## **HOKIES OPEN 2019 AT RYCASS CLASSIC IN DELAND, FLORIDA**

Tech in season openers: The Hokies have posted a 63-60-2 record in their previous 125 season openers. The last time a Tech season opener was played at home was in 1995, and in the 23 years since, the Hokies have gone 12-11 - with 11 of those games being played in South Carolina, seven in North Carolina, three in Georgia, one in Virginia and one in Florida.

In the school's 125-year history, Tech has opened the season in the state of Florida just once, back in the 2004 season. The Hokies took part in a season-opening tournament in DeLand that year as well, and suffered a 15-2 loss in the opener to the host Stetson Hatters on Friday, Feb. 27. Tech split its final two games, beating South Florida, 4-3, before dropping a 2-0 contest to Oklahoma State.

The Hokies in the Sunshine State: This weekend will mark the first of three trips for Tech to the state of Florida - as the Hokies will return to face Florida State in March and Miami in April. Their nine games in the Sunshine State will be the most since the 1996 season, when Tech played nine there as well - three at South Florida and six in Winter Park, but managed to go just 1-8 record in that span.

The Hokies have played 10 or more games in a single season in the state of Florida on three occasions, playing 11 in both 1994 - eight in DeLand, three in Tampa and the team went 6-5; and 1980 - seven in DeLand, four in Tallahassee (Metro Tourney) and the team went 7-4. In 1986, Tech played 10 games, going 3-7, in eight games in DeLand and two in the Metro Tourney in Tallahassee.

Overall, Tech has compiled a 51-99 record in 150 games in the Sunshine State - which included a 3-2 record last year in DeLand. The Hokies are only 14-65 on the road, but hold a 37-34 edge in neutral site contests, which includes three straight wins.

Tech against the field: Overall, against the field, Tech is 2-11 all-time, however, nine of those games are against the hosts Hatters. Versus Stetson, the Hokies are just 1-8 (all on the road) with their lone with coming on March 31, 1986 - a 5-2 decision. They have lost four in a row including a nail-biter last season on March 2 - when Logan Gilbert outdueled Connor Coward in a 2-1 contest. Against current Atlantic Sun opponents, Tech is 9-10 all-time - USC Upstate (7-0), Kennesaw State (1-1) and Lipscomb (0-1).

Versus Manhattan: Tech is 1-0, playing its only game against the Jaspers on Feb. 28, 2016 and winning that 12-7. Then-freshman Nic Enright started the contest and went 3.0 innings with three strikeouts. It was the second start of his career. Luke Scherzer (listed a junior at the time) is the only other Hokie on Tech's roster in that game. Against current MAAC schools, Tech is 15-6 - Niagara (4-1), Marist (3-0), Quinnipiac (3-1). Canisius (2-0) and Rider (2-4).

Versus Sam Houston State: This is the first meeting between the two schools, but Tech has played two current Southland teams, but are 0-3 - losing twice to New Orleans and once to SE Louisiana.

# **#14 John Szefc**

# **Virginia Tech Head Coach - Second Season**

Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock announced the hiring of Tech's 25th head baseball coach on June 9 and formally introduced John Szefc as the head coach of the baseball program on June 15. The 2019 season will mark his second as the Hokies' head coach.

Szefc (pronounced SHEFF) accepted the position after leading Maryland to three NCAA appearances and a 180-122 (.596) overall record as the Terrapins' head coach. He owns a 392-259-3 (.602) career record in 12 seasons as an NCAA head coach, producing 10 campaigns with 30 or more wins.

In addition to ending a 43-year NCAA tournament drought and becoming the fastest coach to 100 career wins at Maryland, Szefc spent seven seasons (1996-2002) at the helm of the Marist College baseball program, where he led the team to four conference championships, four NCAA Regional appearances and a 212-137-3 (.607) overall mark. Szefc earned Northeastern Conference Coach of the Year honors in 1997 and was the American Baseball Coaches

Associate Northeast Region Coach of the Year in 2001.

The first coach in Maryland history to ever take the Terrapins to an NCAA Super Regional, Szefc accomplished the feat twice in 2014 and 2015 as he guided the program to the first two 40-win seasons in school history and claimed Maryland's first two NCAA Regional crowns. Maryland achieved a final No. 14 ranking both seasons, the highest finishes in school history.

He guided the Terrapins to the ACC Tournament final for the first time in 38 years in 2014 and then took Maryland to the Big Ten tournament final in the school's initial season in that conference, winning a program-best 42 games in 2015.

Szefc has coached 102 players that have been drafted or signed professional contracts since 1997, including six selected in the 2017 MLB draft and four in 2018 (including Tech pitchers Connor Coward and Andrew McDonald). Over the last six drafts, 29 of his players have been selected, including the 45th pick of the 2014 draft Jake Stinnett, the highest pick of a Maryland player in almost a decade. He has also helped develop 23 All-Americans, including 10 of the 20 players in Maryland history to earn that distinction.

The Middletown, N.Y. native arrived at Maryland after a two-year stint as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas State (2011-12) and a two-season stay as assistant head coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas (2009-10). He also enjoyed a six-season tenure as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Louisiana-Lafayette (2003-08). Szefc began his coaching career as an assistant at Sacred Heart (1995) and at Drexel (1990-93).

Szefc managed the New York Generals in the Atlantic College Baseball League during the summers of 1995 and 1996. He led the club to a 47-28 record, earned two consecutive division titles and the ACBL title game in 1996.

Collegiately, he played two years at Connecticut before transferring in 1987 to Drexel. During his senior campaign for the Dragons, he was tabbed an All-East Coast Conference outfielder.

He graduated from Drexel University with a degree in corporate communications in 1989. He also holds a master's degree in sports administration from Temple University.

Szefc and his wife, Barbara, have a daughter, Anna, and two sons, John Michael and Sam.

## **WHAT IS A HOKIE?**

Probably the most frequently asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics and the answer dates back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute.

With it came a contest held by the student body for writing a new cheer and senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull said the words had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention. "Hokie" soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics. Below is the "Old Hokie" yell:

Hoki, Hoki, Hoki Hy! Tech! Tech! V.P.I.! Sola-Rex Sola-Rah Polytech-Vir-gin-i-a!! Rae, Ri, V.P.I.

#### **JUST VIRGINIA TECH, PLEASE!**

While the full name of the school is Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, the school is commonly referred to as "Virginia Tech." Founded in 1872, as Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College, the university changed its named to Virginia Polytechnic Institute in 1896.

Fans of the athletic department, as well as media covering the Hokies, shortened the name to VPI, but it eventually became Virginia Tech.

The "State University" was added in 1970 to bring the official title to what it is today.

Those covering Hokie athletics are asked to refer to the university as simply "Virginia Tech."

Virginia Tech University, VPI and SU, VPI&SU, VT or VA Tech are not recognized names and should not be used.

On March 21, 2016, Virginia Tech renamed its baseball stadium to English Field at Union Park in recognition of a generous commitment of support to the athletics department from Union Bank & Trust. The stadium received substantial upgrading with help from the \$3.5 million committed by the Richmond-based bank. On the date, Tech's Board of Visitors approved extending naming rights to the stadium to Union Bank for 10 years in recognition of the company's financial support.

Located at the intersection of Southgate Drive and Duck Pond Drive, English Field at Union Park is an incredible new home for Virginia Tech baseball. Designed by Cannon Design and built by Whiting-Turner, the \$20 million renovation project added a new grandstand area – with new press-level premium suites – 1,132 permanent chair-back seats in concrete stands and a club level above the first-base dugout, along with a social picnic area down the right-field line. The terracing along the third-base line remains.

English Field was officially dedicated during a special ceremony on April 8, 1989 and is named for the late E.R. 'Red' English and his wife, Ruth, who provided financial support for its initial construction.

English, a native of Altavista, Va., played as an offensive and defensive guard on Tech's football team from 1930-33 and graduated in 1934. He contributed to Tech athletics for more than 50 years and was one of the founders of The Student Aid Association in 1949. He served as president of that organization two of its first three years. English received the most outstanding alumni award at Tech in 1984.

Through a generous gift from alumnus George Sampson, the home team dugout was named for long-time Tech baseball coach G.F. 'Red' Laird during a ceremony on April 12, 1991. Laird recruited and coached Sampson at Tech.

The team's year-by-year overall mark in its 30 seasons at English Field at Union Park can be seen on the right. Before it, the Hokies played their home baseball games at Tech Park, where it compiled a 431-122-1 (.779 winning percentage) record over 34 seasons. All-time, Tech is 1.259-572-12 (.686) in games played in Blacksburg.
