KEY STORYLINES

- Tech is second in the ACC standings at 15-3
- The Hokies enter this weekend with an NCAA RPI of No. 17
- Tech is first in the nation with 19 shutouts
- The Hokies are 9-4 against ranked opponents
- Tech ranks second in home runs per game (2.07) and sixth nationally in fielding percentage (.982)
- Tech hit 11 home runs in its 21-0 win at Pitt – the second most hit in a game in NCAA history
- Cori McMillan broke her own program single-season home run record (23). She hit 21 last season
- McMillan leads the team with a .444 batting average and the nation with 23 home runs
- She hit the walk-off home run in Tech's 6-5 win over No. 16 Stanford (3/30)
- Bre Peck broke the all-time home run record and the all-time RBI record with three home runs in Tech's win over Charlotte
- Peck (53) broke the previous home run record of 50 held by Megan Evans (2002-05)
- Peck (175) broke the previous RBI record of 170 held by Kelsey Bennett (2019-23)
- McMillan and Peck became the third and fourth players in Virginia Tech history to hit three home runs in a game (Peck 4/8, McMillan 4/18)
- Through 44 games, seven Hokies are hitting .300 or above
- Thirteen different Hokies have hit a home run this season
- Tech swept Louisville, No. 16 Stanford, NC State and Notre Dame in league play
- The Hokies also went 2-1 in their ACC-opening series against No. 23/RV Virginia
- Going .636 with four home runs at Louisville, Michelle Chatfield was named the D1 Softball National Player of the Week (3/18)
- Her and Emma Lemley also earned ACC Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively (3/18)
- Lemley was given the first golden ticket by the AUSL – signifying she will be drafted
- Lemley threw her nation-leading fourth no-hitter of the season at Kentucky
- Lemley became the first player in program history to throw back-to-back perfect games in wins against the College of Charleston (2/9) and No. 21 Northwestern (2/15)
- Three of her four no-hitters (two of which were perfect games) came against opponents who were ranked or receiving votes
- Lemley is now a three-time ACC Pitcher of the Week this season (2/11, 2/18, 3/18)
- Lemley has a 2.40 ERA and is 15-4 on the season
- Lemley's four no-hitters are tied for the second most in a single season at Virginia Tech
- Sophie Kleiman, a transfer from Indiana, is 10-1 this season with a 1.36 ERA
- Jordan Lynch has started all 44 games and is second on the team with a .397 batting average
- Tech set a program record holding opponents scoreless for 46 innings to start the season
- Tech is in search of its sixth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance in 2025
- Finishing at 40-14-1 in 2024, the Hokies have had two 40-win seasons in the past three years and have finished with 37 or more in all five full seasons under D'Amour
- Tech continued to put up staggering offensive numbers in 2024, being ranked in the top five nationally, ranking second with 2.09 home runs per game, third in slugging percentage (.633), fourth in scoring (7.58) and fifth in batting average (.342)
- 2024 marked the second year in a row Tech has finished No. 2 nationally in home runs per game
- Head coach Pete D'Amour has a .767 winning percentage at Virginia Tech
