersen from Nevada. Francis comes to Blacksburg as an outside hitter, spending fall of 2021 at Arizona
- The Hokies add another setter in Jenna Appel from Loyola Chicago. As a sophomore, she finished with 605 assists and 26 aces. She also ranked 13th in the MVC with 5.00 assists per set

FRESH FACES

- Along with the six transfers, the Hokies also add nine freshmen to the squad for this season
- Three of those freshmen were early enrollees and played the 2021 spring season for the Hokies; Sierra Cates, Hanna Borer and Lauren Fowler
- The other six joined the Hokies this summer and look to make an immediate impact on the young squad

NEWCOMER FAST FACTS

- #0 Hanna Borer – Broke her high school record for assists in a single season with 798, also reached 1,000 career assists
- #1 Lauren Fowler – Helped her high school team to three State Championships and was named the 2020 Region Player of the Year, State Player of the Year and All-State honoree
- #6 Cara Lewis – Helped Maryland become Big Ten's best blocking team for the second straight season, ranking first on the team, second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally with 1.54 blocks per set
- #8 Josie Bloom - Named to the AVCA Phenom List in 2020 and 2021. Also named the No. 1 ranked L/DS in the state of Michigan by PrepDig
- #9 Sierra Cates – Helped her high school team reach the second round of the State Championship Tournament and was named to the County All-Star Team
- #10 Maddie Slagle – Finished her career at Iowa with 760 digs and 1.96 digs per set. As a junior, ranked second on the team with 128 digs and tallied seven or more digs 10 times
- #11 Amaya Roberson – Named to the USA Volleyball Junior National Championships All-Tournament Team and helped her club team to a third-place finish at AAU Nationals
- #16 Sarah Malinowski – Posted an attack percentage of .370 or above in five different matches, with a high of .680 in high school. Also named to the JVA Watchlist (2019-2021)
- #17 Aerin Bowman – Made the All-Tournament Team at USAV Nationals and the 2021 AAU All-tournament Team in 2021
- #18 Lucky-Rose Williams – Earned First Team All-Conference and All-State honors, while

helping her team to a Top-5 ranking in the state of Hawaii

- #19 Reagan Goeke – In a season at Pepperdine, finished the year with 19 kills, .54 kills per set and 31 points. Posted 20 blocks with only two errors
- #20 Sydney Petersen – As a junior at Nevada, placed first on the team in blocks (98), second in kills (223). As a freshman, set a new single season program record with 137 block assists
- #23 Jenna Appel – Played two seasons at Loyola Chicago and ranked 13th in the MVC as a sophomore with 5.00 assists per set. She also had eight double-doubles with 605 total assists
- #24 Ava Francis – Named to the PrepVolleyball Phenom List and ranked the No. 2 recruit in the state of Ohio. Also named an AVCA All-Region Team member, All-American Honorable Mention and an Under Armour All-American
- #26 Jordan Hallman – AVCA Second Team All-American and National All-Region Team in 2021. Ranked second in the state of Tennessee with a .428 hitting percentage and ranked 22nd nationally with 313 kills in high school

Marci Byers was named the sixth head coach of the Virginia Tech volleyball program in January, 2020. She enters her third season at the helm of the Hokies.

During her first season with Tech, the team tallied five conference wins including a sweep of Virginia and a win over then No. 14 Duke in five sets. The Hokies defeated Virginia in 2021 as well, taking down the Cavaliers in five sets. Tech also defeated Boston College and Wake Forest in ACC play during Byers' second season at the helm. Byers looks to build off the 2021 season with many key returners and 15 newcomers set to make an impact.

A four-time Big South Coach of the Year selection at Radford University, she is the winningest coach in Highlanders' history, leading the program to three Big South regular season titles, two Big South Tournament championships and two NCAA Tournament berths. She is one of only five head coaches in Big South history to register 200 or more career victories.

Throughout her tenure at Radford, the Chicago native consistently recruited top talent to the New River Valley from across the country, thanks to her strong relationships within the ACC footprint, as well as with elite club programs in the Midwest, Texas and California.

Byers' squads at Radford topped the 20-win mark five times over seven seasons and compiled an 81-34 (.708) overall record over four years. She led the Highlanders to a 22-7 record in 2018, including a 12-4 mark in Big South play. They reached the Big South Tournament title game for the second consecutive season and were selected to play in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship where they defeated App State in the first round. During her tenure at Radford, her student-athletes twice registered the top team GPA of any program at the school (2008 and 2013).

No stranger to defeating Power Five foes, under her direction in 2017 the Highlanders registered wins at Arizona, at South Carolina and at Virginia Tech en route to a Big South Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. In 2016, Byers led Radford to a 24-6 record, including a perfect 11-0 mark at home and a Big South regular season championship. Her squads also registered wins against Wake Forest in 2016 and Washington State in 2015. Byers' 2014 squad finished with a 24-8

mark that included wins over California and Maryland as Radford claimed the Big South regular season title. The Highlanders earned their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Byers in 2013 after winning both the Big South regular season and tournament titles, finishing the season with a 25-10 record.

Prior to beginning her tenure at Radford in 2008, she spent two seasons at NCAA Division II Chowan University in Murfreesboro, N.C. After going 4-17 in her initial season in 2006, Byers guided the Hawks to a 26-11 record as the squad averaged the most aces per game of any Division II squad. Prior to joining the collegiate ranks, she posted a 121-49 record in 10 seasons coaching in the Richmond prep ranks, spending two seasons at Mills Godwin High School and eight years at Hermitage High School.

Byers has also been a successful coach at the club level. Her 2003-04 team qualified for the Junior Olympics in Houston, while her 2004-05 team reached the Junior Olympics in Salt Lake City. She was also invited to participate in the USA Volleyball Coaches Clinic at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

She is a 1995 graduate of Virginia Union University where she graduated with honors with a bachelor's degree in secondary education with a concentration in mathematics. A four-year starter on the volleyball team, she captained the team as both a junior and senior. Her husband, J.D., serves as an assistant men's basketball coach at VCU. The couple are parents of a daughter, Kamryn Grey.

NOTEWORTHY

ACC POWER

- Three Atlantic Coast Conference teams were ranked in the preseason American Volleyball Coaches Association Top 25 Poll and all three were in the top 10 to enter the season
- Reigning ACC Champion Louisville is No. 2 in this week's poll, followed by No. 9 Pittsburgh and No. 10 Georgia Tech. Both the Cardinals and Panthers advanced to last season's NCAA Championship semifinals and each finished with more than 30 wins.
- Georgia Tech's No. 5 ranking in week 2 was the highest preseason ranking in program history. Miami, North Carolina and Florida State also received votes in the preseason poll.

MILESTONE WATCH

- Junior Brie Postema currently sits at 995 career assists after leading the team as a sophomore a season ago
- In 2021, she posted 538 assists, playing in 26 matches. As a rookie, Postema had 310 assists. Her current career-high sits at 47 which she achieved in the five-set win against Virginia on Oct. 29, 2021.
- Maddie Slagle is also closing in on 1,000 digs, sitting at 961 over her five-year career. After spending four years at Iowa, Slagle leads the team with 201 digs as a Hokie
- Logan Mosley reached her 1,000th career dig a season ago and is now poised to move up on the all-time career digs leaderboard
- Mosley has 1,204 career digs, which is 34 away from tying for 10th all-time in school history with Justine Record (2008-11)

HOME SWEET CASSELL

- The Hokies were 6-0 at Cassell Coliseum before falling to Syracuse this past Sunday
- Tech had not dropped a set so far in Cassell, recording all six sweeps prior to Sunday's match
- The Hokies are 389-182 in Blacksburg in program history

MIDWAY POINT

- The Hokies are currently halfway through the season and are currently 9-6 overall and 2-2 in ACC play.
- The current kills leader is Cera Powell with a total of 144 and an average of 2.82 per set. ••
- Maddie Slagle leads the Hokies with a total of 201 and an average of 3.72 per set.

- Hanna Borer currently leads the Hokies in assists with a total of 331 and leads in service aces with a total of 17.

DEFENSE WINS MATCHES

- Anabel Zier has been solid on defense this season, ranking 7th in the ACC with 1.10 blocks/set and a total of 57 over the season.
- She sits only 0.1/set behind Kate Brennan of Boston College
- Zier has had help as Cara Lewis trails Zier by only six blocks with a .92 blocks per set.
- Maddie Slagle has also helped out the defense ranking 8th in the ACC with 201 digs with 3.72/set.
- She has led the team in digs this season, with Hanna Borer adding 106 as well

C. POWELL

- Cera Powell was one of the most consistent Hokies in the lineup a season ago, playing in 26 matches
- She totaled 223 total points, with 203 kills and 2.56 points per set. She also averaged 2.33 kills per set
- She currently leads the team with 144 kills and 2.82 kills per set
- Powell is averaging 3.15 points per set, which is almost more than half a point more than the next highest player on the team
- The senior has also made an impact defensively and on the service line, adding 98 digs and 12 service aces

HOKIE BLOCK PARTY

- A season ago, Virginia Tech ranked fifth nationally in total blocks midway through the season
- Tech ended the year with 259.5 blocks per season vs 205.5 posted by opponents throughout the season
- With 2.30 blocks per set, the Hokies also led opponents compared to 1.82 by opponents
- Cera Powell returns as a member of the Hokie block, posting 29 total a season ago. Cara Lewis, Sydney Petersen, Anabel Zier, Reagan Goeke and Jordan Hallman look to add some depth as well to the position group
