## ► EXIT LIGHT, ENTER HOKIES

### VIRGINIA TECH PRIMED FOR HOME OPENER

• Virginia Tech head coach Brent Pry is 3-0 when competing in home openers at Lane Stadium/Worsham Field.

• During Pry's tenure, the Hokies have posted home-opening victories against Boston College (2022), Old Dominion (2023) and Marshall (2024) - all sellouts.

• Each of Virginia Tech's three home-opening victories under Pry have been by 17 points or more. The Hokies have scored at least 27 points during each such win and have held their opponents to no more than 17 points.

### A DECADE OF HOME-OPENING SUCCESS

• Virginia Tech has won nine consecutive home-opening games dating back to the 2016 season. Notable performances include:

• **2017:** No. 18 Virginia Tech shut out Delaware, 27-0, behind Josh Jackson's two touchdown passes and a mammoth defensive day by Tremaine Edwards (4.0 TFLs, 1.5 sacks). The Hokies' defense totaled 12 TFLs, four sacks, an interception and a fumble recovery.

• **2018:** No. 12 Virginia Tech walloped William & Mary, 62-17, producing 586 yards of total offense. The Hokies won the rushing yards battle, 305-34.

• **2020:** During the first game after the COVID-19 pandemic had broken, No. 20 Virginia Tech defeated NC State, 45-24. The Hokies pounced, building a 31-7 lead during the second quarter. Khalil Herbert logged 195 all-purpose yards (104 rushing) while the defense combined for six sacks and two interceptions.

• **2021:** With fans returning to Lane Stadium/Worsham Field in full force as the COVID-19 pandemic subsided, Virginia Tech upset No. 10 North Carolina, 17-10.

• **2022:** Brent Pry notched his first career head coaching victory as Virginia Tech downed Boston College, 27-10. The Hokies held the Eagles to 4 rushing yards, partly with TyJuan Garbutt boasting 3.0 TFLs, a solo sack, a forced fumble and a pass breakup.

### PRY'S VANDERBILT TIES

• Virginia Tech head coach Brent Pry spent three seasons at Vanderbilt (2011-13) as the Commodores' co-defensive coordinator and linebackers coach.

• Under head coach James Franklin, Pry helped Vanderbilt put together consecutive nine-win seasons, including back-to-back bowl wins (2012, 2013). The Commodores celebrated SEC victories against Florida, Georgia and Tennessee during the 2013 campaign.

### DOUBLE DOSE OF THE SEC

• After opening the 2025 season against No. 13 South Carolina in the Aflac Kickoff Game (Atlanta, Georgia), Virginia Tech will go toe-to-toe with another SEC foe in Vanderbilt. The Commodores cruised to the 45-3 home win against Charleston Southern on Aug. 30.

• The Hokies are facing multiple SEC opponents within the same season for the first time since 2016. That fall, Virginia Tech lost in September to No. 17 Tennessee, 45-24, at Bristol Motor Speedway, avenging the result in December with its 35-24 victory against Arkansas in the Belk Bowl (scored 35 unanswered points to win).

### DRONES PASSES MILESTONE

• Virginia Tech redshirt-senior quarterback Kyron Drones surpassed 4,000 career passing yards (4,087) during the Hokies' Aug. 31 opener against No. 13 South Carolina.

• Drones enters Saturday's game with 3,868 career passing yards at Virginia Tech, needing 132 yards to eclipse the 4,000-yard mark with the Hokies. He is also 431 yards away from matching Steve Casey (1979-81) for 10th place on the program's all-time passing list.

## MATCHUP AT A GLANCE

• Virginia Tech leads the all-time series against Vanderbilt, 6-4.

• The Hokies' series against the Commodores dates back to 1930 when the two programs met at Dudley Field in Nashville, Tennessee, as members of the Southern Conference (Vanderbilt prevailed, 40-0.)

• Six of the 10 prior head-to-head meetings between the two programs took place during the 1980s (Virginia Tech controlled the 5-1 advantage during the decade).

• The Hokies are 3-0 when opposing the Commodores at Lane Stadium, having won games during 1983 (21-10), 1986 (29-21) and 1989 (18-0).

• Virginia Tech opened the 2024 regular season by renewing its series with Vanderbilt for the first time since 1989. The Hokies were narrowly defeated in overtime, 34-27, at FirstBank Stadium in Nashville.

• During the 2024 meeting, Virginia Tech trailed, 17-0, during the second quarter, though rallied during the second half to take the 27-20 lead with 4:21 remaining in regulation. However, the Commodores answered by scoring the game-tying touchdown with 1:51 to play in the fourth quarter, completing another touchdown drive during the extra period before denying the Hokies their chance to extend the game.

• Saturday's 2025 meeting between Virginia Tech and Vanderbilt features a rematch between starting quarterbacks Kyron Drones and Diego Pavia. In 2024, Drones connected for 22 completions totaling 322 passing yards (career high) and two touchdowns; Pavia was 12-for-16 through the air while accounting for 190 passing yards, 104 rushing yards and three total touchdowns - including the game-winning, 4-yard touchdown rush during overtime.

• The Hokies outgained the Commodores, 397-371, in total offensive yards during the teams' 2024 meeting in Nashville.

• Virginia Tech enters Saturday's game seeking its first victory against a non-ACC, Power Four opponent since Sept. 3, 2017, when the Hokies defeated West Virginia, 31-24, at FedEx Field in Landover, Maryland (spans 15 attempts).

• The Hokies' most recent win against the SEC took place during the 2016 Belk Bowl against Arkansas (35-24); No. 18 Virginia Tech trailed the Razorbacks, 24-0, at halftime before scoring 35 unanswered points in triumph.

## GREENE MACHINE

- Donavon Greene (transfer from Wake Forest) suited up for the first time in maroon and orange during Virginia Tech's season opener against No. 13 South Carolina.
- Donavon made three receptions totaling 94 receiving yards. Each of his receptions chalked as a "big play" of 25 or more yards, advancing the chains each time.
- Junior wide receiver Ayden Greene also had a solid day against the Gamecocks, registering five receptions and 71 receiving yards, including a 36-yard haul.

- Ayden's performance in the Aflac Kickoff Game followed his first career 100-yard receiving game during the 2025 Duke's Mayo Bowl (six catches, 115 receiving yards).

## D-LINE DEPTH

- Twelve (12) distinct defensive linemen played during Virginia Tech's season opener against No. 13 South Carolina, including 10 who logged double-digit snap counts.
- Seven of the Hokies' linemen contributed at least two tackles into the team's defensive total.
- Virginia Tech totaled seven TFLs and sacked the Gamecocks' quarterback, LaNorris Sellers, four times.
- Redshirt-freshman Emmett Laws had a hand in two of the Hokies' sacks - one of which went down for a safety during the first quarter.
- Elhadj Fall - one of six transfers onto the line this season - came up big during his Virginia Tech debut, recording a 14-yard strip sack of Sellers.

## LOVE-LY START

- Virginia Tech placekicker John Love started the 2025 season on the right foot against No. 13 South Carolina, kicking the 40th, 41st and 42nd field goals of his collegiate career. In order, Love converted from 29 yards, 56 yards and 39 yards against the Gamecocks.
- Love's 56-yard boot ended the first half, capping a successful two-minute drill by the Hokies that drew them within 10-8 at halftime. The kick marked the third longest of his career behind his 60-yard field goal during the 2025 Duke's Mayo Bowl and his 57-yard field goal at No. 7 Miami during the 2024 regular season.
- The product of Spartanburg, South Carolina, was named to the Lou Groza Award watch list this summer. To date, he has made 42 of his 47 career field goals for an 89.4 make percentage.
- Love has made four field goals of 50 yards or longer and owns three of the top five longest kicks spanning Virginia Tech program history.
- With 210 career points, Love enters Saturday's game against Vanderbilt nine points shy of cracking the Hokies' top-10 scoring list.

## COPELAND RETURNS

- Virginia Tech defensive tackle Kemari Copeland returned to the Hokies' lineup at the Aflac Kickoff Game after missing the final eight games of the 2024 season due to injury.
- A redshirt-junior from Virginia Beach, Virginia, Copeland registered five tackles against No. 13 South Carolina, including a TFL.
- Affectionately known as "The Hulk," Copeland was one of three Hokies named to *The Athletic's* "Freaks List" by Bruce Feldman. He has a vertical jump of 32.5 inches and can squat 685 pounds.

## HAWKINS MAKES HOKIES DEBUT

- Running back Marcellous Hawkins made his Virginia Tech debut against No. 13 South Carolina, turning in a workmanlike effort.

- Hawkins recorded 15 carries totaling 58 rushing yards against a quality defense, averaging nearly 4.0 yards per carry.
- The native of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, transferred to Virginia Tech after spending three seasons at Central Missouri. His best season came during 2023 when he rushed for 1,053 yards (team high) on 157 carries, scoring 18 rushing touchdowns.

## PRESEASON PRAISE FOR DRONES

- Virginia Tech quarterback Kyron Drones garnered plenty of recognition entering his final season in Blacksburg.
- Drones, who was hampered by injuries at the end of the 2024 season, finds himself on watch lists for the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award, the Maxwell Award, the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award and the Senior Bowl 300.

## NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Like Antwaun Powell-Ryland, Kelvin Gilliam and Kaleb Spencer before them, five members of Virginia Tech's 2025 transfer class have returned home to the Commonwealth of Virginia after starting their careers out of state:

- **S - Jordan Bass (Hampton, Va.):** Spent the past two seasons at Pitt, where he played in 19 games, recording 25 tackles, 5.5 TFLs and a sack. Bass is a former four-star recruit and was the No. 4 player from Virginia in the Class of 2023 according to *247Sports*.

- **S - Sherrod Covil (Chesapeake, Va.):** Arrives in Blacksburg following three seasons at Clemson. The senior played in 32 games with the Tigers, registering 36 tackles (14 solo), 1.0 TFL and a pass breakup. Covil was a top-10 player from Virginia in the Class of 2022.

- **DL - James Djonkam (Springfield, Va.):** Played two seasons at Arizona State and most recently at Eastern Michigan in 2024. Last season, he led EMU in tackles with 98 (34 solo), tallying 11.5 TFLs with 3.0 sacks, three pass breakups, four quarterback hurries and a forced fumble. Djonkam was a 2024 All-MAC Second Team selection.

- **DL - Immanuel Hickman Sr. (Chesterfield, Va.):** Joins Virginia Tech after starting his career at East Carolina, playing in 31 games through three seasons, making 16 starts. Hickman spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons at South Florida where he saw action in 14 games with the Bulls.

- **WR - Cameron Seldon (Browns Store, Va.):** Spent the previous two seasons at Tennessee, playing in 19 games at running back (despite making the move to wide receiver). Seldon carried the ball 48 times for the Volunteers, totaling 224 rushing yards and a touchdown, averaging 5.1 yards per carry during the 2024 season. The junior was the top ranked player from Virginia in the Class of 2023 according to *247Sports*.

## NEW STAFF ADDITIONS IN 2025

- Pry added/promoted several new assistant coaches during the offseason:

- **Philip Montgomery** (offensive coordinator)
- **Sam Siefkes** (defensive coordinator)
- **Matt Moore** (offensive line coach)
- **Jarrett Ferguson** (strength & conditioning coach)

- Montgomery was the head coach at Tulsa from 2015 to 2022 and has held offensive coordinator titles at Auburn, Baylor and Houston, as well as with the Birmingham Stallions during their 2024 UFL championship season.

- Among Montgomery's former pupils are 2011 Heisman Trophy winner Robert Griffin III (Baylor), Big 12 Player of the Year Bryce Petty (Baylor) and NFL quarterbacks Case Keenum (Houston) and Kevin Kolb (Houston).

- Siefkes arrived in Blacksburg following four seasons of coaching linebackers in the NFL, serving on the staffs at the Arizona Cardinals (2023-24) and the Minnesota Vikings (2021-22).

- From 2018 to 2020, Siefkes was the defensive coordinator at Wofford, where he developed one of the top-ranked NCAA FCS defenses.

- Moore joined the Hokies following six seasons coaching at West Virginia, including the previous five seasons serving as offensive line coach. Prior to working with the Mountaineers, he made coaching stops at Troy, Louisiana Tech, Texas Tech and Middle Tennessee.

- Ferguson was promoted this offseason to assistant athletic director of football strength and conditioning, having held 16 years of experience as a member of the Virginia Tech strength and conditioning staff.

- A fullback for the Hokies under head coach Frank Beamer, Ferguson played a key role on four bowl teams, including the 1999 squad that finished as national runner-up to Florida State (2000 Sugar Bowl).

- In addition to Virginia Tech's core staff additions/promotions, Stu Holt is now the standalone special teams coordinator while Brent Davis serves as tight ends coach. Shawn Quinn assumed the role of outside linebackers coach while Xavier Adibi tutors the inside linebackers.

## GOOD WORKS NOMINEE

### TYSON FLOWERS

Safety **Tyson Flowers** has been nominated for the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, and is on the watch list for the Wuerffel Trophy, college football's highest community service honor.

The Allstate AFCA Good Works Team is comprised of 22 college football student-athletes and one honorary head coach who make outstanding contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement, 11 of which are FBS players. These individuals embody the true spirit of teamwork and giving back through commendable acts of kindness. The Allstate Wuerffel Trophy is presented to the FBS player who best combines exemplary community service with leadership achievement on and off the field.

Flowers, from Fort Worth, Texas, transferred this offseason to Virginia Tech from Rice where he played in 10 games, making 38 tackles, recording two interceptions, two breakups and a forced fumble en route to being named All-AAC Honorable Mention by College Football Network.

During his time in Blacksburg, Flowers has embraced the university's **Ut Prosim** motto, "That I may serve," making a positive impact in the New River Valley and surrounding area. Among his efforts he has volunteered with Night to Shine, a program of the Tim Tebow Foundation that provides a prom-night experience for people with special needs, ages 14 and older. Tyson's role involved greeting guests, assisting with activities, and ensuring each participant felt celebrated and included throughout the night.

Flowers has also given his time to visit students at Pulaski County Schools and created Valentine's Day cards for patients at Warm Hearth Village Senior Living and Carilion Children's Hospital, in addition to volunteering for the Ronald McDonald House of SW Virginia. He helped celebrate their annual "Tab Top" recycling event, by greeting families, signing autographs and inspiring young fans. The event allows elementary schools and local businesses to collect aluminum tab tops from any container (soda pop, soup, pet food, etc.) and work with a local recycling company to turn those tabs into money for families of hospitalized children.

### COACHING HIGHLIGHTS

• Brent Pry begins his fourth season in Blacksburg after serving as defensive coordinator/linebackers coach at Penn State.

• Pry returned to Blacksburg in November 2021 after working as a defensive graduate assistant for the Hokies from 1995 to 1997 under head coach Frank Beamer and defensive coordinator Bud Foster.

• A 30-year coaching veteran, Pry has coached teams that have qualified for 15 bowl appearances and have finished inside the FBS top 25 in total defense eight times.

• He has played an instrumental role in coaching top 10 defenses at Virginia Tech, Penn State, Vanderbilt, Georgia Southern and Western Carolina.

• During Pry's tenure as defensive coordinator at Penn State from 2016 to 2021, the Nittany Lions posted three seasons with 11 wins and four seasons with nine or more victories. He helped the Nittany Lions to the 2016 Big Ten Championship, defeating No. 6 Wisconsin, 38-31, at Lucas Oil Stadium.

• His longtime association with current Penn State football head coach James Franklin dates back to the 1993 season when Franklin was the quarterback for East Stroudsburg University, where Pry coached outside linebackers and defensive backs.

• Pry was a 2021 Broyles Award nominee for the top assistant coach in the country as the Nittany Lions ranked fourth nationally in red zone defense (66.7%), seventh in scoring defense (16.8 points per game), eighth in defensive pass efficiency (111.98) and held their opponents to 4.7 yards per play.

• Under Pry's direction in 2020, Penn State ranked third in the Big Ten in total defense (328.8 yards per game) - the 17th best mark nationally - second in pass defense (198.6 yards per game), second in TFLs per game (6.7) and fourth in rush defense (130.2 yards per game).

• Pry's defense helped lead Penn State to an 11-2 record in 2019, ranking eighth nationally in scoring defense (16.0 points per game). The Nittany Lions also led the nation in fewest yards allowed per carry (2.6) and forced fumbles (22) while ranking fifth in rushing defense (95.0 yards per game).

• In 2018, Pry's Penn State defense led the nation in sacks per game (3.62) and ranked fourth in TFLs per game (8.2). His 2018 squad also ranked fifth in fewest yards per pass attempt (5.67), eighth in defensive pass efficiency (106.1) and 11th in red zone scoring percentage (.750).

• Penn State registered an 11-2 record in 2017 with Pry earning his first Broyles Award nomination. The Nittany Lions finished seventh in FBS scoring defense (16.5 points per game) and sacks per game (3.23) during the 2017 campaign.

• After taking sole reins as Penn State's defensive coordinator post in 2016, the team posted an 11-3 mark and finished seventh in the nation, averaging 8.1 TFLs per game.

• As co-defensive coordinator for Penn State in 2014, Pry helped direct a unit that finished second in FBS in total defense (278.7 yards per game).

• Pry served as co-defensive coordinator at Vanderbilt from 2011 to 2013 prior to his arrival in State College, Pennsylvania.

• While at Georgia Southern in 2010, his defensive unit helped the Eagles to a win over No. 1 Appalachian State and made an appearance in the NCAA FCS semifinals.

• A member of the Memphis staff from 2007 to 2009, Pry's defensive line corps helped the Tigers to back-to-back bowl appearances.

• He also coached at Louisiana-Lafayette (2002-06), helping the Ragin' Cajuns to their first Sun Belt Conference championship following a four-year tour of duty at Western Carolina (1998-2001).

• During his stint as a graduate assistant at Tech from 1995 to 1997, he was a part of the staff that guided the Hokies to three bowl berths.

• Pry lettered as a defensive back at the University of Buffalo before suffering a career-ending injury. He began his coaching career as an undergraduate student in 1992, graduating in 1993 with his degree in history from Buffalo.

• Pry's father, Jim, played collegiately at Marshall and began his own 40-year college coaching career at his alma mater in 1973. The elder Pry went on to enjoy a distinguished career that included stops at Illinois, Duke, Dartmouth, Akron, East Stroudsburg, Buffalo, VMI and Bethune-Cookman, as well as time as a high school head coach.

• Pry and his wife, Amy, are the parents of a son, Colby, and two daughters, Madeline and Catherine.

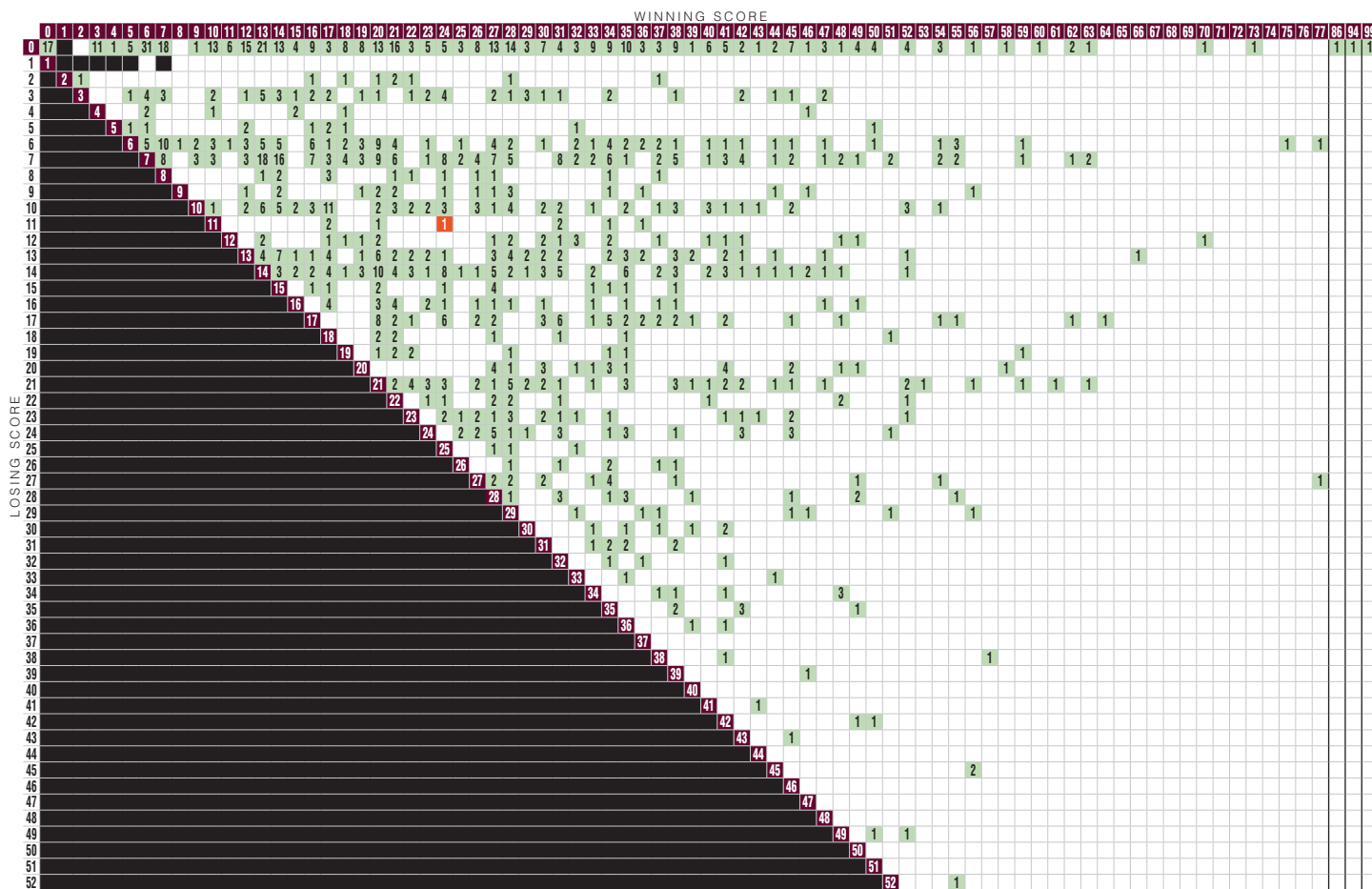

### What is Scorigami?

Scorigami is the art of building final scores that have never happened before. The concept was thought of by Jon Bois who sought to find unique scores in NFL history. In this case, we use it to see how often a score or range of points scored occurs, essentially creating a heat map of results across Virginia Tech football's history. Each data point is the final score of a Virginia Tech football game.

### How do I read this chart?

The winning team's score is along the top (horizontal axis) and the losing team's score is along the left (vertical axis). Scores marked in green have happened, scores in white have not yet happened, scores in black are impossible. The bottom half is all black because the losing team can not score more points than the winning team. The orange square is the most recent game. The numbers inside the squares are the amount of times that score has happened. The higher the number in the square, the more common the score.

## SCORING STREAK

Virginia Tech's current **384**-game scoring streak from 1995 to present stands as the 4th-longest in Division I-A college history. In that span, the Hokies have shutout their opponents **34** times. Tech has scored on its first offensive possession **131** times, plus another five occasions where it scored on returns on its first touch of the game. The Hokies have scored in the first quarter **280** times during the streak, and have had it extended by halftime in **365** of the **384** games.
