Ben Thomas takes the reins

Ben Thomas, the previous head coach of the Virginia Tech track & field, has now taken over the program as the Director of Track & Field and Cross Country. This comes after Dave Cianelli, the 2024 USTFCCCA Hall of Fame inductee and 2024 Virginia Tech Sports Hall of the Fame inductee, retired in the summer of 2024. Thomas was the head cross country and distance coach at VT from 2001 to 2018 and then returned as the director-inwaiting (head coach) from Oregon in 2023.

Fixsen is BACK

Julia Fixsen returned to the vault after taking a year to recover from an injury. The graduate student was the 2023 NCAA Outdoor Individual Champion in the pole vault, with a result of 4.45m (14'7.25").

Judson Lincoln IV sights set on records

Junior sprinter, Judson Lincoln IV, looks to break records in his third year with the program, posting a 32.37 in the 300m at the Clemson Invite to open the season, positioning himself at 4th in the USTFCCCA/NCAA All-Time records, just 0.09 from the Tech record and 0.38 from the collegiate record, both held by former Hokie, Jacory Patterson. Lincoln IV's current best indoor 400m is 45.53, sitting just behind the program record of 45.14, which is also the ACC record.

Top-tier jumps recruit makes Virginia Tech debut

Federico Bruno is a five-time Italian National Champion (U20 & U23) in the triple jump. He holds a career-best of 16.31m (53'5") in the event.

Lookin' for a four-peat

The women's team is looking to extend their consecutive conference ITF title streak from three to four in the 2025 season. Major returners such as Fixsen. Killinen and Price will take over the leadership reins for the fairly youthful squad.

Couttie shifts from rough terrain to the even-keeled track

The first cross country All-American for Virginia Tech since 2019, George Couttie, is preparing for his first indoor season as a Hokie. The sophomore will specialize in the 800m and 1500m.

Tech adds four to staff

Cleo Borel joins the staff as the throws coach from Texas State. A four-time Olympian, Coach Borel still holds the Rector Field House record in the shot put at 19.48m (63'11").

Tim Sykes returns to the distance program, as an assistant coach, from Akron. John Ellis joins the staff as the jumps & multis coach, from Arizona State. Tra'von Phillips joins Dunson and the sprints & hurdles group as Assistant Coach.

BEN THOMAS

Director of Track & Field and Cross Country

SO FAR AS DIRECTOR OF TRACK & FIELD, CROSS COUNTRY, AT VIRGINIA TECH...

Heading into the 2024 cross country season, Virginia Tech was not in the nationals conversations. Throughout the season, Thomas coached George Couttie to All-ACC honors. At the NCAA Southeast Regional, the Virginia Tech men's team upset the No. 5 Wake Forest squad to secure an at-large bid to the NCAA Championship. The effort was led by George Couttie's first-place finish in the 10k in 29:41.7. Couttie, Nicholas Kipchirchir and Sharon Chepchirchir were all awarded NCAA All-Region honors. The fourth place team finish at the regional was the highest since Tech's second-place finish in 2019. Couttie was also the first Hokie to capture the event win since Peter Seufer in 2019. At Nationals, the Hokies finished 26th overall, with George Couttie leading the squad with a 14th place finish. The finish garnered Couttie All-American honors, the first of his career and the first for cross country since Peter Seufer in 2019, and the third highest finish in program history.

During his time at Oregon as the associate head coach, Thomas recruited and coached Cole Hocker. In the 2024 Paris Summer Olympics, Hocker shocked the world by upsetting Jakob Ingebrigsten and Josh Kerr in the 1500m final, to collect Olympic Gold in Olympic and American record fashion with his 3:27.65 mark.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS...

In his third year at Oregon, Thomas lit the indoor track world on fire, coaching Cooper Teare to the collegiate records and national championships in the mile (3:50.39) and the 1500m (3:35.46), and Cole Hocker, Luis Peralta, Charlie Hunter and Cooper Teare to the DMR (9:19.42). Teare's indoor mile record is still standing, while Teare (3:35.46) and Hocker (3:35.63) shift to second and third in the collegiate records for the 1500m.

Just prior to his original departure from VT, Thomas coached Vincent Ciattei, Greg Chiles, Patrick Joseph and Neil Gourley to the indoor national championship in the DMR where the captured the win in 9:30.76.
