## **KEY STORYLINES**

## THE MATCHUP

- The Gamecocks opened the Fort Myers Tip-Off with a 75-66 defeat to No. 22 Xavier.
- Virginia Tech is 13-19 against South Carolina all-time.
- The former Metro and Southern Conference rivals will be meeting for the second year in a row. Tech and South Carolina squared off in the Hall of Fame Series Charlotte event on Nov. 10, 2023 where the Gamecocks prevailed, 79-77. Sean Pedulla led all scorers with 26 points to go along with nine rebounds and five assists. Tech caught fire in the second stanza. connecting on 15 of 22 attempts from the floor (68.2%).
- Mylyjael Poteat and Brandon Rechsteiner are the only current Hokies to have played in that game last season. Poteat contributed nine points on 3 for 3 shooting off the bench.
- Prior to last season, the two sides had not met since Dec. 5, 1997. That game was also in Charlotte, N.C., where the fifth-ranked Gamecocks edged the Hokies, 74-73, as part of the Pepsi/Harris Teeter Challenge.
- South Carolina connected on 35 of 47 free throws in that contest, including the game-winning free throw by Melvin Watson with 3.5 seconds left.

## **BY THE NUMBERS**

23

VT head coach **Mike Young** enters his **Jordan Year** as a head coach, and sixth in Blacksburg. He's **five wins** shy of **100** at the helm of the Hokies.



The Hokies' **five assists** against Michigan Monday night was the **lowest total** by Tech under Mike Young, topping the previous mark of six on Jan. 4, 2020 at Virginia.



Each of Tech's **next four games** will be against foes ranked inside the top 80 of the KenPom rankings: Michigan (27), South Carolina (74), Vanderbilt (77) and Pitt (17).

## **NOTEWORTHY**

## **YOUNG, PARIS MEET AGAIN**

- The head coaches for Tech and South Carolina have squared off six times prior to Wednesday night. Young is 5-1 in those meetings.
- Young (Wofford) and Paris (Chattanooga) battled each other four times while both were in the SoCon, then played again on Dec. 11, 2019 in Young's inaugural season in Blacksburg a 63-58 win by the Hokies.
- Paris notched his first win against Young on Nov. 10, 2023 when the Gamecocks defeated Tech, 79-77, in Charlotte, N.C.

## **BENNY BUCKETS GOING FOR 1K**

- Tech senior Ben Burnham will look to eclipse 1,000 career points Wednesday night vs.
   South Carolina. The Fort Mill, S.C., native chose the Hokies over the Gamecocks, Florida State and Ole Miss last spring once he entered the transfer portal out of College of Charleston.
- Burnham has 995 career points entering the contest vs. South Carolina.

## **GET AFTER THE GLASS**

- VT ranked 10th in the ACC and 191st nationally in rebound margin last season.
   Most of the rebounding struggles were on the offensive side where the Hokies grabbed just 25% of their offensive rebound opportunities, which ranked 298th out of 362 programs per Ken Pomeroy.
- In 13 of its 21 games against ACC foes last season, Tech lost the battle of the boards, including double-digit margins against Duke (-18), Pitt (-14), Boston College (-13) and North Carolina (-12).
- Fast forward to this season and the Hokies rank 18th in the country in that stat at 39.5%. They are averaging 13.5 offensive rebounds per game after manufacturing a season-high 18 against the Wolverines, who featured the tallest frontcourt the Hokies have faced so far this season.

## TRYING TO FIND THE RIGHT BUTTON

- During the Hokies' three-game skid, they have turned the ball over a combined 59 times.
- Tech has slid to No. 341 in the KenPom rankings for turnover percentage (turnovers/ possessions) at 22.7%. In comparison, Mike Young's worst team in this category in his 23 years as head coach was his 2003-04

Wofford team at 24% - ranked No. 291.

• "I don't care what level you're at, what league you're in, [you can't] turn the ball over that many times," Young said. "We've been ranked in the top 25 nationally in assist/turnover ratio many, many times in my career. I've got to do a better job coaching, and I am jumping up and down and doing everything I can, but I've got to find the right button."

## STREAKING IN THE WRONG DIRECTION

- Prior to its current skid, the last time VT lost three straight nonconference games was the 2007-08 season. Tech hasn't lost four in a row in non-league play since the 1970-71 season.
- The Hokies have lost three straight games by double digits for the first time since the 2019-20 season – Mike Young's first season in Blacksburg.
- Prior to this year, the last time VT lost three straight nonconference games by double figures was during the 1952-53 season.

## NOT YOUR TYPICAL FRESHMAN

- Mike Young called Tyler Johnson a "fierce offensive rebounder" during a preseason media availability. The freshman from Orlando, Fla. lived up to that billing against Winthrop, going for a season-high 10 rebounds, including six on the offensive glass.
- He became the first VT true freshman with at least 10-plus rebounds in a single game since Khadim Sy vs. New Mexico on Nov. 24, 2016.
- "He's got a nose for it and he will knock your head off," Young said of Johnson. "He's tough, he's physical, he's a good basketball player."

## **LA-WOW FACTOR**

- Tobi Lawal was impressive in his Tech debut Nov. 4 vs. Delaware State. The VCU transfer recorded a career-high 23 points on 6 of 9 shooting, went 9 for 11 from the foul line, pulled down eight rebounds and posted team highs with two steals and two blocks.
- However, Lawal holds himself to a high standard and knows there's more he can showcase. "It was an OK Tech debut," Lawal said. "I could've done much better. I didn't play that well. I equate myself to a very high standard and I don't think it was good

- enough, especially in certain areas like the turnovers (five). A lot of silly mistakes on defense."
- Mylyjael Poteat added, "he's an athletic freak."

## **SCHUTTA GETS HIS SHOT AGAIN**

- Prior to the season opener, Tech redshirt sophomore Jaden Schutt last played an in-season college basketball game on March 16, 2023. He played three minutes in Duke's 74-51 victory in the 2023 NCAA first round game vs. Oral Roberts at the Amway Center in Orlando, Fla.
- Nov. 4 vs. Delaware State marked 599 days since Schutt took the floor against Oral Roberts.
- Schutt played in an exhibition on Nov. 1, 2023 against UNC Pembroke, then suffered a pair of injuries (knee and hand) that prompted a redshirt.
- The Yorkville, Ill., native dialed up a careerhigh 17 points on 6 of 11 shooting in Tech's 58-52 victory over Winthrop.
- "Every time I get up and down the court, just kind of getting more confident," Schutt said. "Every day's just obviously a blessing to go play. Just happy to play basketball."

## **ROSTER FLIP**

- The Hokies return just 12.8% of their scoring from a season ago, led by Mylyjael Poteat's 219 points
- Only five of Tech's 14 players were on the 2023-24 roster: Poteat, Brandon Rechsteiner, Conner Venable, Patrick Wessler and Jaydon Young.
- The Hokies reeled in five from the transfer portal, including two from high major programs: Rodney Brown Jr. (Cal) and Jaden Schutt (Duke). Tobi Lawal (VCU), Ben Burnham (College of Charleston) and

Connor Serven (Eastern Michigan) round out the transfer class.

## **5-MAN PROGRESSION**

- Virginia Tech has had recent success with developing its centers with the likes of two-time All-ACC pick Keve Aluma and Lynn Kidd, who transferred to Miami in the offseason.
- Now, Mylyjael Poteat steps into the role on the horizon of his third season in Blacksburg.
- Below is a progression chart of Aluma, Kidd and Poteat. Aluma's 2018-19 season was at Wofford, Kidd's 2020-21 season was at Clemson and Poteat's 2020-21 season was at Rice.

- Mike Young will be inducted into Wofford's Athletics Hall of Fame as a member of the 2024 class.
- A five-member class, he will be joined by a pair of players he coached in Fletcher Magee and Cameron Jackson.
- Young compiled a 299-244 overall record at Wofford, while guiding the Terriers to five NCAA Tournaments.
- In his final season in Spartanburg, S.C., Young steered Wofford to a 30-5 overall record, including a perfect 18-0 mark in SoCon play.

## **NON-NEGOTIABLES**

• Despite everything that's new with the men's basketball program, there are four things Mike Young is adamant won't change for the team this year: being a great teammate, representing Virginia Tech in a class fashion, taking care of the ball and great shot selection.

## **TRACKING ON 400**

• Mike Young is closing in on career win No. 400. He would become the fourth active ACC head men's basketball coach to reach the milestone.

## **NAW IN PARIS**

- Nickeil Alexander-Walker (2017-19) competed for Team Canada at the 2024 Paris Olympics. The Canadians advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to host France.
- Currently playing for the Minnesota
   Timberwolves of the NBA, Alexander-Walker
   became just the second Hokie to qualify for
   the Olympics in men's basketball (Bimbo
   Coles, 1988, Seoul, South Korea).

## **50 SPOT**

- Since Mike Young got to Blacksburg, the Hokies are 43-5 in contests shooting 50% or greater only losses: vs. BYU (11/27/19), vs. Miami (1/26/22), at College of Charleston (11/20/22), at Miami (1/31/23), vs. South Carolina (11/10/23).
- Since the 2010-11 season, Tech is 114-16 when shooting 50% or better.

## **BYERS BOUGHT IN ON DEFENSIVE END**

- J.D. Byers was hired as an assistant coach in April, bringing 13 years of experience at the Division I level with him to Blacksburg. He worked three stints with current Penn State head coach Mike Rhoades, most recently at VCU from 2017 to 2023.
- According to KenPom, VCU ranked 15th in adjusted defensive efficiency in 2022-23. Its three rankings the prior four seasons: seventh, 14th, 45th and seventh. Tech has only posted a top-40 defense five times since joining the ACC in 2004, the last time being 2019-20 under Buzz Williams (No. 20). H/T David Cunningham

## **GOT TO WIN ON THE ROAD**

- In order for the Hokies to return to the NCAA tournament, they must find a way to improve their record away from Cassell Coliseum.
- In each of the last two seasons, Tech has

- gone 2-10 in true road games.
- "We've got to do a better job of going away from home, away from the friendly confines of the Cassell, and win games," Mike Young said. "That's a big deal. I think we went 2-8 in the league last year, and that's just not good enough. That's the difference between an NCAA tournament berth and not going to the greatest tournament on Earth."

## **TIMES ARE CHANGING**

- Only four scholarship players return for the Hokies in 2024-25. With the addition of nine newcomers, the new-look roster makes Mike Young think back to his connection with Fork Union Military Academy.
- A 1982 graduate who was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2022, Young played for the late Fletcher Arritt, a member of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame who sent over 400 players on to play at the college level and won 889 career games.
- Young, who visited Arritt often at Fork
   Union when he was the coach at Wofford,
   recalled a conversation they had one spring
   about Arritt having to field a new team
   every year. Young thought to himself on
   several occasions, "I would never want to do
   that."

## **SHARE THE BASKETBALL**

- Year in and year out, Virginia Tech is known as a great passing and facilitating team under Coach Young's direction.
- Three of the past five seasons, Tech has finished among the top-three in the ACC for assists per game.







- Ben Hammond was the point guard for Paul VI, which finished the 2023-24 season 35-3 and ranked No. 2 in the country by ESPN.
- The Fairfax, Va., native played all four years for the Panthers, becoming the program's all-time winningest player after guiding PVI to four VISAA state titles and two WCAC titles.



# **WHAT'S A HOKIE?**

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.

Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of

his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The official university school colors - Chicago Maroon and Burnt Orange - also were introduced in 1896. The colors were chosen by a committee because they made a 'unique combination' not worn elsewhere at the time. The official definition of "Hokie" is "a loyal Virginia Tech Fan."




